- As of 2023 the region's population increased by 7.6% since 2018, growing by 419. Population is expected to increase by 12.4% between 2023 and 2028, adding 734.
- From 2018 to 2023, jobs increased by 8.1% in Lander County, NV from 3,636 to 3,929. This change outpaced the national growth rate of 3.6% by 4.5%. As the number of jobs increased, the labor force participation rate decreased from 74.6% to 70.7% between 2018 and 2023.
- Concerning educational attainment, 3.3% of Lander County, NV residents possess a Bachelor's Degree (17.8% below the national average), and 17.9% hold an Associate's Degree (8.9% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2023 are Metal Ore Mining, Education and Hospitals (Local Government), and Local Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals.




Jan 2024 Labor Force Breakdown






Unemployment by Gender




Unemployment by Race

Unemployment by Ethnicity





As of 2023 the region's population increased by 7.6% since 2018, growing by 419. Population is expected to increase by 12.4% between 2023 and 2028, adding 734.



Job Trends




Lander County, NV had a January 2024 unemployment rate of 3.69%, increasing from 3.29% 5 years before.






Lander County, NV has 1,100 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 1,172.




Veterans

Lander County, NV has 341 veterans. The national average for an area this size is 302.




Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is about average in Lander County, NV. The national average for an area this size is 1,728 people 55 or older, while there are 1,700 here.




Violent Crime












Top Growing Industries




Top Industry Employment Concentration






Top Industry GRP







Top Occupation Employment Concentration









