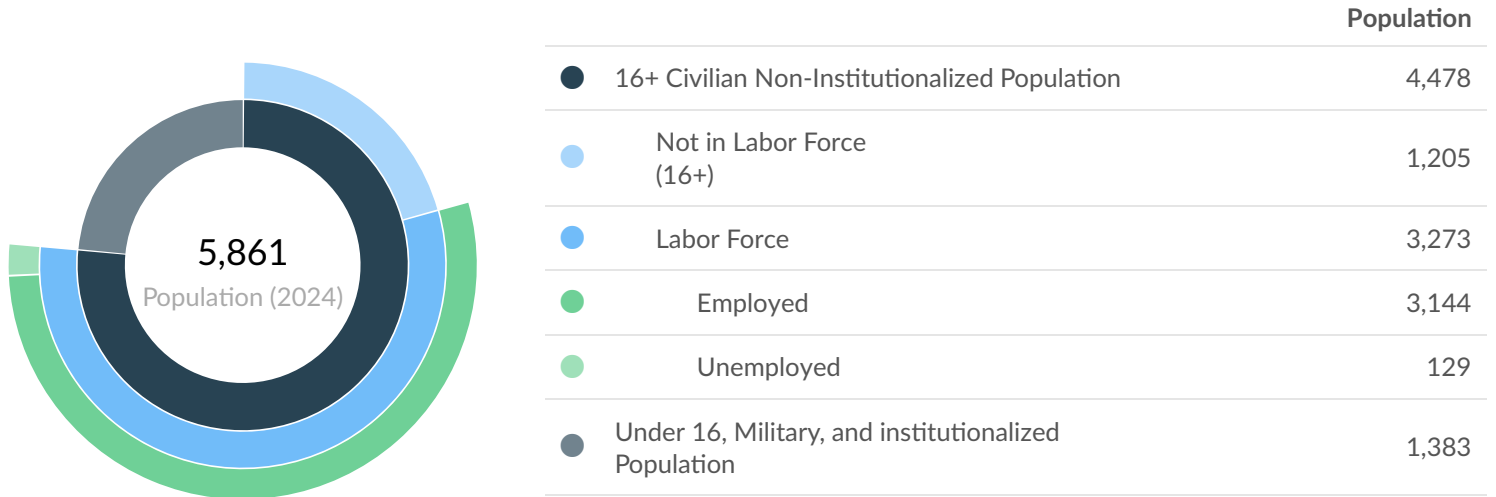
Median household income is **\$17.2K above** the national median household income of \$75.1K.

### Takeaways

- As of 2023 the region's population **increased by 4.7%** since 2018, growing by 257. Population is expected to **increase by 6.9%** between 2023 and 2028, adding 400.
- From 2018 to 2023, jobs **increased by 10.7%** in Lander County, NV from 3,636 to **4,026**. This change **outpaced the national growth rate of 4.5% by 6.2%**. As the number of jobs increased, the **labor force participation rate decreased from 74.6% to 72.4% between 2018 and 2023**.
- Concerning educational attainment, **6.3% of Lander County, NV residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (14.8% below the national average), and **17.4% hold an Associate's Degree** (8.6% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2023 are Metal Ore Mining, Education and Hospitals (Local Government), and Local Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals.

