
#### **Takeaways**

- As of 2023 the region's population **declined by 7.9%** since 2018, falling by 160. Population is expected to **decrease by 1.0%** between 2023 and 2028, losing 19.
- From 2018 to 2023, jobs increased by 2.6% in Eureka County, NV from 4,526 to 4,643. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 4.3% by 1.7%. As the number of jobs increased, the labor force participation rate increased from 65.8% to 68.8% between 2018 and 2023.
- Concerning educational attainment, 9.3% of Eureka County, NV residents possess a Bachelor's Degree (11.9% below the national average), and 3.7% hold an Associate's Degree (5.1% below the national average).
- The top three industries in 2023 are Metal Ore Mining, Nonmetallic Mineral Mining and Quarrying, and Local Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals.













# **Population Trends**



### **Job Trends**






Eureka County, NV had a June 2024 unemployment rate of 6.89%, increasing from 2.50% 5 years before.


Eureka County, NV has 315 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 379.

Retirement risk is high in Eureka County, NV. The national average for an area this size is 558 people 55 or older, while there are 679 here.



Eureka County, NV has 3.22 violent crimes per 1,000 people. The national rate is 3.6 per 1,000 people.













### **Largest Occupations**






### **Top Growing Occupations**





# **Top Occupation Employment Concentration**








