Takeaways

- As of 2023 the region's population increased by 22.9% since 2018, growing by 10,392. Population is expected to increase by 16.2% between 2023 and 2028, adding 9,005.
- From 2018 to 2023, jobs increased by 12.1% in Nye County, NV from 13,556 to 15,197. This change outpaced the national growth rate of 4.5% by 7.6%. As the number of jobs increased, the labor force participation rate decreased from 42.6% to 39.2% between 2018 and 2023.
- Concerning educational attainment, **8.5% of Nye County, NV residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (12.7% below the national average), and **8.6% hold an Associate's Degree** (0.3% below the national average).
- The top three industries in 2023 are Scientific Research and Development Services, Metal Ore Mining, and Education and Hospitals (Local Government).
















Unemployment Rate Trends

Nye County, NV had an October 2024 unemployment rate of 6.99%, increasing from 5.45% 5 years before.






Millennials

Nye County, NV has 8,323 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 11,321.




Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is high in Nye County, NV. The national average for an area this size is 16,821 people 55 or older, while there are 26,085 here.




Racial Diversity

Violent Crime


Nye County, NV has 3.18 violent crimes per 1,000 people. The national rate is 3.6 per 1,000 people.








Top Growing Industries




Top Industry Employment Concentration






Top Occupation Employment Concentration






Top Posted Occupations
