The program will focus on:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• exploring the process of drug and device development</li> <li>• the federal regulations that guide clinical trials</li> <li>• learning how to read a clinical protocol</li> </ul> <p>The modules are designed help learn how to use the clinical protocol to run the day to day operations, including how to screen and enroll study participants, follow a study protocol, and manage study documentation. Protocol amendments, the formal process for making changes to a protocol will be introduced.</p> <p>The program is intended to be completed in an online format with competency evaluations at the end of each of nine modules prior to advancement to the next module. The program can be completed in 30 contact hours but offers up to 60 contact hours with enhancements.</p>
