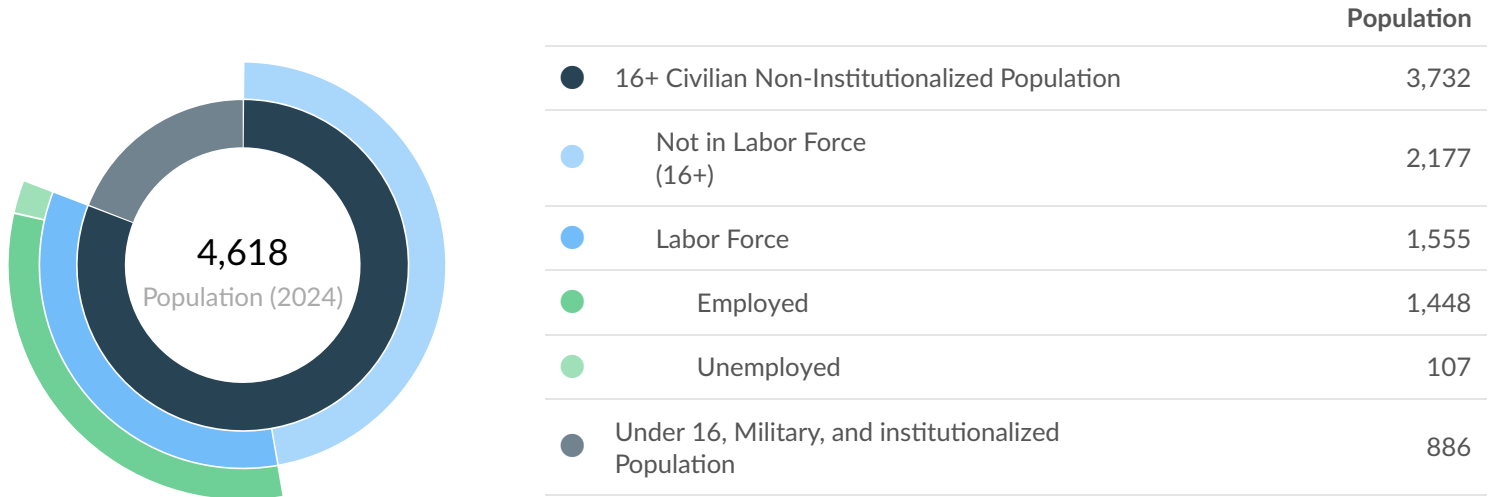
Median household income is **\$28.5K below** the national median household income of \$75.1K.

Takeaways

- As of 2023 the region's population **increased by 0.3%** since 2018, growing by 13. Population is expected to **increase by 4.2%** between 2023 and 2028, adding 190.
- From 2018 to 2023, jobs **declined by 16.3%** in Mineral County, NV from 1,707 to **1,428**. This change **fell short of the national growth rate of 4.3% by 20.6%**. As the number of jobs declined, the **labor force participation rate decreased from 53.3% to 39.1% between 2018 and 2023**.
- Concerning educational attainment, **11.1% of Mineral County, NV residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (10.1% below the national average), and **3.1% hold an Associate's Degree** (5.7% below the national average).
- The top three industries in 2023 are Education and Hospitals (Local Government), Local Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals, and Facilities Support Services.

