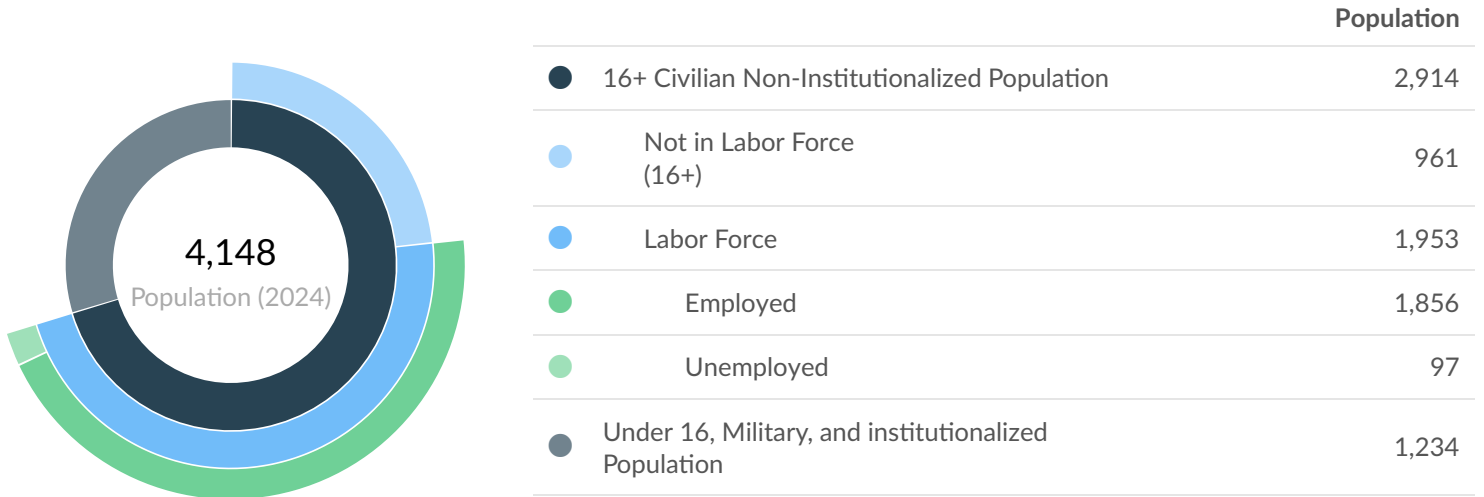

- As of 2023 the region's population **declined by 17.6%** since 2018, falling by 918. Population is expected to **decrease by 15.3%** between 2023 and 2028, losing 661.
- From 2018 to 2023, jobs **increased by 5.1%** in Lincoln County, NV from 1,478 to **1,553**. This change **outpaced the national growth rate of 3.6% by 1.5%**. As the number of jobs increased, the **labor force participation rate increased from 51.7% to 67.8% between 2018 and 2023**.
- Concerning educational attainment, **8.5% of Lincoln County, NV residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (12.6% below the national average), and **6.0% hold an Associate's Degree** (2.9% below the national average).
- The top three industries in 2023 are Education and Hospitals (Local Government), Local Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals, and State Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals.

