- As of 2023 the region's population **increased by 4.9%** since 2018, growing by 108,215. Population is expected to **increase by 2.9%** between 2023 and 2028, adding 67,138.
- From 2018 to 2023, jobs **increased by 9.2%** in Clark County, NV from 1,101,528 to **1,202,851**. This change **outpaced the national growth rate of 3.6% by 5.6%**. As the number of jobs increased, the **labor force participation rate increased from 61.8% to 64.6% between 2018 and 2023**.
- Concerning educational attainment, **17.4% of Clark County, NV residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (3.7% below the national average), and **8.4% hold an Associate's Degree** (0.5% below the national average).
- The top three industries in 2023 are Traveler Accommodation, Restaurants and Other Eating Places, and Education and Hospitals (Local Government).

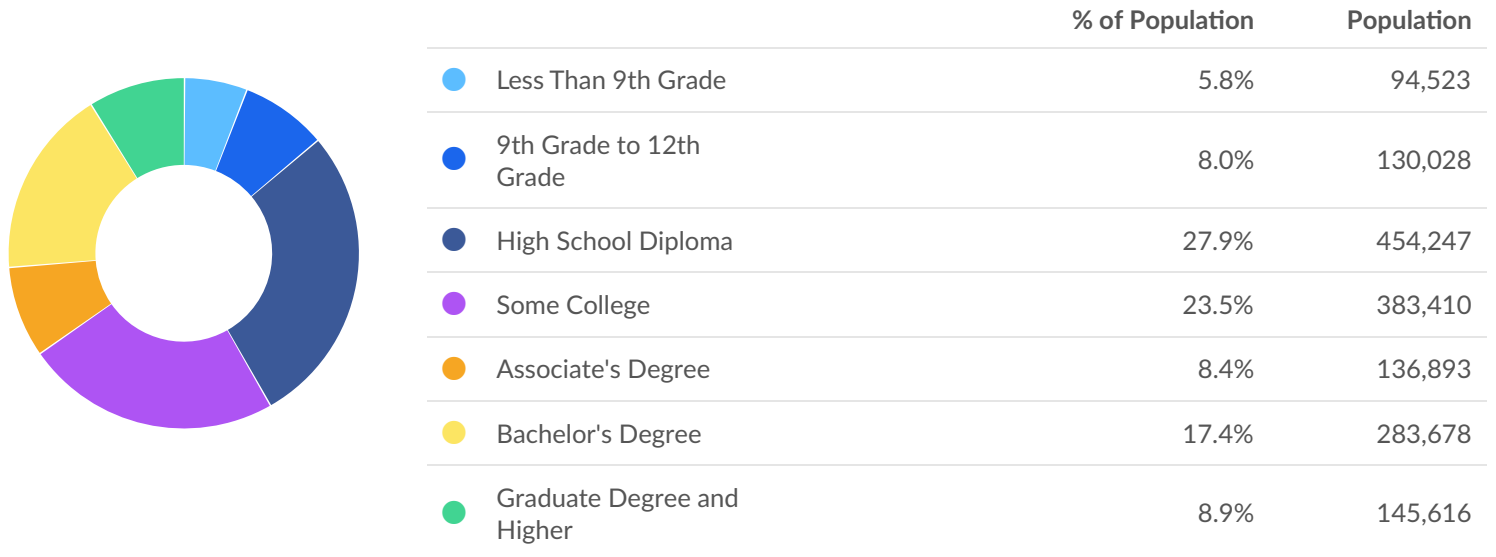

## Jan 2024 Labor Force Breakdown



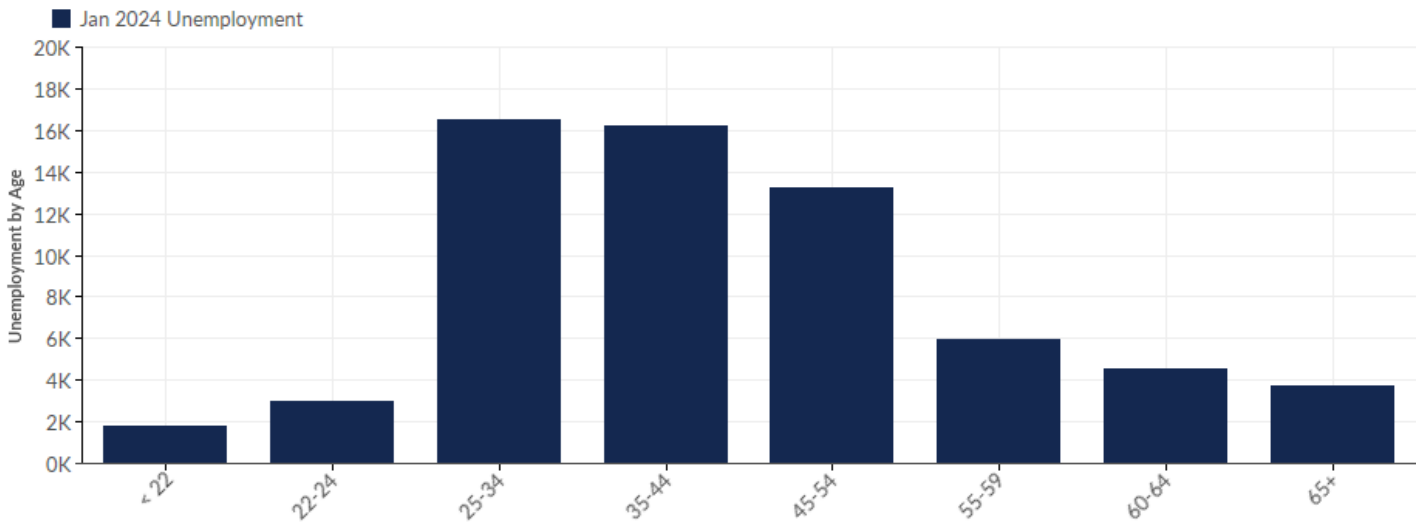
## Educational Attainment

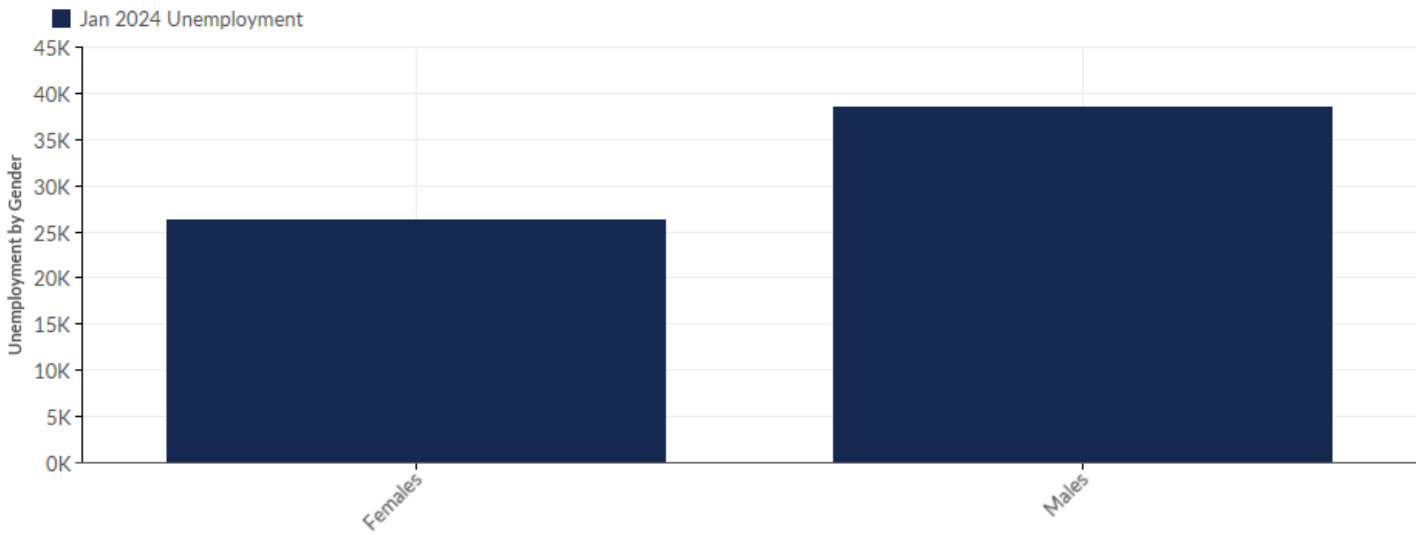

