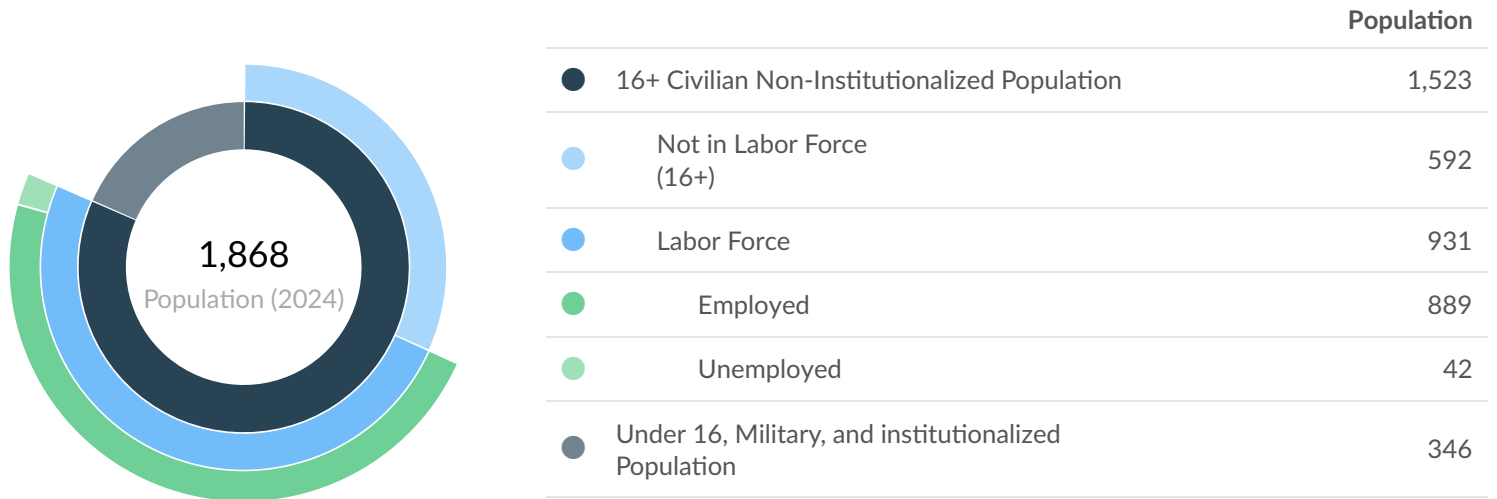
Median household income is **\$714 below** the national median household income of \$69.0K.

### Takeaways

- As of 2023 the region's population **declined by 7.6%** since 2018, falling by 154. Population is expected to **increase by 0.5%** between 2023 and 2028, adding 10.
- From 2018 to 2023, jobs **increased by 2.7%** in Eureka County, NV from 4,526 to **4,648**. This change **fell short of the national growth rate of 3.6% by 0.9%**. As the number of jobs increased, the **labor force participation rate increased from 65.8% to 70.2% between 2018 and 2023**.
- Concerning educational attainment, **6.3% of Eureka County, NV residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (14.8% below the national average), and **5.0% hold an Associate's Degree** (3.9% below the national average).
- The top three industries in 2023 are Metal Ore Mining, Nonmetallic Mineral Mining and Quarrying, and Support Activities for Mining.