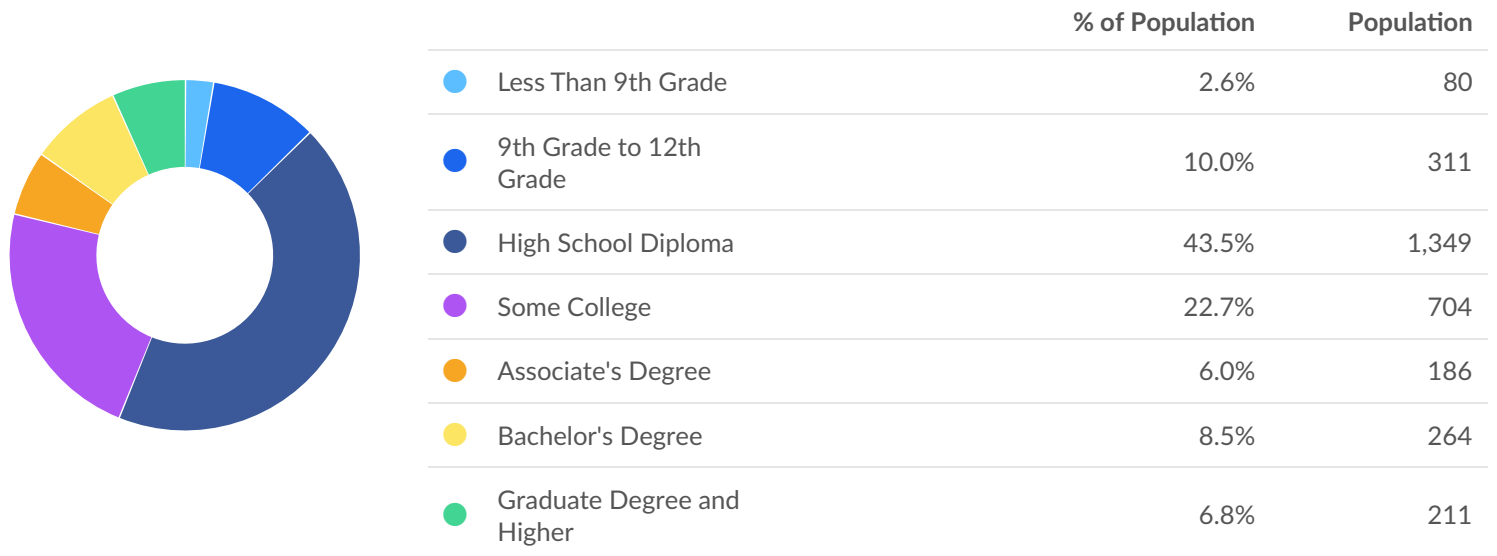

Jan 2024 Labor Force Breakdown



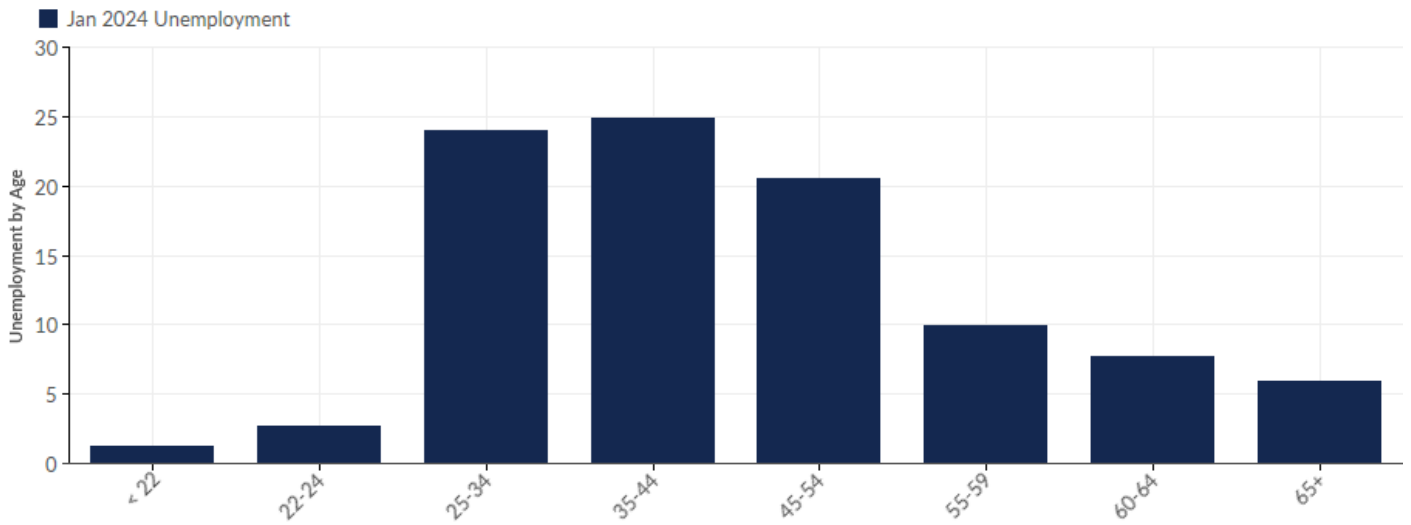
Educational Attainment

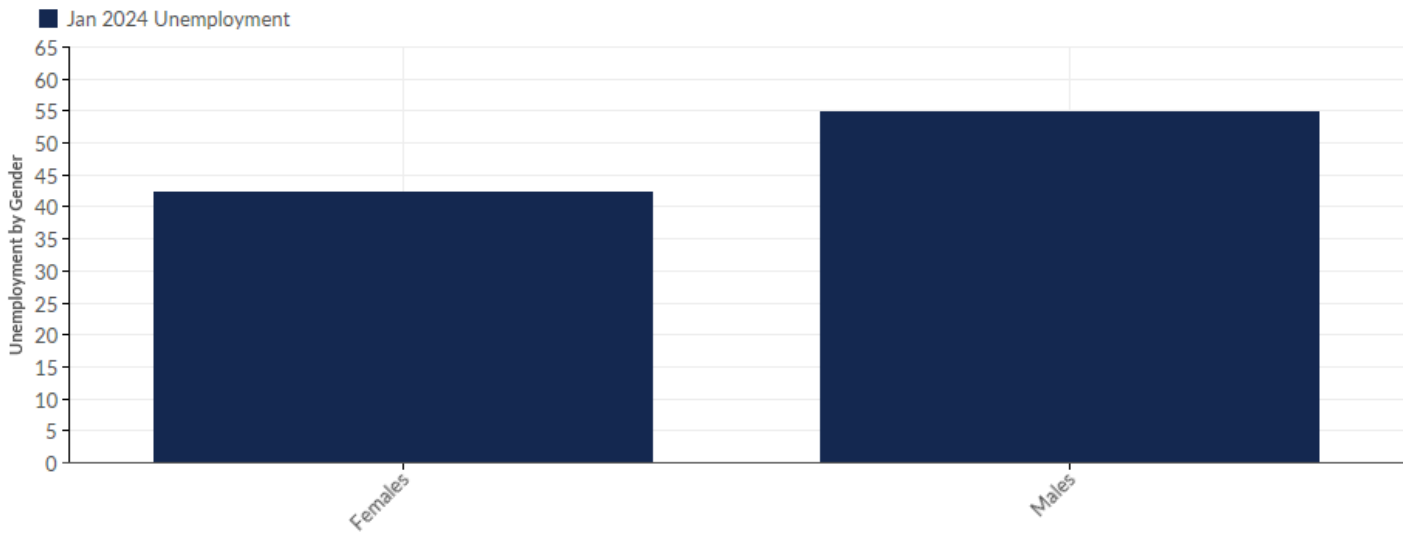

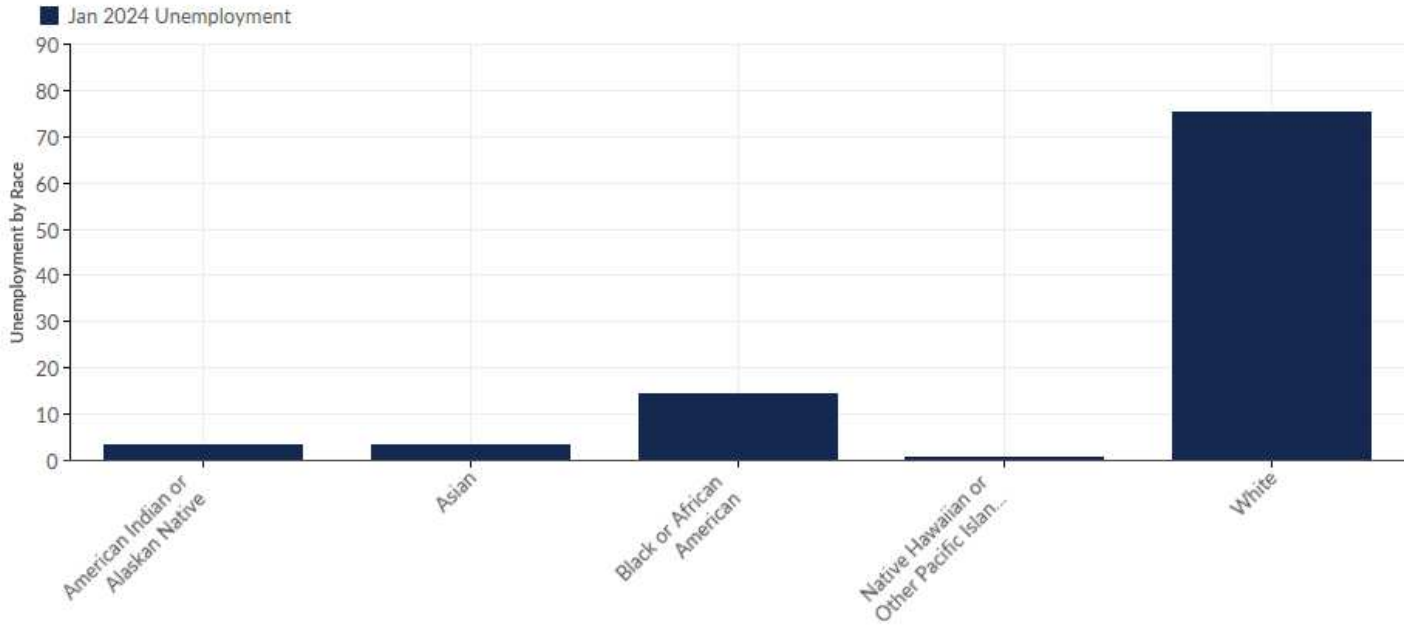

Unemployment by Gender



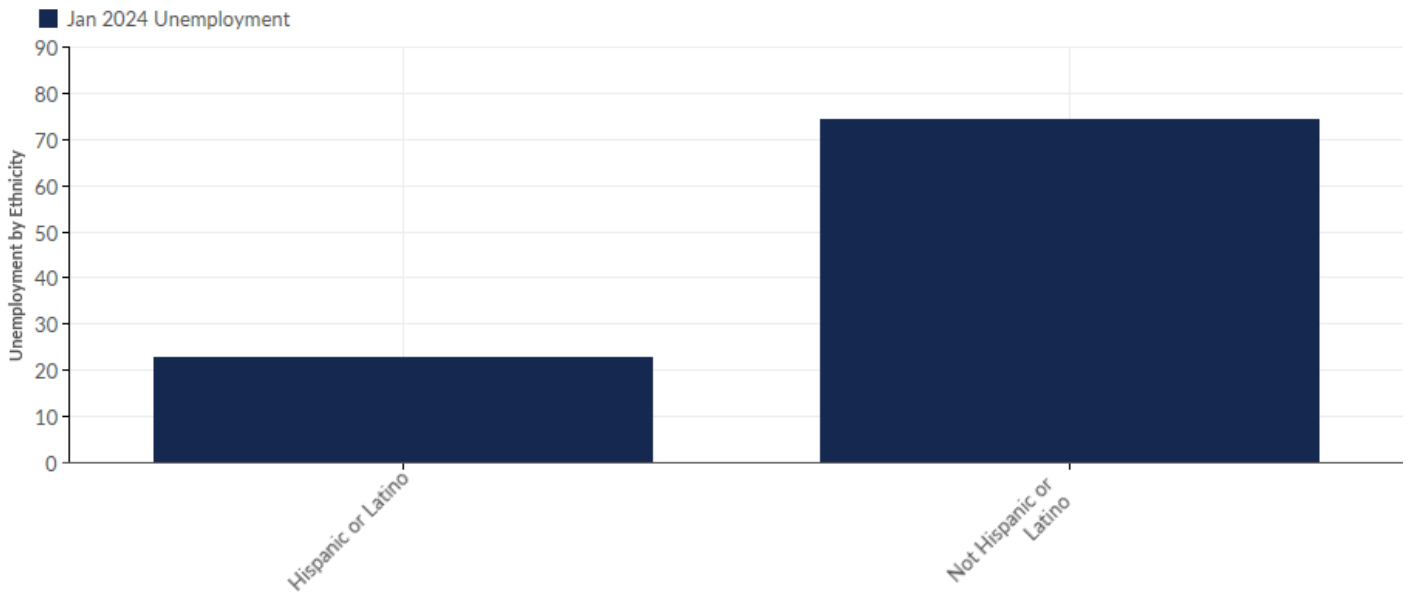

Unemployment by Ethnicity

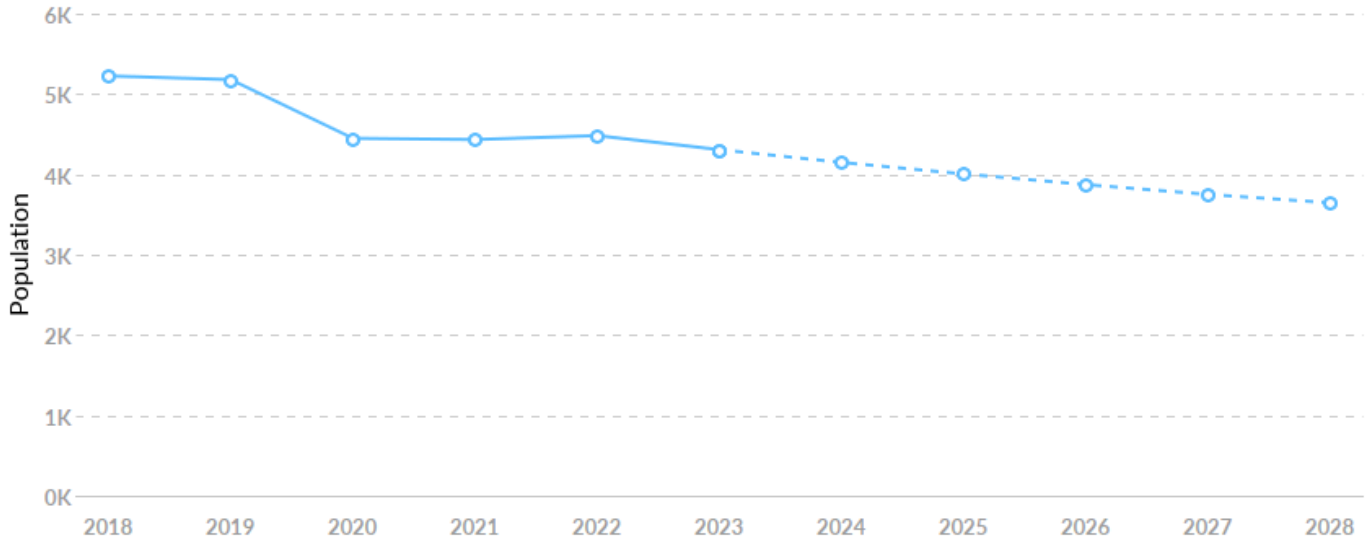

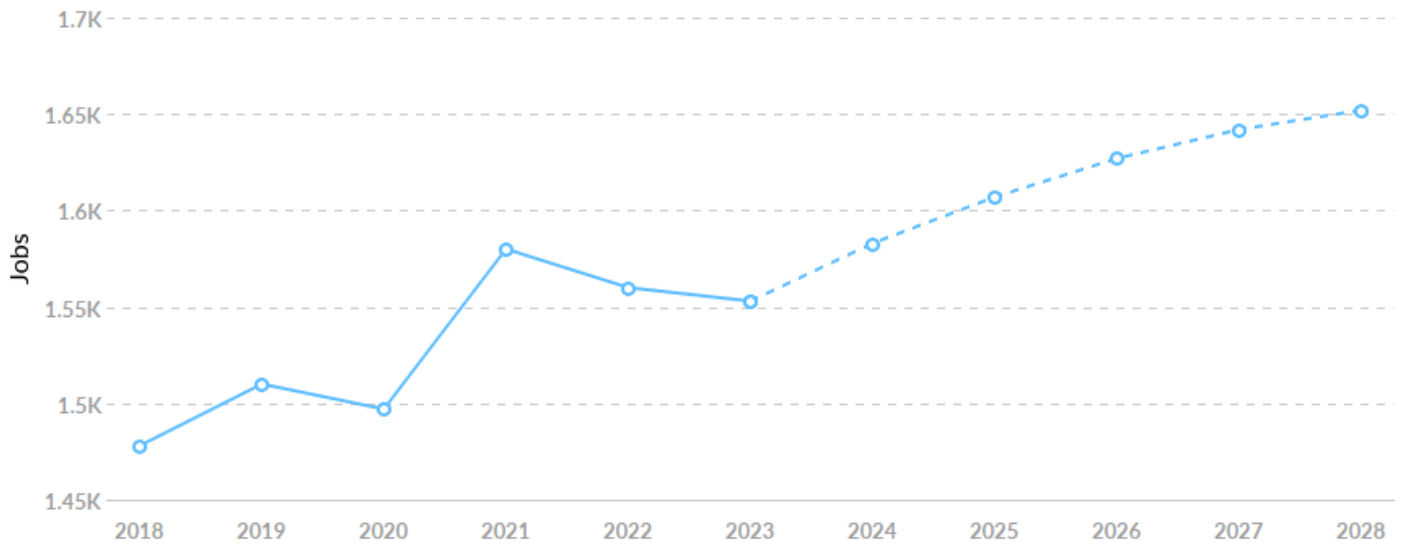

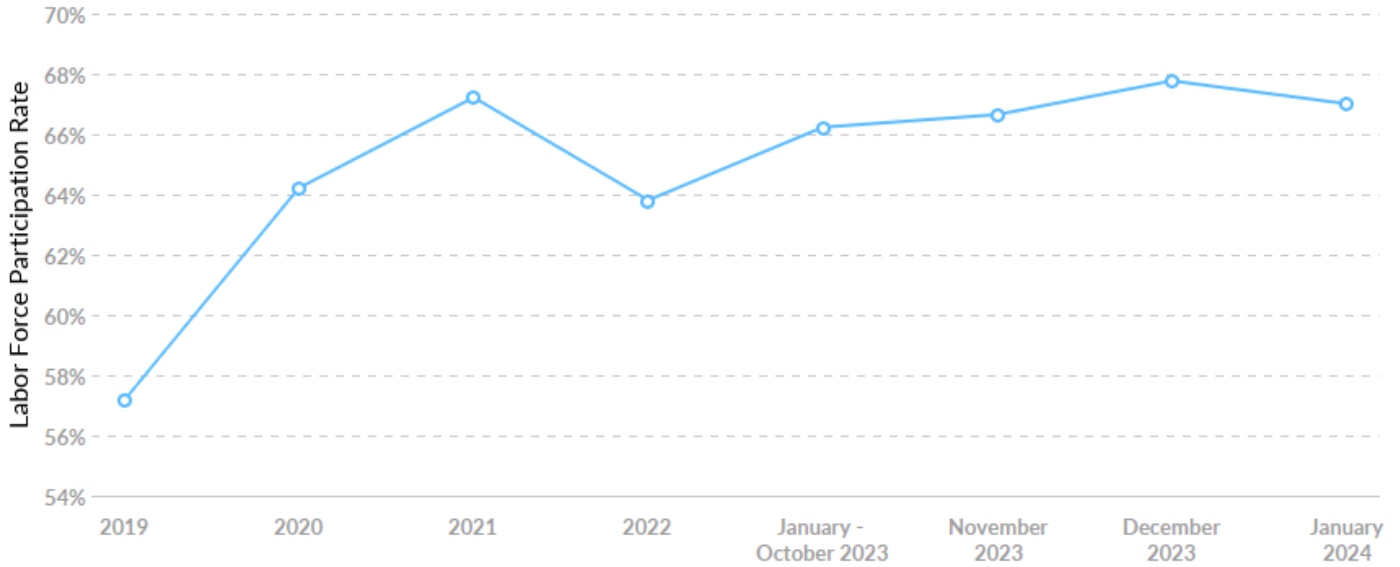
