- From 2018 to 2023, jobs increased by 0.4% in Elko County, NV from 24,221 to 24,315. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 3.6% by 3.2%. As the number of jobs increased, the labor force participation rate decreased from 67.7% to 61.8% between 2018 and 2023.
- Concerning educational attainment, **10.3% of Elko County**, **NV residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (10.8% below the national average), and **9.9% hold an Associate's Degree** (0.9% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2023 are Traveler Accommodation, Education and Hospitals (Local Government), and Restaurants and Other Eating Places.












# **Population Trends**





# **Unemployment Rate Trends**


Elko County, NV had a January 2024 unemployment rate of 3.87%, increasing from 3.11% 5 years before.








Elko County, NV has 11,930 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 10,989.




**Retiring Soon** 

Retirement risk is low in Elko County, NV. The national average for an area this size is 16,197 people 55 or older, while there are 13,618 here.




**Racial Diversity**

#### Violent Crime


Elko County, NV has 3.15 violent crimes per 1,000 people. The national rate is 3.6 per 1,000 people.










#### **Top Industry Employment Concentration**






### **Top Occupation Employment Concentration**







# **Educational Pipeline**

In 2022, there were 843 graduates in Elko County, NV. This pipeline has shrunk by 1% over the last 5 years. The highest share of these graduates come from "Nursing Assistant/Aide and Patient Care Assistant/Aide" (Certificate), "Liberal Arts and Sciences/Liberal Studies" (Associate's), and "Industrial Mechanics and Maintenance Technology/Technician" (Certificate).
