- From 2018 to 2023, jobs increased by 3.9% in Lincoln County, NV from 1,478 to 1,536. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 4.5% by 0.6%. As the number of jobs increased, the labor force participation rate increased from 51.7% to 65.1% between 2018 and 2023.
- Concerning educational attainment, **8.9% of Lincoln County, NV residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (12.2% below the national average), and **5.6% hold an Associate's Degree** (3.2% below the national average).
- The top three industries in 2023 are Education and Hospitals (Local Government), Local Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals, and State Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals.




Oct 2024 Labor Force Breakdown






Unemployment by Gender



Unemployment by Ethnicity







Job Trends






Lincoln County, NV had an October 2024 unemployment rate of 4.82%, increasing from 4.11% 5 years before.




Millennials

Lincoln County, NV has 421 veterans. The national average for an area this size is 227.




Retiring Soon


Racial Diversity

Racial diversity is low in Lincoln County, NV. The national average for an area this size is 1,854 racially diverse people, while there are 709 here.














Top Growing Industries






Top Industry Employment Concentration






Top Industry GRP