Job Trends

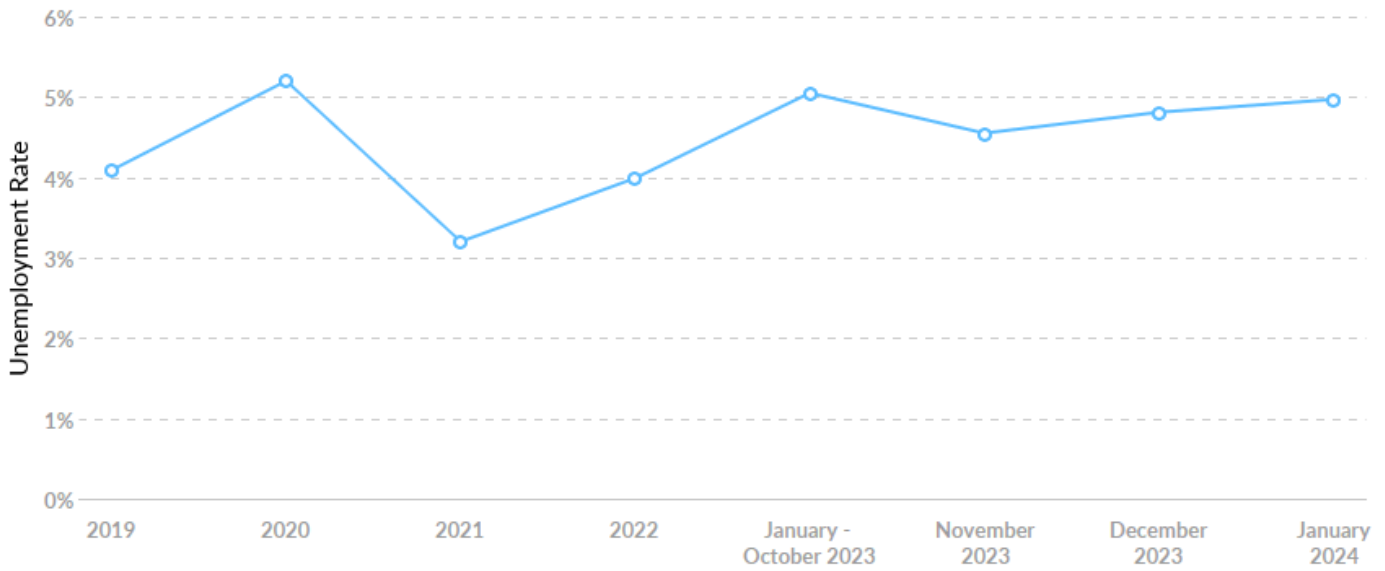

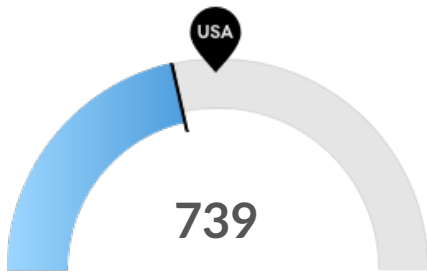
Unemployment Rate Trends

Lincoln County, NV had a January 2024 unemployment rate of 4.97%, **increasing from 4.09%** 5 years before.



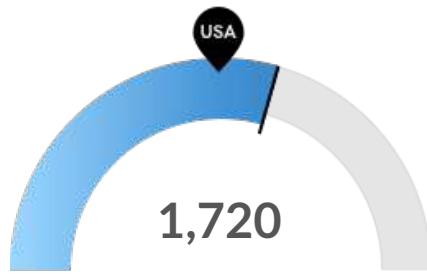

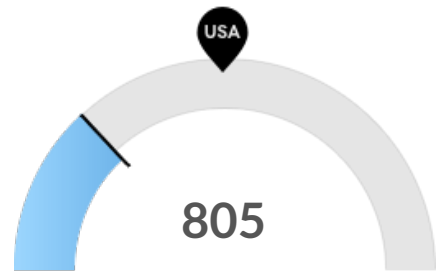
Millennials

Lincoln County, NV has 739 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 911.



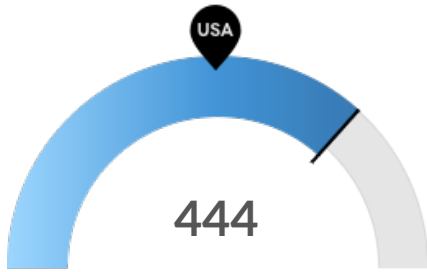
Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is high in Lincoln County, NV. The national average for an area this size is 1,343 people 55 or older, while there are 1,720 here.



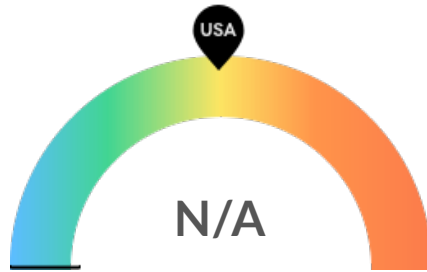
Racial Diversity

Racial diversity is low in Lincoln County, NV. The national average for an area this size is 1,843 racially diverse people, while there are 805 here.



