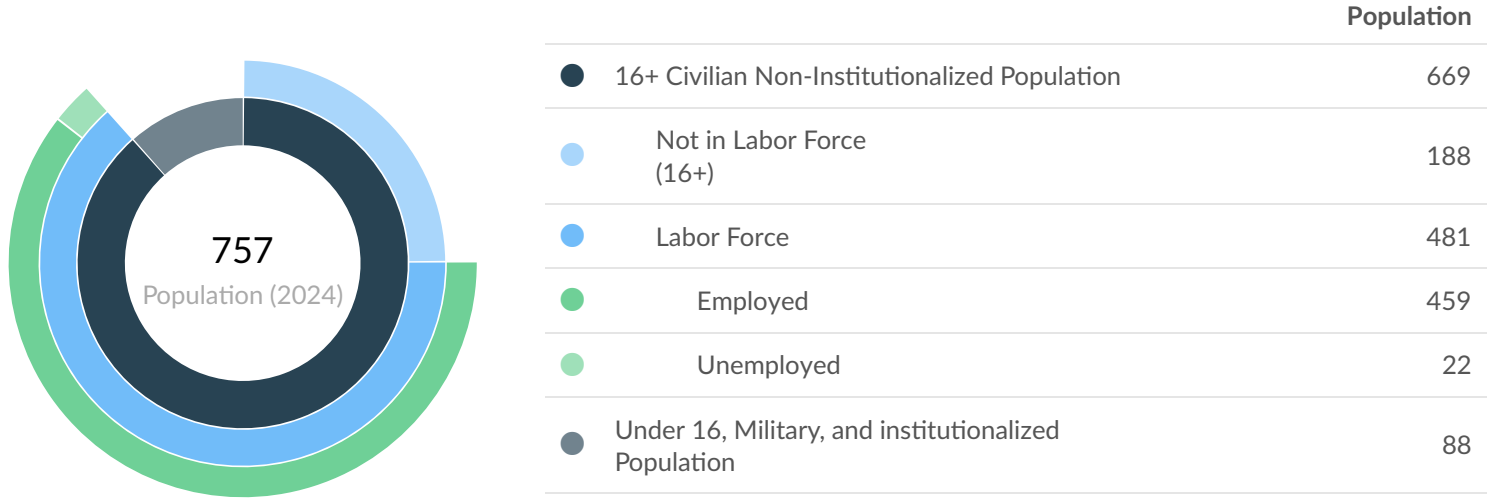
Median household income is **\$34.5K below** the national median household income of \$75.1K.

- From 2019 to 2024, jobs **increased by 3.1%** in Esmeralda County, NV from 356 to **367**. This change **fell short of the national growth rate of 3.9% by 0.8%**. As the number of jobs increased, the **labor force participation rate increased from 59.1% to 71.9% between 2019 and 2024**.
- Concerning educational attainment, **13.0% of Esmeralda County, NV residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (8.5% below the national average), and **6.2% hold an Associate's Degree** (2.8% below the national average).
- The top three industries in 2024 are Nonmetallic Mineral Mining and Quarrying, Local Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals, and Support Activities for Mining.

