- From 2018 to 2023, jobs declined by 5.3% in Mineral County, NV from 1,707 to 1,616. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 3.6% by 8.9%. As the number of jobs declined, the labor force participation rate decreased from 53.3% to 52.2% between 2018 and 2023.
- Concerning educational attainment, **10.2% of Mineral County, NV residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (10.9% below the national average), and **3.9% hold an Associate's Degree** (5.0% below the national average).
- The top three industries in 2023 are Facilities Support Services, Education and Hospitals (Local Government), and Local Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals.







Unemployment by Gender





Unemployment by Ethnicity










Labor Force Participation Rate Trends

Mineral County, NV had a January 2024 unemployment rate of 6.14%, increasing from 4.08% 5 years before.




Millennials

Retirement risk is high in Mineral County, NV. The national average for an area this size is 1,356 people 55 or older, while there are 1,882 here.




Racial diversity is about average in Mineral County, NV. The national average for an area this size is 1,861 racially diverse people, while there are 1,844 here.




Veterans

Mineral County, NV has 1.77 violent crimes per 1,000 people. The national rate is 3.6 per 1,000 people.




Property Crime








Top Growing Industries




Top Industry Employment Concentration







Top Growing Occupations




Top Occupation Employment Concentration





Top Occupation Earnings