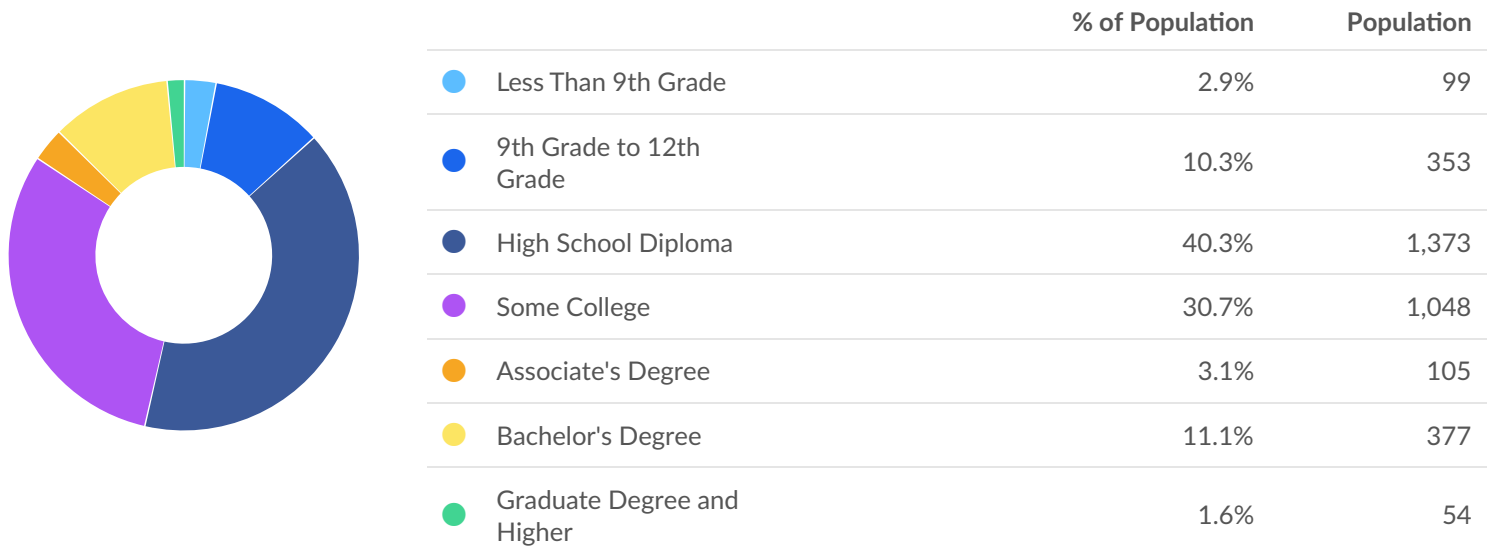

Jun 2024 Labor Force Breakdown



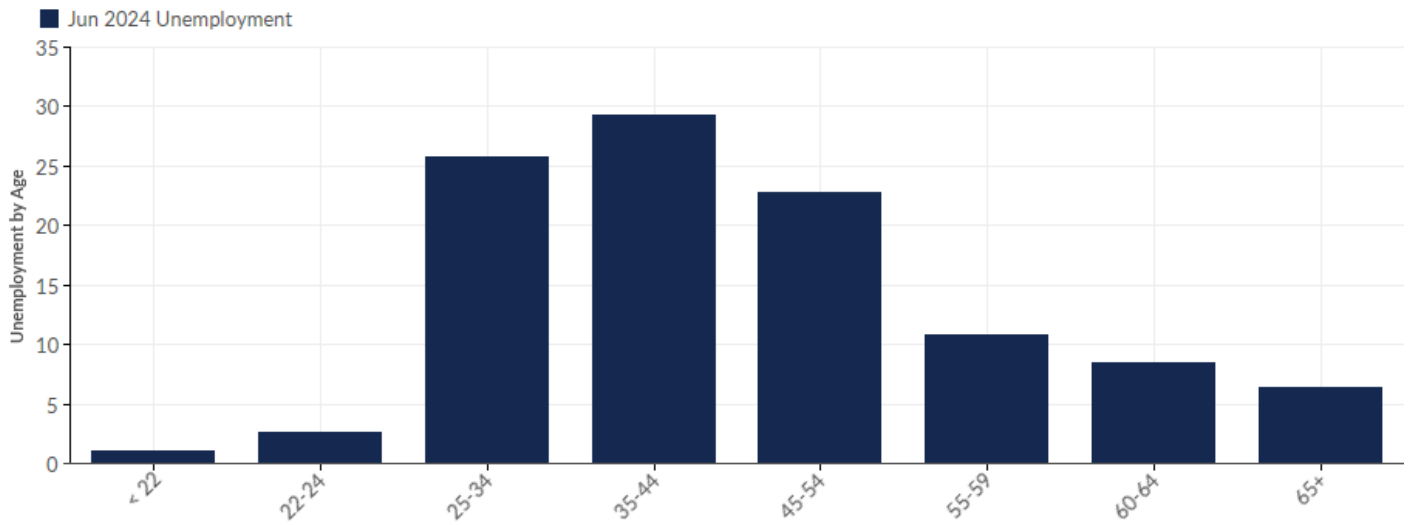
Educational Attainment

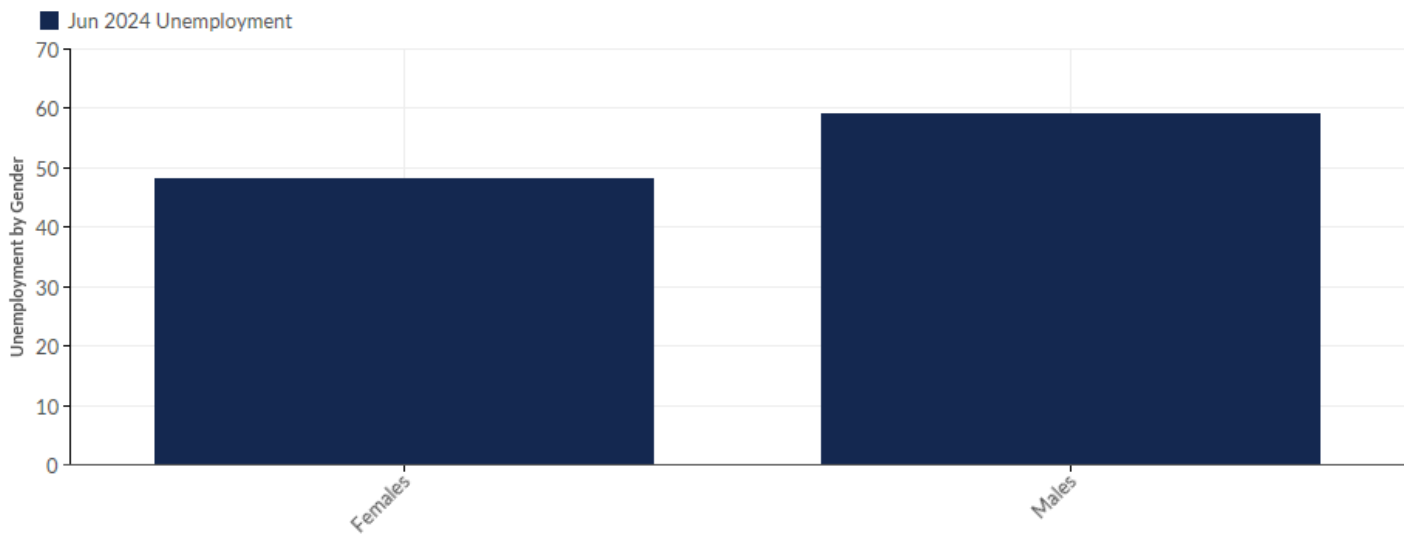

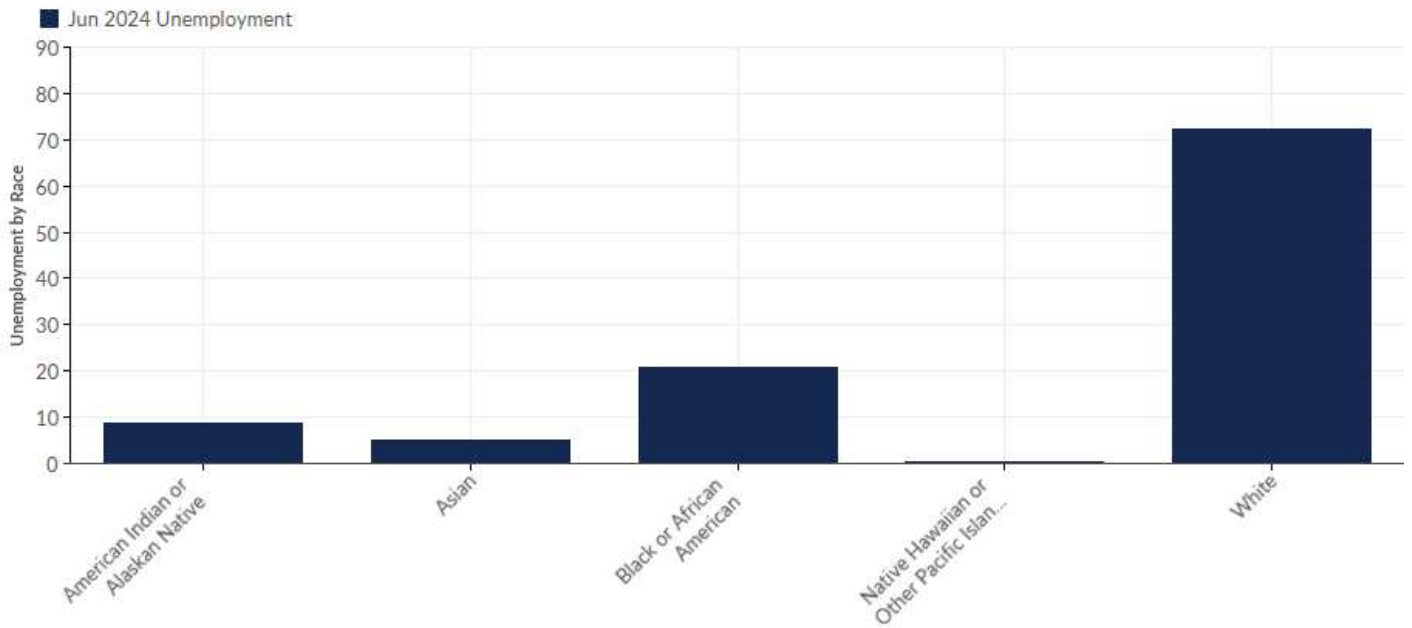

Unemployment by Gender



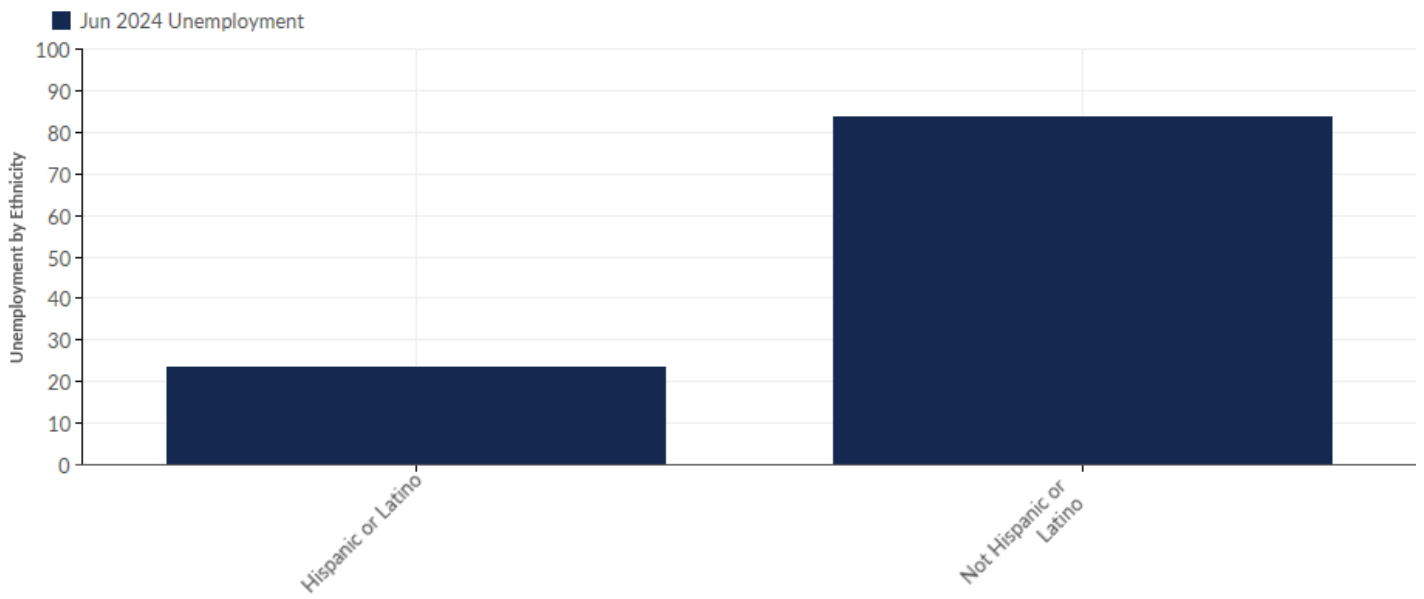

Unemployment by Ethnicity

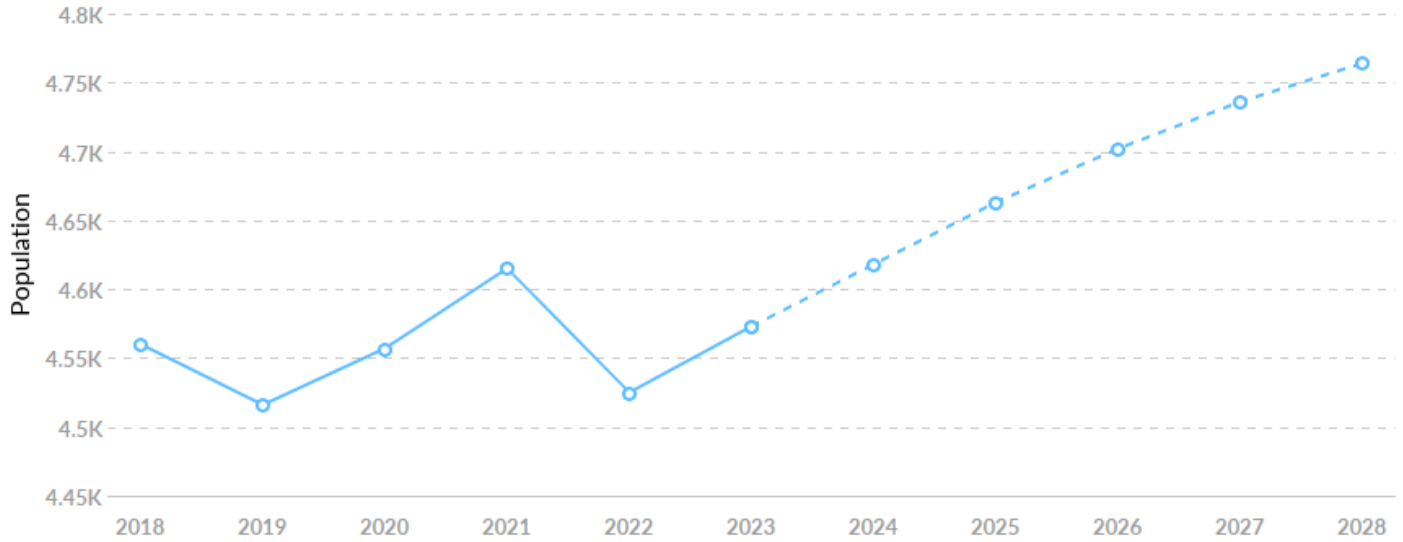

Population Trends

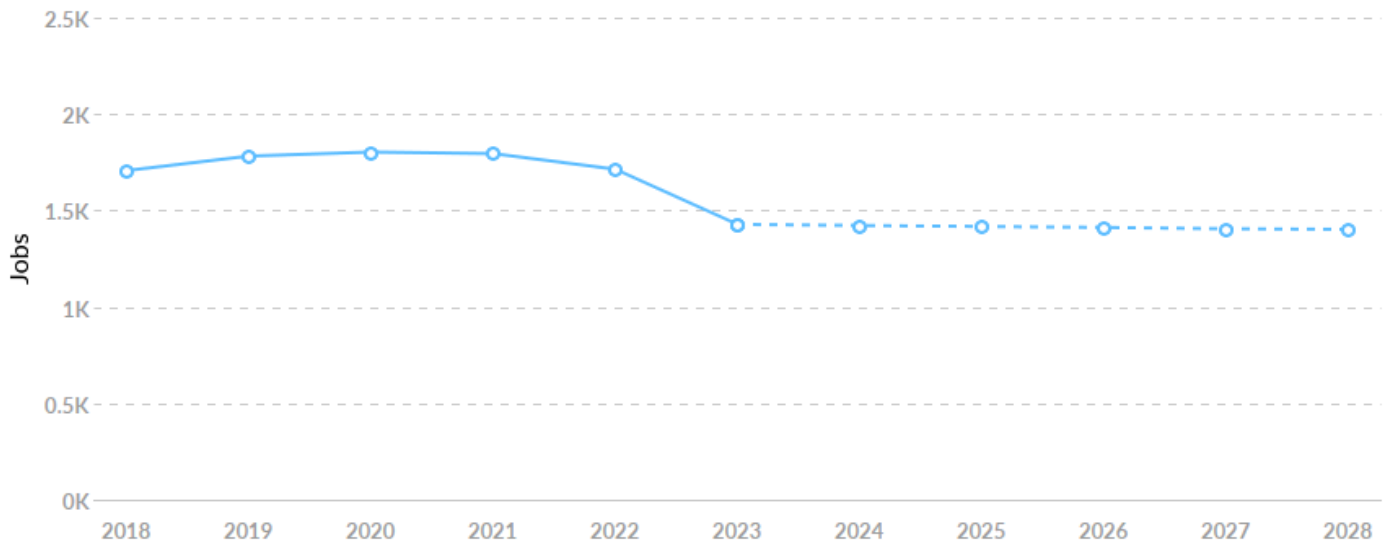

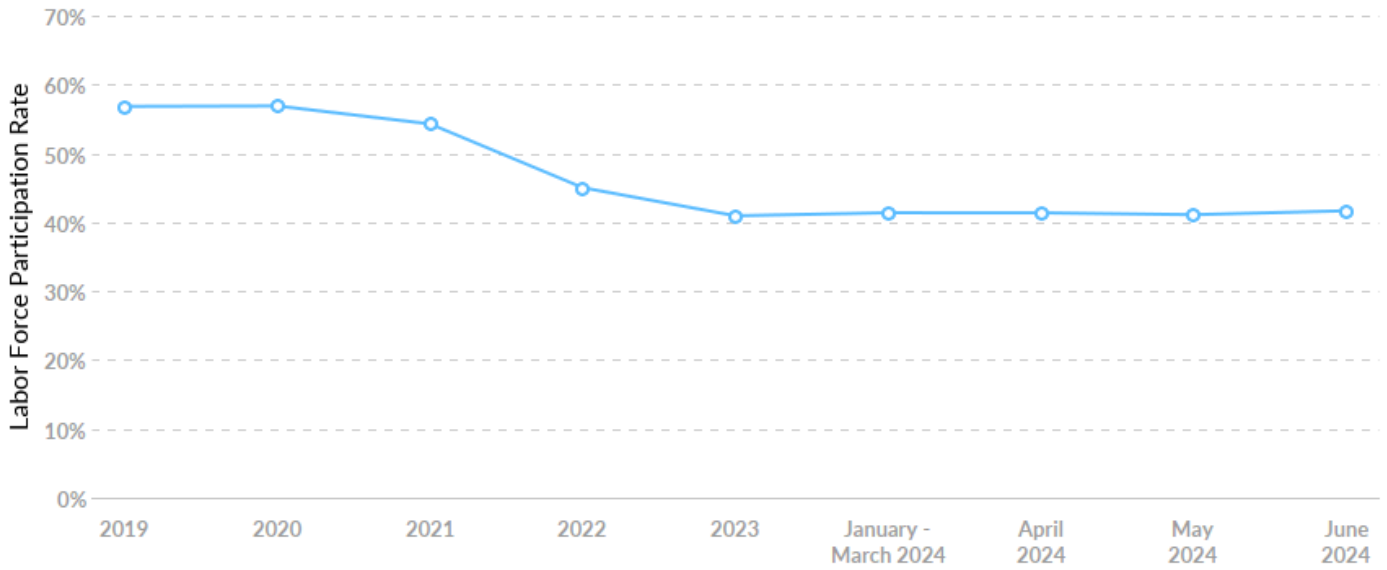
Job Trends