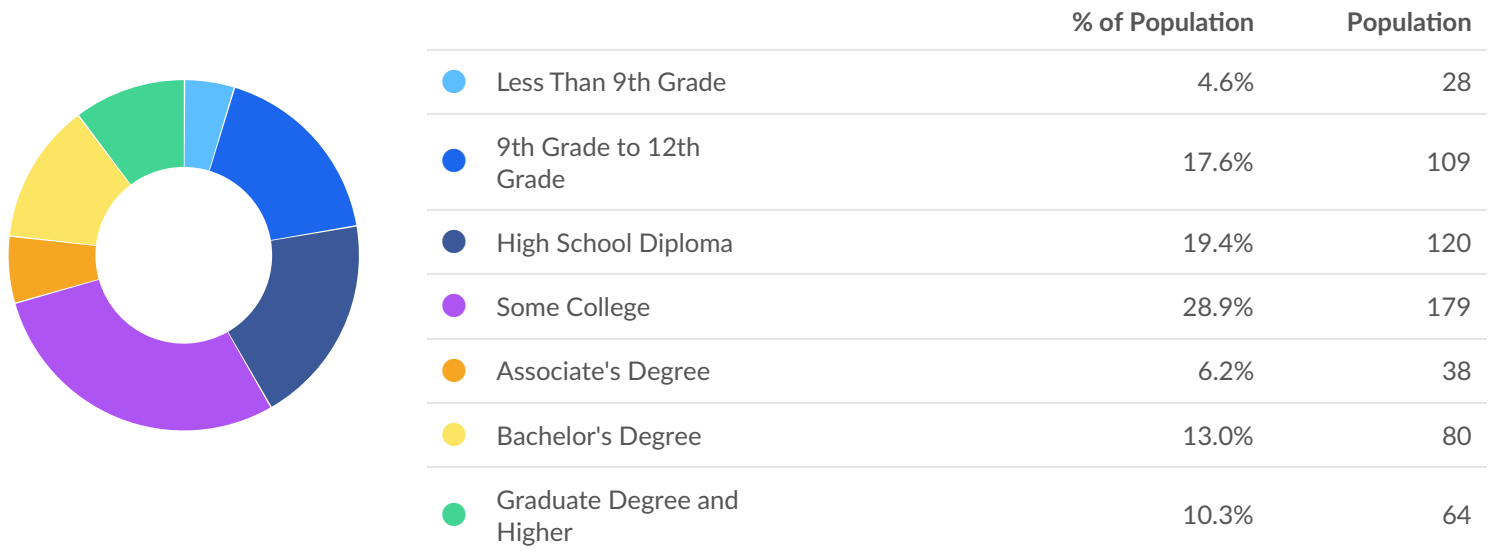

Dec 2024 Labor Force Breakdown



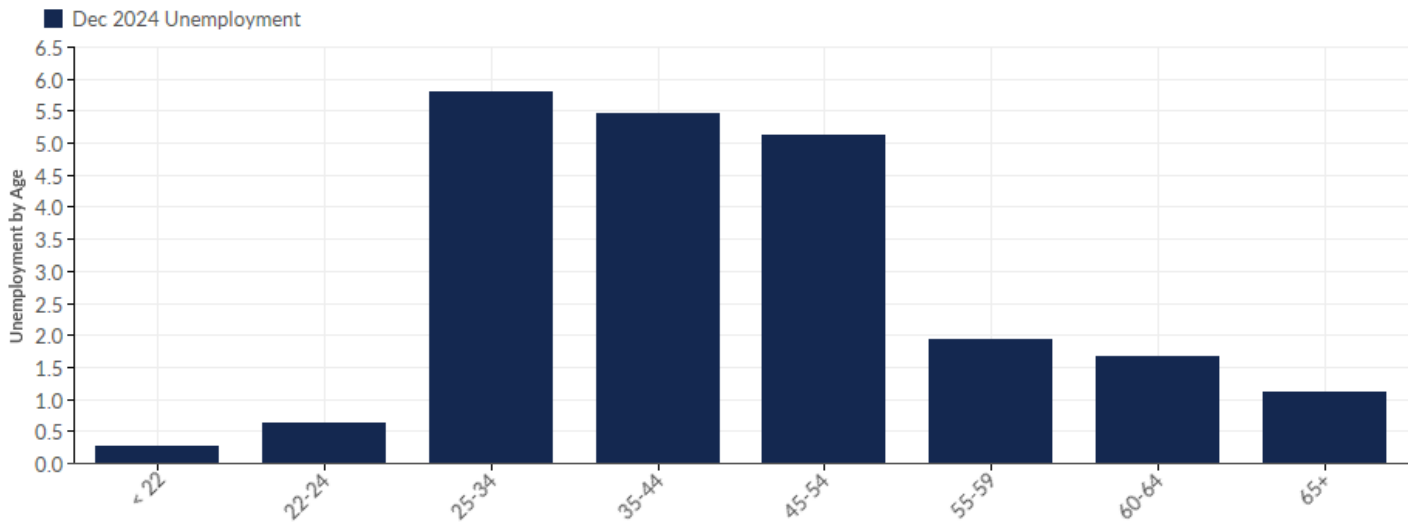
Educational Attainment

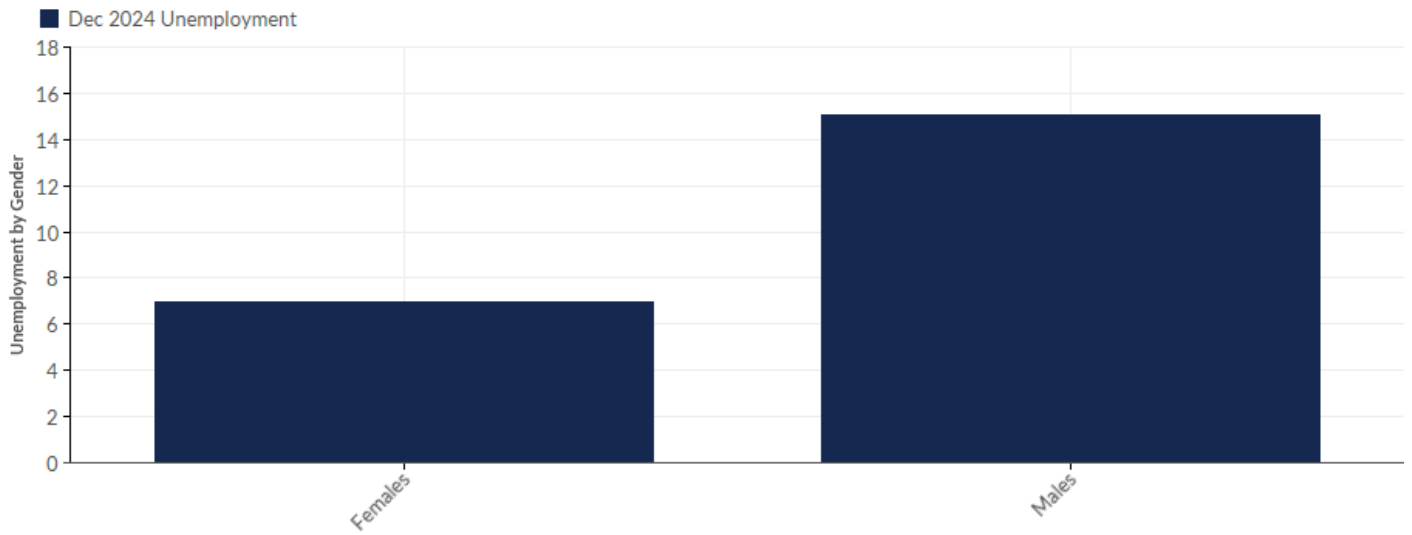

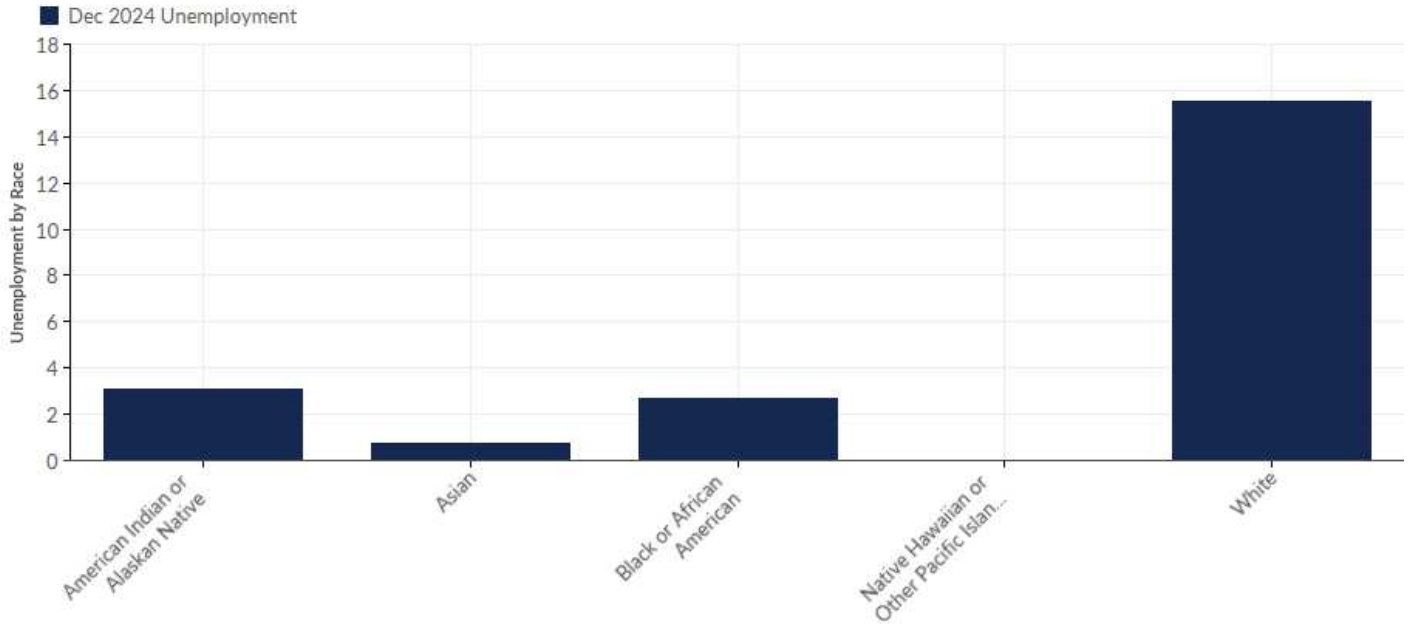

