- As of 2024 the region's population declined by 7.0% since 2019, falling by 145. Population is expected to increase by 1.8% between 2024 and 2029, adding 34.
- From 2019 to 2024, jobs increased by 7.4% in Eureka County, NV from 4,418 to 4,743. This change outpaced the national growth rate of 3.9% by 3.5%. As the number of jobs increased, the labor force participation rate increased from 66.1% to 68.8% between 2019 and 2024.
- Concerning educational attainment, **9.3% of Eureka County, NV residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (12.2% below the national average), and **3.3% hold an Associate's Degree** (5.6% below the national average).
- The top three industries in 2024 are Metal Ore Mining, Support Activities for Mining, and Nonmetallic Mineral Mining and Quarrying.






Unemployment by Gender



Unemployment by Ethnicity





As of 2024 the region's population declined by 7.0% since 2019, falling by 145. Population is expected to increase by 1.8% between 2024 and 2029, adding 34.



Job Trends






Eureka County, NV had a December 2024 unemployment rate of 3.84%, increasing from 2.50% 5 years before.



Eureka County, NV has 317 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 390.




Veterans

Eureka County, NV has 88 veterans. The national average for an area this size is 95.




Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is high in Eureka County, NV. The national average for an area this size is 579 people 55 or older, while there are 689 here.




Violent Crime

Racial diversity is low in Eureka County, NV. The national average for an area this size is 798 racially diverse people, while there are 387 here.




Property Crime








Top Growing Industries




Top Growing Occupations






Top Occupation Employment Concentration