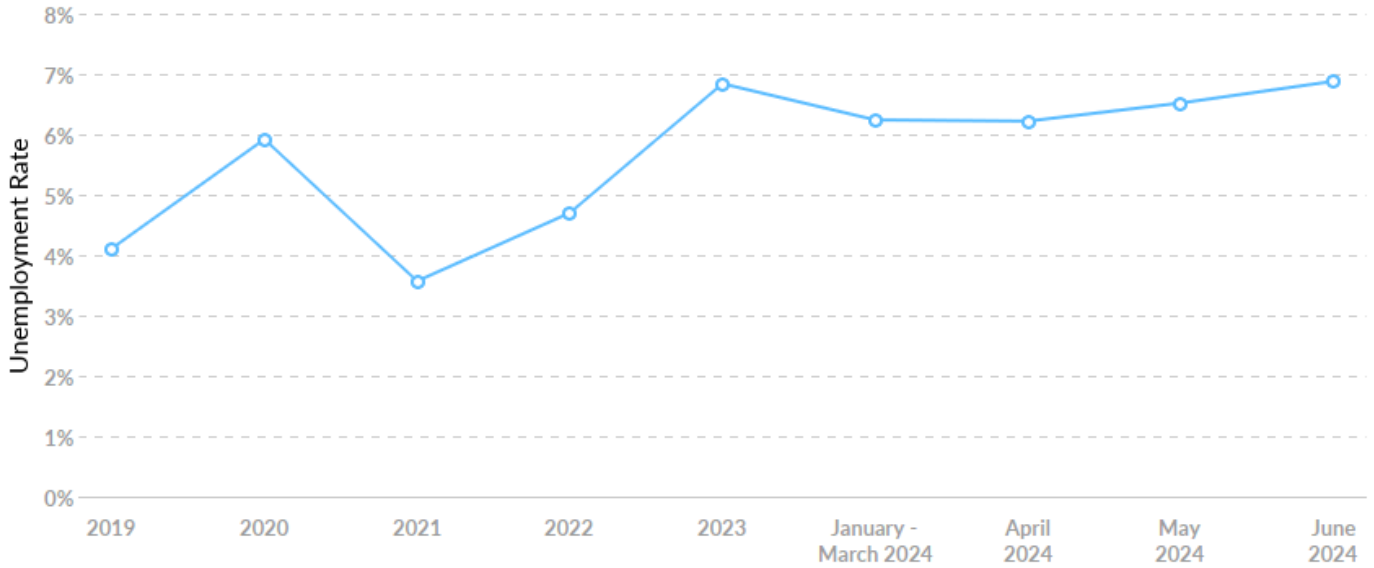

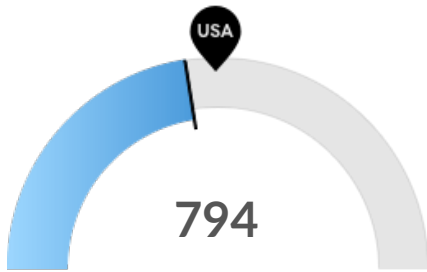
Unemployment Rate Trends

Mineral County, NV had a June 2024 unemployment rate of 6.88%, increasing from 4.11% 5 years before.



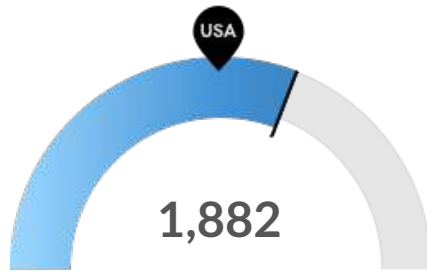

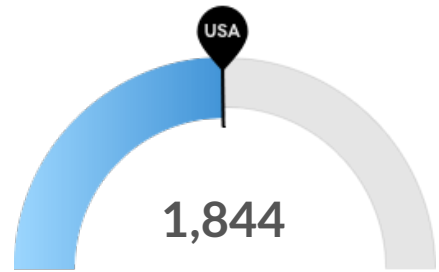
Millennials

Mineral County, NV has 794 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 920.



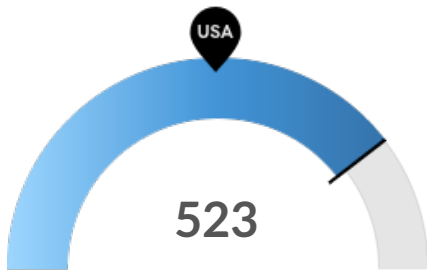
Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is high in Mineral County, NV. The national average for an area this size is 1,356 people 55 or older, while there are 1,882 here.



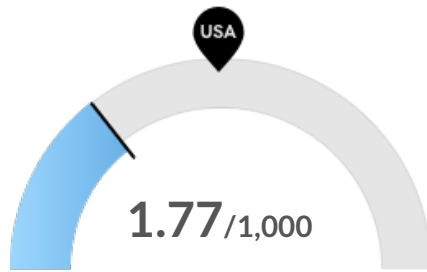
Racial Diversity

Racial diversity is about average in Mineral County, NV. The national average for an area this size is 1,861 racially diverse people, while there are 1,844 here.



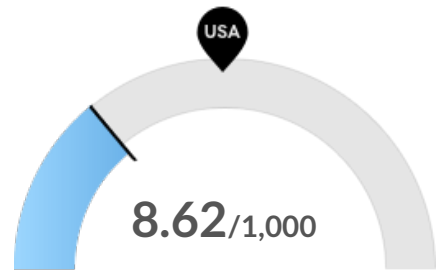
Veterans

Mineral County, NV has 1.77 violent crimes per 1,000 people. The national rate is 3.6 per 1,000 people.