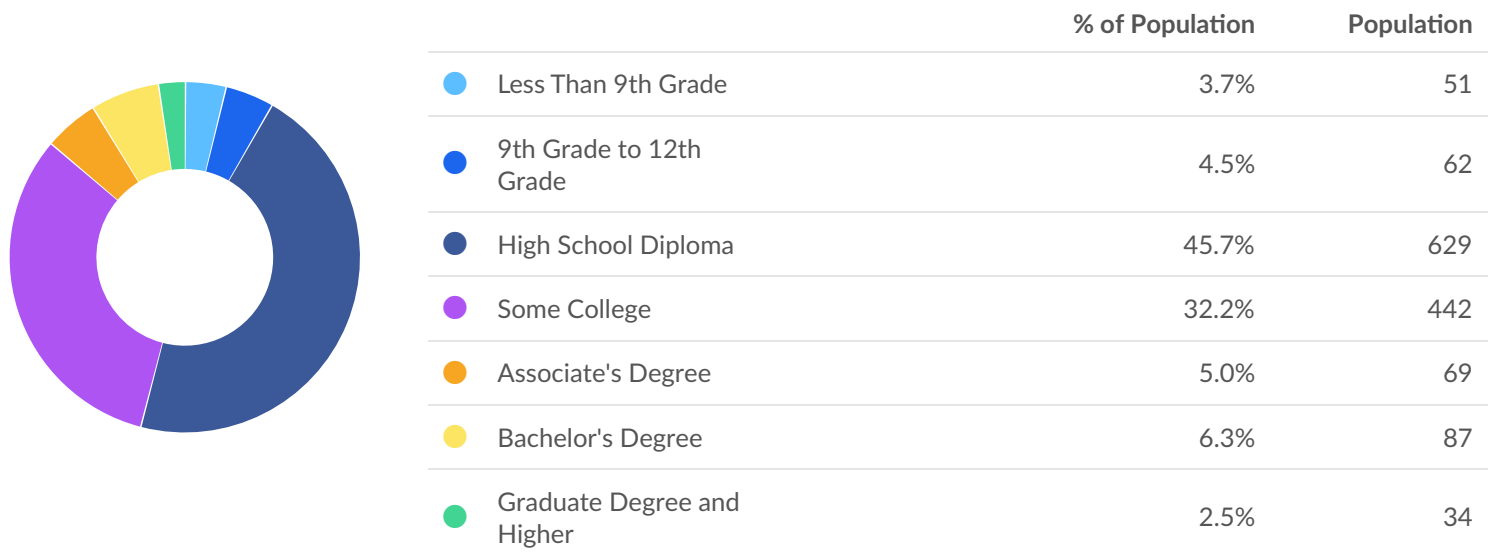

## Jan 2024 Labor Force Breakdown



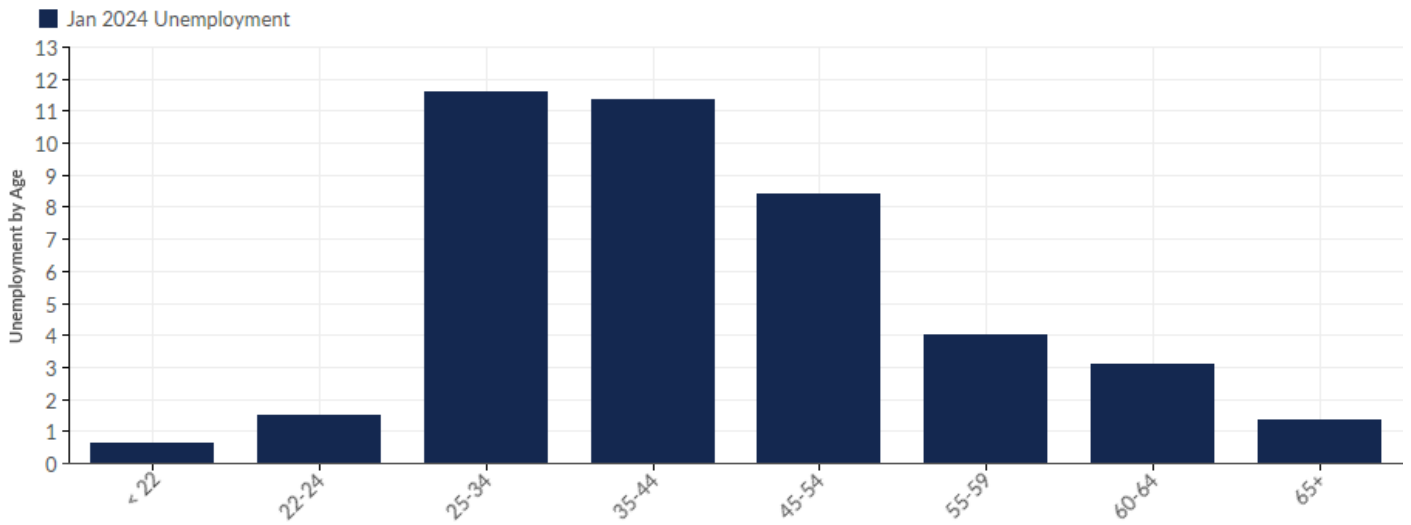
## Educational Attainment

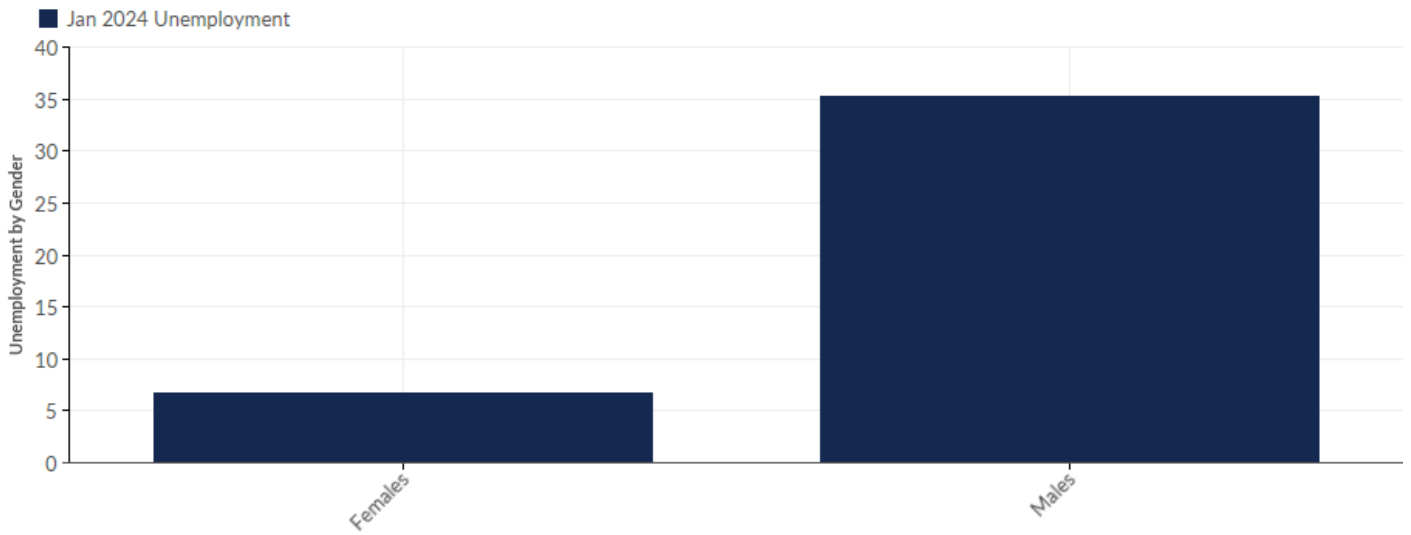

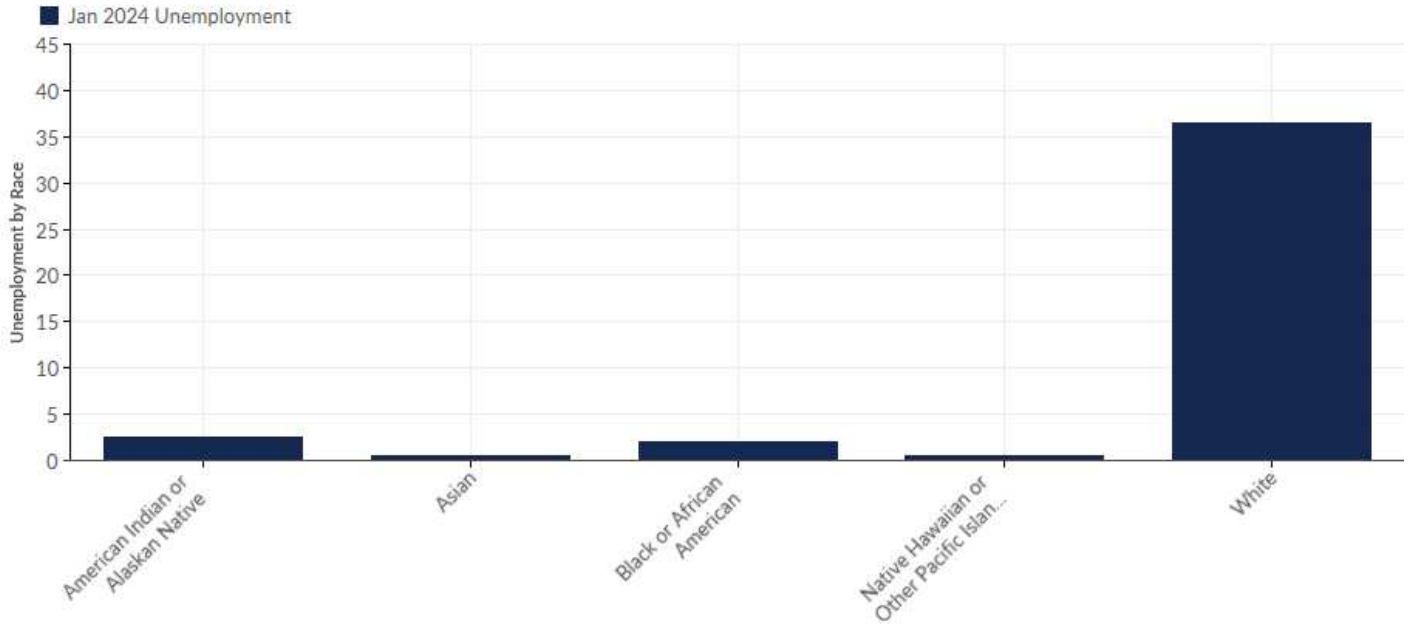

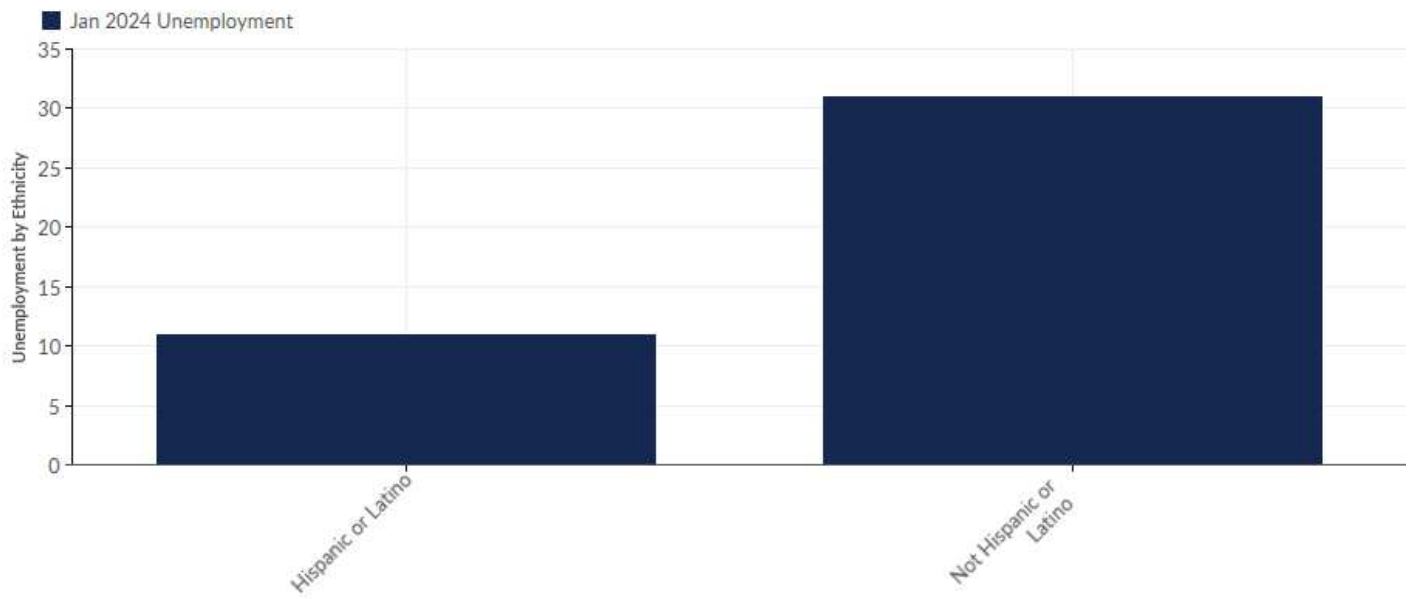

## Unemployment by Ethnicity

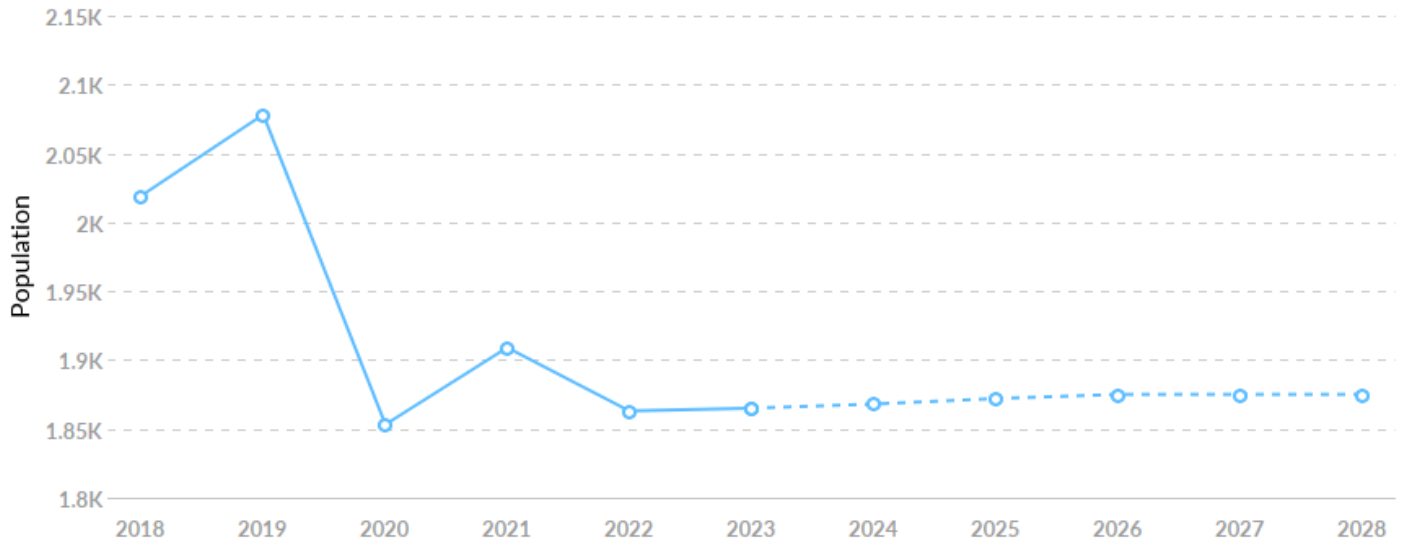

## Population Trends

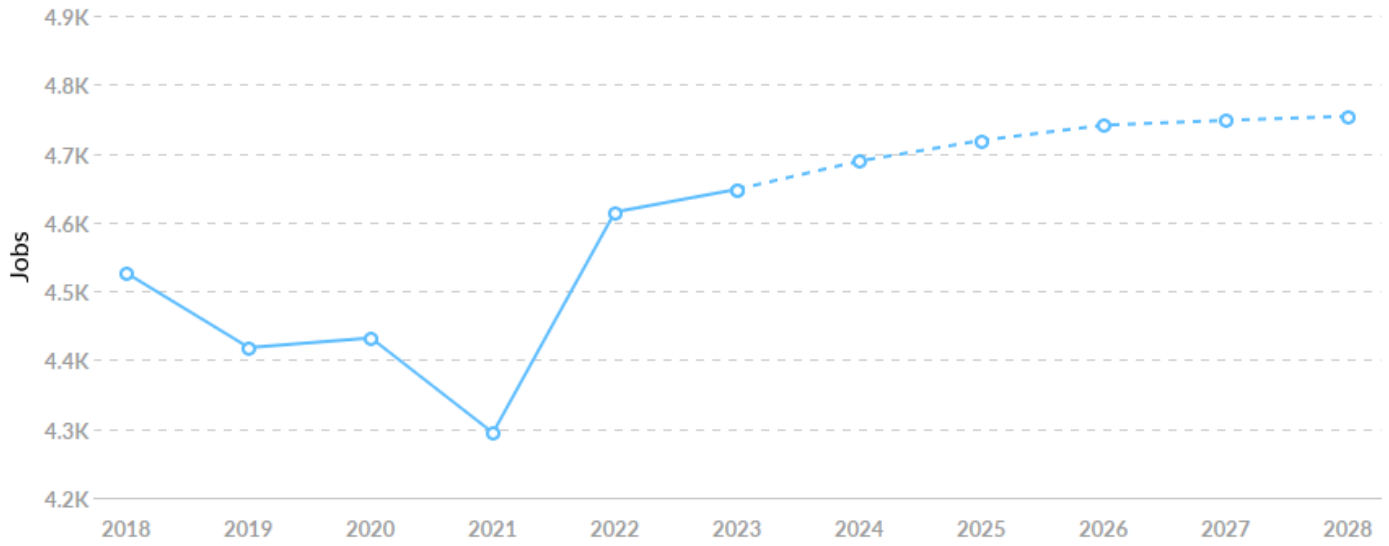

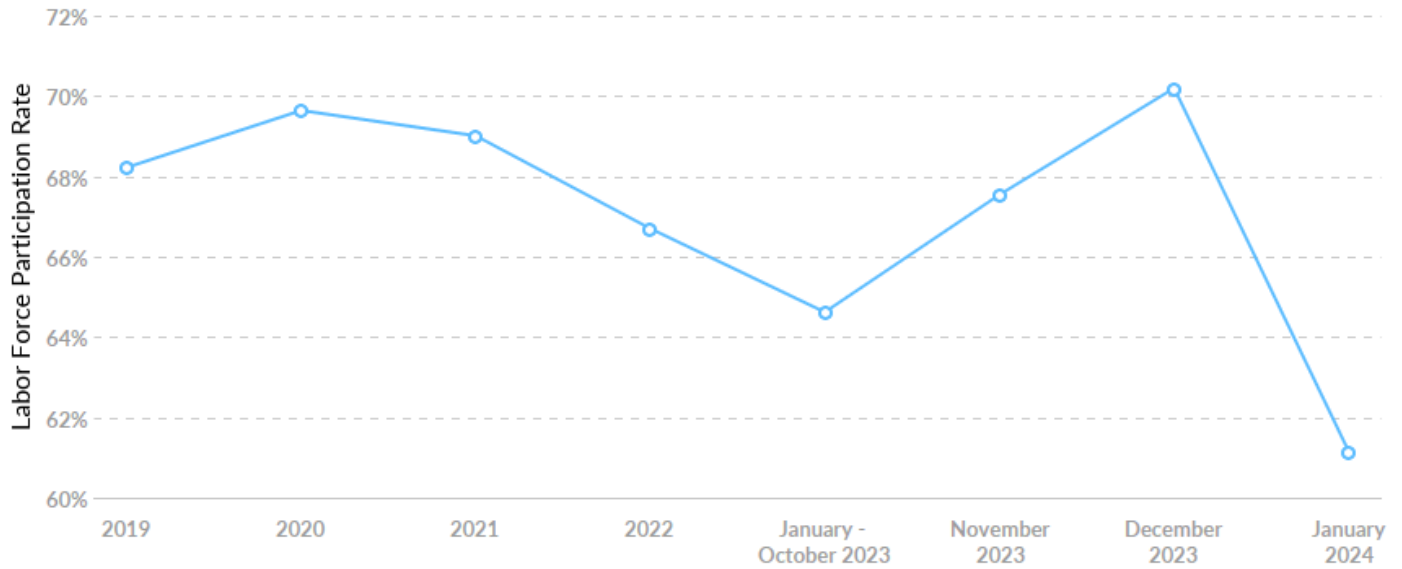
## Job Trends

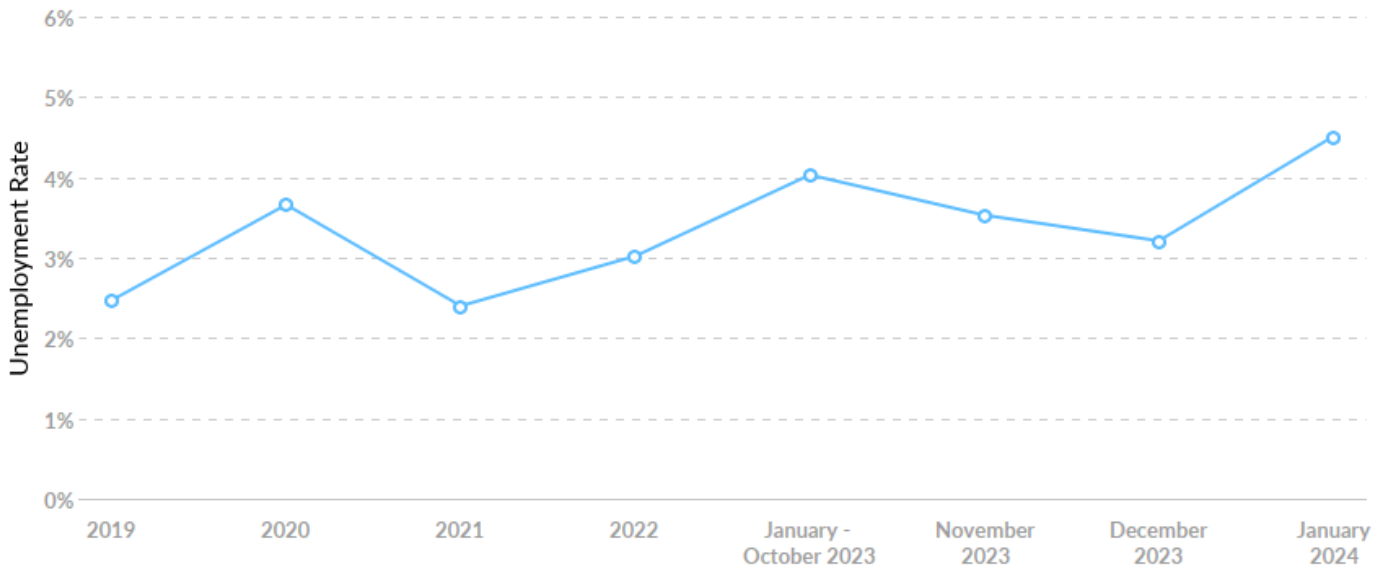

