
Takeaways

- As of 2024 the region's population increased by 1.3% since 2019, growing by 650. Population is expected to decrease by 0.7% between 2024 and 2029, losing 350.
- From 2019 to 2024, jobs increased by 2.3% in Douglas County, NV from 22,661 to 23,172. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 3.9% by 1.6%. As the number of jobs increased, the labor force participation rate decreased from 54.6% to 52.2% between 2019 and 2024.
- Concerning educational attainment, **21.2% of Douglas County, NV residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (0.2% below the national average), and **10.8% hold an Associate's Degree** (1.8% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2024 are Traveler Accommodation, Local Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals, and Restaurants and Other Eating Places.











Unemployment by Ethnicity





As of 2024 the region's population increased by 1.3% since 2019, growing by 650. Population is expected to decrease by 0.7% between 2024 and 2029, losing 350.



Job Trends






Douglas County, NV had a December 2024 unemployment rate of 4.81%, increasing from 4.16% 5 years before.




Douglas County, NV has 7,031 millennials (ages 25-39). The size is 10,067.






Veterans

Douglas County, NV has 4,834 veterans. The national average for an area this size is 2,539.




Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is high in Douglas County, NV. The national average for an area this size is 14,956 people 55 or older, while there are 25,009 here.




Violent Crime

Douglas County, NV has 7.41 property crimes per 1,000 people. The national rate is 18.02 per 1,000 people.









Top Growing Industries




Top Industry Employment Concentration






Top Industry GRP







Top Occupation Employment Concentration











