
Takeaways

- As of 2023 the region's population increased by 6.6% since 2018, growing by 1,630. Population is expected to increase by 5.8% between 2023 and 2028, adding 1,517.
- From 2018 to 2023, jobs increased by 7.6% in Churchill County, NV from 10,292 to 11,076. This change outpaced the national growth rate of 3.6% by 4.0%. As the number of jobs increased, the labor force participation rate decreased from 58.7% to 56.6% between 2018 and 2023.
- Concerning educational attainment, **13.2% of Churchill County, NV residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (8.0% below the national average), and **10.8% hold an Associate's Degree** (1.8% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2023 are Federal Government, Military, Local Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals, and Federal Government, Civilian.











Unemployment by Ethnicity







Job Trends




Churchill County, NV had a January 2024 unemployment rate of 4.32%, increasing from 3.73% 5 years before.




Millennials

Churchill County, NV has 5,419 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 5,255.




Veterans

Churchill County, NV has 3,163 veterans. The national average for an area this size is 1,348.




Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is about average in Churchill County, NV. The national average for an area this size is 7,745 people 55 or older, while there are 8,362 here.




Violent Crime

Racial diversity is low in Churchill County, NV. The national average for an area this size is 10,628 racially diverse people, while there are 7,549 here.




Property Crime








Top Growing Industries






Top Industry Employment Concentration






Top Industry GRP





Top Occupation Employment Concentration