Unemployment by Gender



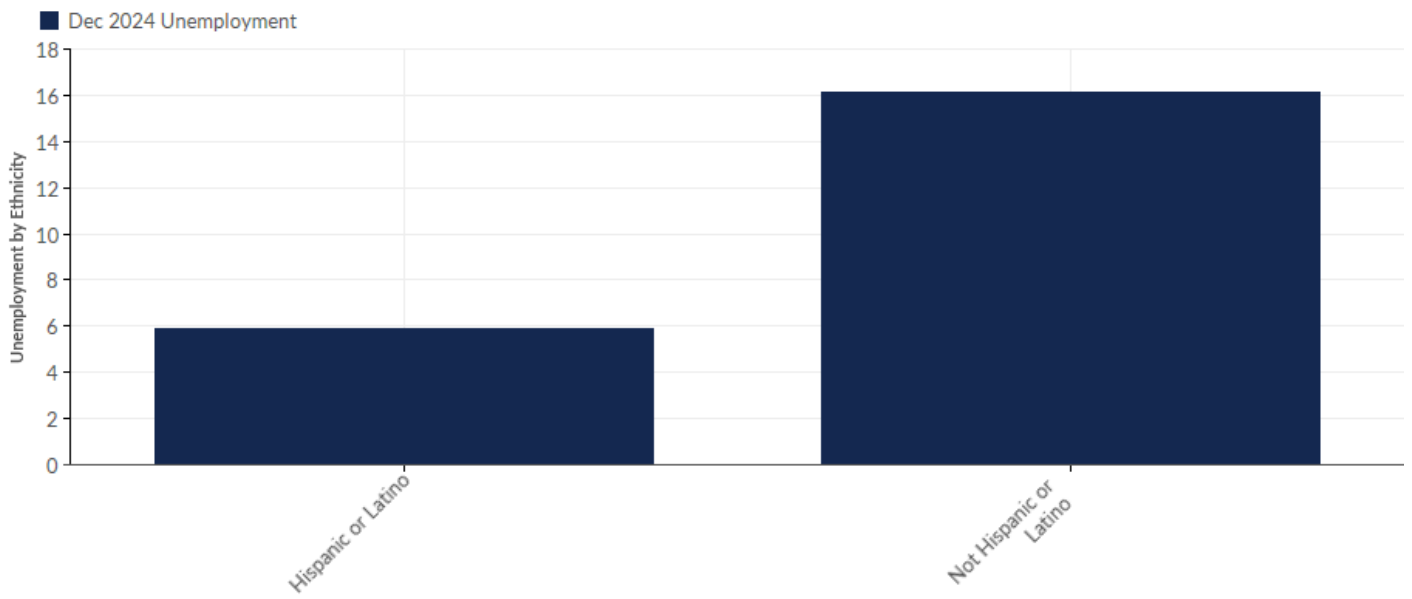

Unemployment by Ethnicity

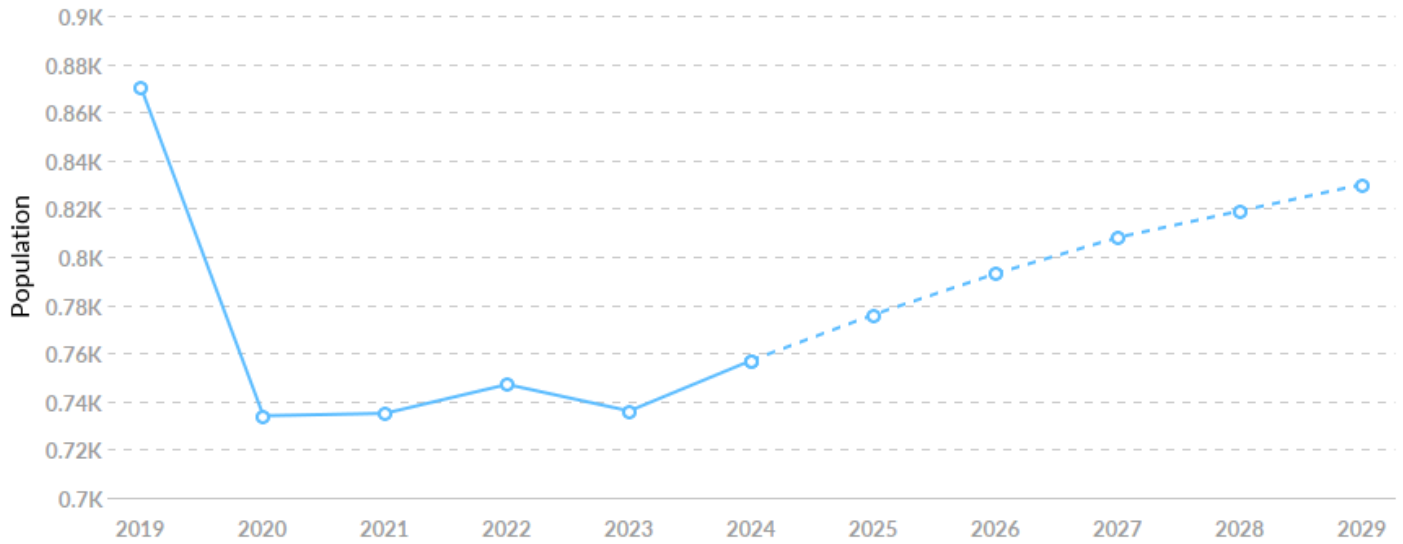

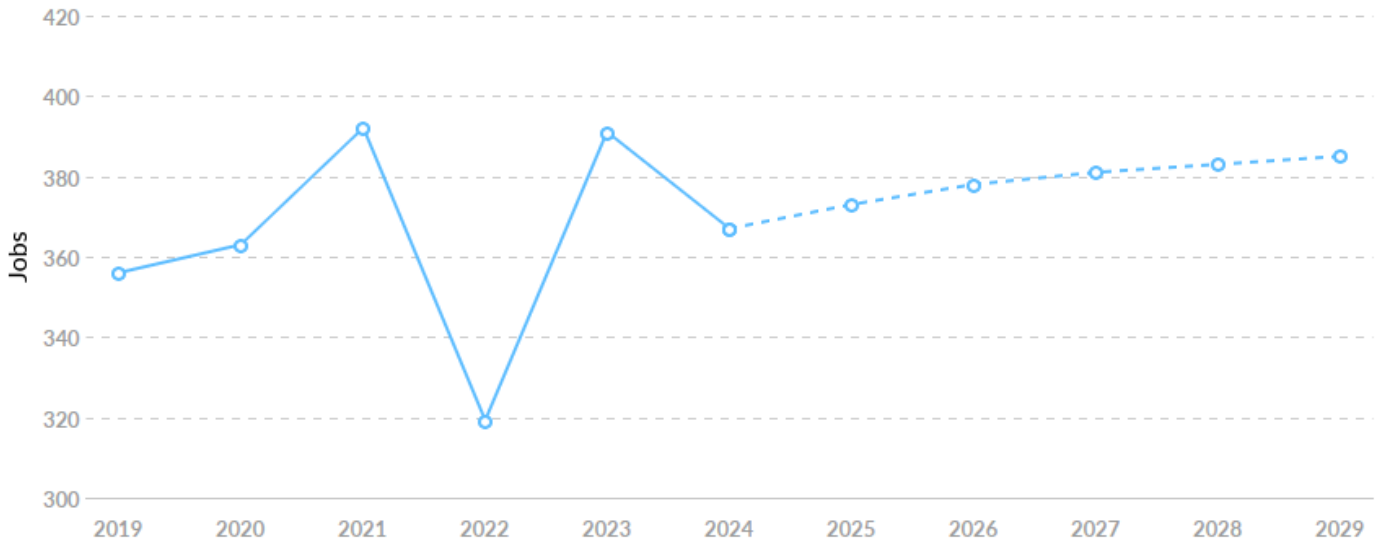

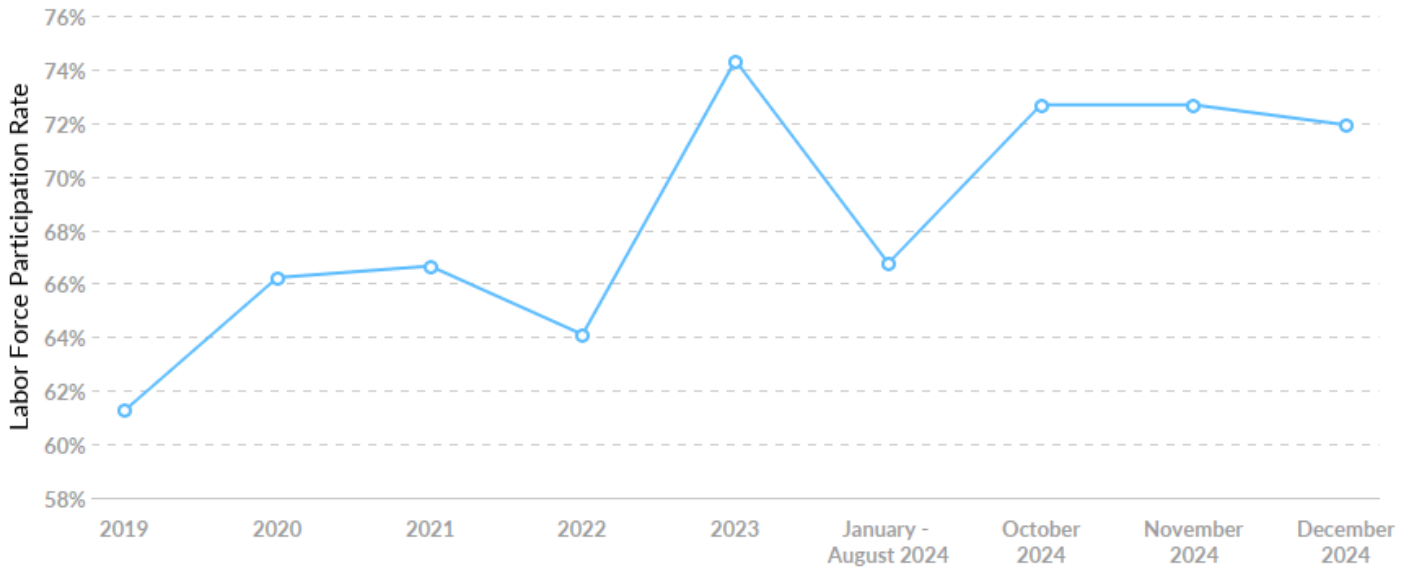
Job Trends