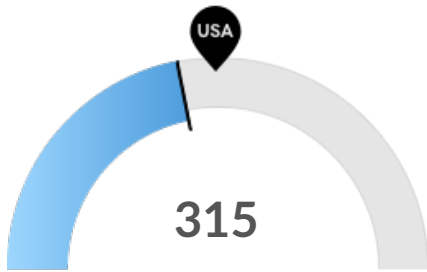
## Unemployment Rate Trends

Eureka County, NV had a January 2024 unemployment rate of 4.51%, **increasing from 2.47%** 5 years before.



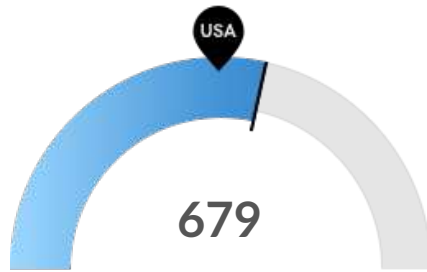

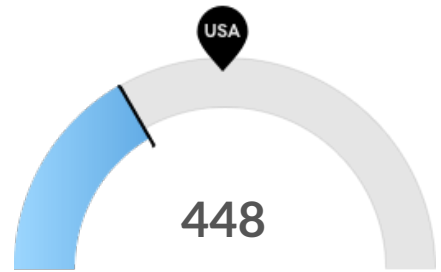
**Millennials**

Eureka County, NV has 315 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 379.



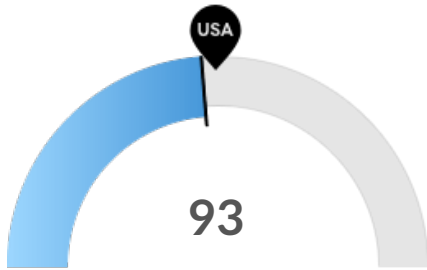
**Retiring Soon**

Retirement risk is high in Eureka County, NV. The national average for an area this size is 558 people 55 or older, while there are 679 here.



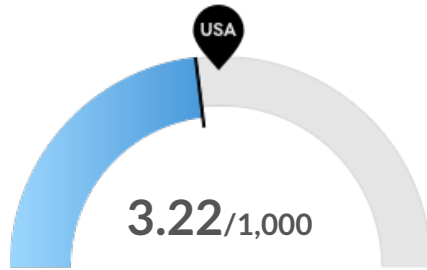
**Racial Diversity**

Racial diversity is low in Eureka County, NV. The national average for an area this size is 766 racially diverse people, while there are 448 here.



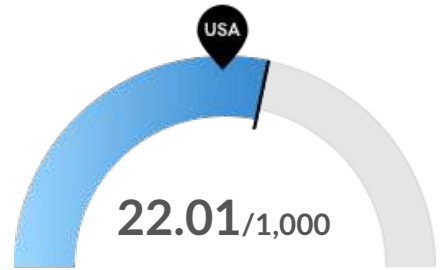
**Veterans**

Eureka County, NV has 3.22 violent crimes per 1,000 people. The national rate is 3.6 per 1,000 people.

