- As of 2023 the region's population increased by 5.0% since 2018, growing by 2,749. Population is expected to increase by 2.3% between 2023 and 2028, adding 1,316.
- From 2018 to 2023, jobs increased by 4.9% in Carson City County, NV from 32,423 to 34,025. This change outpaced the national growth rate of 4.5% by 0.4%. As the number of jobs increased, the labor force participation rate decreased from 58.5% to 56.7% between 2018 and 2023.
- Concerning educational attainment, **16.6% of Carson City County**, **NV residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (4.5% below the national average), and **11.2% hold an Associate's Degree** (2.3% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2023 are State Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals, Restaurants and Other Eating Places, and General Medical and Surgical Hospitals.









Unemployment by Ethnicity







Carson City County, NV had an October 2024 unemployment rate of 4.93%, increasing from 4.18% 5 years before.














Top Industry Employment Concentration





Top Occupation Employment Concentration