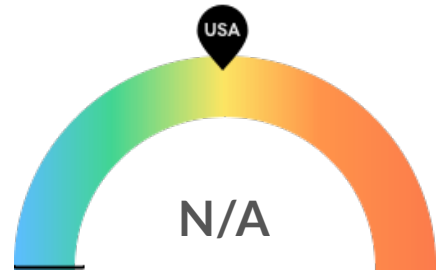
Veterans

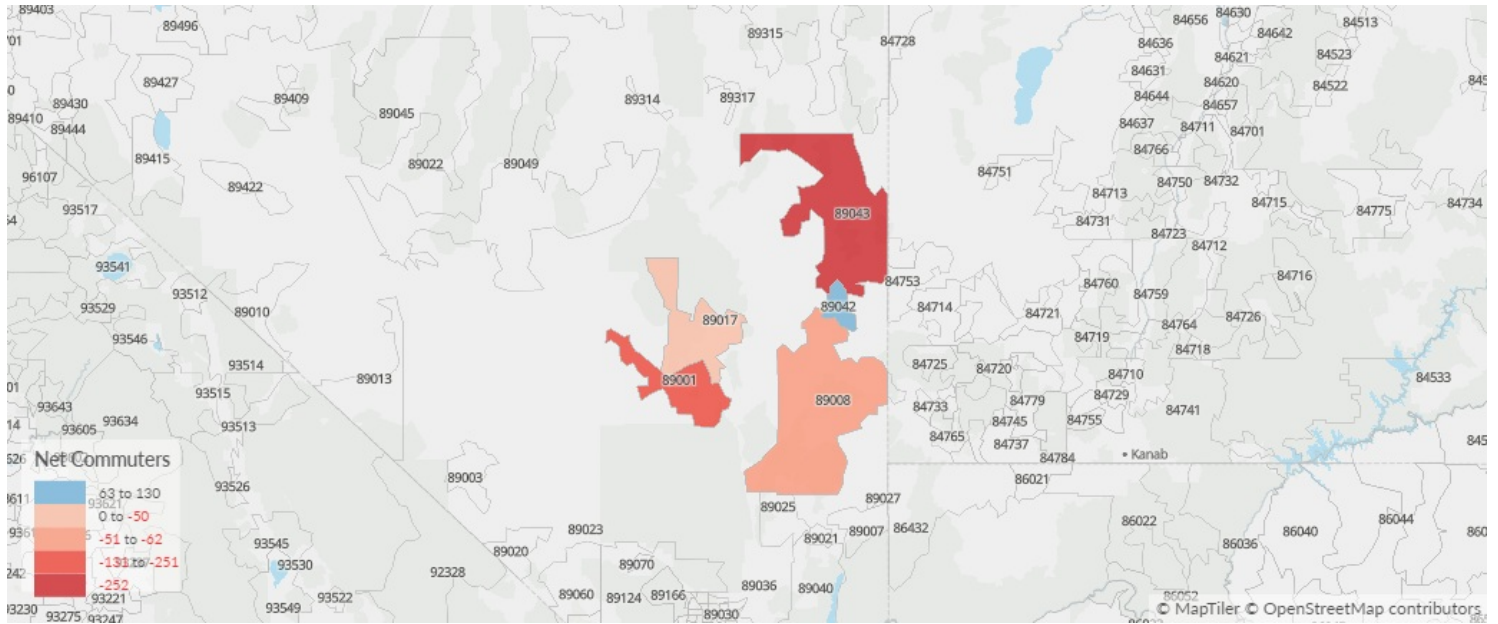

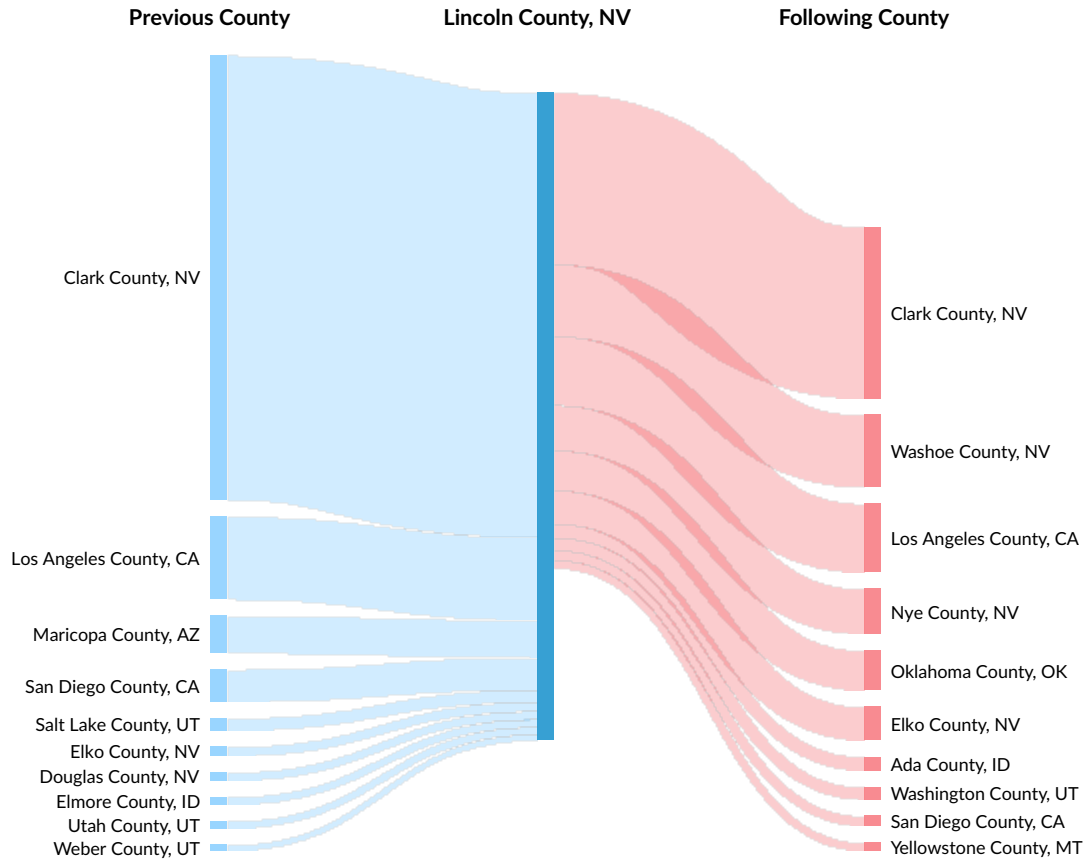

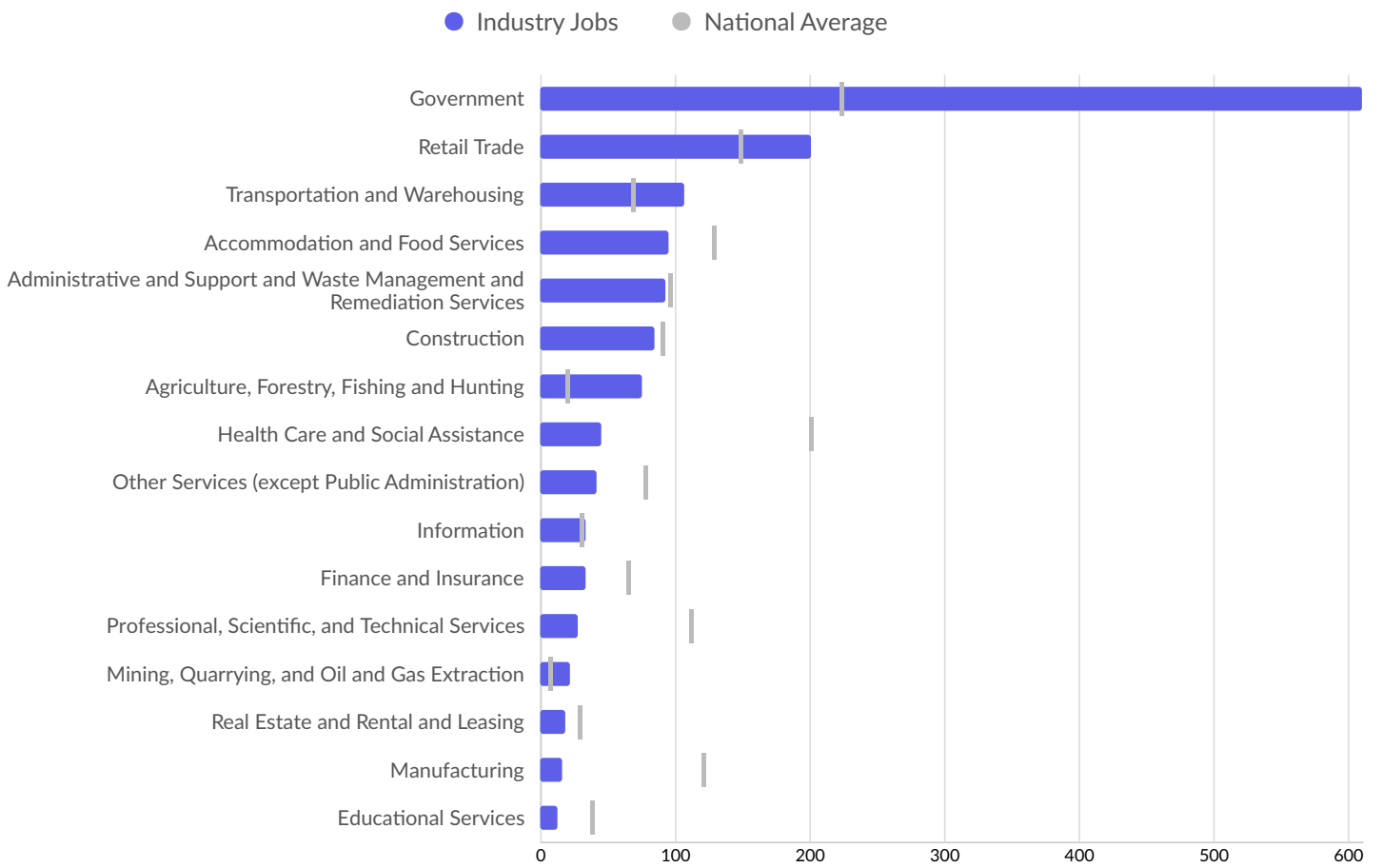