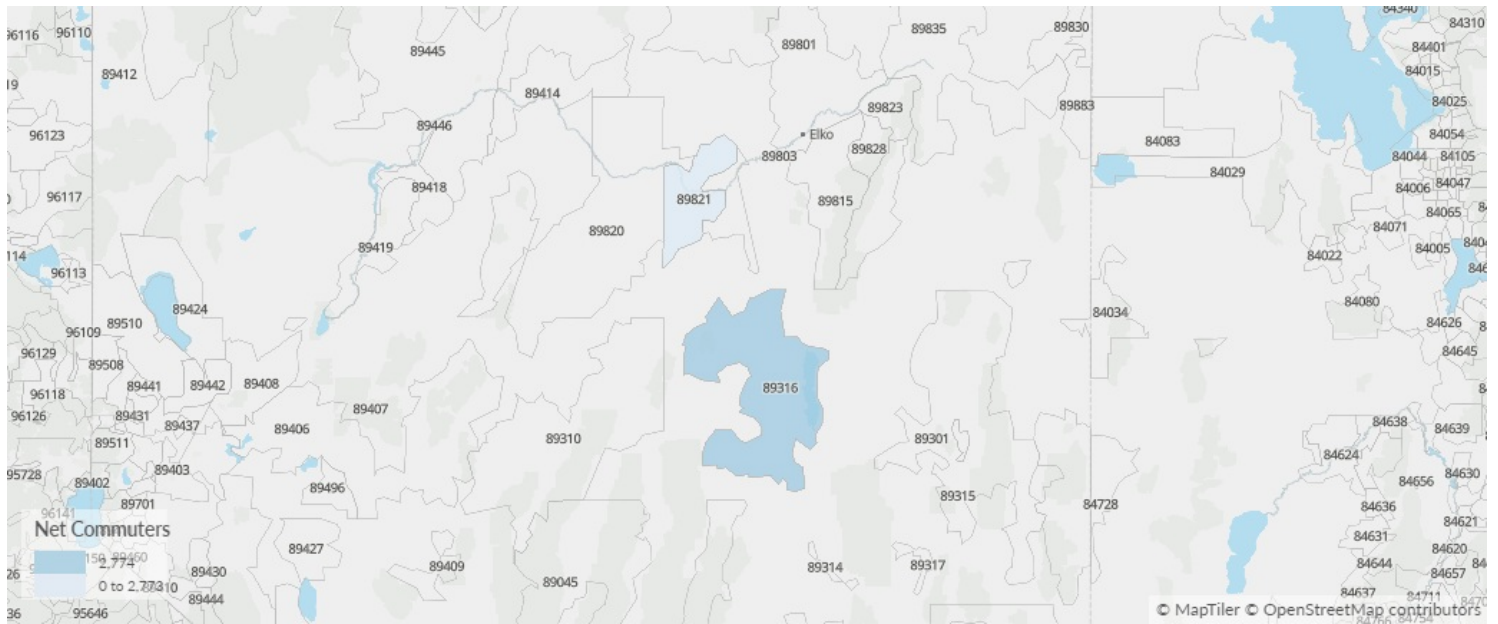


**Property Crime**

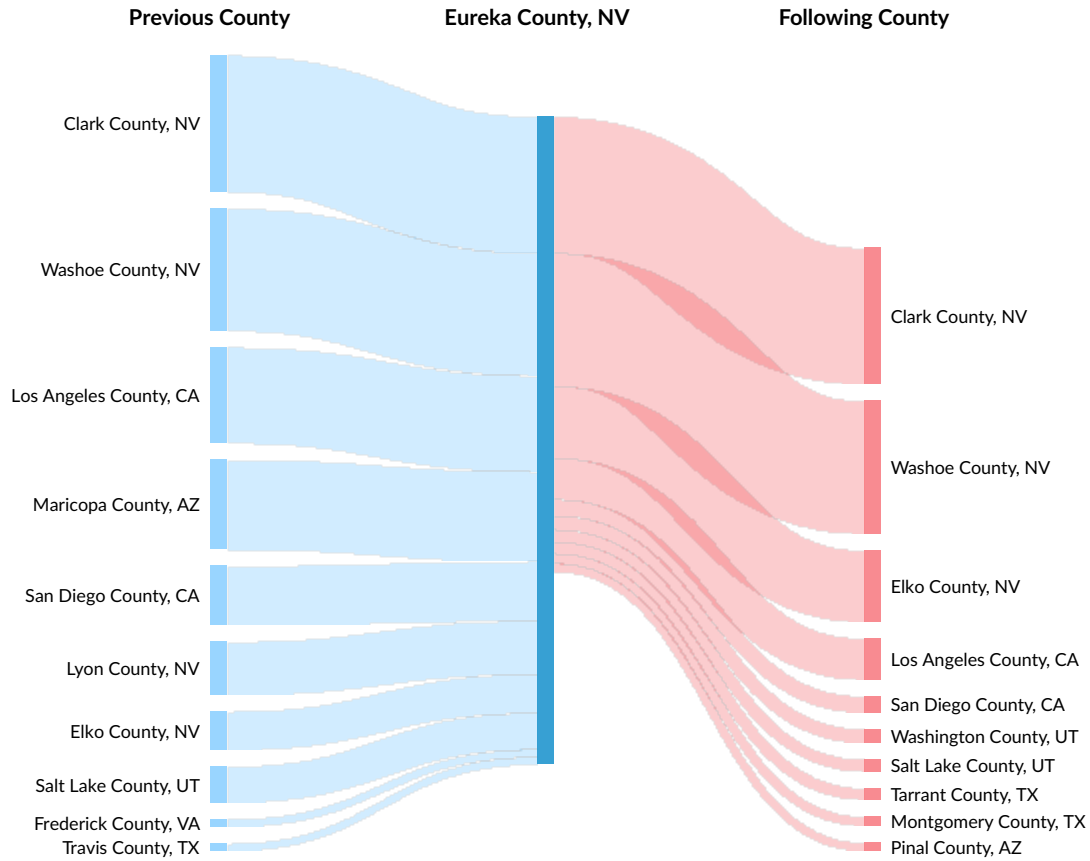

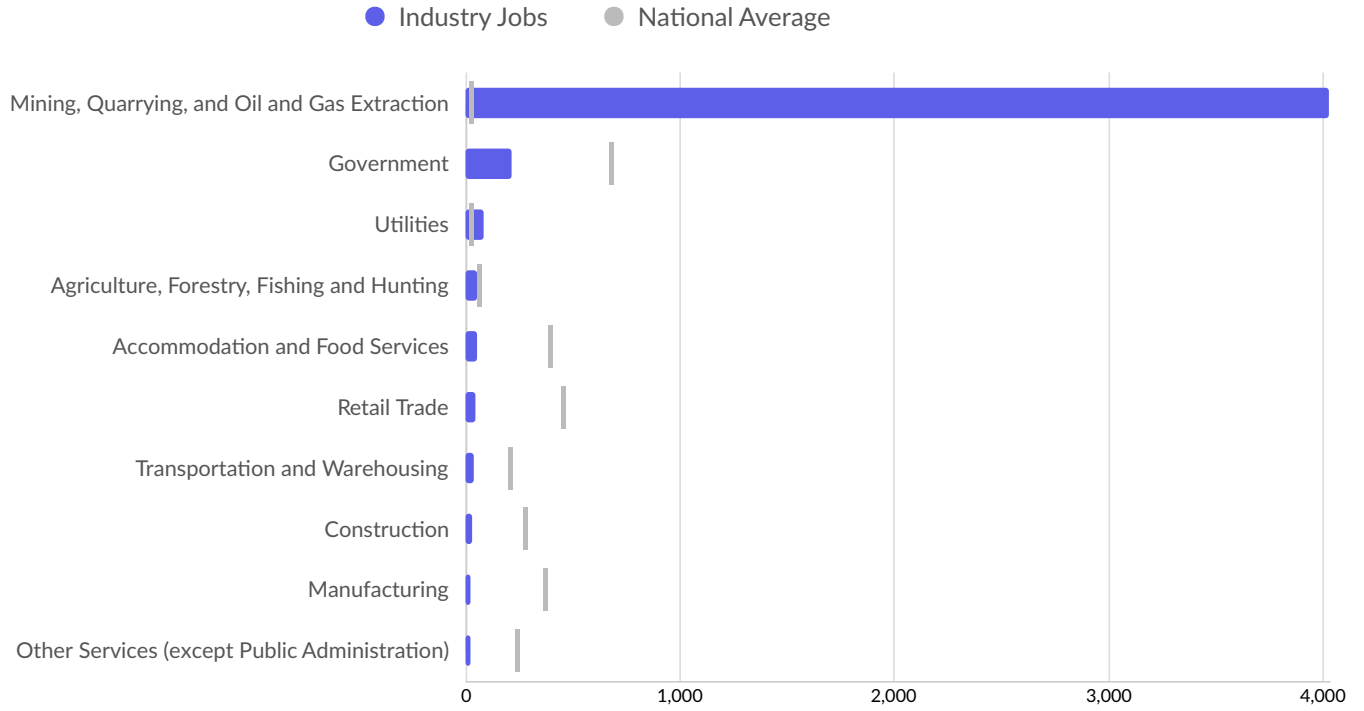

