
















Unemployment Rate Trends

Pershing County, NV had an October 2024 unemployment rate of 4.38%, increasing from 4.15% 5 years before.










Top Growing Industries




Top Industry Employment Concentration






Top Occupation Employment Concentration


Top Occupation Earnings



Median Hourly Earnings