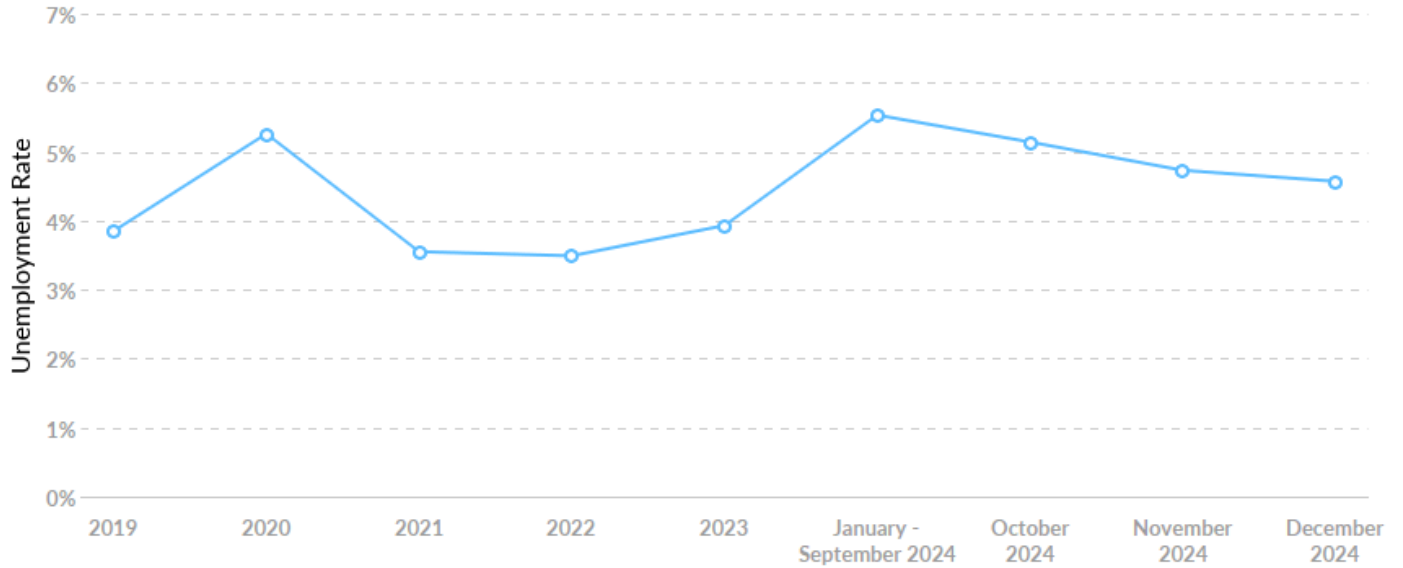

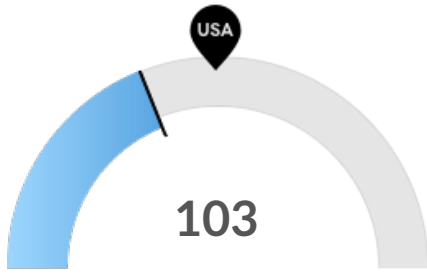
Unemployment Rate Trends

Esmeralda County, NV had a December 2024 unemployment rate of 4.57%, **increasing from 3.85%** 5 years before.