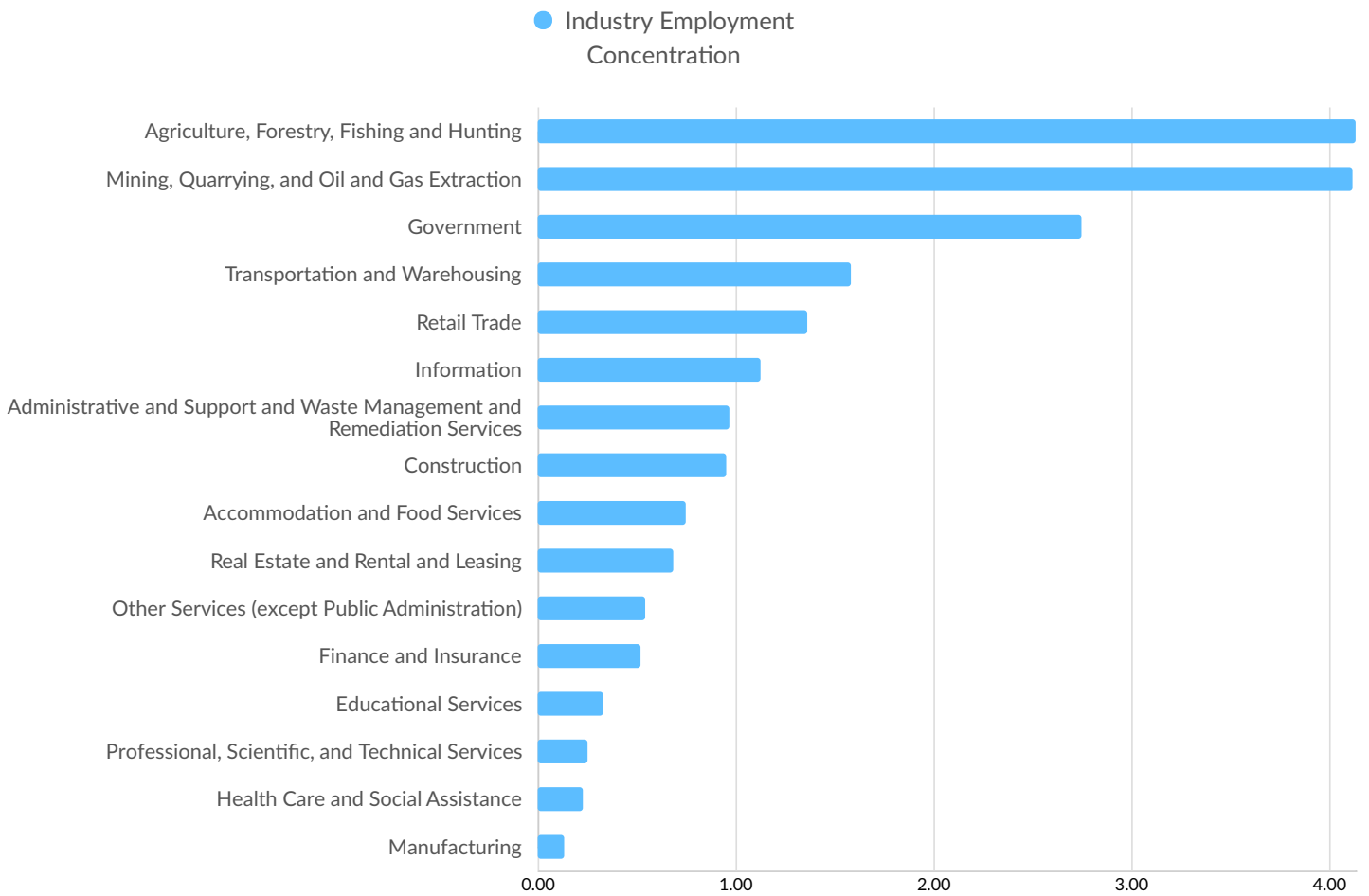

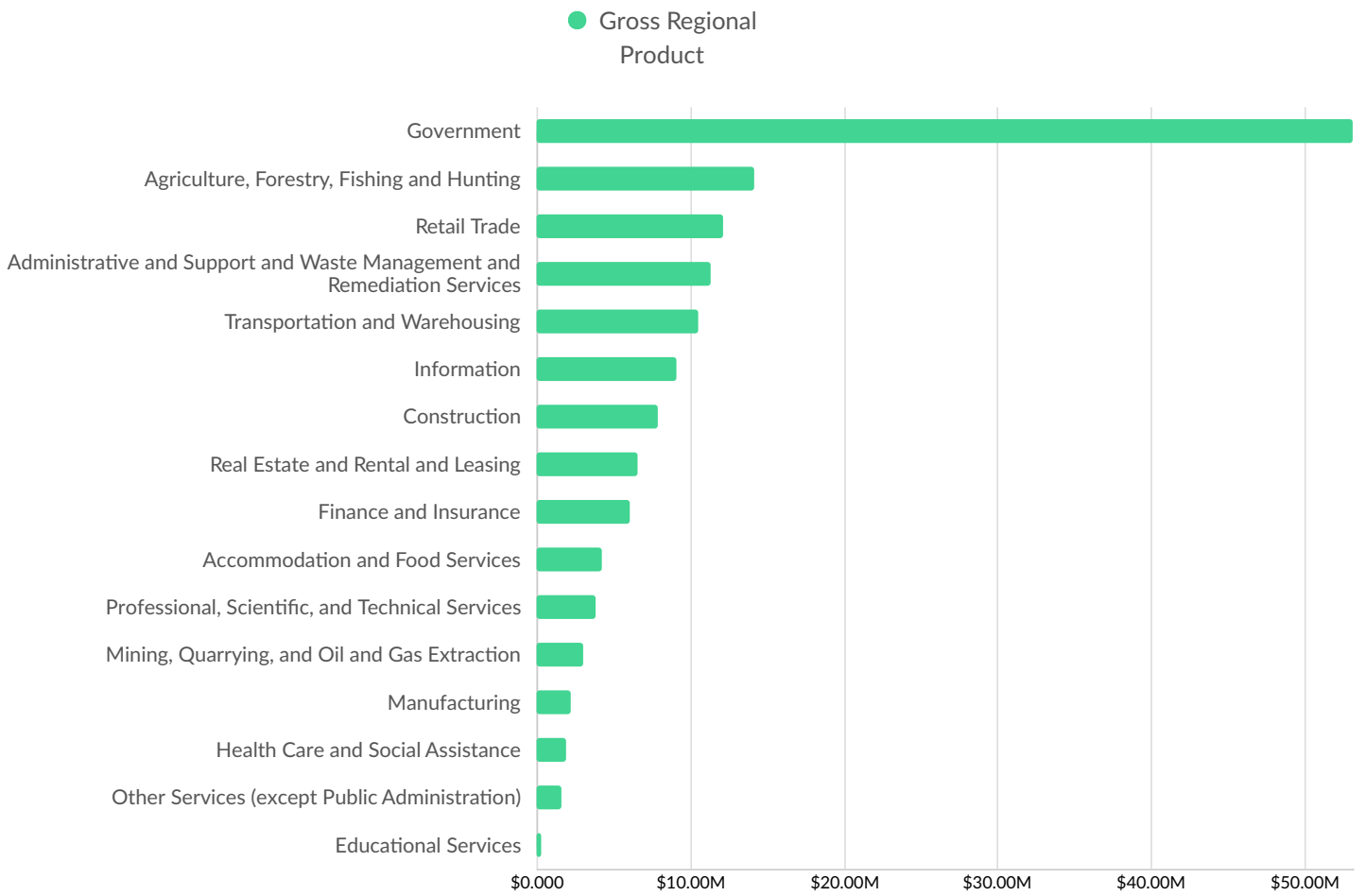
Top Growing Industries



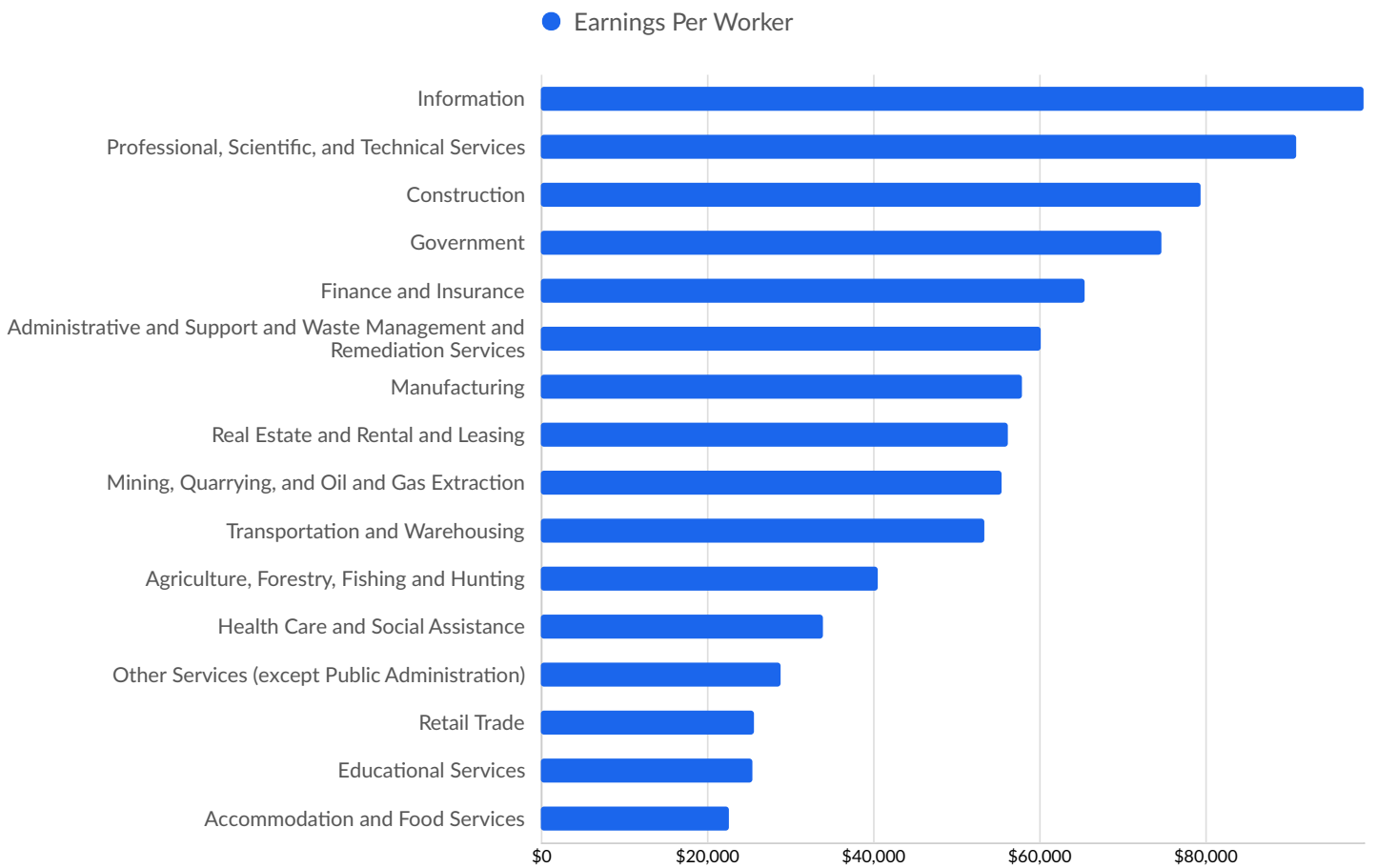