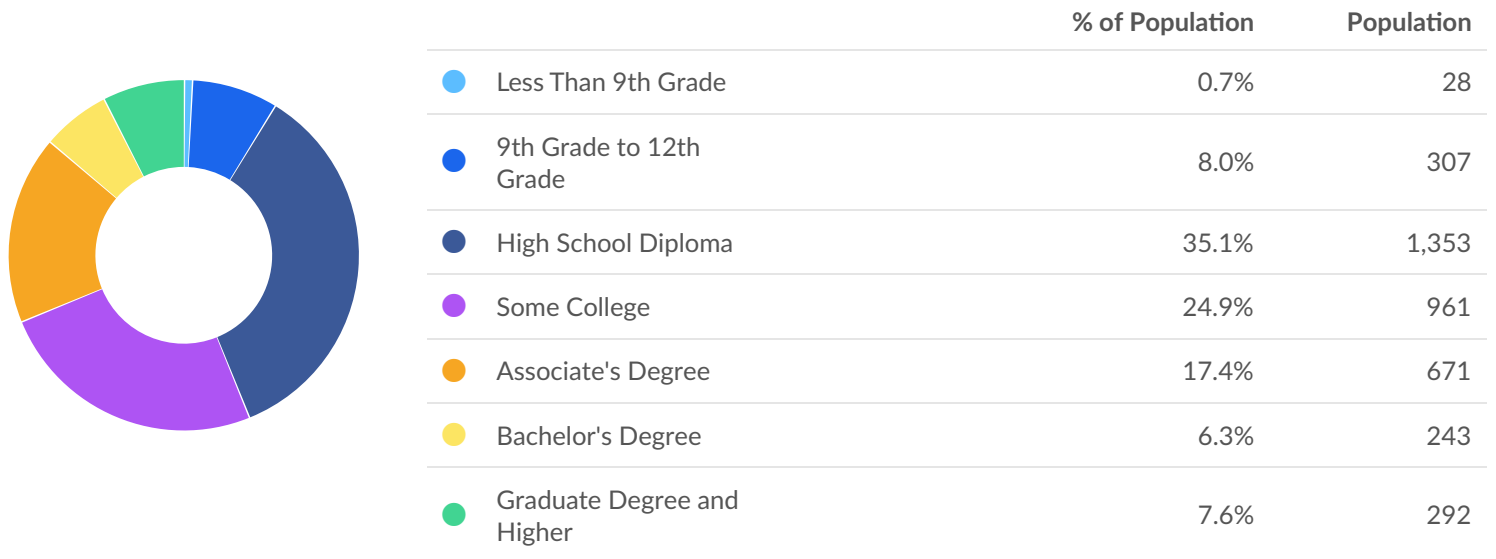

## Oct 2024 Labor Force Breakdown



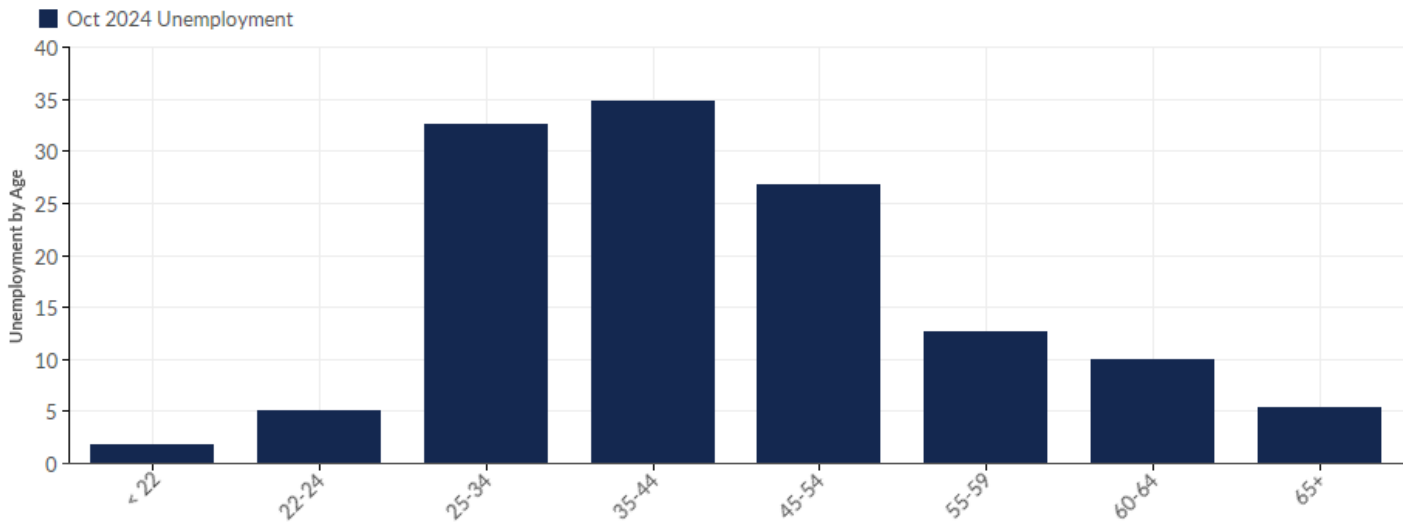
## Educational Attainment

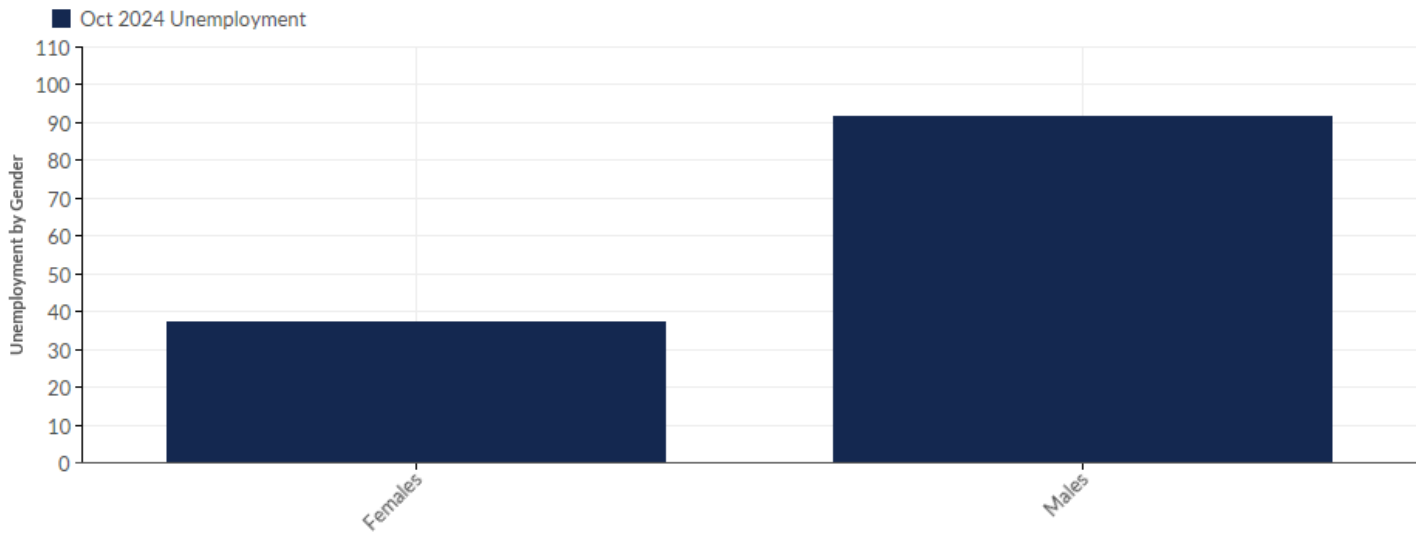

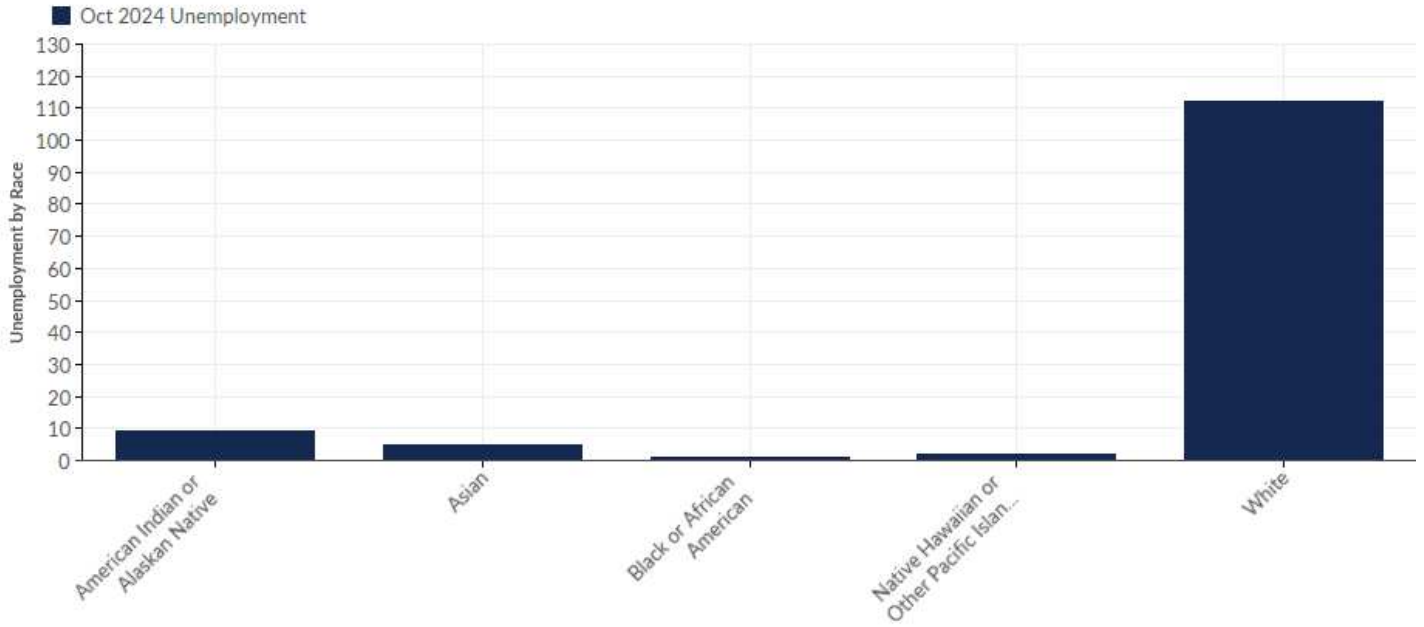

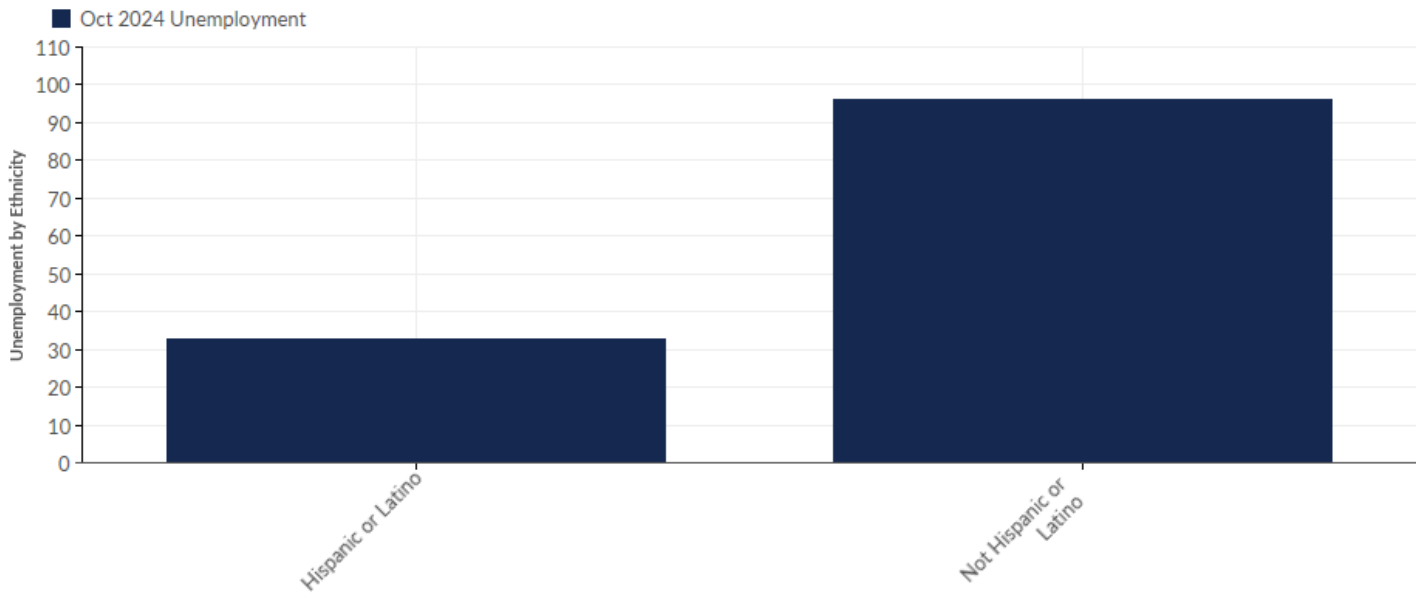

## Unemployment by Ethnicity

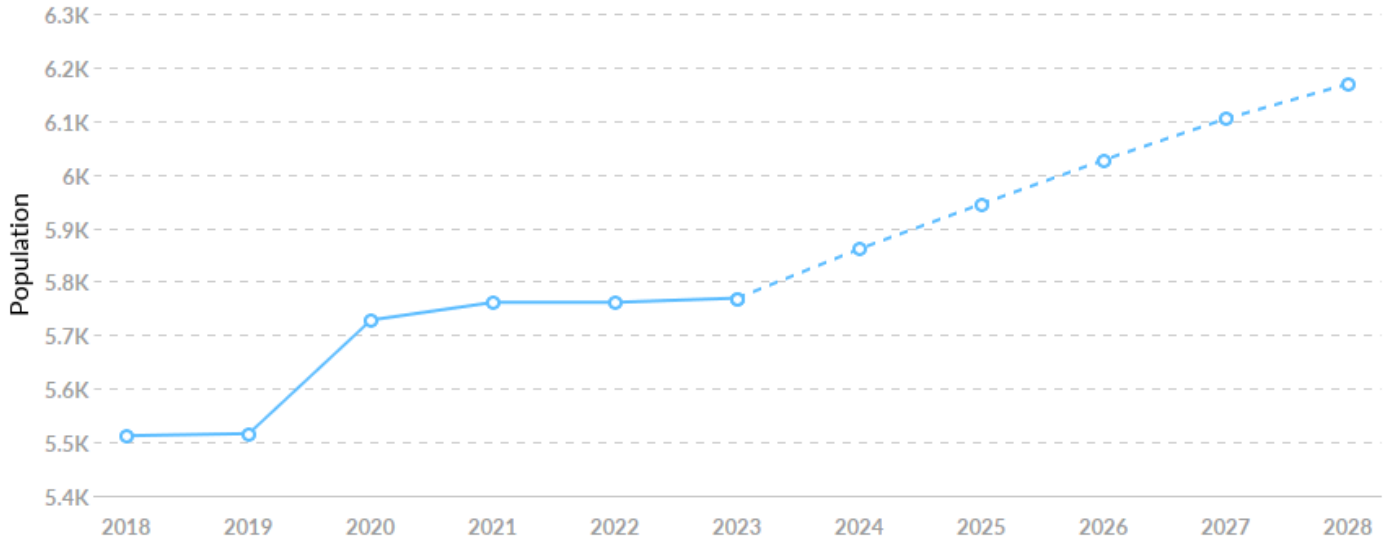

## Population Trends

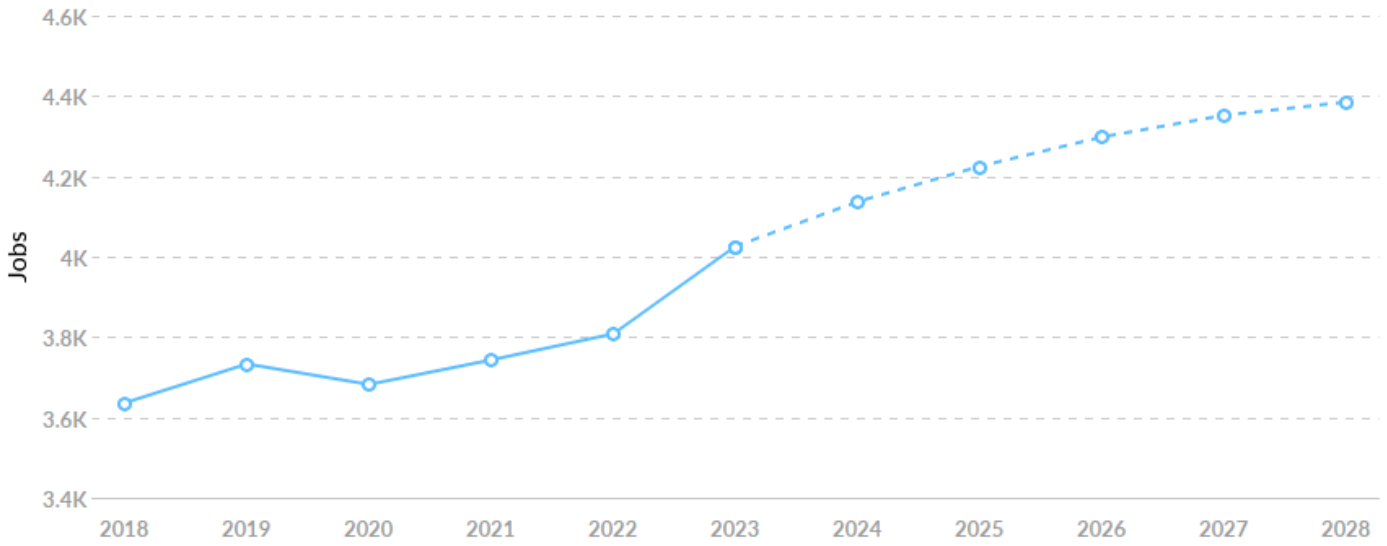

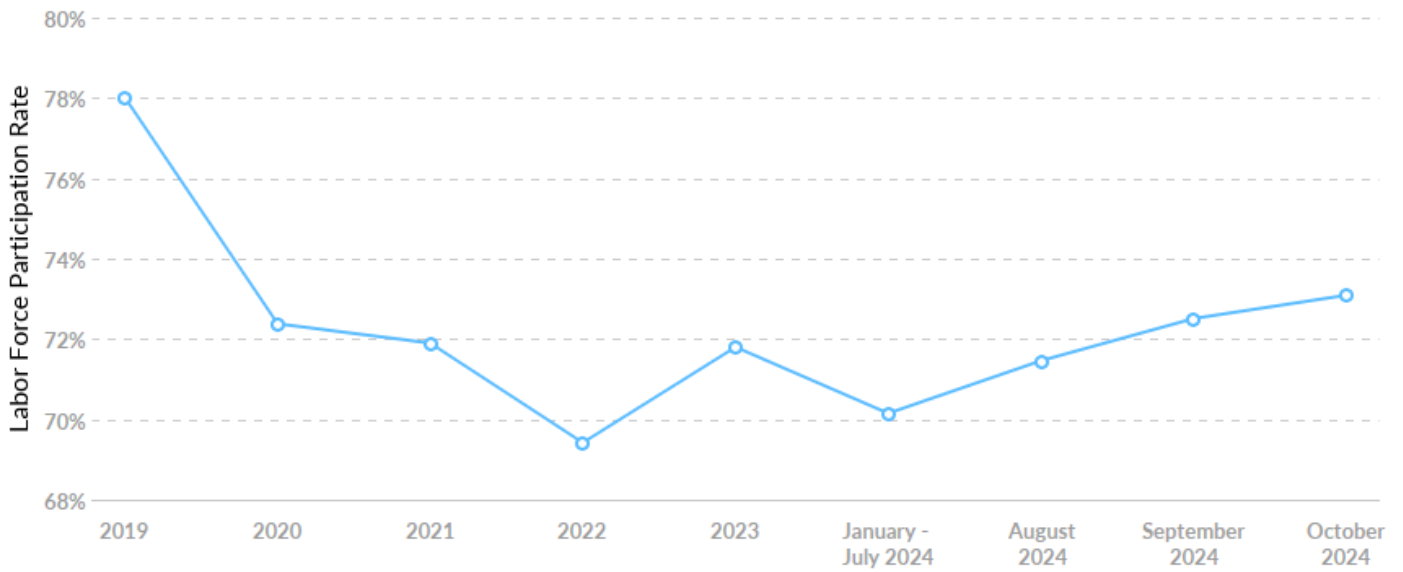
## Job Trends

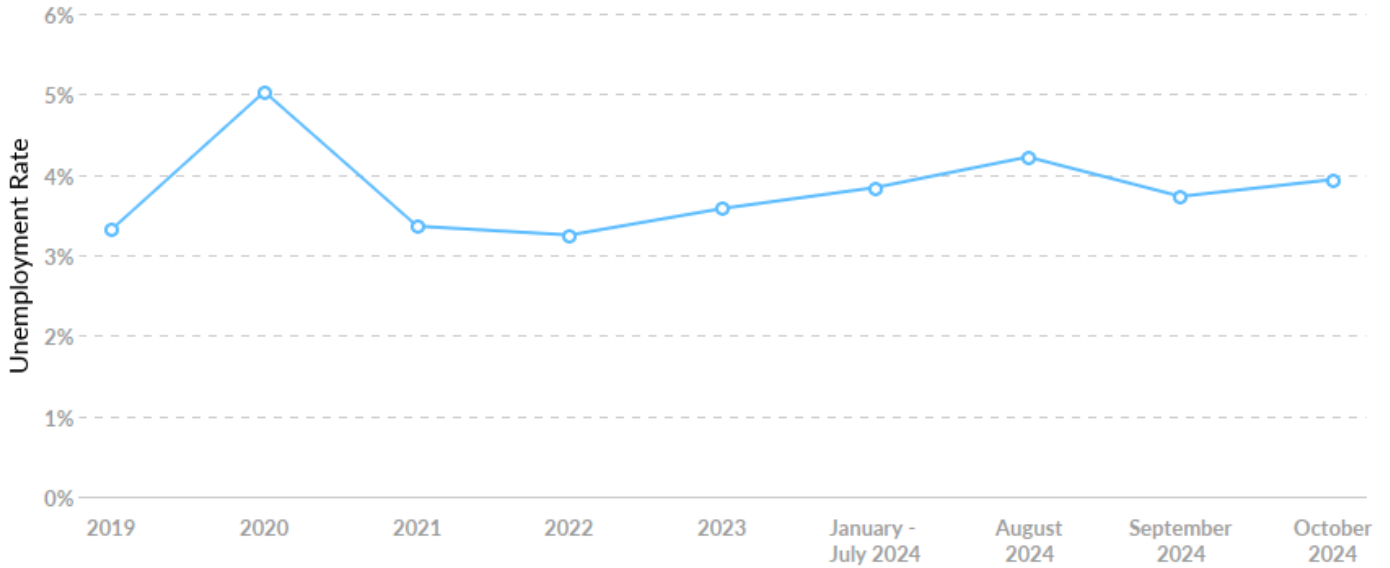