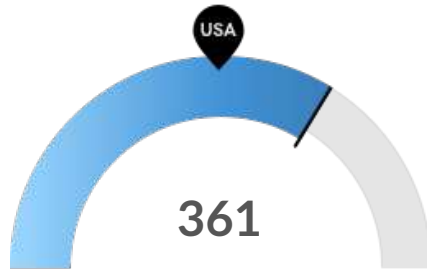

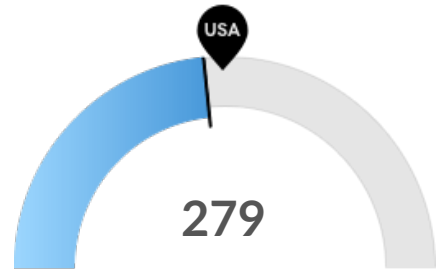
Millennials

Esmeralda County, NV has 103 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 150.



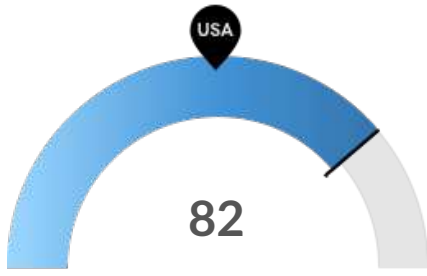
Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is high in Esmeralda County, NV. The national average for an area this size is 222 people 55 or older, while there are 361 here.



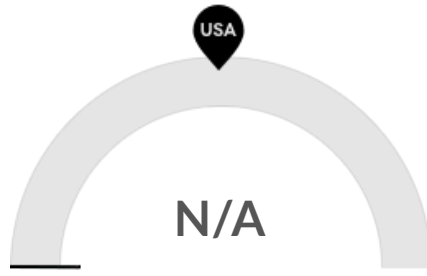
Racial Diversity

Racial diversity is about average in Esmeralda County, NV. The national average for an area this size is 307 racially diverse people, while there are 279 here.