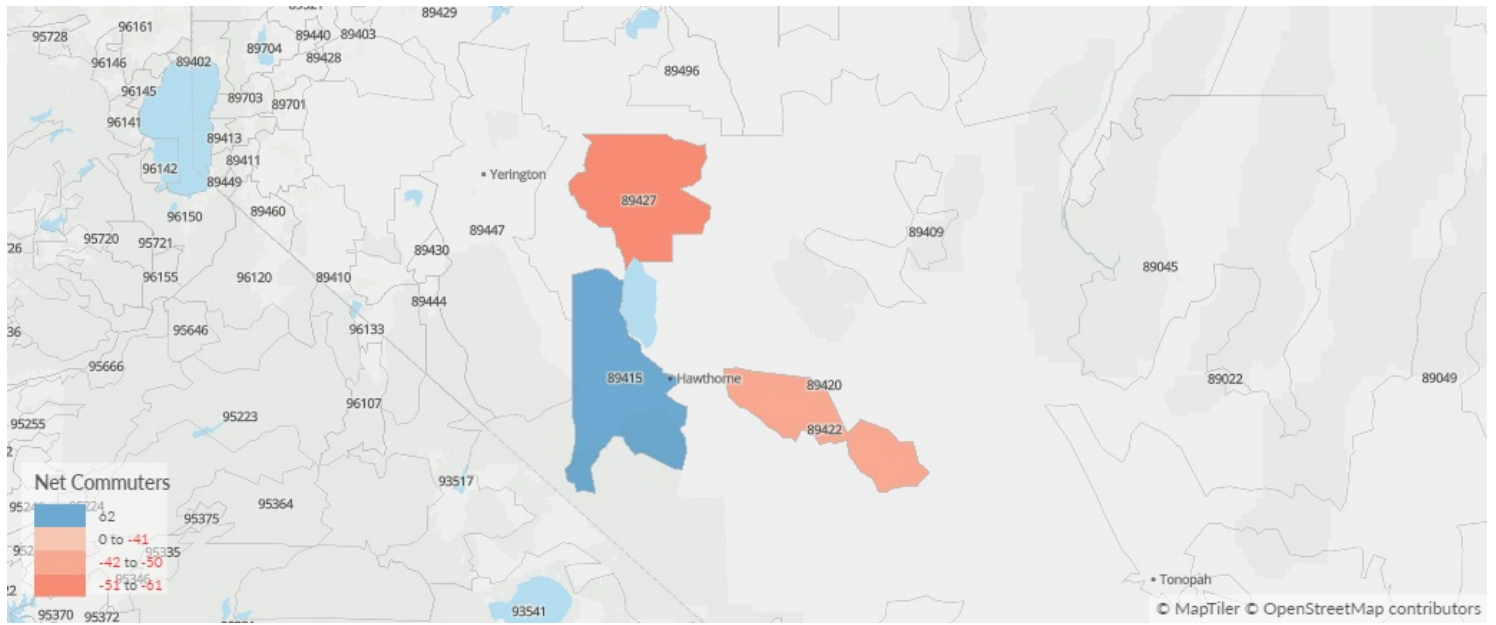


Property Crime

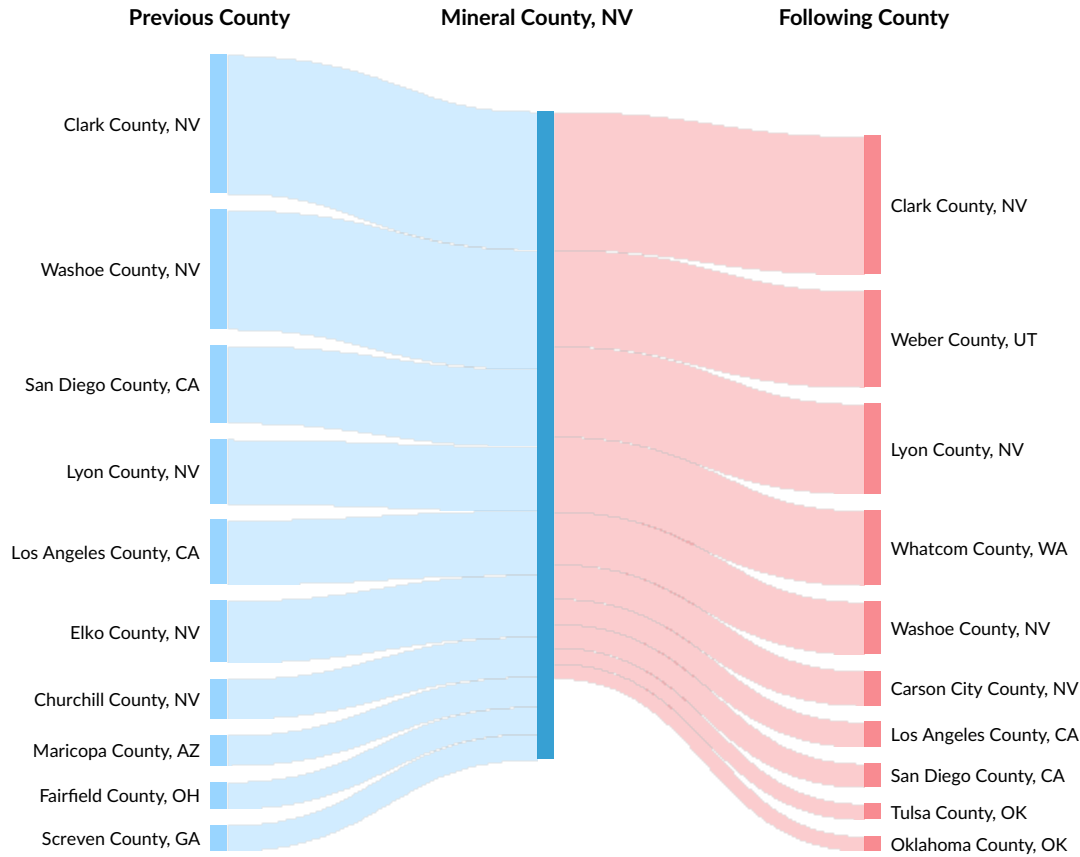

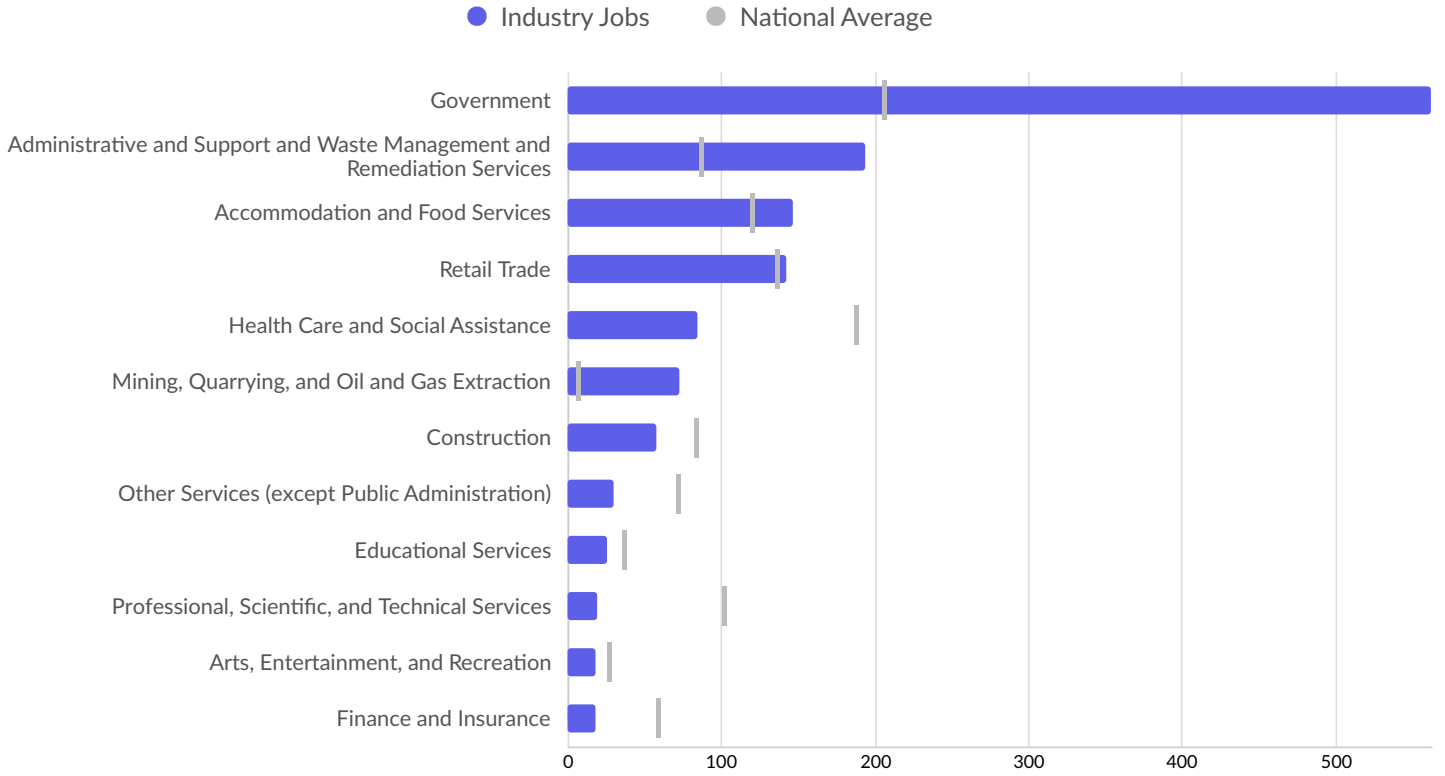