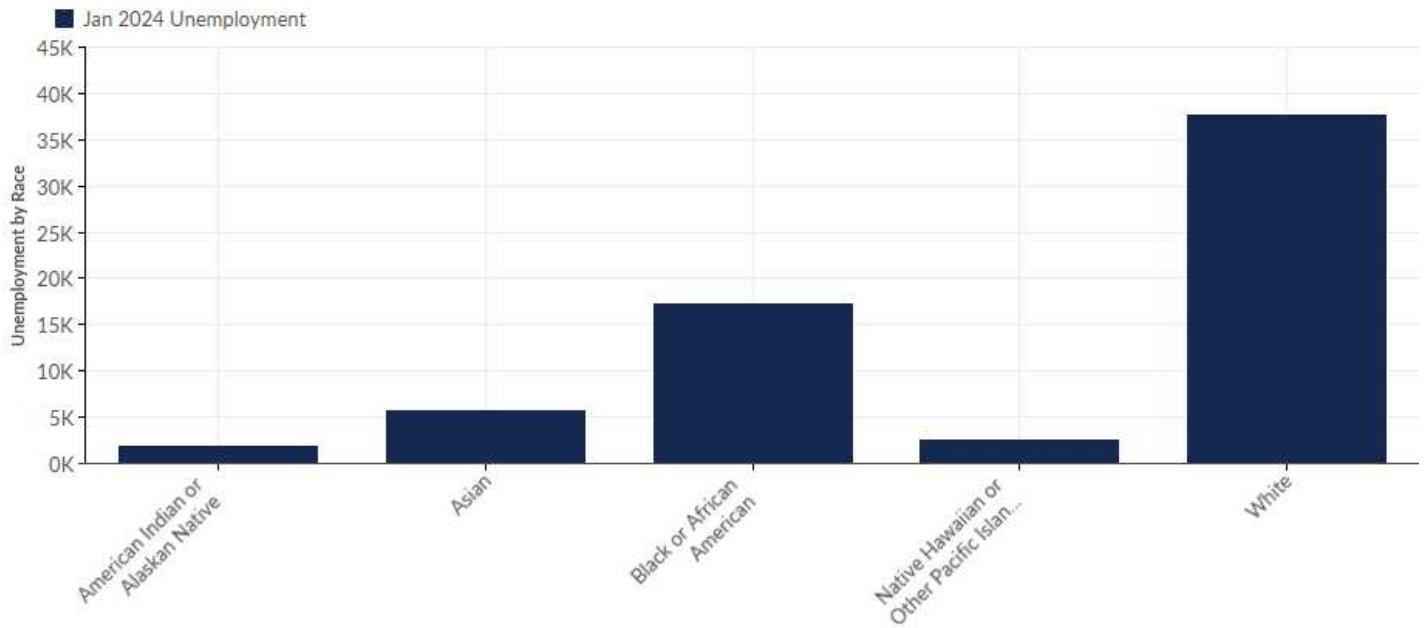

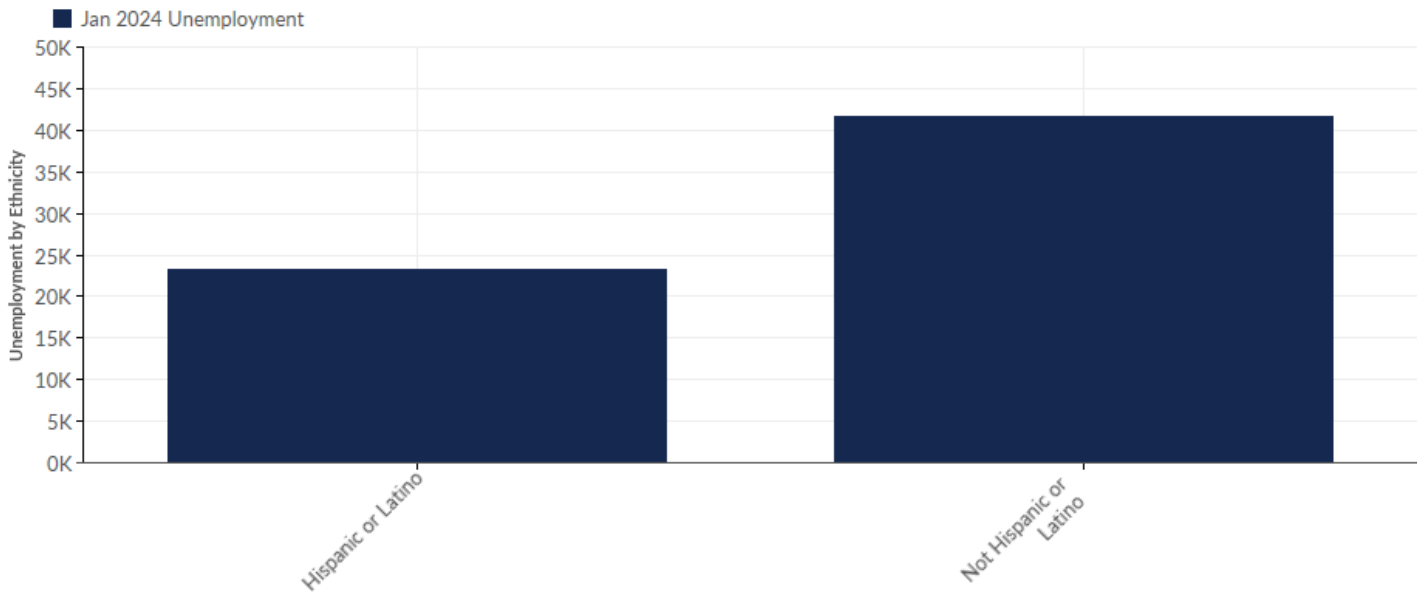

## Unemployment by Ethnicity

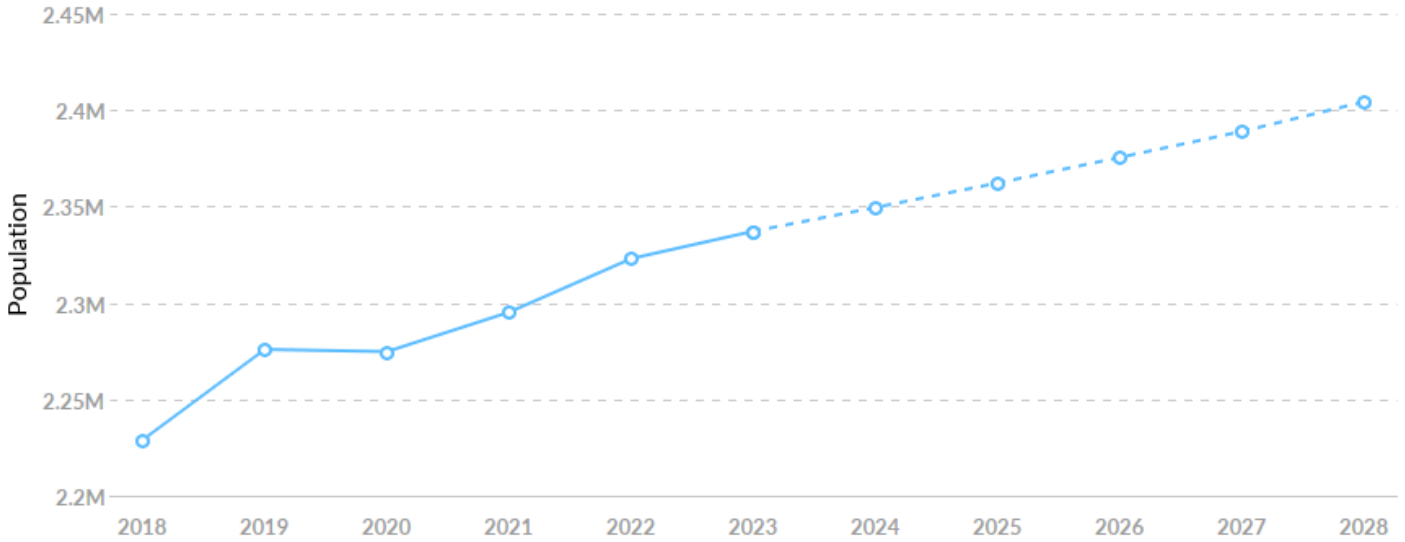

## Population Trends

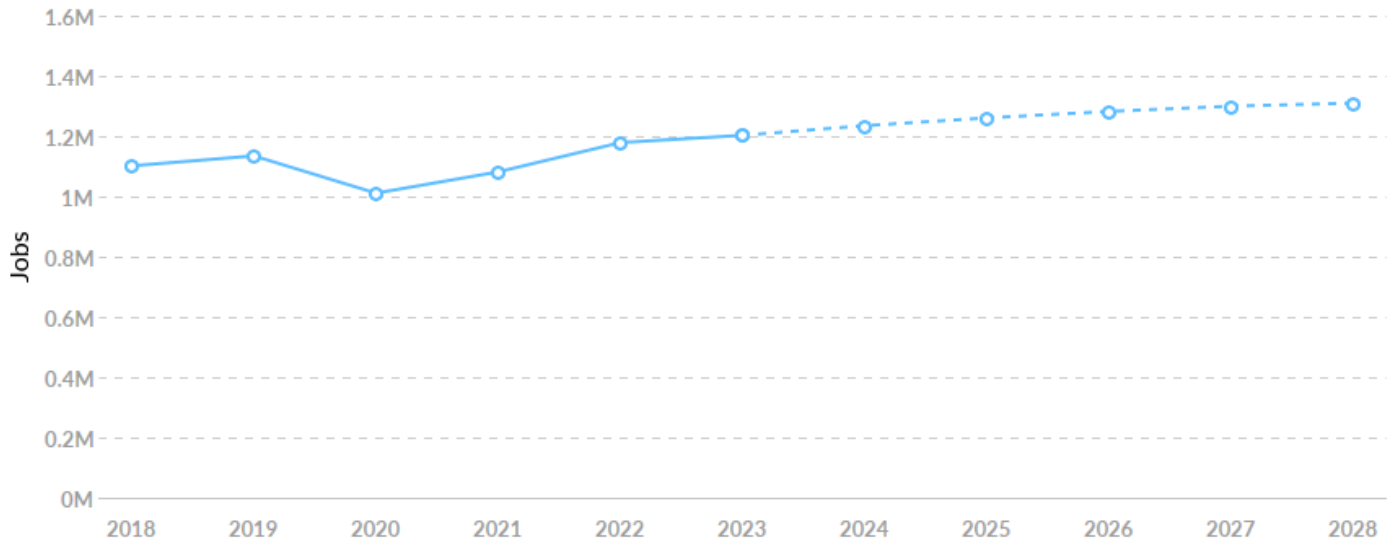

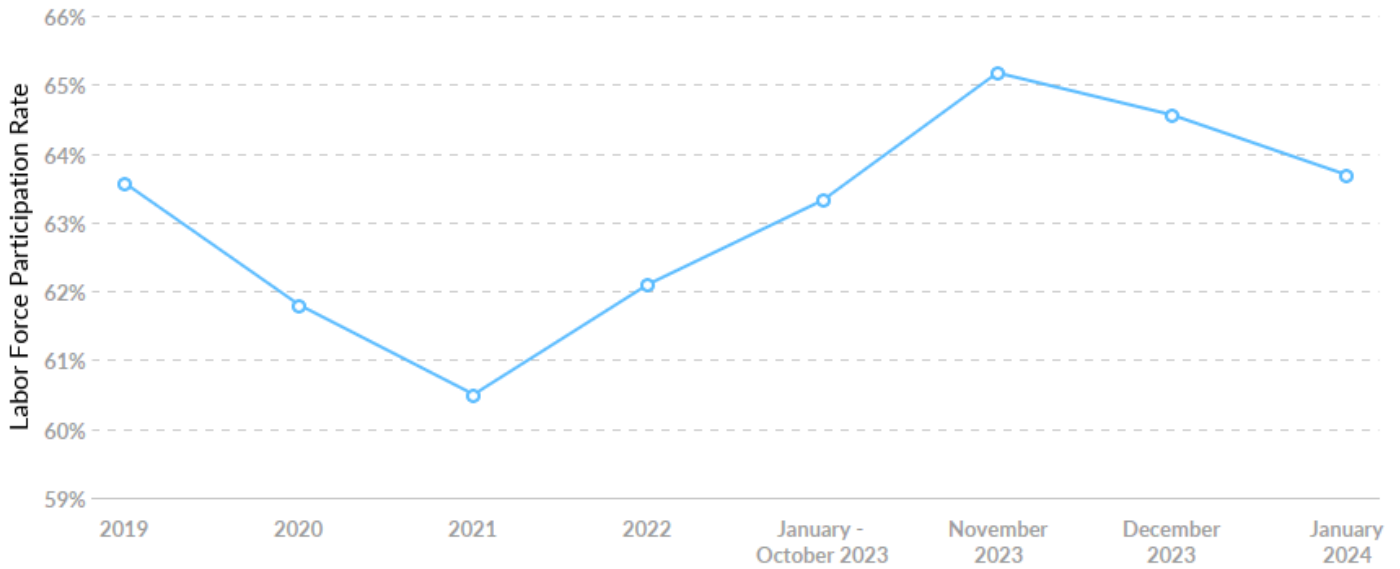
## Job Trends

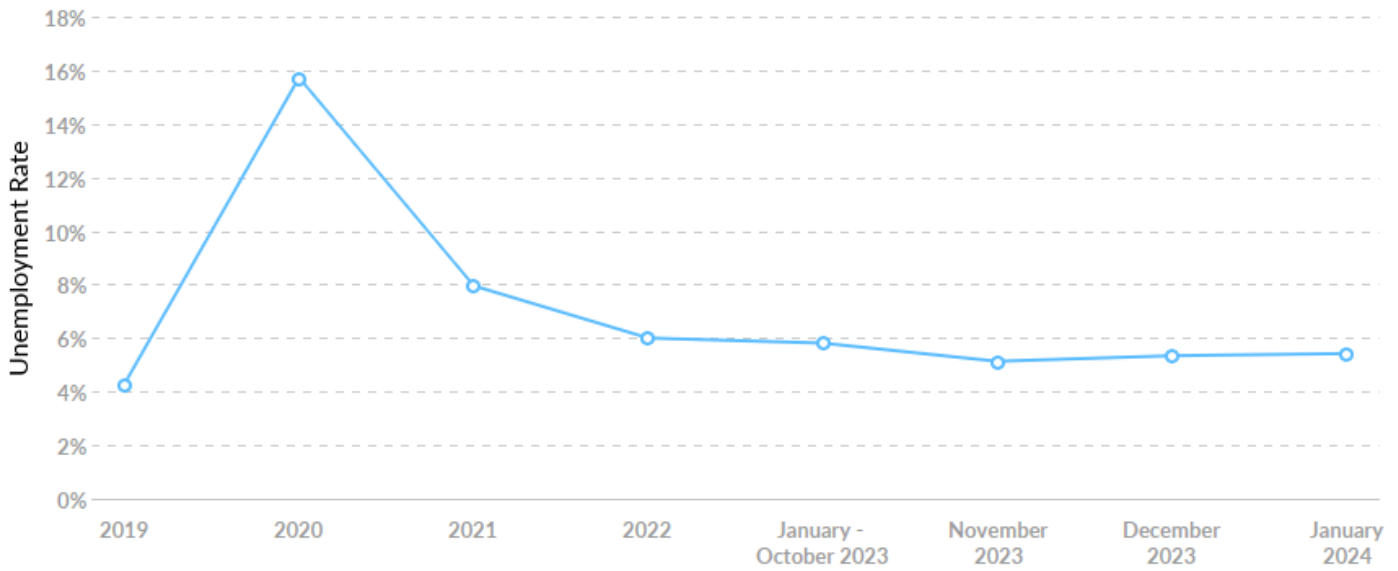

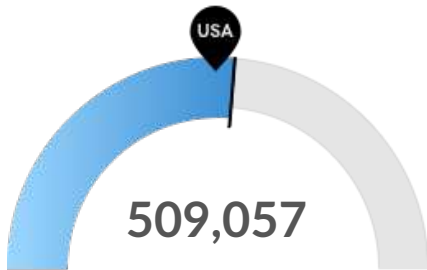
## Unemployment Rate Trends

Clark County, NV had a January 2024 unemployment rate of 5.42%, **increasing from 4.28%** 5 years before.



