
Takeaways

- As of 2024 the region's population increased by 1.7% since 2019, growing by 295. Population is expected to increase by 0.8% between 2024 and 2029, adding 145.
- From 2019 to 2024, jobs increased by 1.3% in Humboldt County, NV from 8,409 to 8,517. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 3.9% by 2.6%. As the number of jobs increased, the labor force participation rate decreased from 64.7% to 60.5% between 2019 and 2024.
- Concerning educational attainment, **17.7% of Humboldt County, NV residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (3.7% below the national average), and **9.2% hold an Associate's Degree** (0.3% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2024 are Metal Ore Mining, Education and Hospitals (Local Government), and Restaurants and Other Eating Places.




Dec 2024 Labor Force Breakdown






Unemployment by Gender



Unemployment by Ethnicity







Job Trends






Humboldt County, NV had a December 2024 unemployment rate of 4.14%, increasing from 3.06% 5 years before.






Millennials

Humboldt County, NV has 3,413 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 3,482.




Humboldt County, NV has 1,074 veterans. The national average for an area this size is 884.




Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is about average in Humboldt County, NV. The national average for an area this size is 5,173 people 55 or older, while there are 4,875 here.




Violent Crime

Racial diversity is low in Humboldt County, NV. The national average for an area this size is 7,137 racially diverse people, while there are 6,101 here.




Property Crime








Top Growing Industries






Top Industry Employment Concentration






Top Industry GRP



Top Occupation Employment Concentration