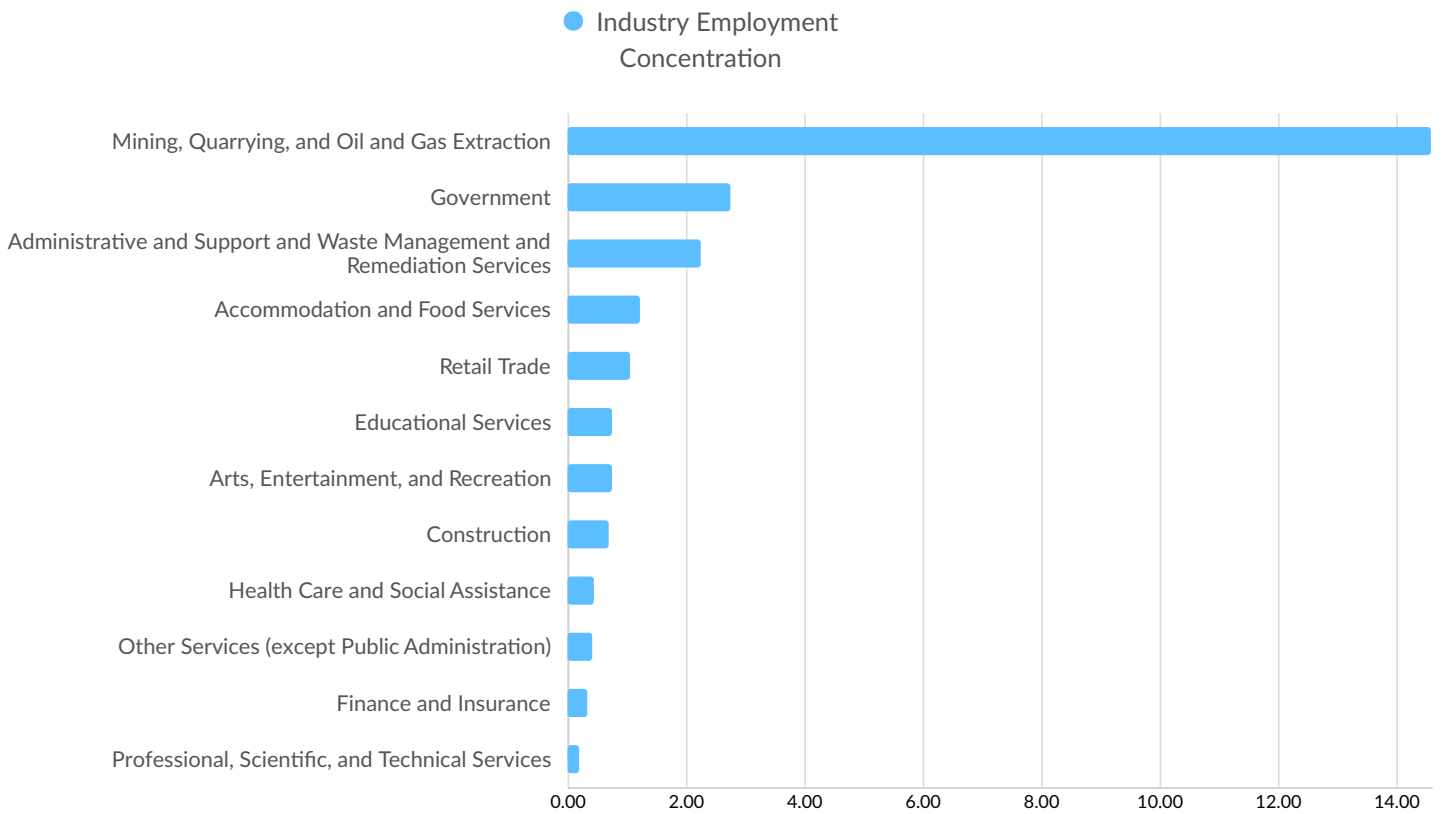

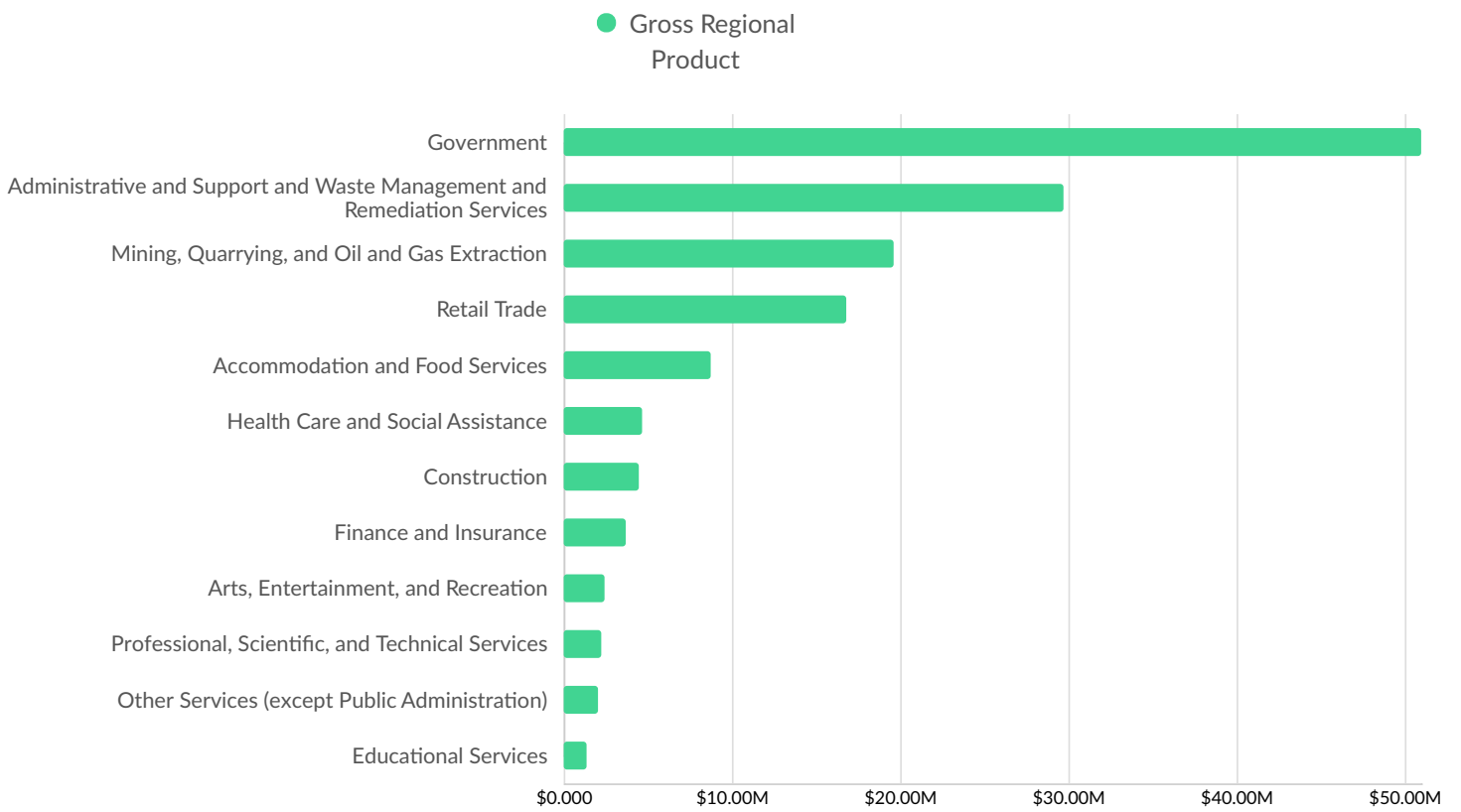
Top Growing Industries