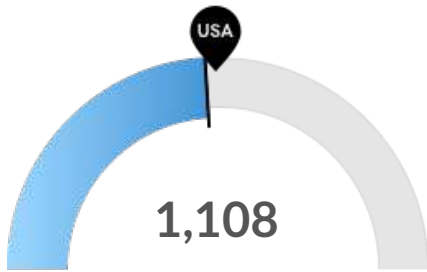
## Unemployment Rate Trends

Lander County, NV had an October 2024 unemployment rate of 3.94%, **increasing from 3.32%** 5 years before.



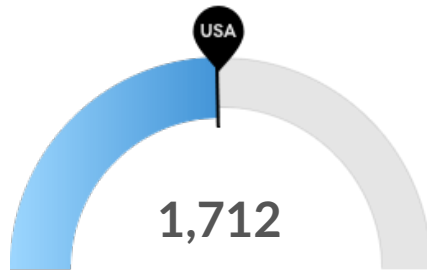

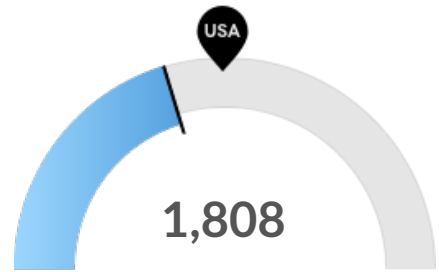
**Millennials**

Lander County, NV has 1,108 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 1,172.



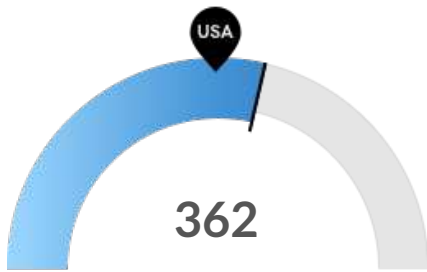
**Retiring Soon**

Retirement risk is about average in Lander County, NV. The national average for an area this size is 1,742 people 55 or older, while there are 1,712 here.



