- From 2018 to 2023, jobs increased by 9.5% in Lander County, NV from 3,636 to 3,983. This change outpaced the national growth rate of 3.9% by 5.6%. As the number of jobs increased, the labor force participation rate decreased from 74.6% to 71.1% between 2018 and 2023.
- Concerning educational attainment, **6.3% of Lander County, NV residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (14.8% below the national average), and **17.3% hold an Associate's Degree** (8.5% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2023 are Metal Ore Mining, Education and Hospitals (Local Government), and Local Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals.

### **Educational Attainment**












### **Population Trends**




### **Unemployment Rate Trends**










### **Top Industry Employment Concentration**






#### **Top Occupation Employment Concentration**


### **Top Occupation Earnings**



Median Hourly Earnings