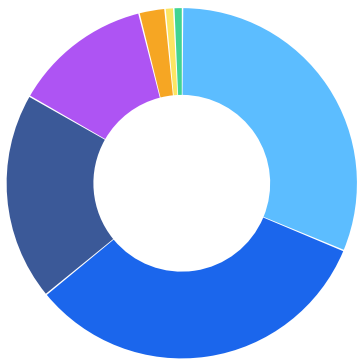

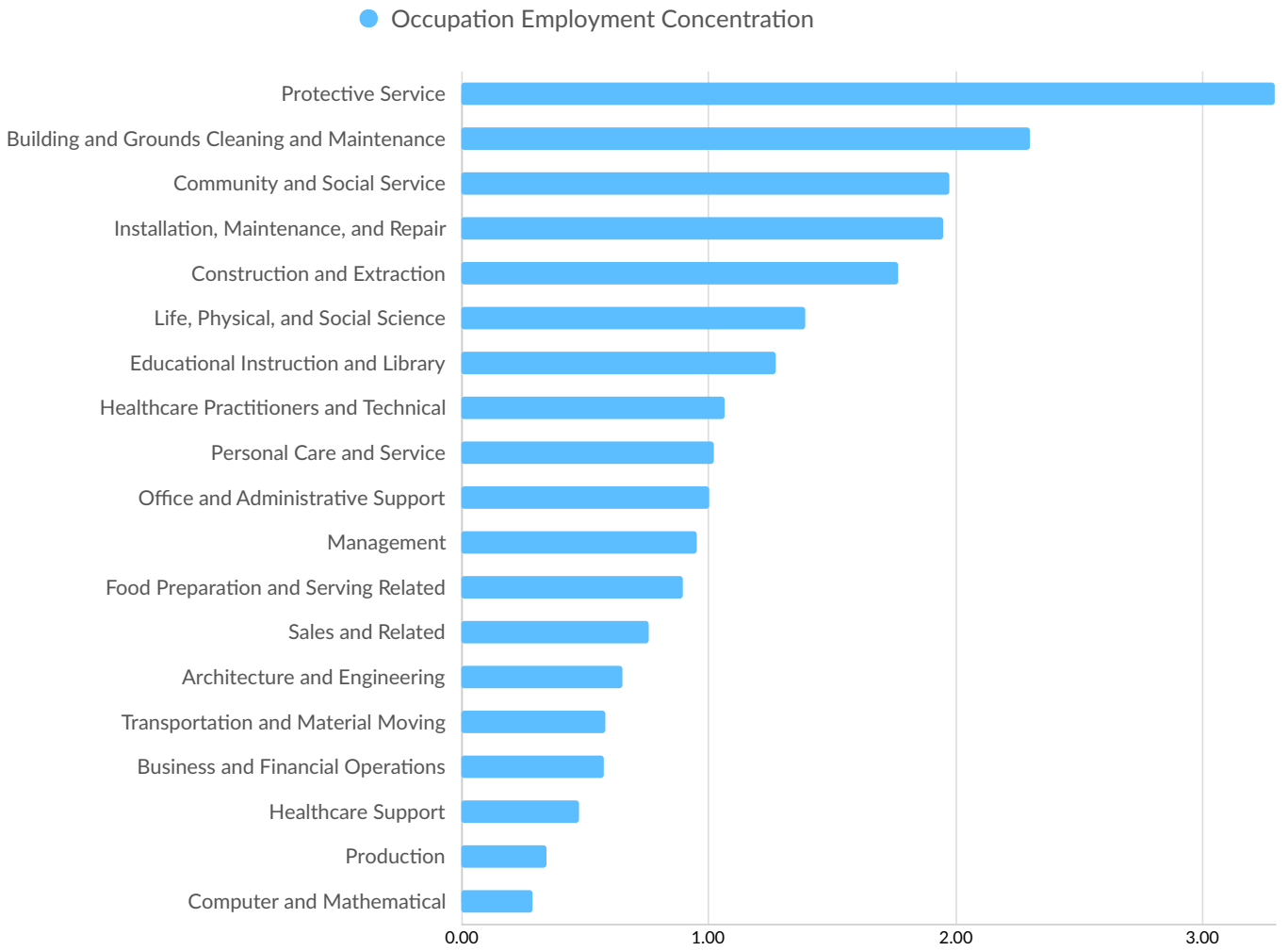

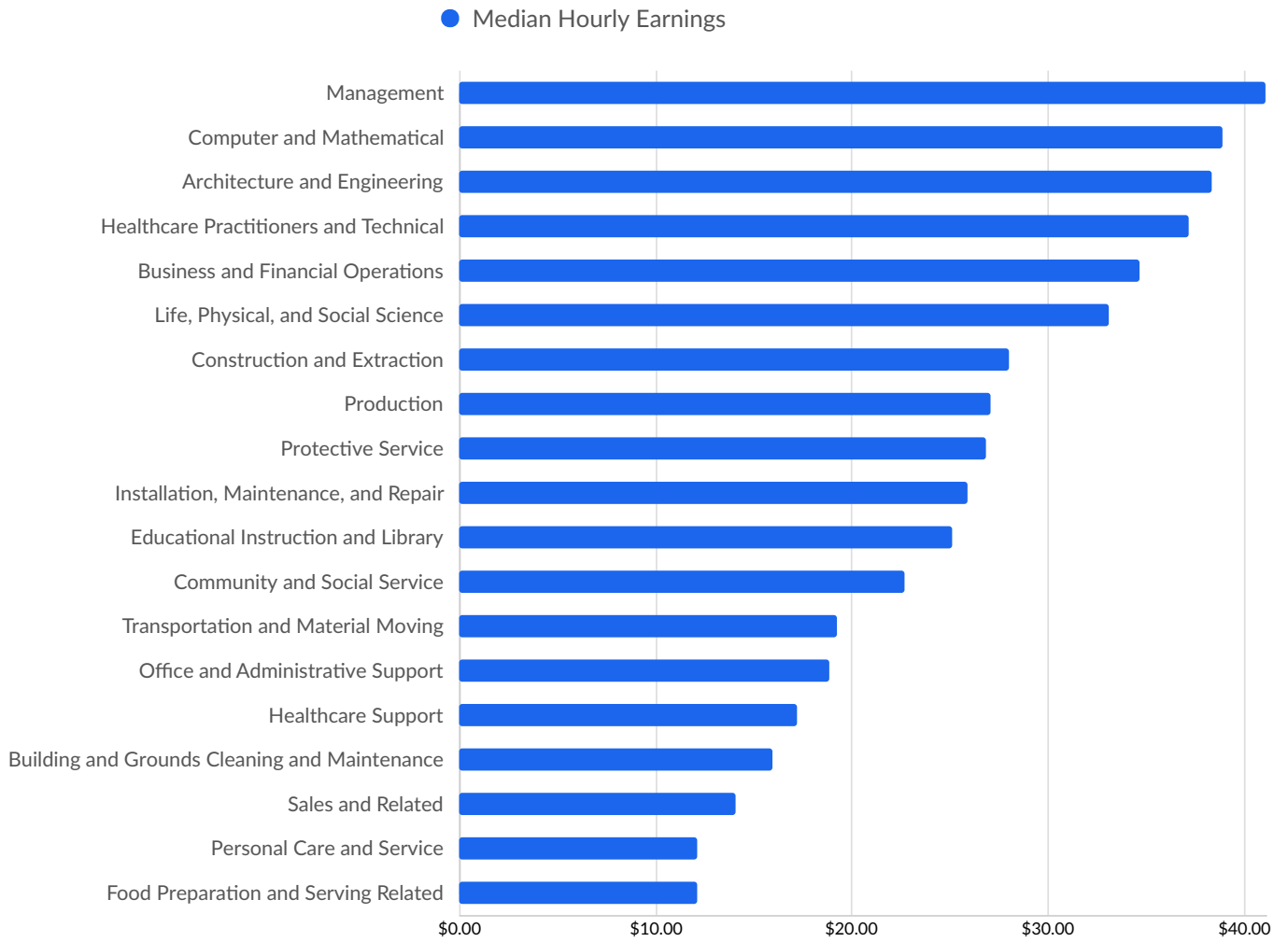
Top Growing Occupations



