

**Public Notice for Procurement of Qualified Environmental Professional  
(QEP) Service Proposal**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Northern Nevada Development Authority (NNDA) is requesting written, sealed proposals only, for a Qualified Environmental Professional (QEP).

NNDA will use U.S. Environmental Protection Agency grant funding to conduct assessments of contaminated or potentially contaminated properties (“Brownfields”) within the boundaries of Carson City, Douglas, Lyon, Mineral and Storey Counties. The selected QEP will assist by providing project management, community outreach services, preparing an inventory of potential Brownfields sites, conducting Phase I and Phase II assessments, Certified Site packages and developing clean-up plans.

Said proposals must be in the hands of NNDA at 308 N. Curry St Ste 101, Carson City, Nevada 89703, **NO LATER THAN 5:00 p.m. on August 1, 2023**. Proposals postmarked but not received until after this deadline will not be accepted. Vendor submittals may not be sent via the Internet/e-mail and will not be entertained for award by NNDA.
