- From 2019 to 2024, jobs increased by 1.9% in Lincoln County, NV from 1,510 to 1,538. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 3.9% by 2.0%. As the number of jobs increased, the labor force participation rate increased from 55.6% to 65.2% between 2019 and 2024.
- Concerning educational attainment, **8.1% of Lincoln County, NV residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (13.4% below the national average), and **5.4% hold an Associate's Degree** (3.5% below the national average).
- The top three industries in 2024 are Education and Hospitals (Local Government), Local Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals, and State Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals.




Dec 2024 Labor Force Breakdown






Unemployment by Gender



Unemployment by Ethnicity







Job Trends






Lincoln County, NV had a December 2024 unemployment rate of 4.97%, increasing from 4.11% 5 years before.












Top Growing Industries






Top Industry Employment Concentration






Top Industry GRP