Top Industry Employment Concentration

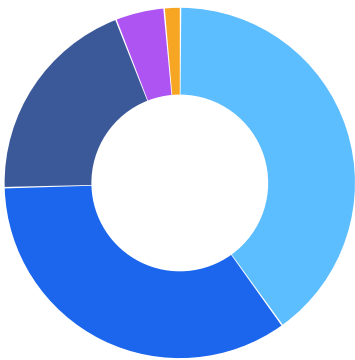

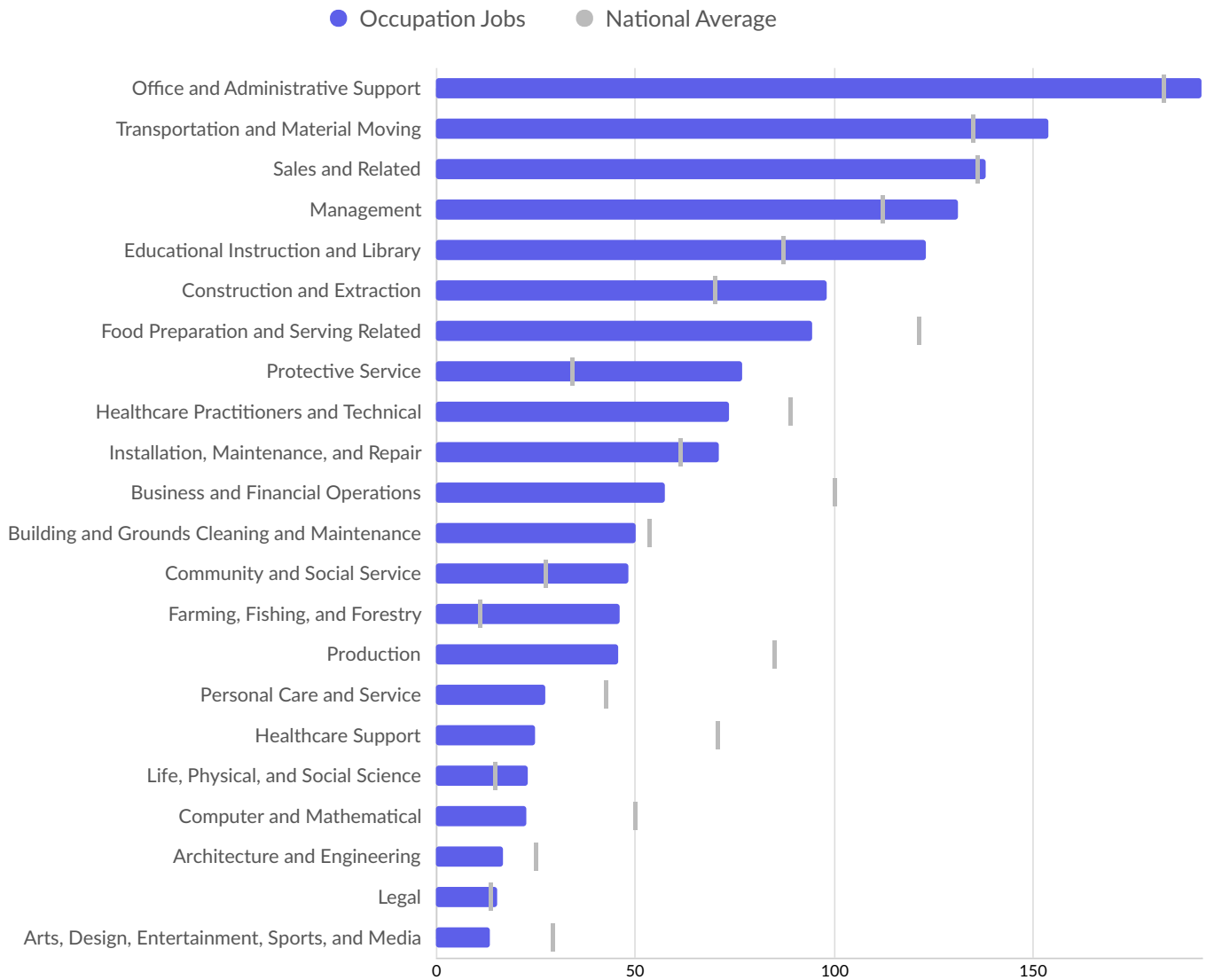

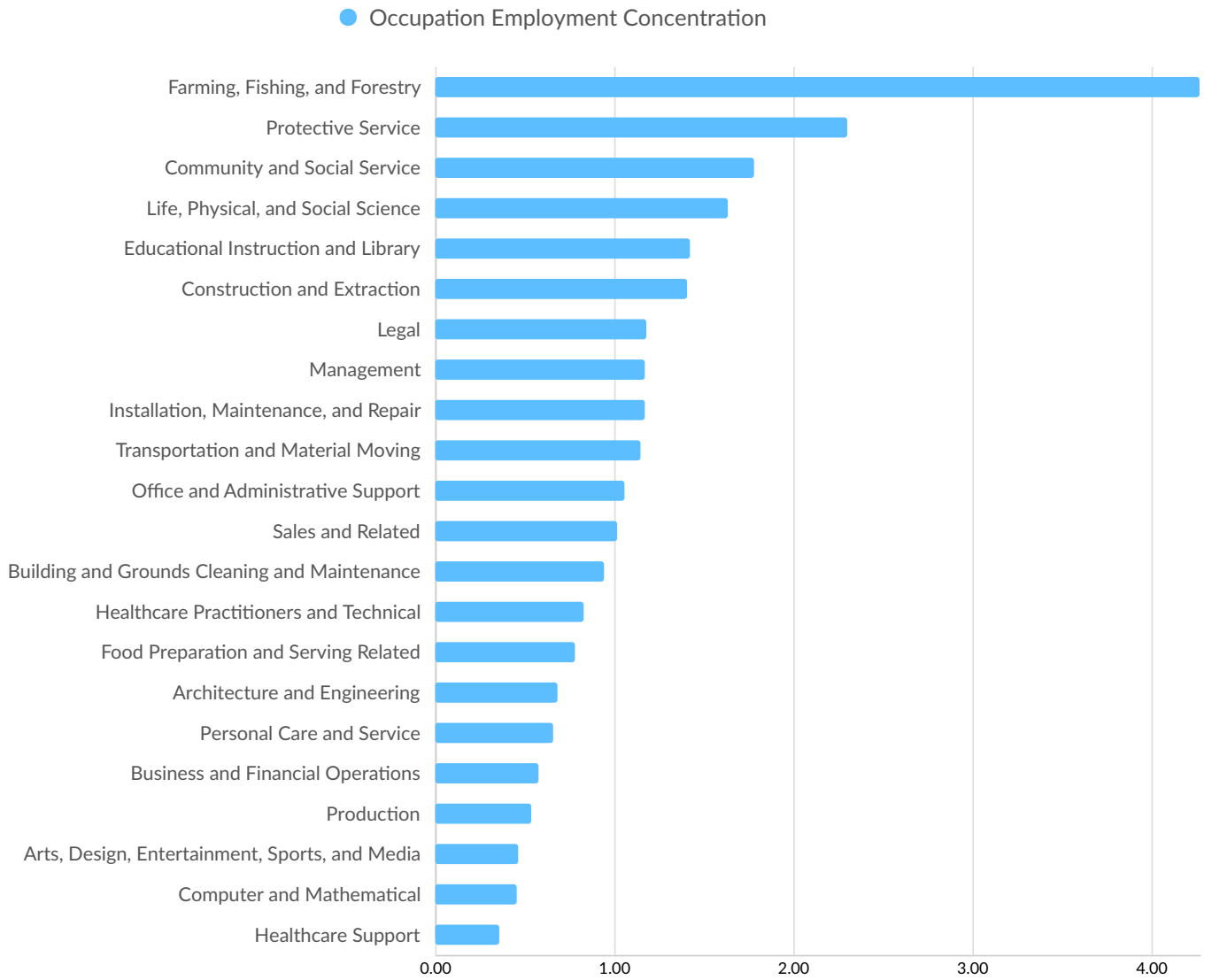

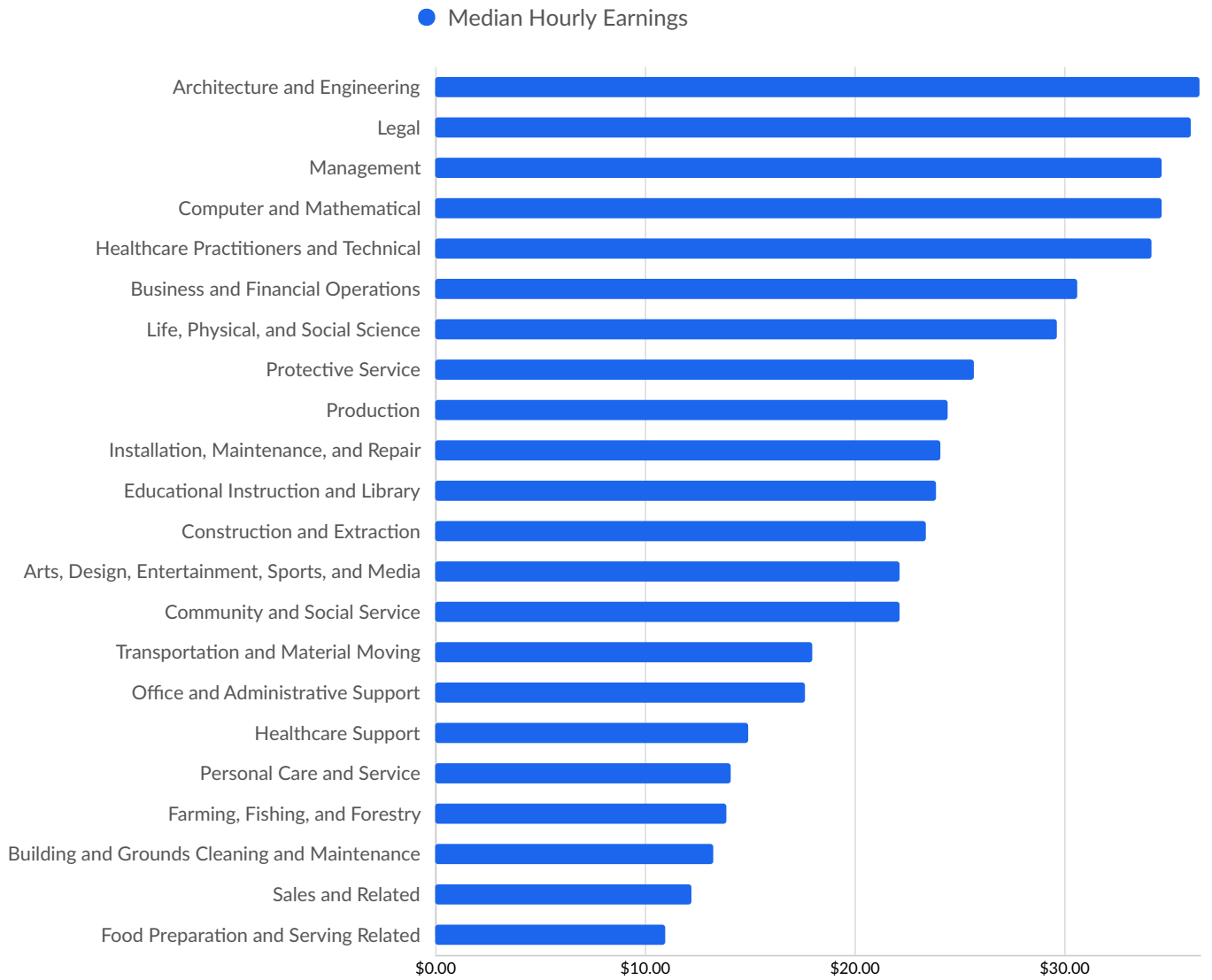