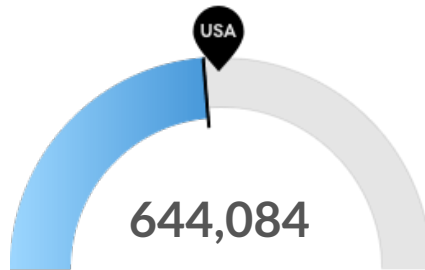

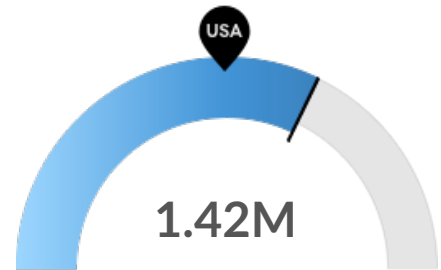
**Millennials**

Clark County, NV has 509,057 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 472,346.



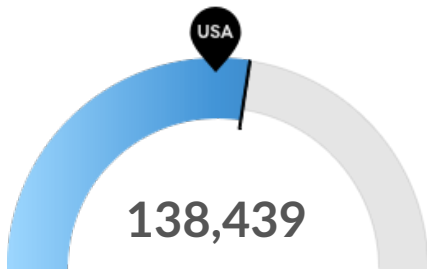
**Retiring Soon**

Retirement risk is about average in Clark County, NV. The national average for an area this size is 696,157 people 55 or older, while there are 644,084 here.



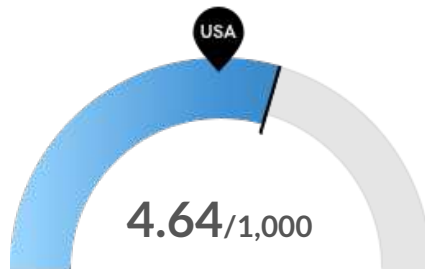
**Racial Diversity**

Racial diversity is high in Clark County, NV. The national average for an area this size is 955,307 racially diverse people, while there are 1,420,834 here.



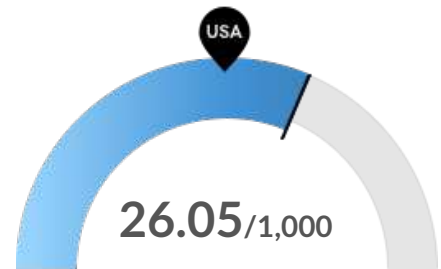
**Veterans**

Clark County, NV has 4.64 violent crimes per 1,000 people. The national rate is 3.6 per 1,000 people.