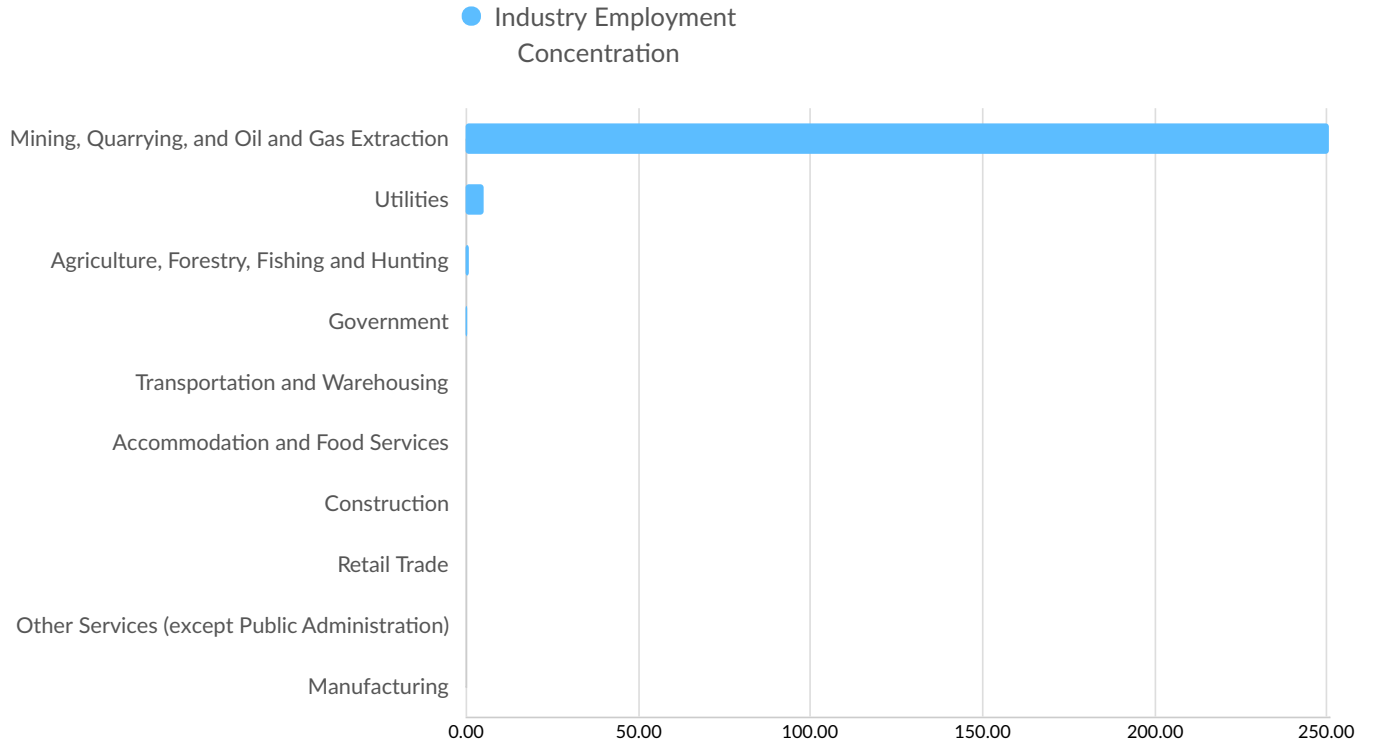

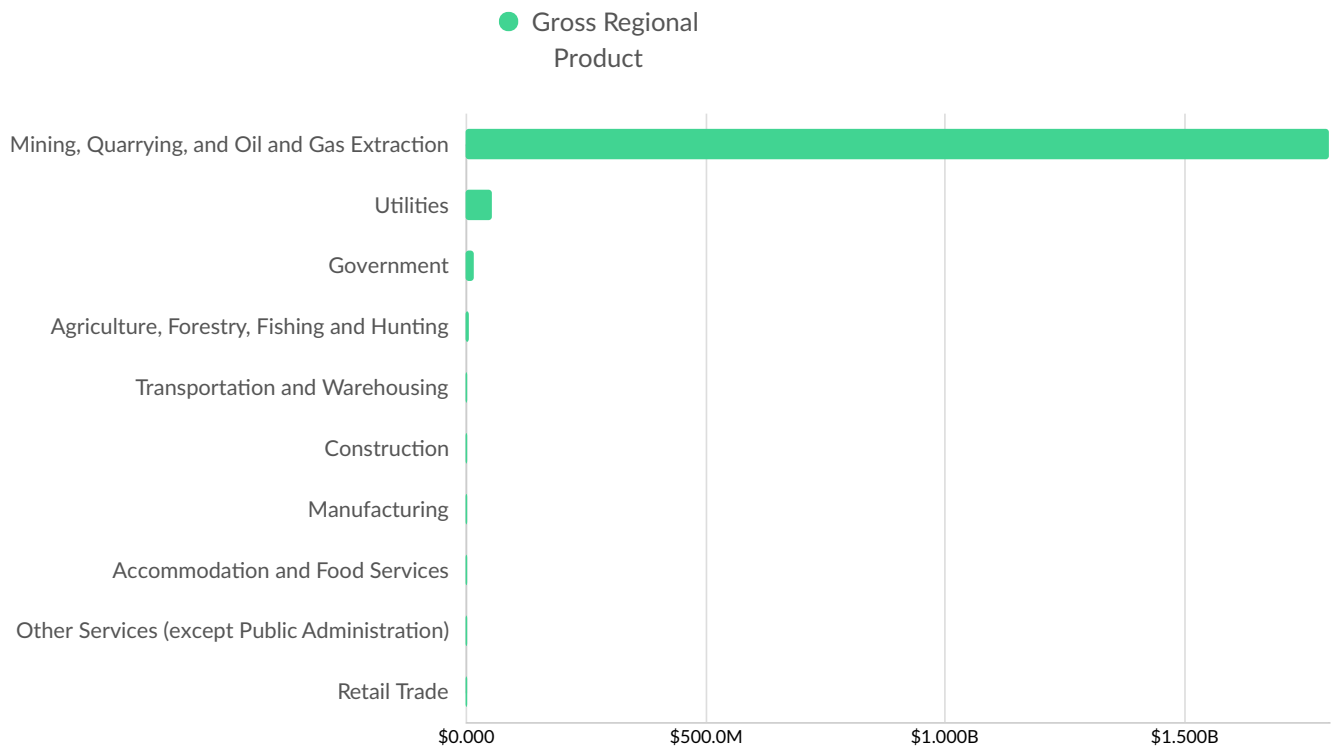
## Top Growing Industries

