- Concerning educational attainment, **17.9% of Clark County, NV residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (3.6% below the national average), and **8.5% hold an Associate's Degree** (0.4% below the national average).
- The top three industries in 2024 are Traveler Accommodation, Restaurants and Other Eating Places, and Education and Hospitals (Local Government).




Dec 2024 Labor Force Breakdown





Unemployment by Ethnicity







Job Trends






Millennials

Clark County, NV has 509,761 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 474,753.