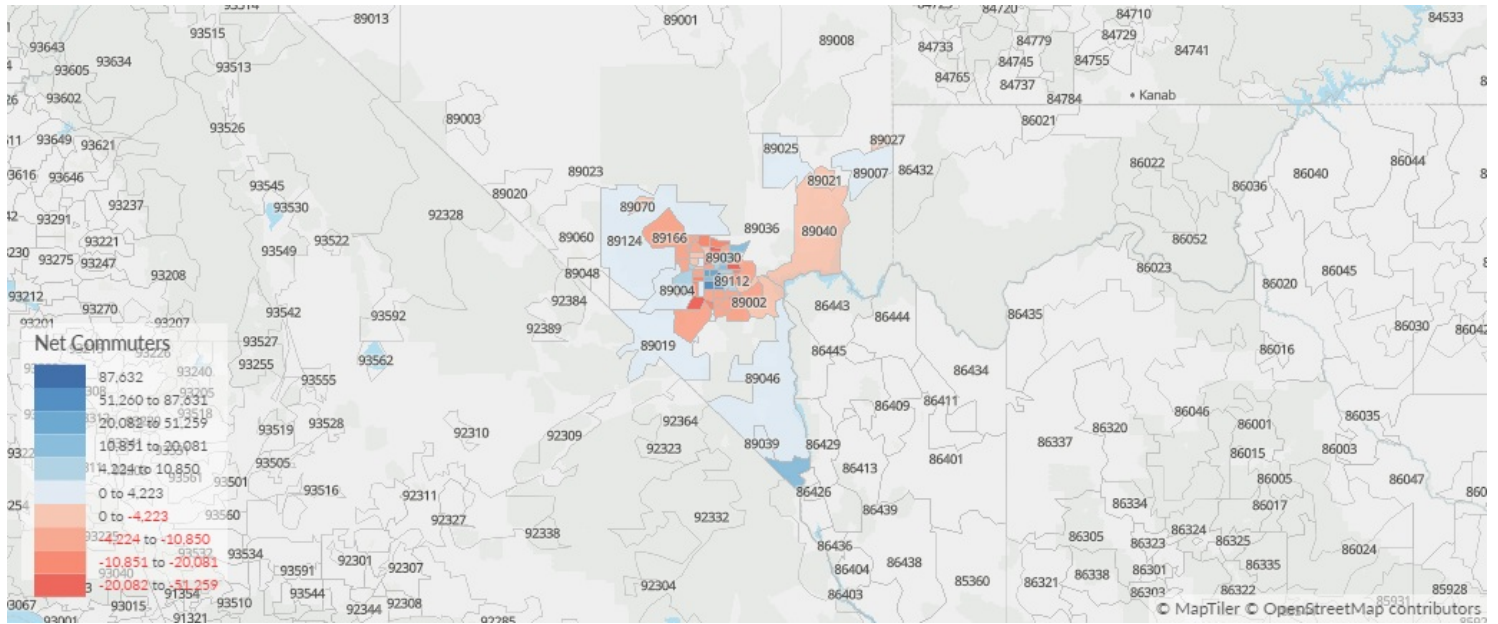


**Property Crime**

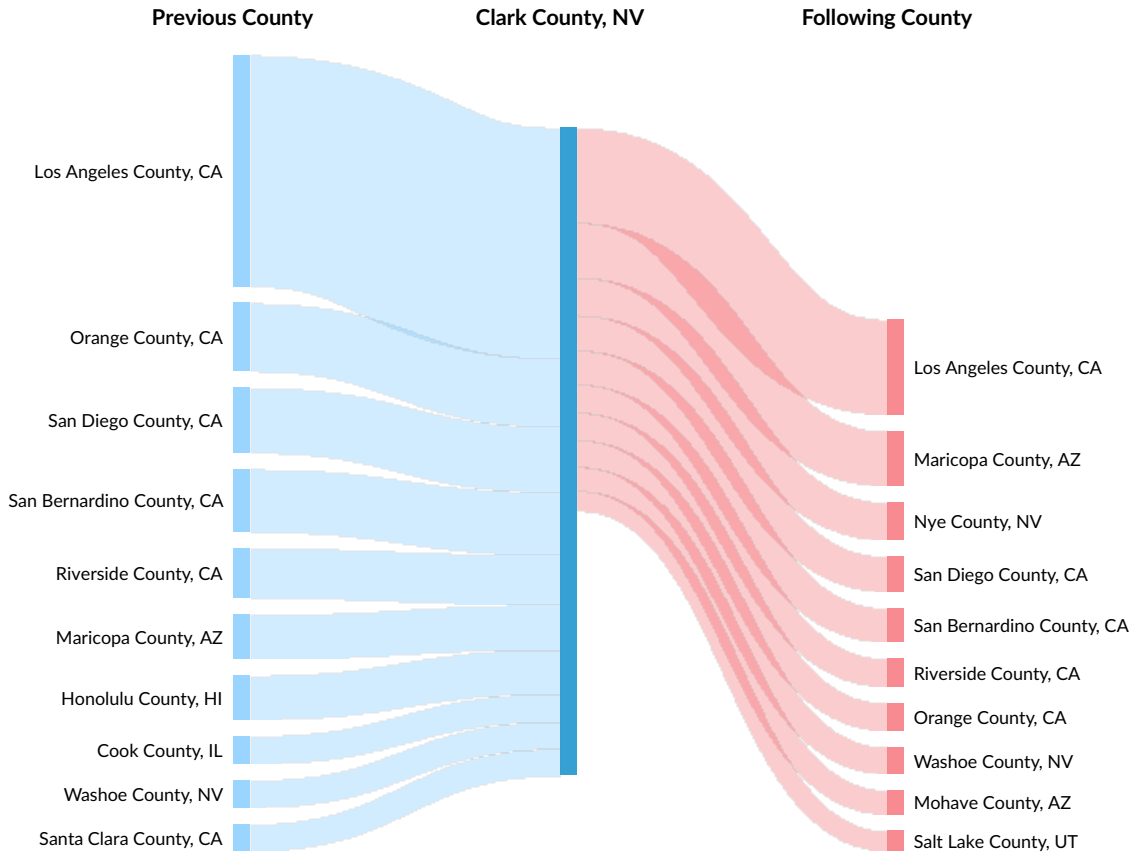

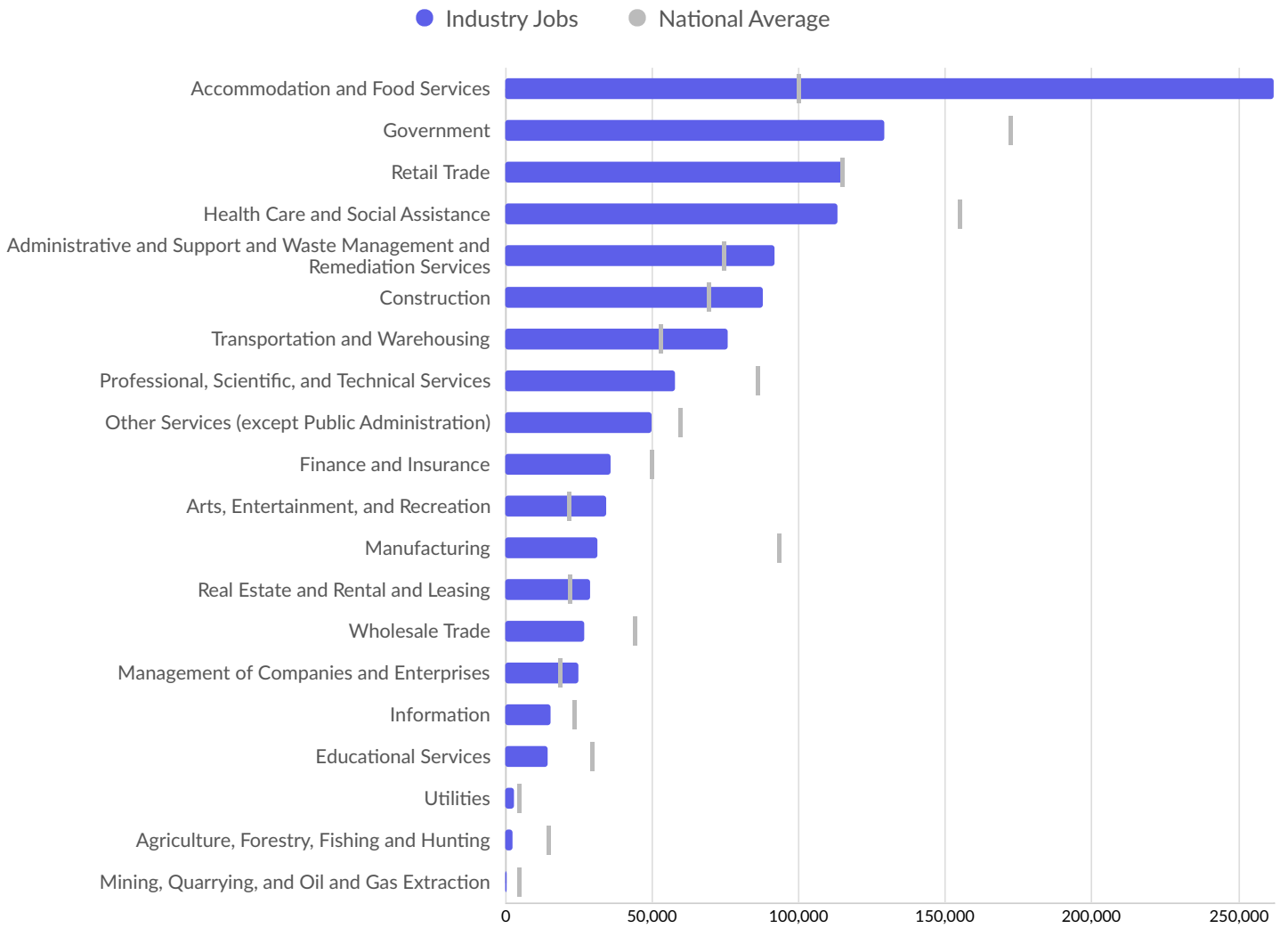

