- From 2018 to 2023, jobs increased by 10.1% in Esmeralda County, NV from 357 to 393. This change outpaced the national growth rate of 3.9% by 6.2%. As the number of jobs increased, the labor force participation rate increased from 61.5% to 71.7% between 2018 and 2023.
- Concerning educational attainment, **12.6% of Esmeralda County, NV residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (8.5% below the national average), and **5.9% hold an Associate's Degree** (2.9% below the national average).
- The top three industries in 2023 are Nonmetallic Mineral Mining and Quarrying, Local Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals, and Education and Hospitals (Local Government).




Feb 2024 Labor Force Breakdown






Unemployment by Gender



Unemployment by Ethnicity





As of 2023 the region's population declined by 9.9% since 2018, falling by 82. Population is expected to increase by 5.8% between 2023 and 2028, adding 43.



Job Trends






Esmeralda County, NV had a February 2024 unemployment rate of 5.17%, increasing from 3.85% 5 years before.


Racial Diversity
















Top Industry Employment Concentration






