- From 2018 to 2023, jobs increased by 6.6% in Washoe County, NV from 244,172 to 260,233. This change outpaced the national growth rate of 3.6% by 3.0%. As the number of jobs increased, the labor force participation rate increased from 64.2% to 64.7% between 2018 and 2023.
- Concerning educational attainment, 20.0% of Washoe County, NV residents possess a Bachelor's Degree (1.2% below the national average), and 8.8% hold an Associate's Degree (0.1% below the national average).
- The top three industries in 2023 are Restaurants and Other Eating Places, Traveler Accommodation, and Warehousing and Storage.




Jan 2024 Labor Force Breakdown



Educational Attainment











Unemployment by Ethnicity







Job Trends






Washoe County, NV had a January 2024 unemployment rate of 4.38%, increasing from 3.41% 5 years before.




Millennials

an area this size is 25,949.




Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is about average in Washoe County, NV. The national average for an area this size is 148,866 people 55 or older, while there are 151,068 here.




Violent Crime

Racial diversity is about average in Washoe County, NV. The national average for an area this size is 204,282 racially diverse people, while there are 197,583 here.




Property Crime










Top Growing Industries






Top Industry Employment Concentration






Top Industry GRP








Top Occupation Employment Concentration