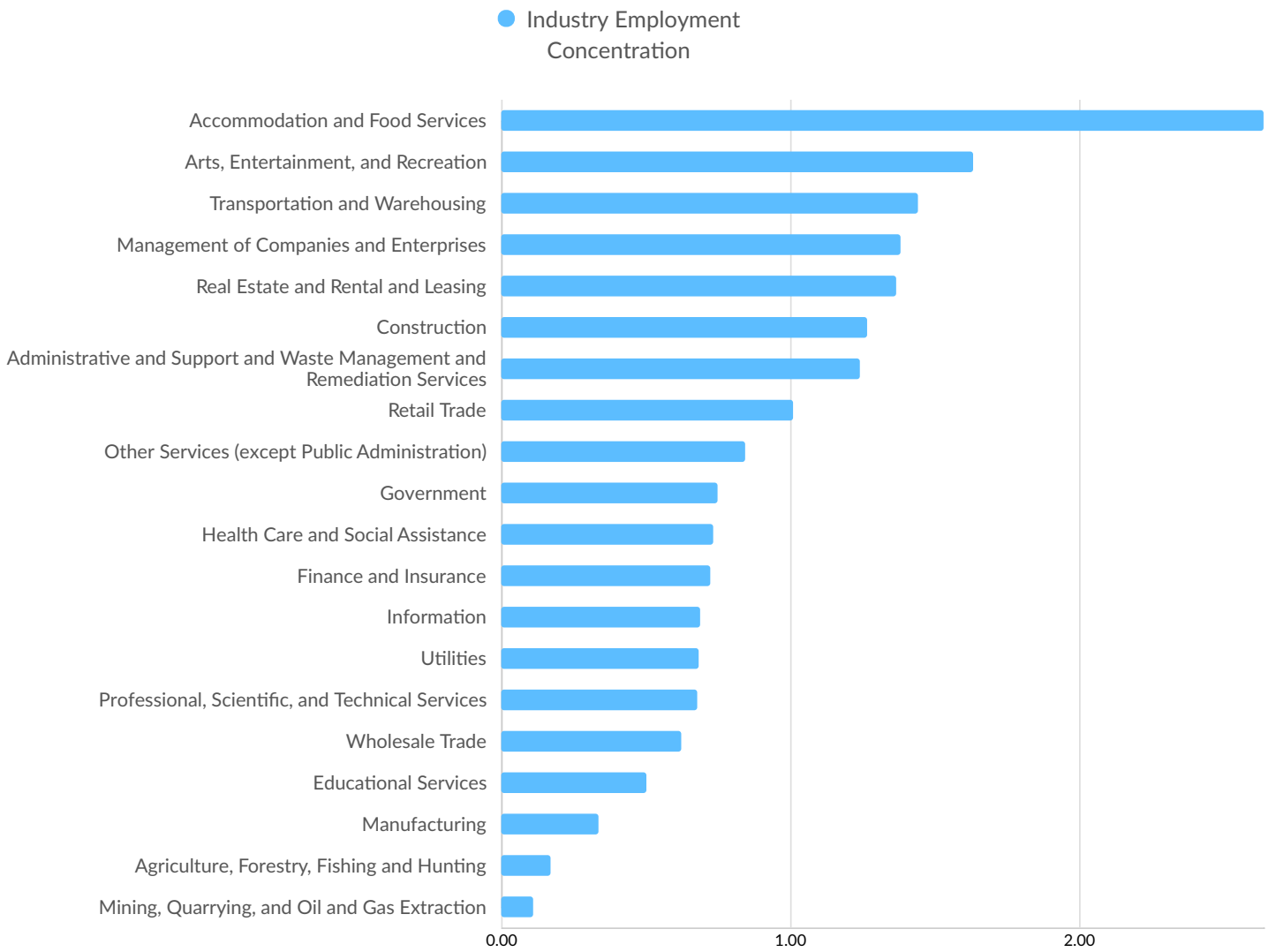

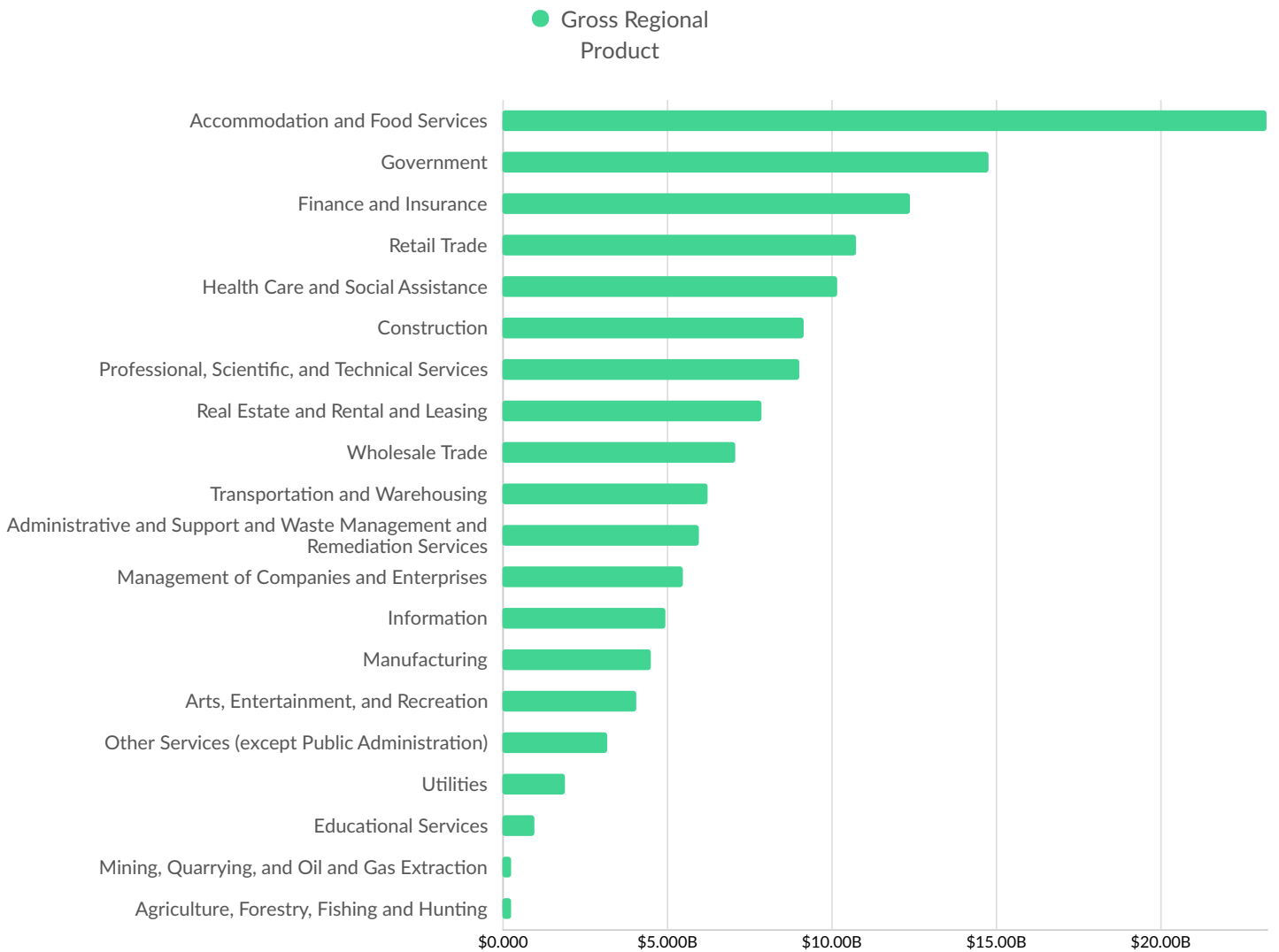

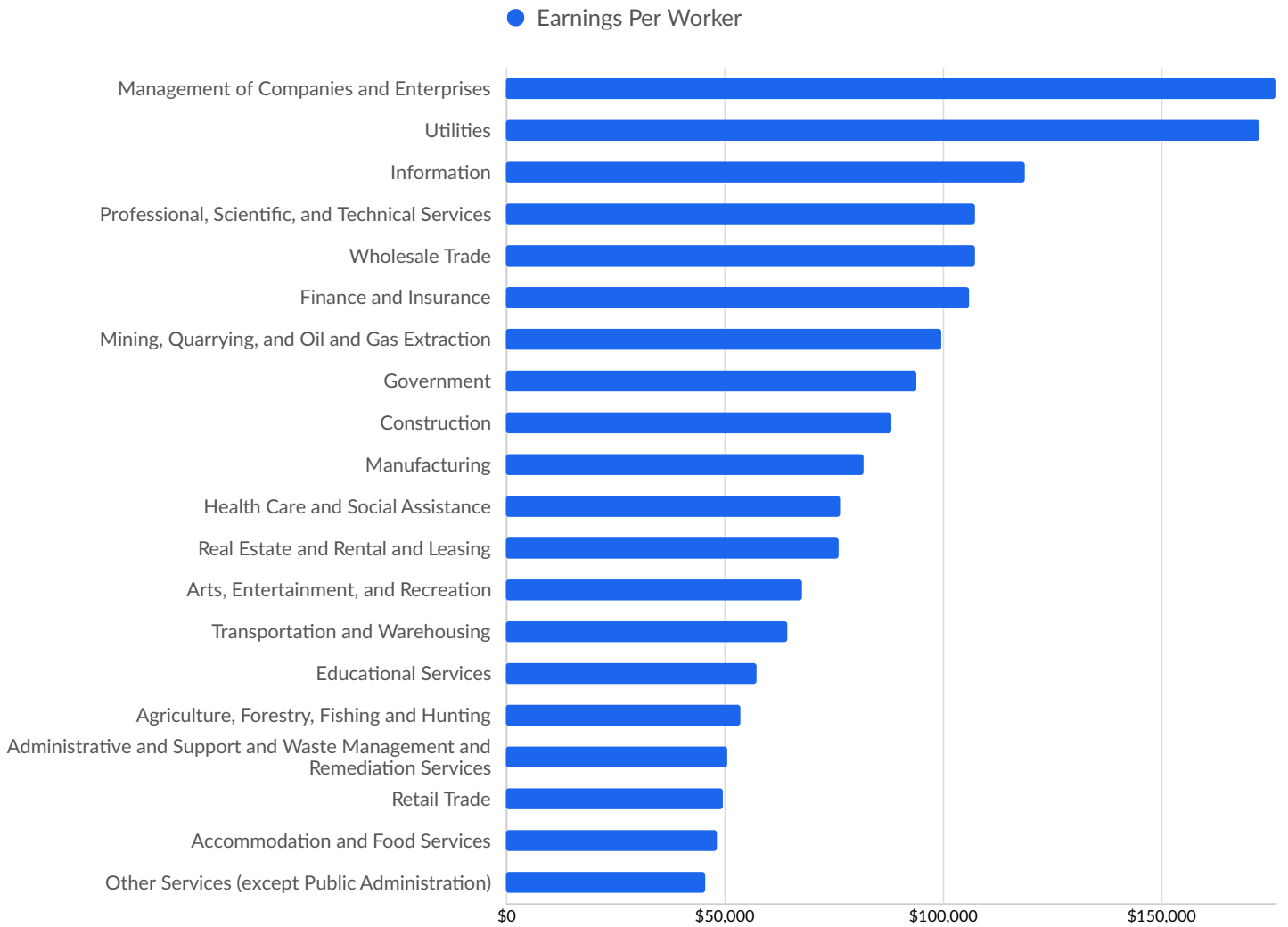
## Top Industry Employment Concentration

