
Takeaways

- As of 2023 the region's population **declined by 0.7%** since 2018, falling by 32. Population is expected to **increase by 4.0%** between 2023 and 2028, adding 181.
- From 2018 to 2023, jobs declined by 15.7% in Mineral County, NV from 1,707 to 1,439. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 4.5% by 20.2%. As the number of jobs declined, the labor force participation rate decreased from 53.3% to 39.1% between 2018 and 2023.
- Concerning educational attainment, **11.1% of Mineral County, NV residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (10.1% below the national average), and **3.1% hold an Associate's Degree** (5.7% below the national average).
- The top three industries in 2023 are Education and Hospitals (Local Government), Local Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals, and Facilities Support Services.











Unemployment by Ethnicity





As of 2023 the region's population declined by 0.7% since 2018, falling by 32. Population is expected to increase by 4.0% between 2023 and 2028, adding 181.



Job Trends






Mineral County, NV had an October 2024 unemployment rate of 6.91%, increasing from 4.11% 5 years before.






Mineral County, NV has 768 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 920.


Retiring Soon


Retirement risk is high in Mineral County, NV. The national average for an area this size is 1,367 people 55 or older, while there are 1,929 here.

Mineral County, NV has 1.76 violent crimes per 1,000 people. The national rate is 3.6 per 1,000 people.


Property Crime





Top Growing Industries




Top Industry Employment Concentration






Top Industry GRP







Top Occupation Employment Concentration