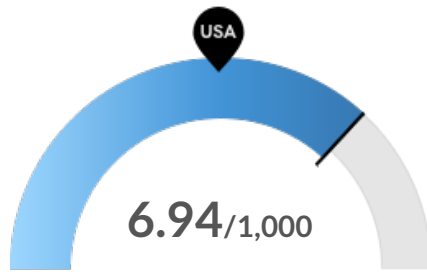
**Racial Diversity**

Racial diversity is low in Lander County, NV. The national average for an area this size is 2,403 racially diverse people, while there are 1,808 here.



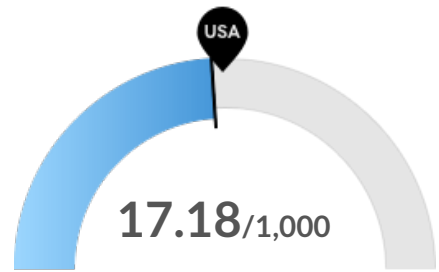
**Veterans**

**Property Crime**

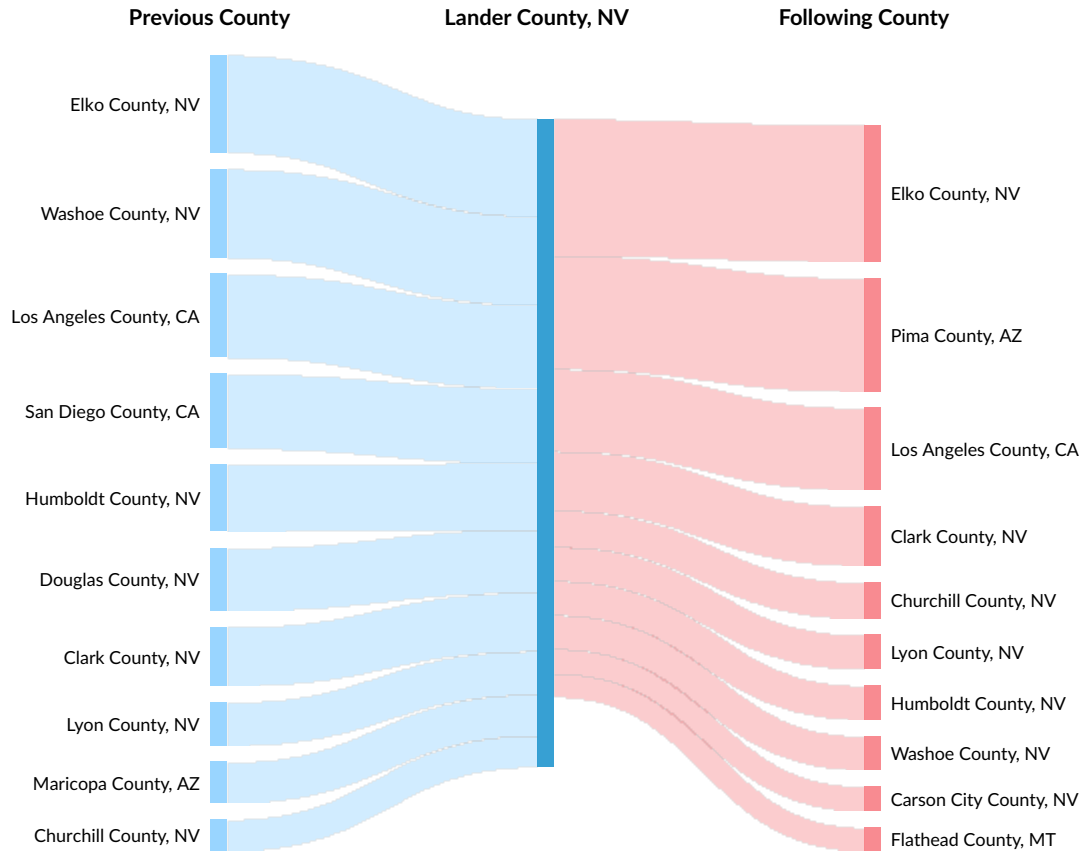
Lander County, NV has 17.18 property crimes per 1,000 people. The national rate is 18.22 per 1,000 people.