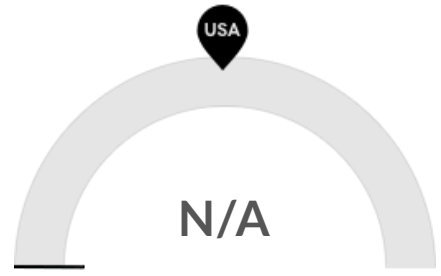
Veterans

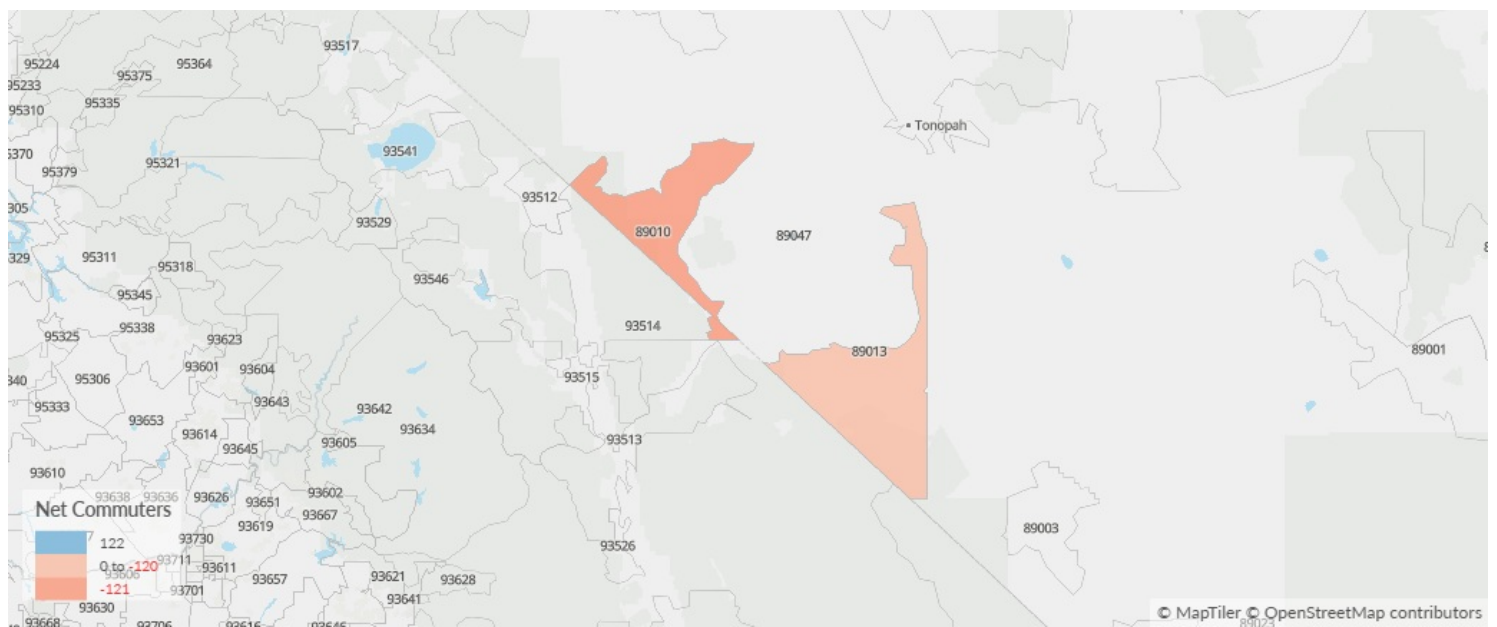

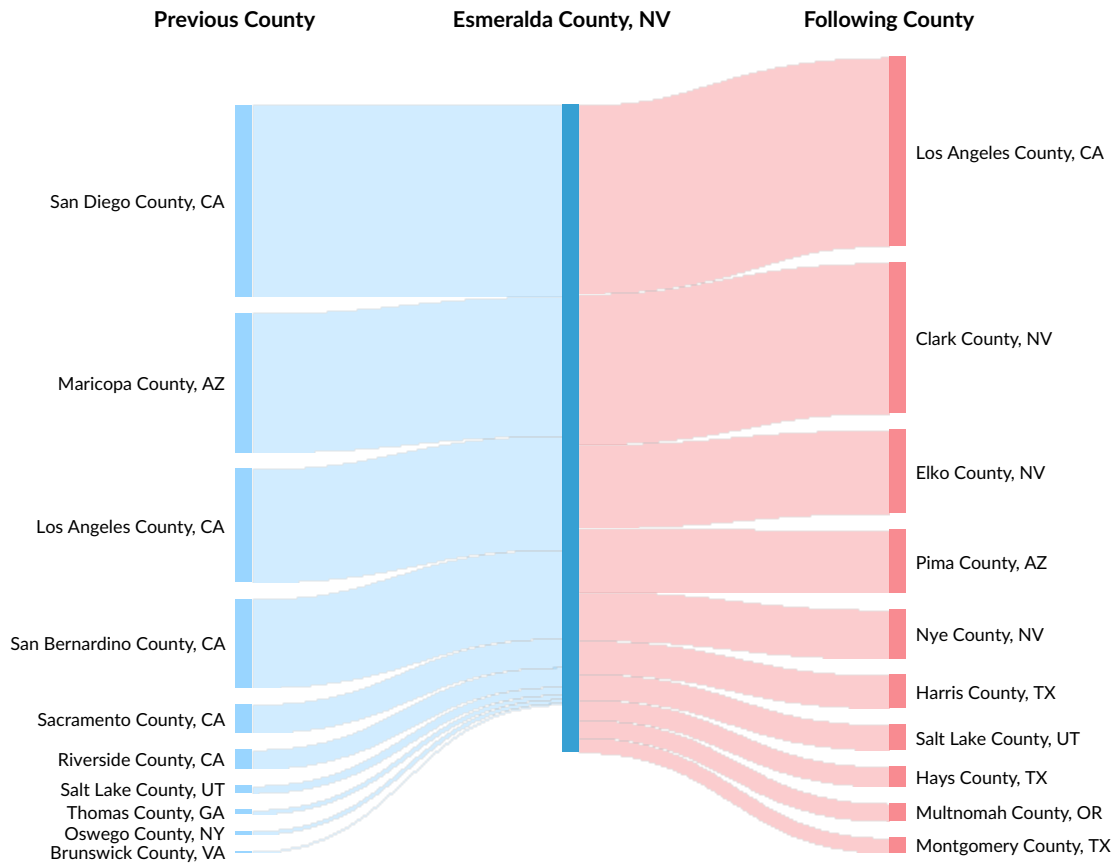

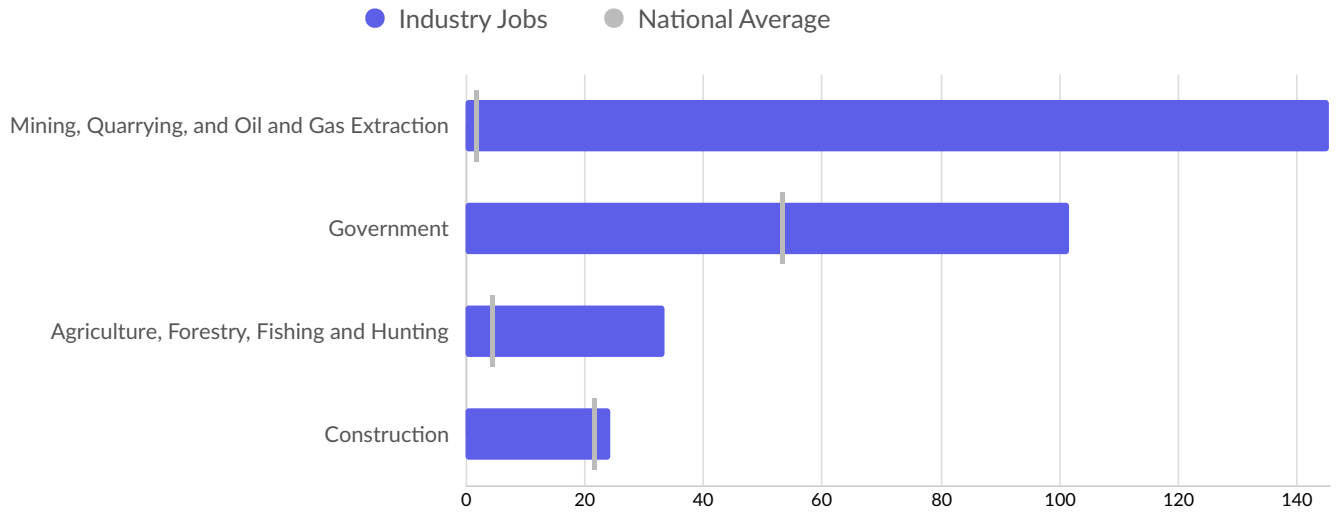

