Highlight length of program and access or mobility features that would be of interest to an employer.</i>	MSTP is designed to provide foundational manufacturing skills for local employers and meet the training requirements for the manufacturing industry. MSTP offers an Introduction to Manufacturing component that is mostly an online independent study format that takes 4 to 6 weeks to complete. MSTP also offers a Manufacturing Technician "Boot Camp" format that provides online and in-class hands-on experience with industry equipment that takes 12 weeks to complete. Depending on which component the student completes will depend on the amount of time they spend on the following: Preparatory Electricity & Electronic Training (PEET), Industrial trainer, Pneumatic training, Hydraulic training, Industrial motors training, and Robotics training.