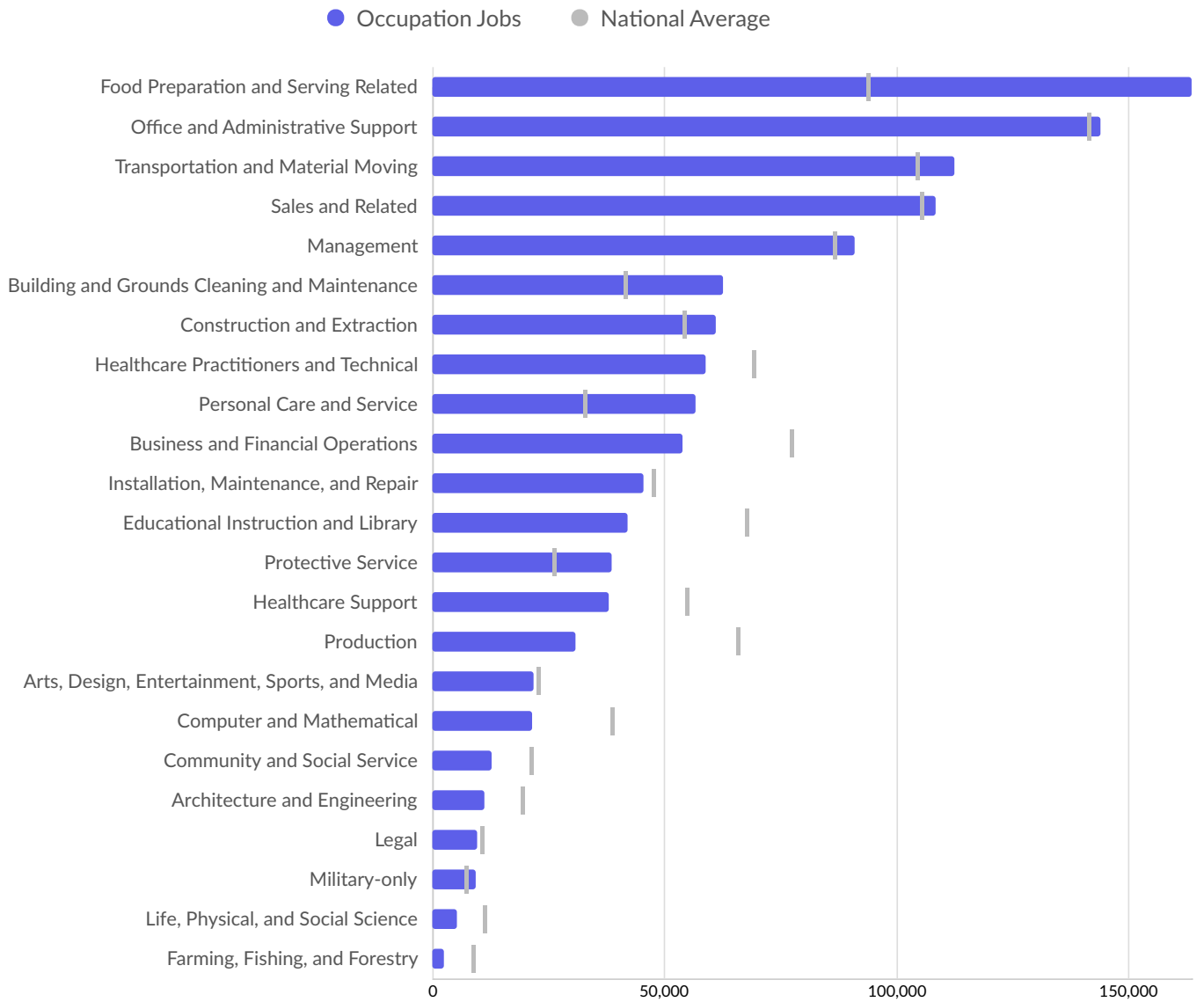

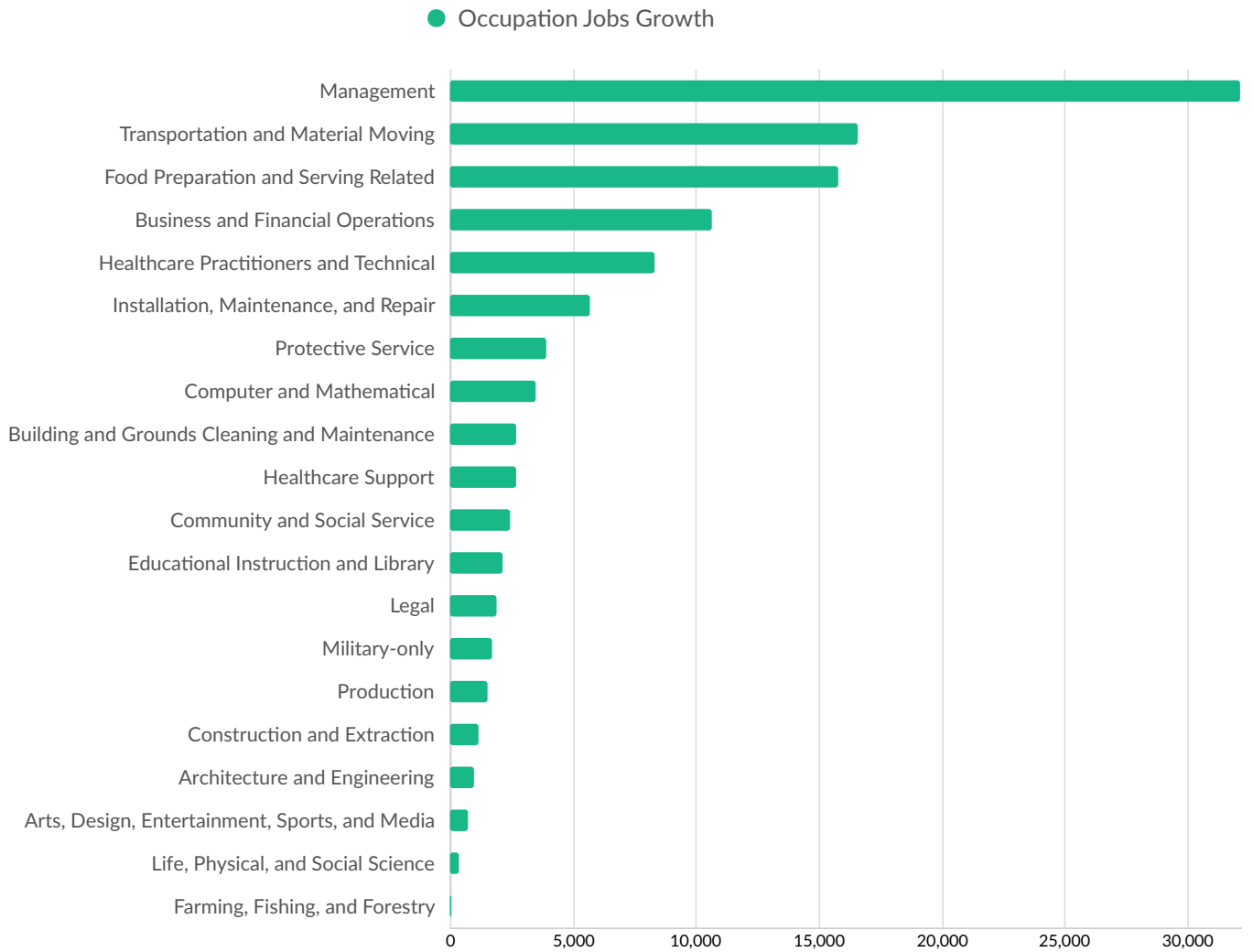

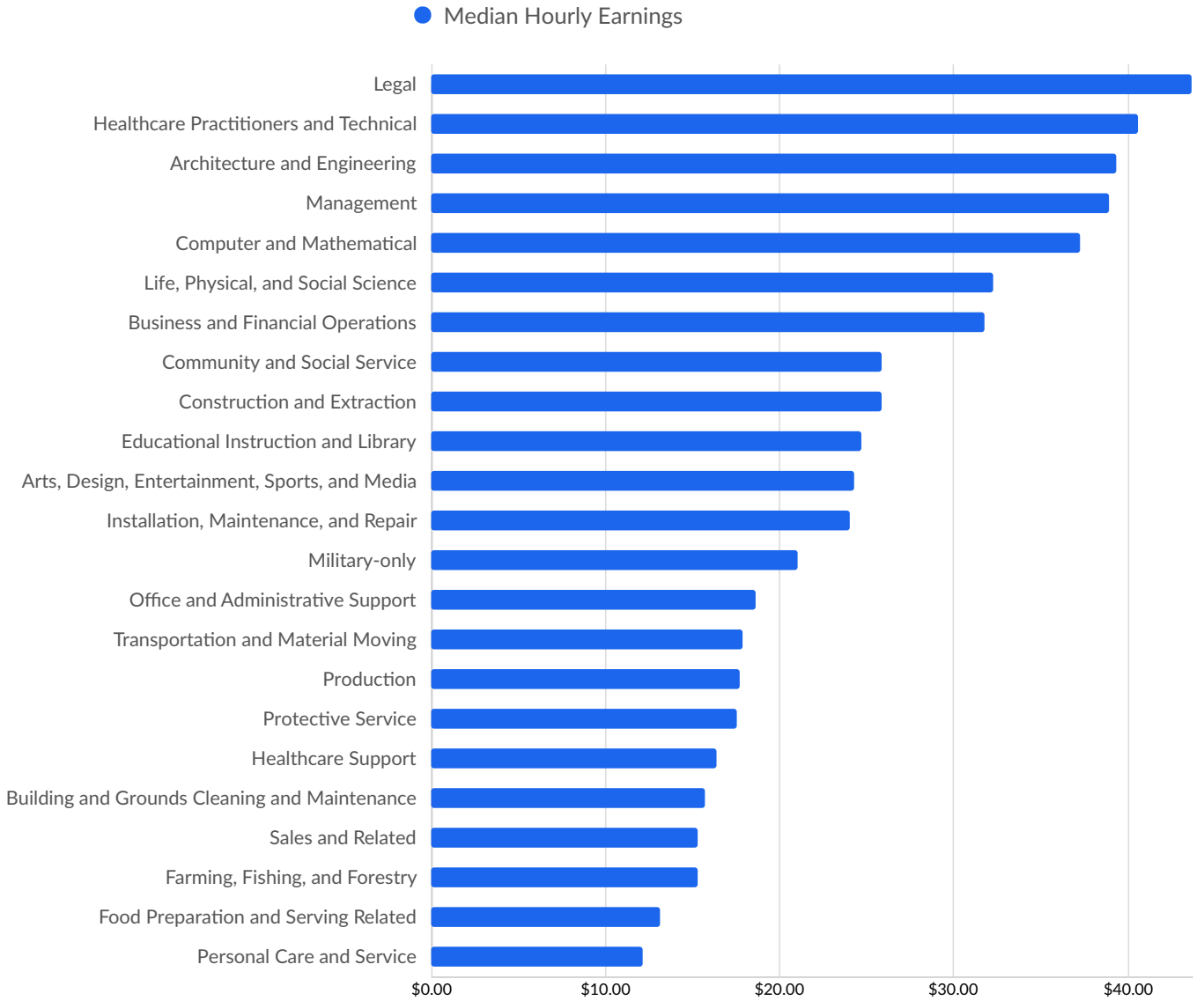