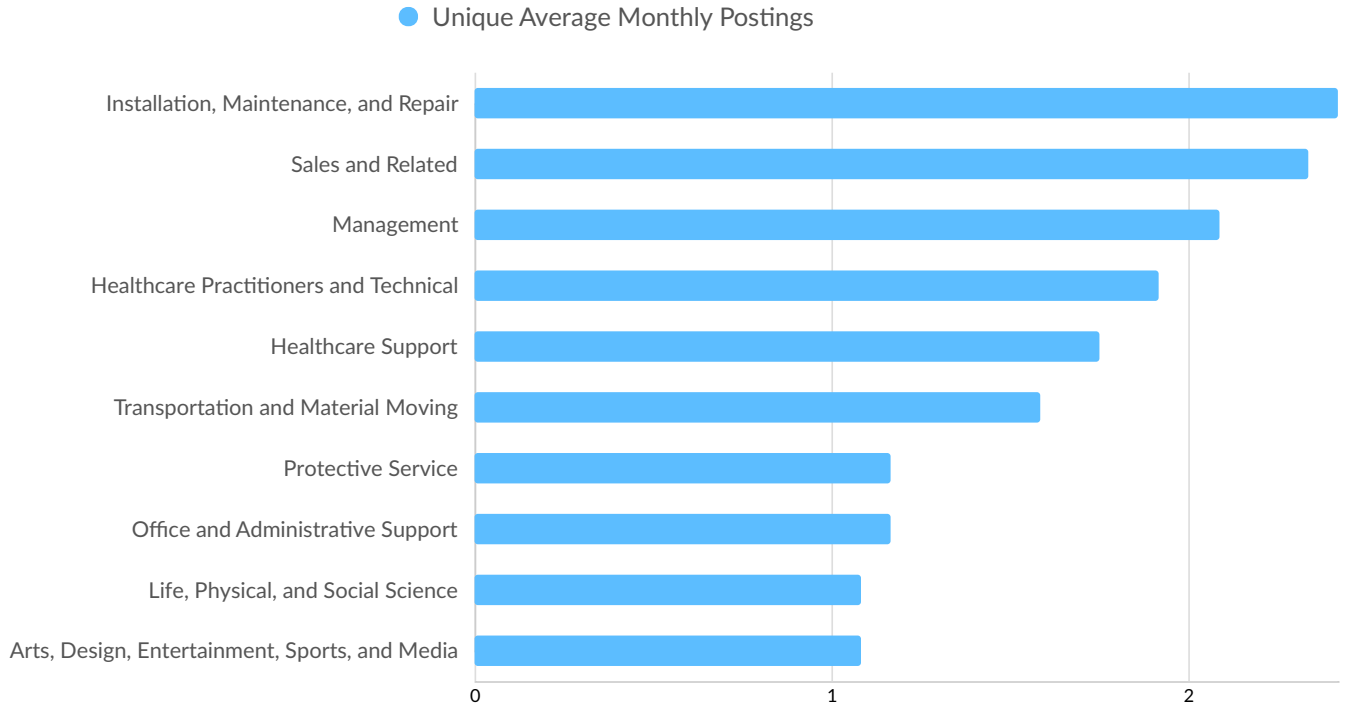
Top Occupation Employment Concentration



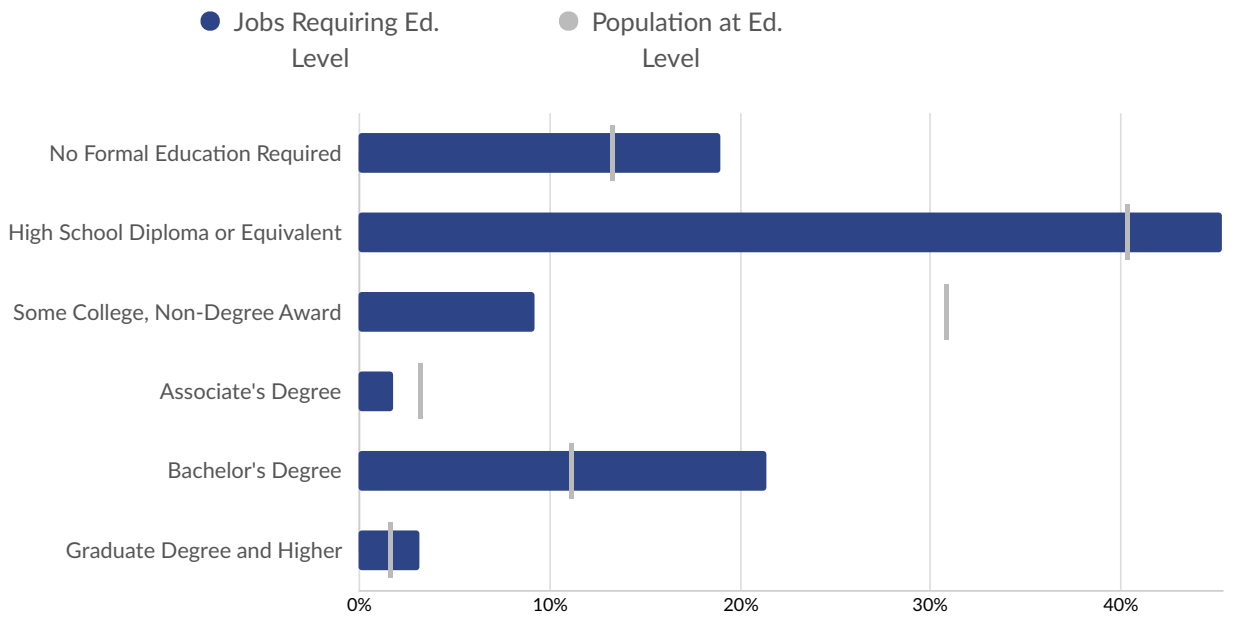