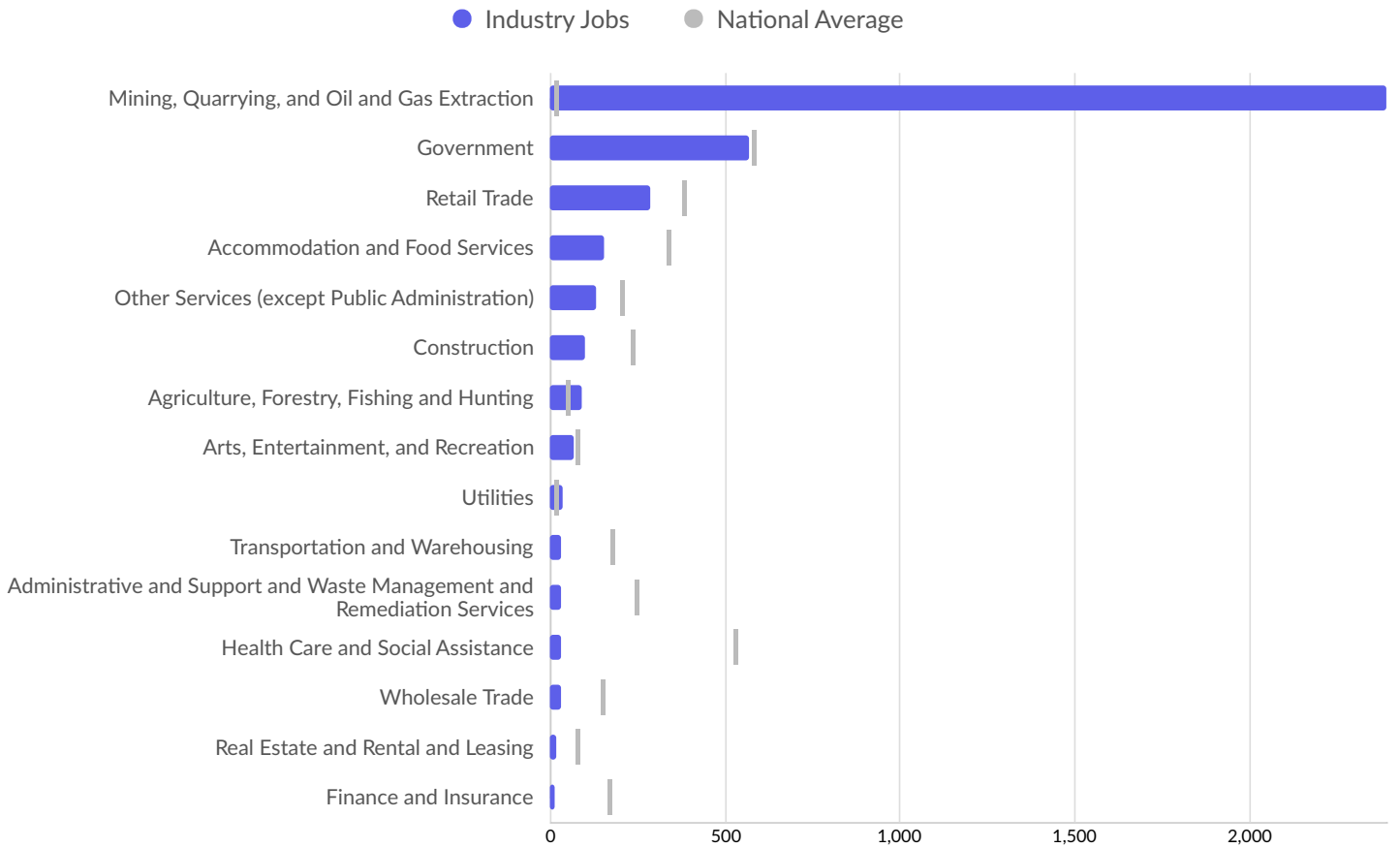

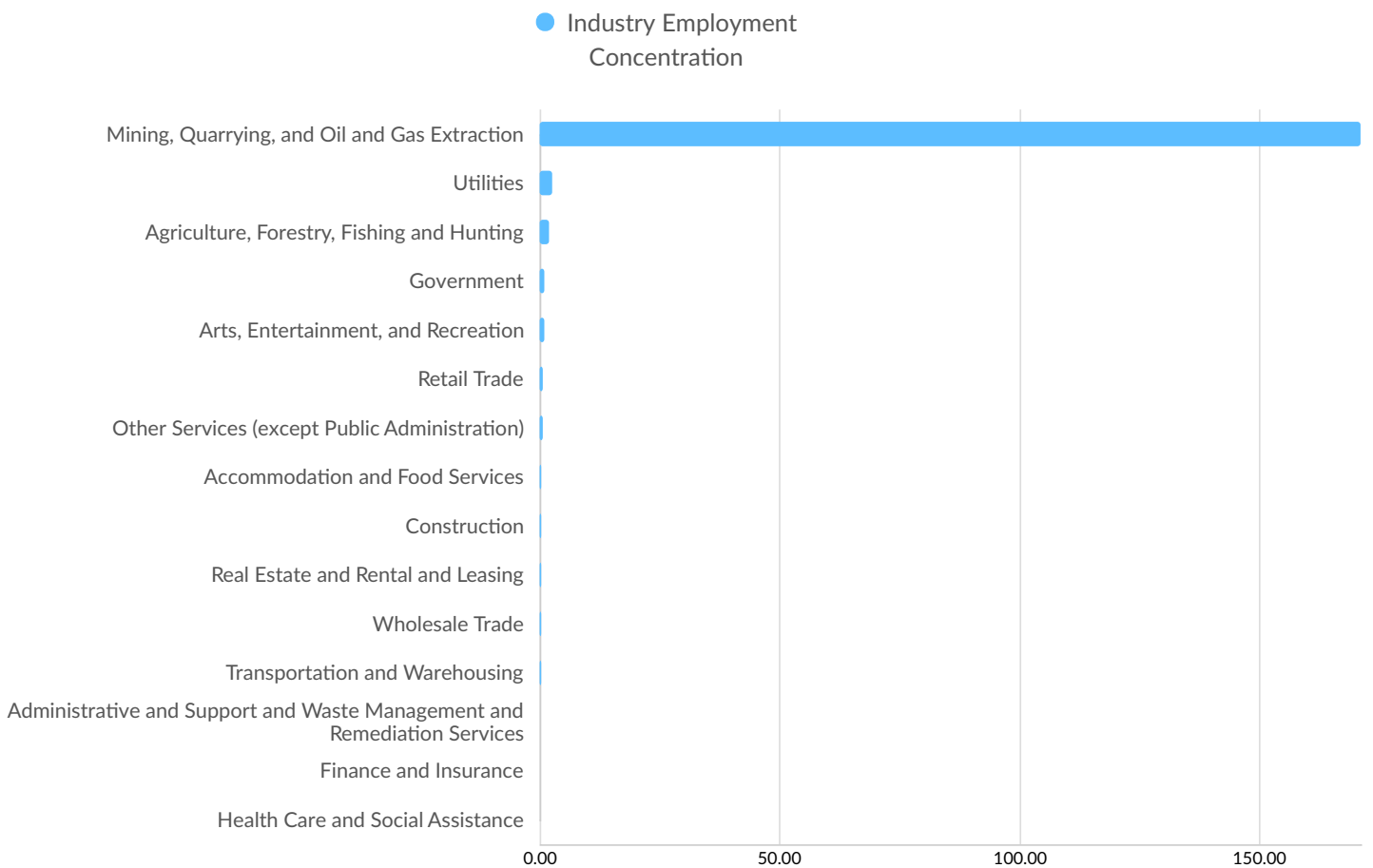

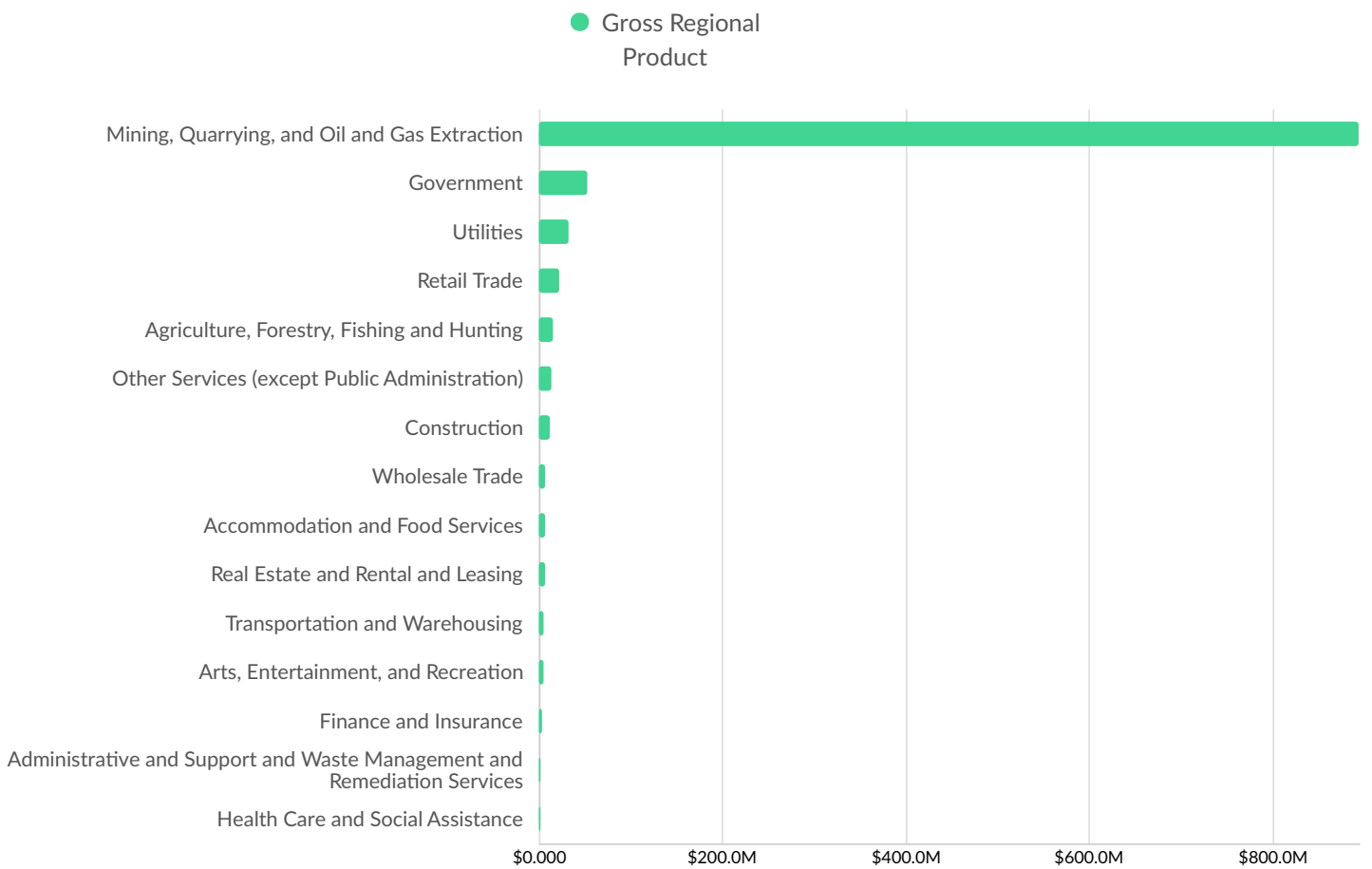