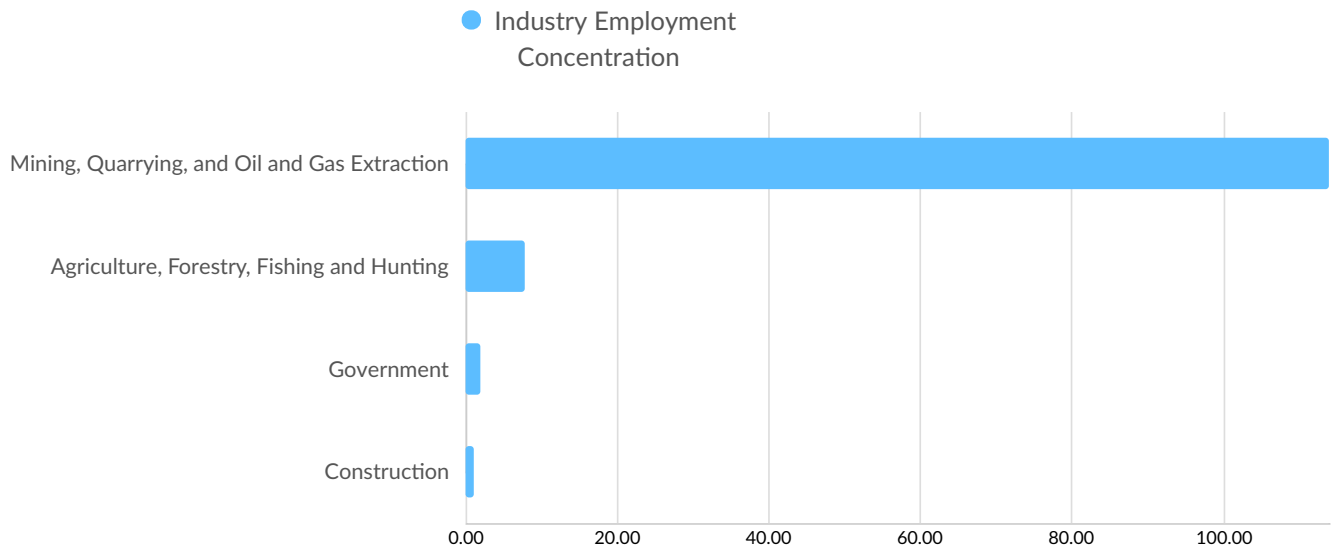

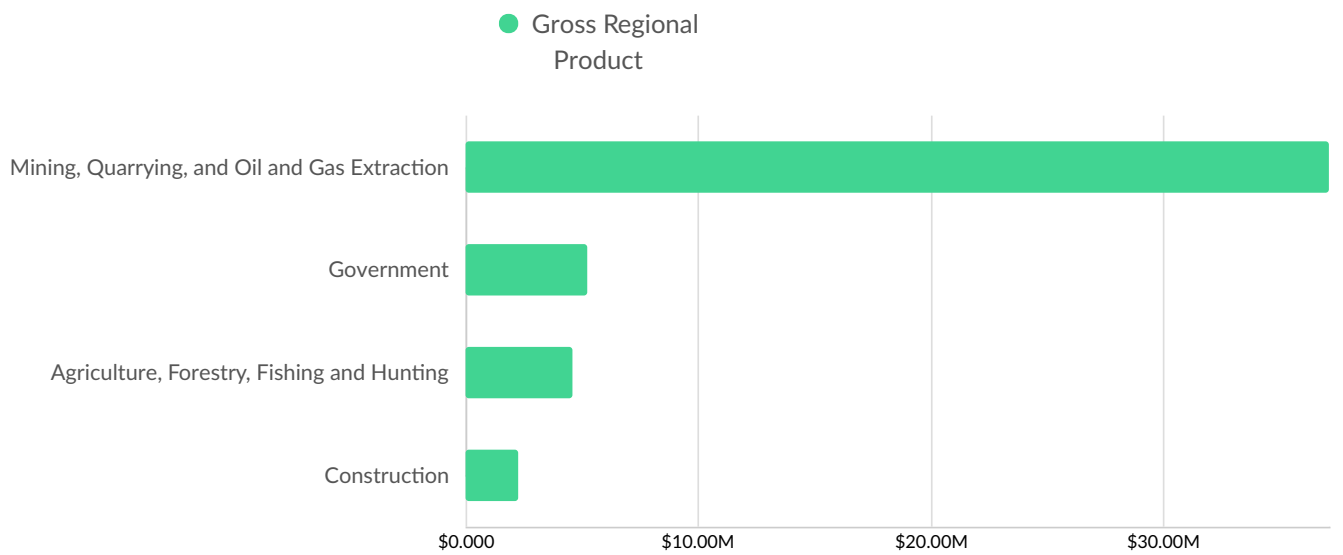
Top Growing Industries



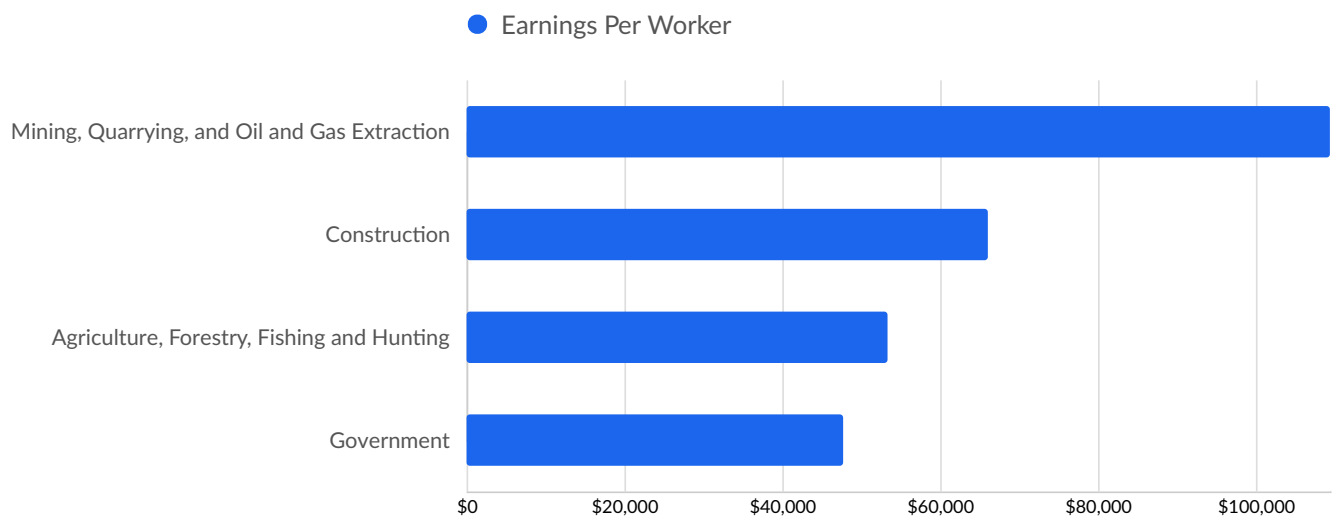
Top Industry Employment Concentration

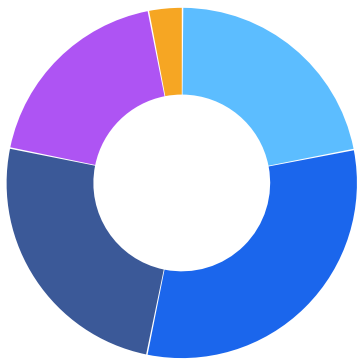