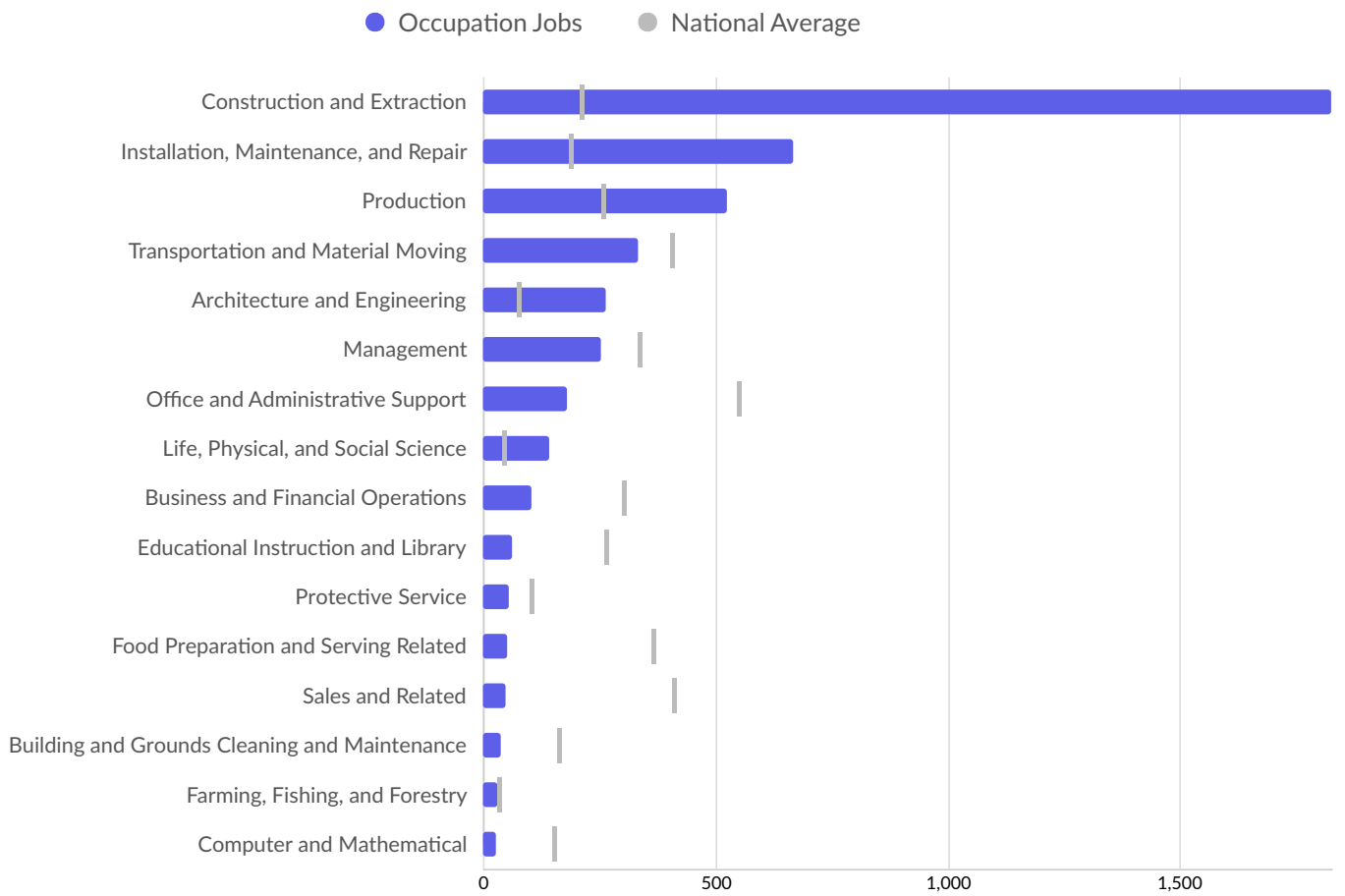

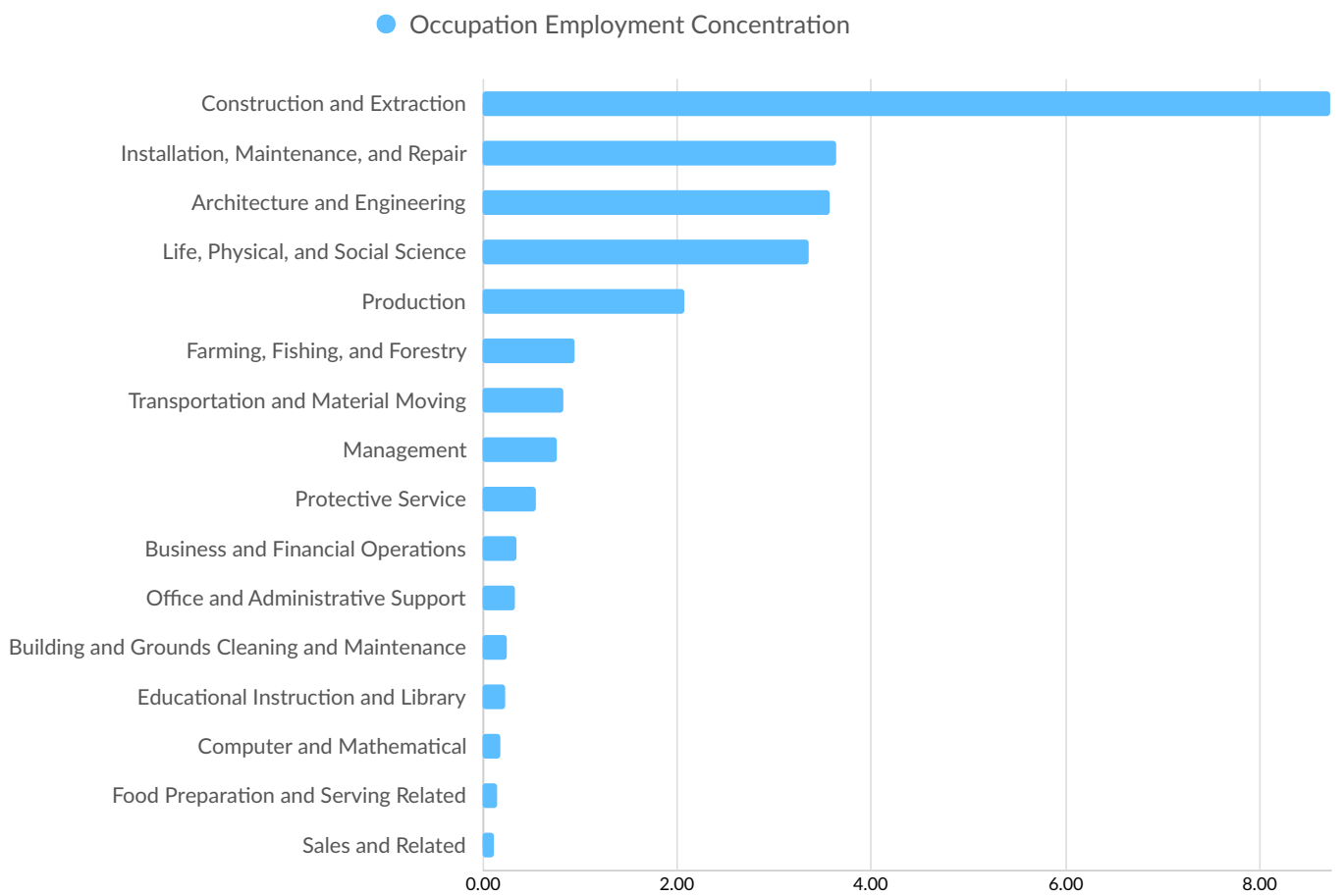

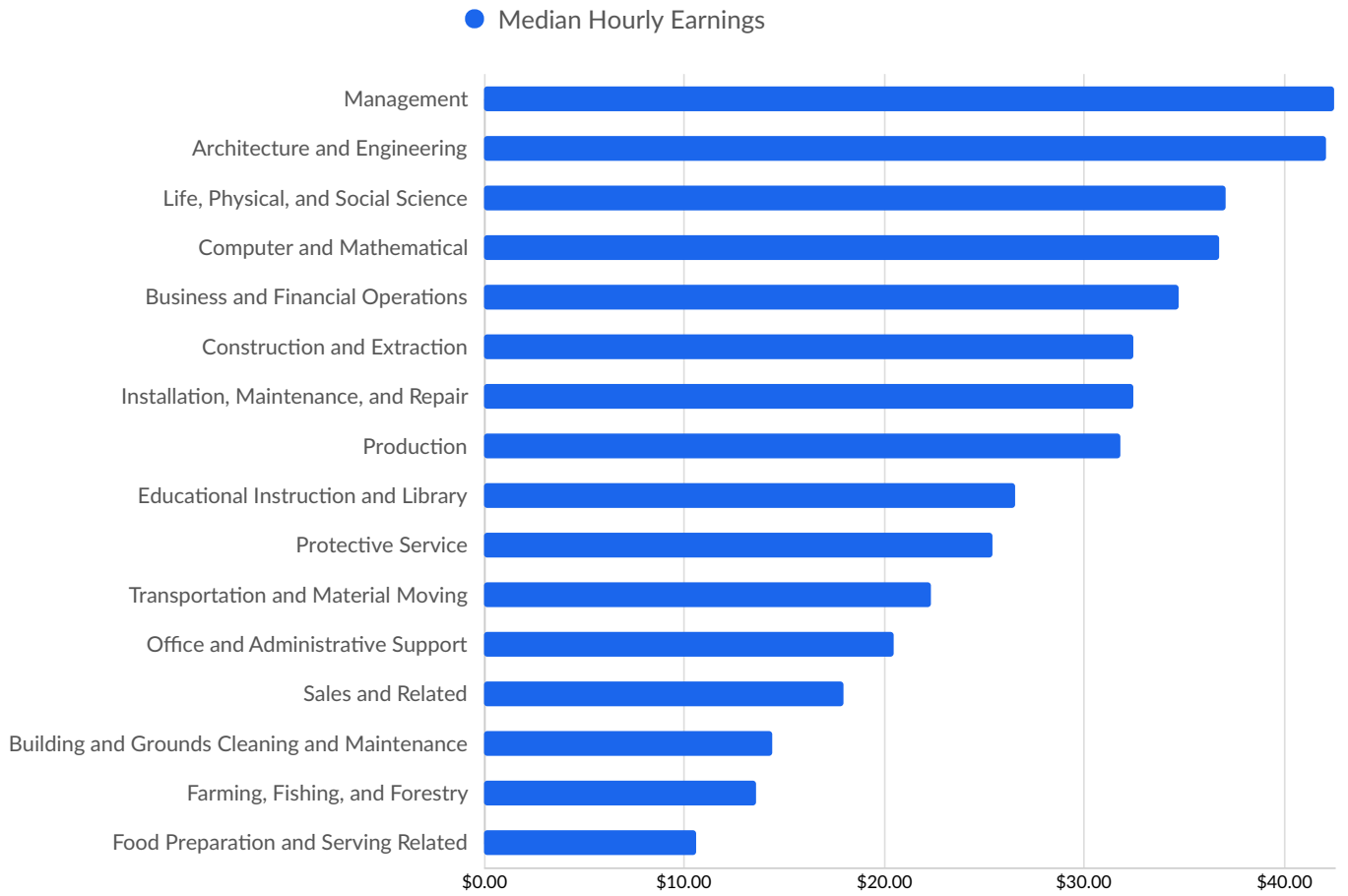