## Top Occupation Employment Concentration

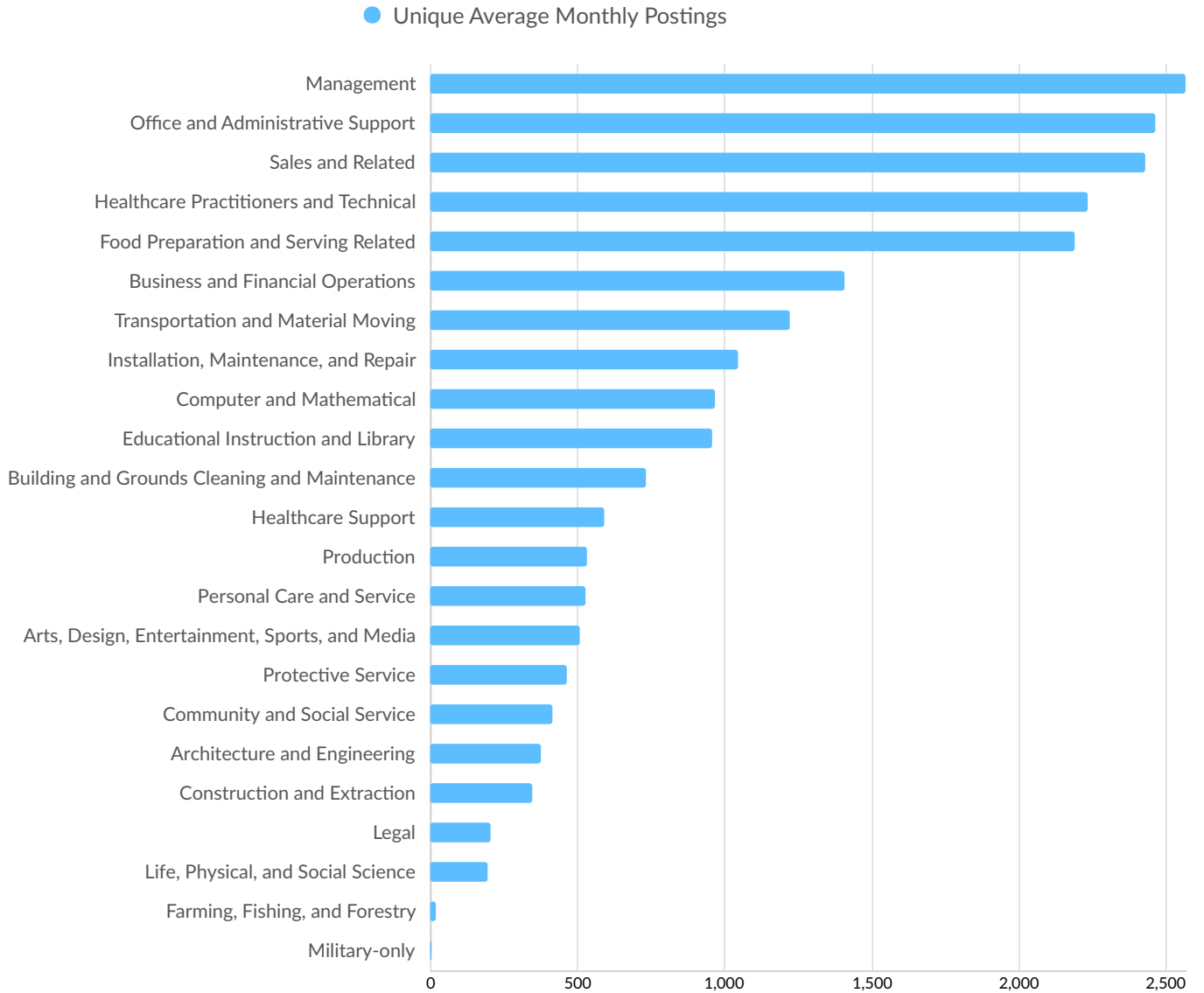

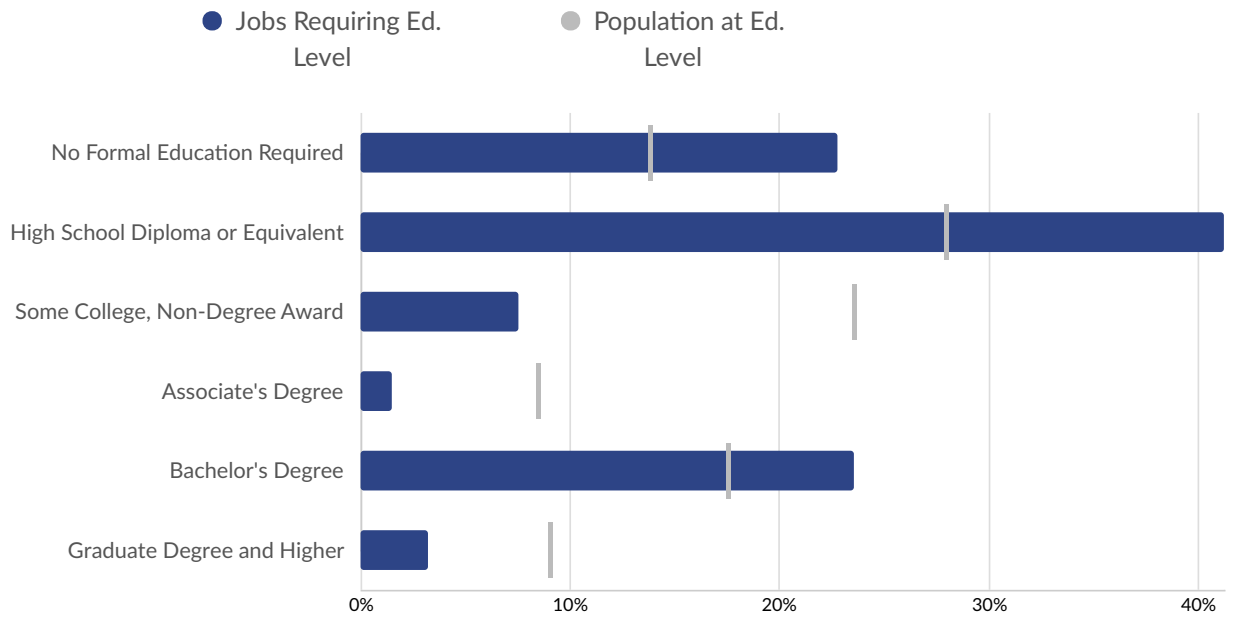