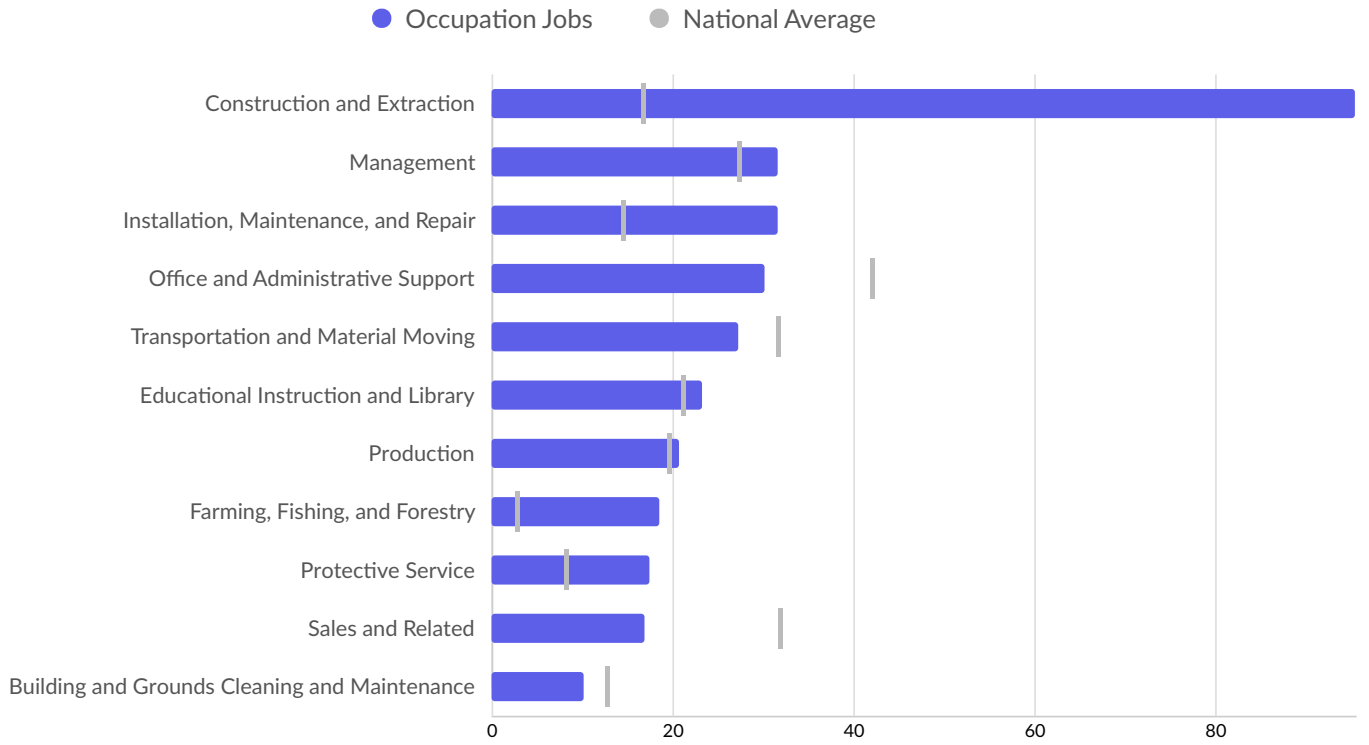

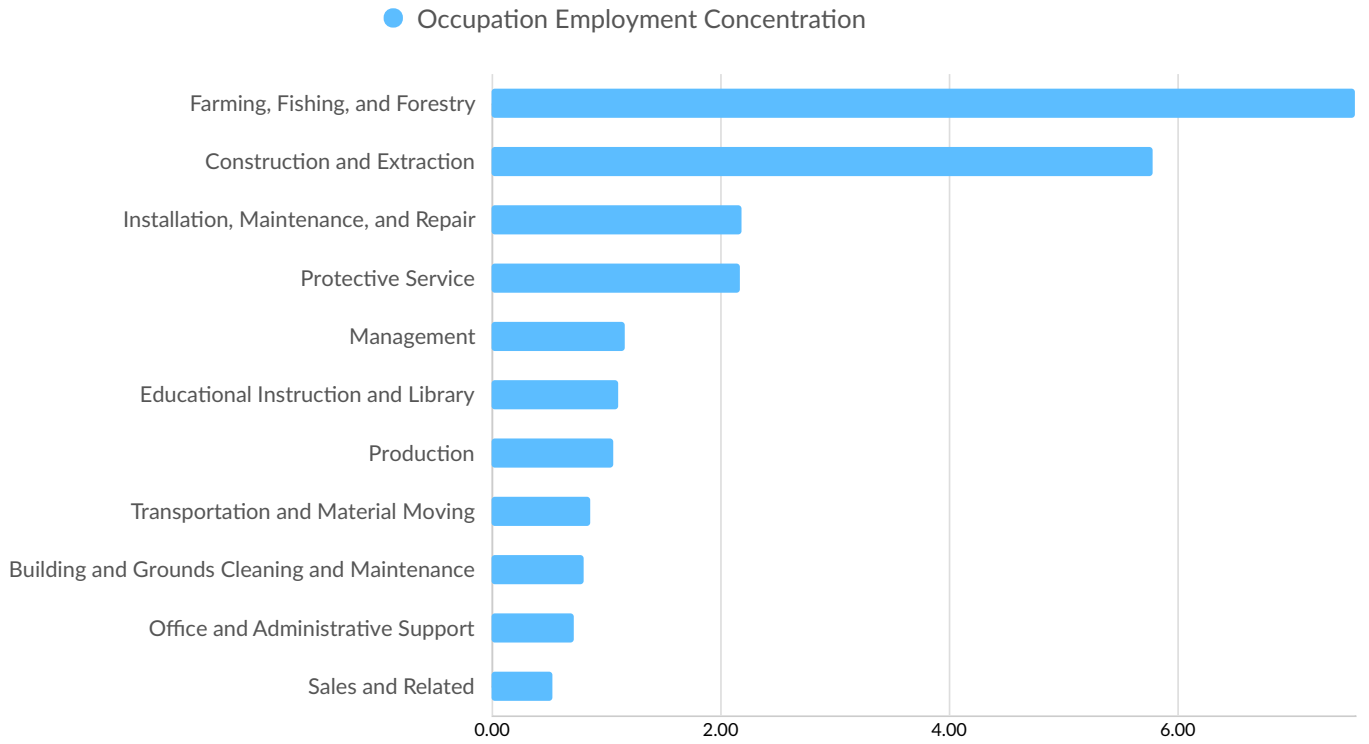
Largest Occupations

Top Occupation Employment Concentration

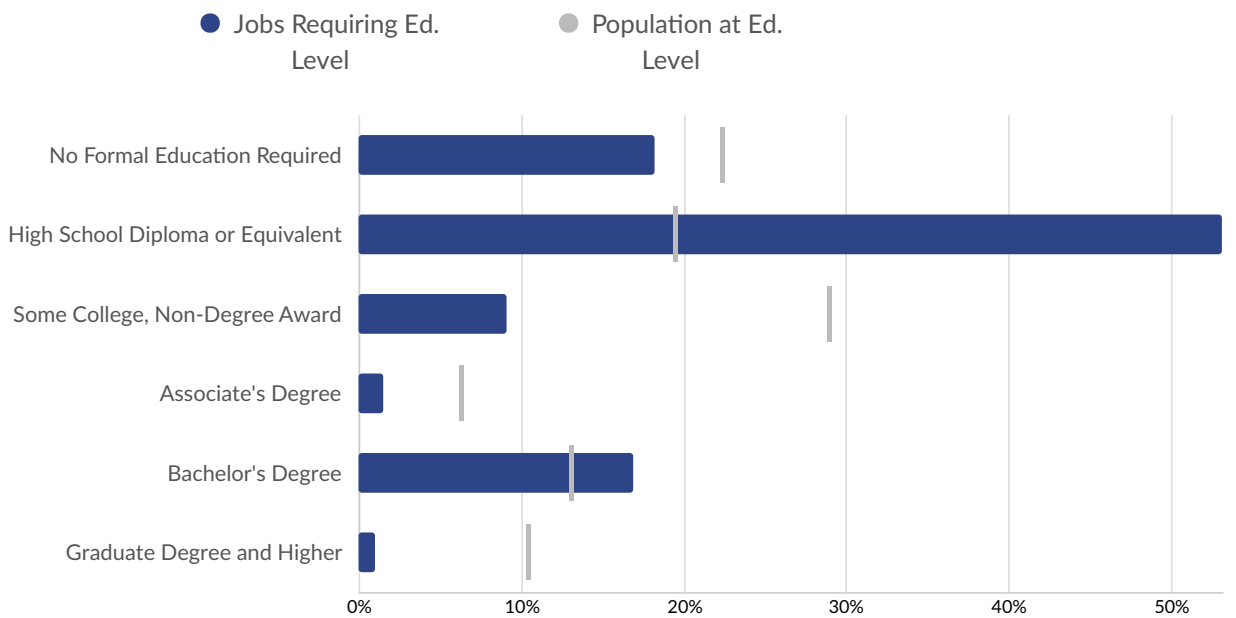