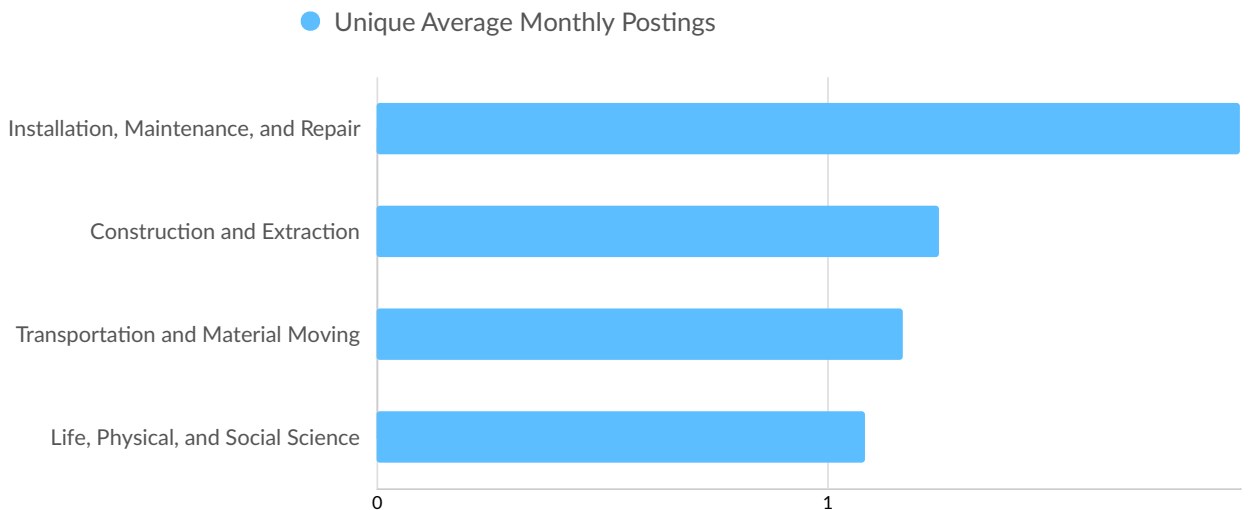
## Top Occupation Employment Concentration



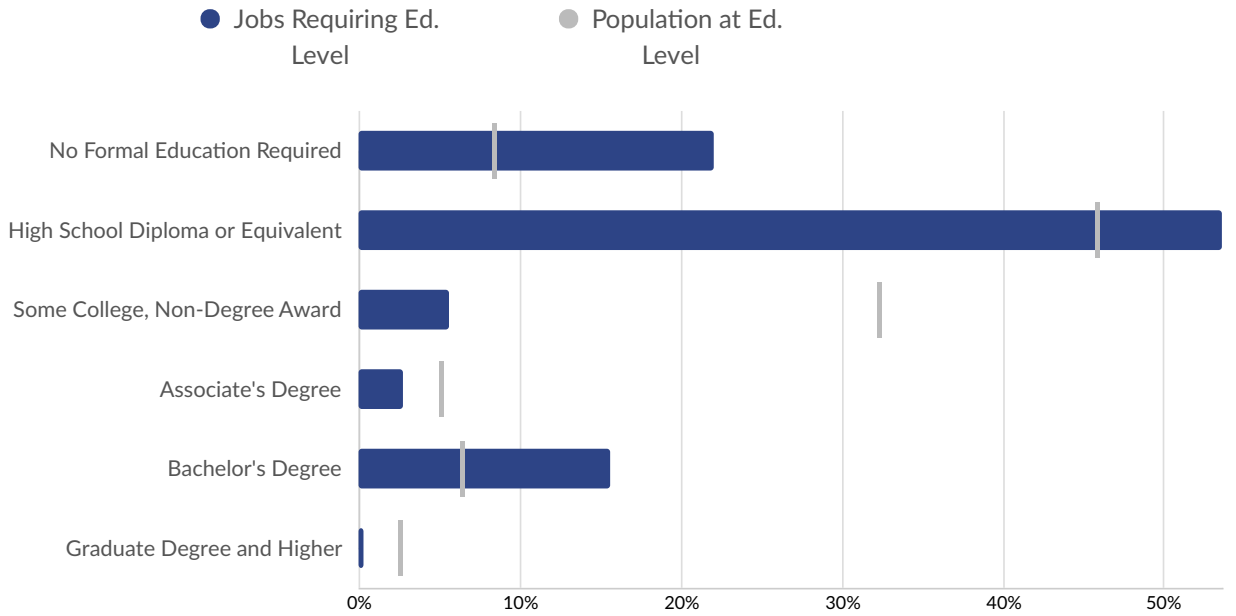
