Campus for Hope seeks to transform the traditional shelter model with an innovative campus that addresses the root causes of homelessness through personalized care. Instead of costing the community, our approach will help everyone by creating pathways to stability and a more prosperous future for everyone.

With an estimated 8,000 homeless people, and many more in crisis/trauma, in the greater Las Vegas area, our community — and most especially these individuals — need an innovative solution.

In true Nevada-style, a broad-based, collaborative, public-private partnership was formed to design, construct and operate a comprehensive campus designed to provide critical services to individuals and families experiencing homelessness in Nevada. This is the business community of Southern Nevada, local and state governments and the non-profits and community organizations moving forward to bring to life a new way to help our community's most vulnerable.

This innovative solution will address the challenges of homelessness in our state and will contribute to Nevada's economic development and enhance our workforce.

This project will be dramatically different from any other project created to ease homelessness.

Campus for Hope will transform 26 of the 77 acres on the Southern Nevada Adult Mental Health Services campus. The buildings, originally built in the 1960s, will be removed to completely reimagine a modern space built to meet the needs of the community. This will be a beautiful campus built on the principle that treating people with dignity creates accountability. This is not a shelter, but rather a facility where people are able to get a variety of services to regain their footing in their lives.