Top Growing Occupations



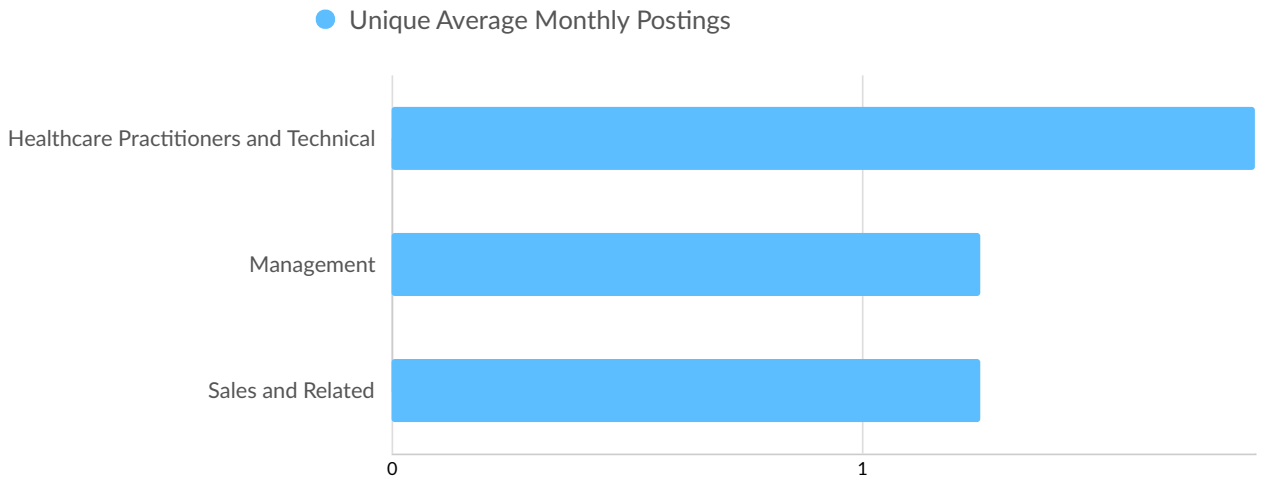
Top Occupation Employment Concentration



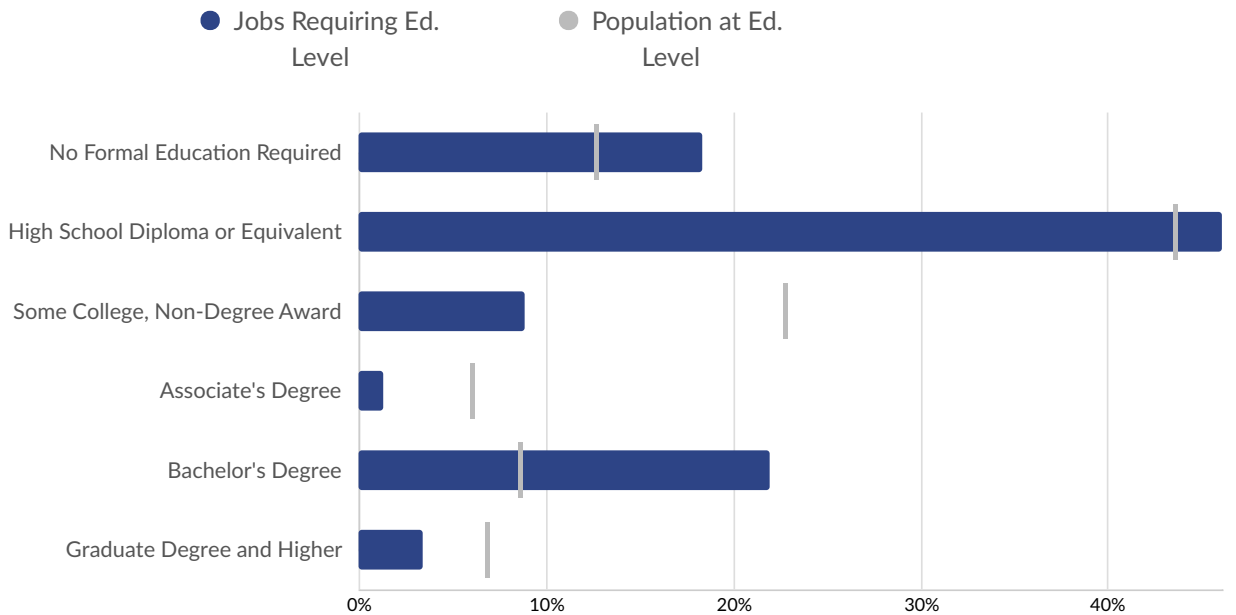
