- As of 2023 the region's population increased by 3.5% since 2018, growing by 1,823. Population is expected to increase by 2.7% between 2023 and 2028, adding 1,466.
- From 2018 to 2023, jobs increased by 0.5% in Elko County, NV from 24,221 to 24,345. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 4.5% by 4.0%. As the number of jobs increased, the labor force participation rate decreased from 67.7% to 61.6% between 2018 and 2023.
- Concerning educational attainment, **10.5% of Elko County**, **NV residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (10.7% below the national average), and **10.6% hold an Associate's Degree** (1.8% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2023 are Traveler Accommodation, Education and Hospitals (Local Government), and Restaurants and Other Eating Places.












Population Trends



Elko County, NV had an October 2024 unemployment rate of 4.14%, increasing from 3.14% 5 years before.






Elko County, NV has 11,985 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 11,031.

Retirement risk is low in Elko County, NV. The national average for an area this size is 16,390 people 55 or older, while there are 13,809 here.




Racial Diversity

Violent Crime


Elko County, NV has 3.15 violent crimes per 1,000 people. The national rate is 3.6 per 1,000 people.








Top Growing Industries




Top Industry Employment Concentration







Top Growing Occupations




Top Occupation Employment Concentration





Top Occupation Earnings






