- From 2018 to 2023, jobs increased by 11.5% in Esmeralda County, NV from 357 to 398. This change outpaced the national growth rate of 4.3% by 7.2%. As the number of jobs increased, the labor force participation rate increased from 61.5% to 76.7% between 2018 and 2023.
- Concerning educational attainment, **12.7% of Esmeralda County, NV residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (8.5% below the national average), and **5.9% hold an Associate's Degree** (2.9% below the national average).
- The top three industries in 2023 are Nonmetallic Mineral Mining and Quarrying, Local Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals, and Education and Hospitals (Local Government).




Jun 2024 Labor Force Breakdown









Unemployment by Ethnicity
























Top Growing Industries






Top Industry Employment Concentration




Top Industry GRP








Top Growing Occupations




Top Occupation Employment Concentration


