Apple, Inc. (Apple) plans to expand its existing Washoe County Data Center operations. Apple is an American multinational corporation and technology company headquartered in Cupertino, California. The company designs, develops, and sells consumer electronics, computer software, and online services. Apple opened its data center located just outside of Reno, in December 2012 and is the first company to have built a data center at the Reno Technology Park. All Apple facilities — including its data center in Reno — are powered entirely with renewable energy. Most recently, Apple utilized the NV GreenEnergy Rider program to create two additional solar projects: the 200-megawatt Techren II solar project, online in 2019, and the 50-megawatt Turquoise Project, online in 2020. Over the past year, Apple's Reno data center was supported by projects that generated 440 million kilowatt-hours (kWh) of renewable energy. Use of this renewable energy allowed Apple to avoid more than 130,600 million metric tons of CO2e (carbon dioxide equivalent) during the year. *Source: Apple, Inc.*
