Takeaways

- As of 2023 the region's population increased by 13.5% since 2018, growing by 7,538. Population is expected to increase by 12.9% between 2023 and 2028, adding 8,141.
- From 2018 to 2023, jobs increased by 12.7% in Lyon County, NV from 13,860 to 15,614. This change outpaced the national growth rate of 3.9% by 8.8%. As the number of jobs increased, the labor force participation rate decreased from 48.3% to 46.4% between 2018 and 2023.
- Concerning educational attainment, **11.8% of Lyon County**, **NV residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (9.4% below the national average), and **11.6% hold an Associate's Degree** (2.7% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2023 are Education and Hospitals (Local Government), Restaurants and Other Eating Places, and Warehousing and Storage.













Lyon County, NV had a February 2024 unemployment rate of 6.45%, increasing from 5.03% 5 years before.






Millennials

Retirement risk is high in Lyon County, NV. The national average for an area this size is 18,456 people 55 or older, while there are 22,012 here.




Racial Diversity

Racial diversity is low in Lyon County, NV. The national average for an area this size is 25,326 racially diverse people, while there are 17,616 here.




Veterans

Lyon County, NV has 2.58 violent crimes per 1,000 people. The national rate is 3.6 per 1,000 people.




Property Crime










Top Industry Employment Concentration







Top Growing Occupations




Top Occupation Employment Concentration






