- From 2018 to 2023, jobs increased by 8.5% in White Pine County, NV from 4,475 to 4,857. This change outpaced the national growth rate of 3.9% by 4.6%. As the number of jobs increased, the labor force participation rate increased from 68.9% to 79.8% between 2018 and 2023.
- Concerning educational attainment, **10.5% of White Pine County, NV residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (10.7% below the national average), and **11.5% hold an Associate's Degree** (2.7% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2023 are Metal Ore Mining, Education and Hospitals (Local Government), and State Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals.




Feb 2024 Labor Force Breakdown






Unemployment by Gender




Unemployment by Race

Unemployment by Ethnicity







Job Trends






White Pine County, NV had a February 2024 unemployment rate of 3.53%, increasing from 3.11% 5 years before.



Millennials




Veterans

White Pine County, NV has 713 veterans. The national average for an area this size is 460.




Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is high in White Pine County, NV. The national average for an area this size is 2,634 people 55 or older, while there are 2,958 here.




Violent Crime

Racial diversity is low in White Pine County, NV. The national average for an area this size is 3,614 racially diverse people, while there are 2,579 here.




Property Crime








Top Growing Industries






Top Industry Employment Concentration






Top Industry GRP





Top Occupation Employment Concentration