## Top Growing Industries



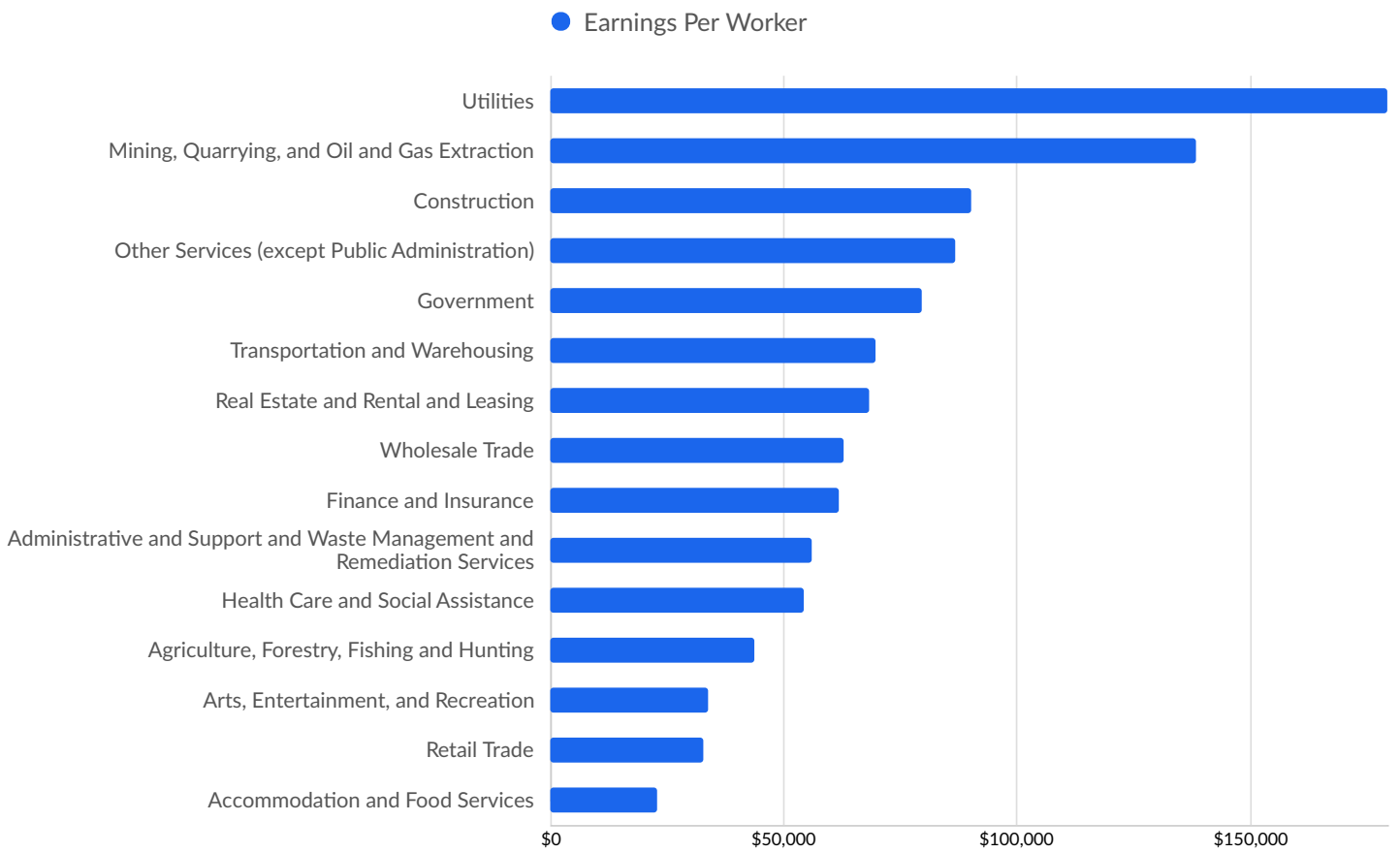
## Top Industry Employment Concentration

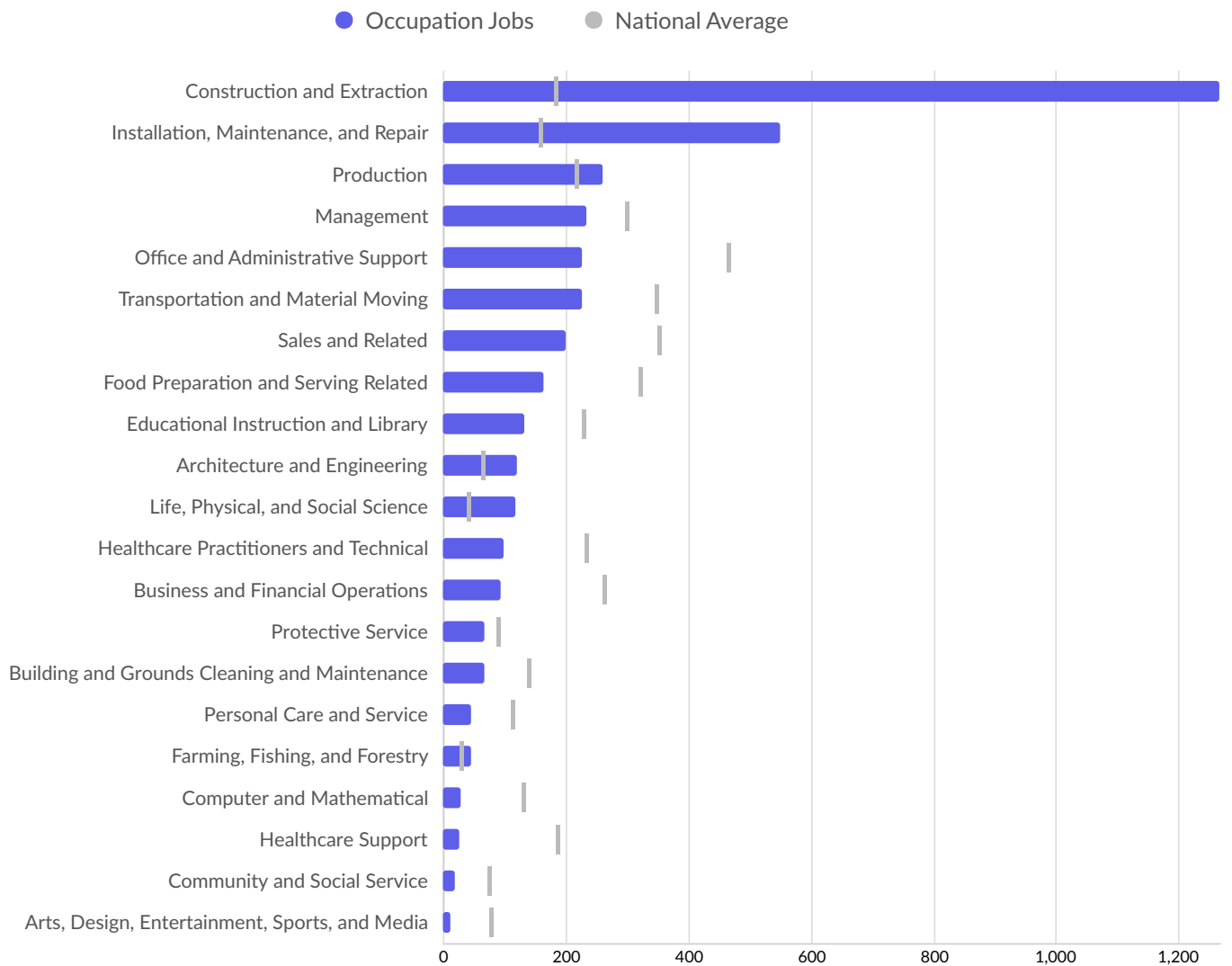

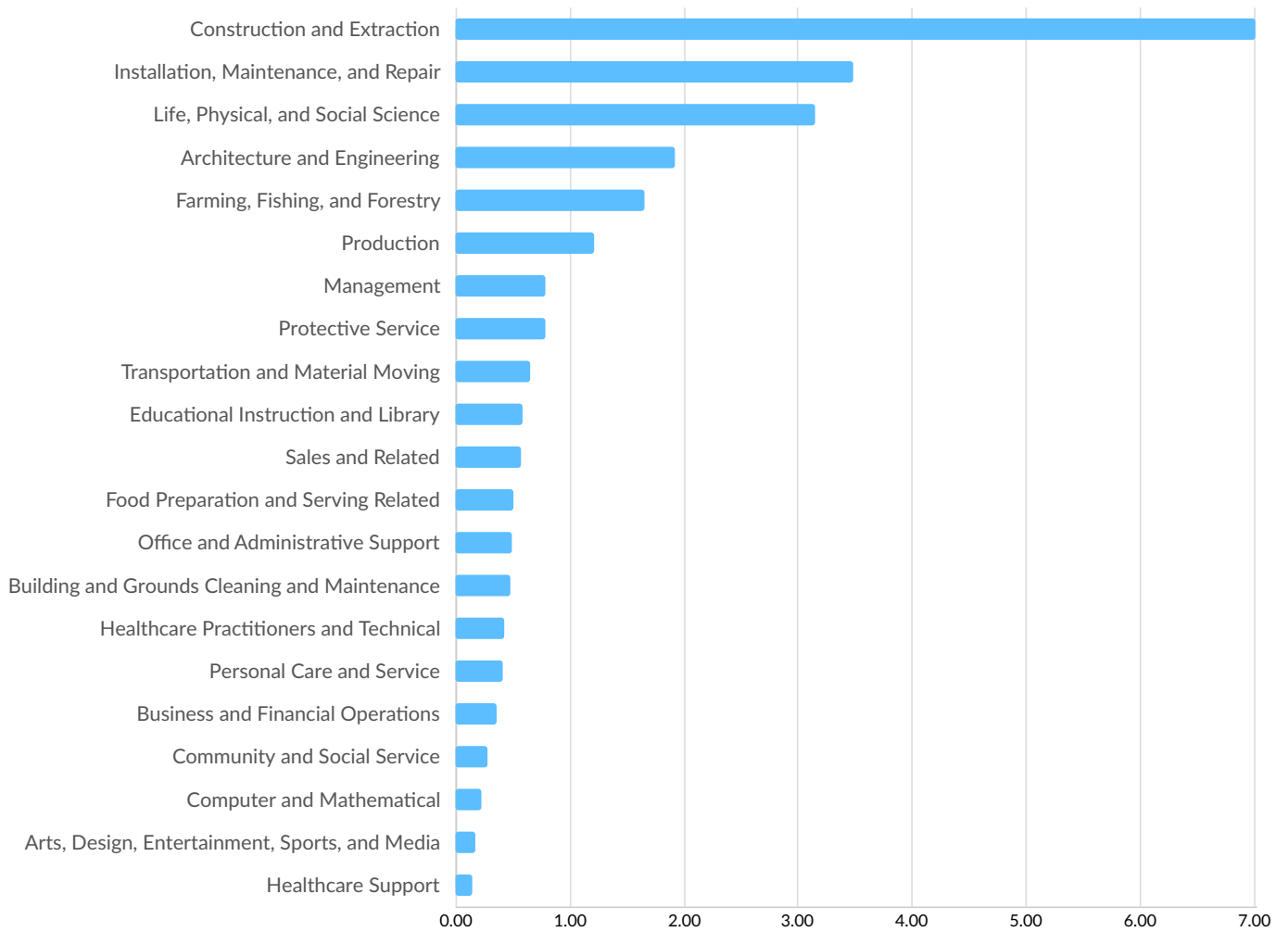

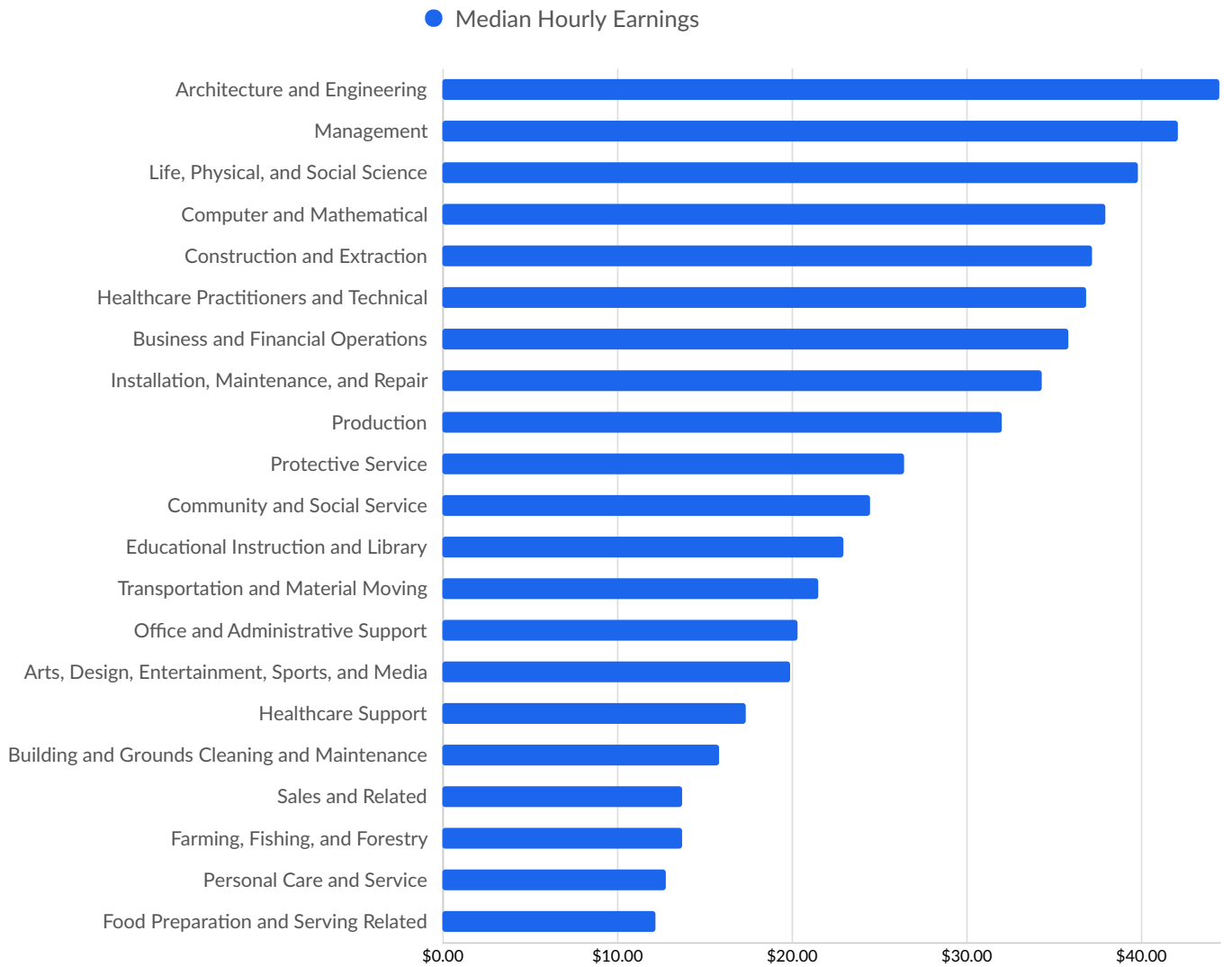


## Top Occupation Employment Concentration

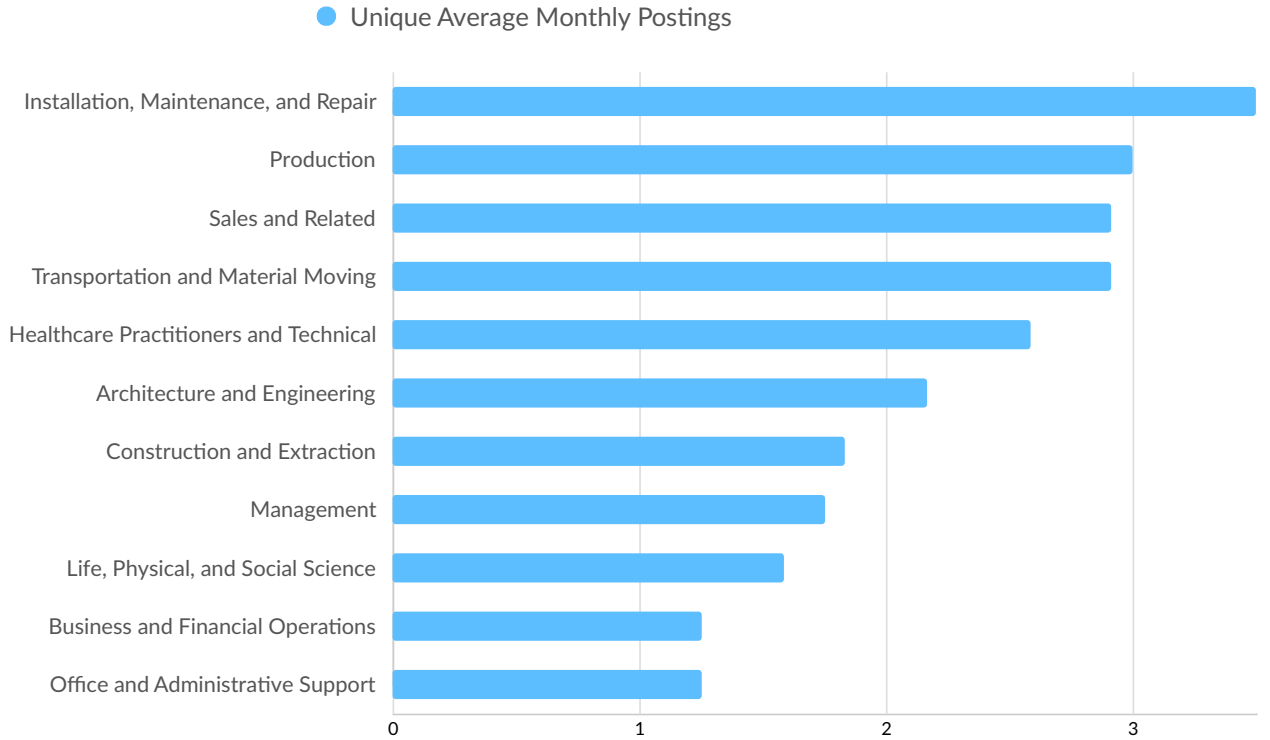

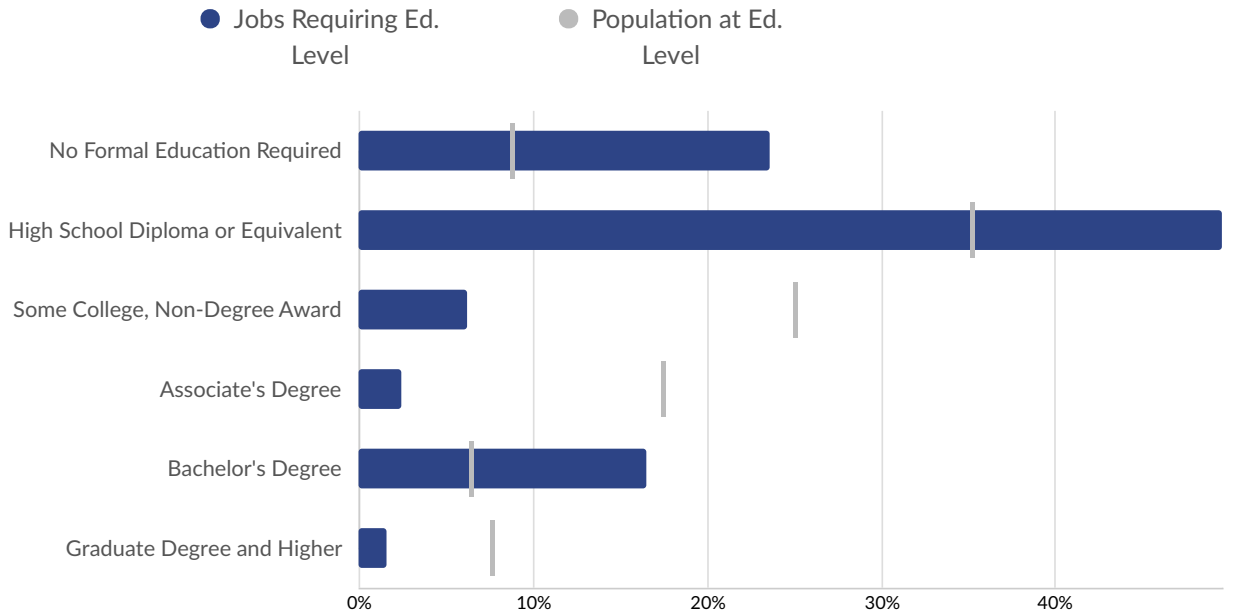
