### Takeaways

- From 2019 to 2024, jobs increased by 7.1% in Lyon County, NV from 14,464 to 15,497. This change outpaced the national growth rate of 3.9% by 3.2%. As the number of jobs increased, the labor force participation rate decreased from 49.0% to 46.0% between 2019 and 2024.
- Concerning educational attainment, **12.0% of Lyon County**, **NV residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (9.4% below the national average), and **11.9% hold an Associate's Degree** (3.0% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2024 are Education and Hospitals (Local Government), Restaurants and Other Eating Places, and Local Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals.












# **Population Trends**





Lyon County, NV had a December 2024 unemployment rate of 6.34%, increasing from 5.07% 5 years before.






Millennials

Lyon County, NV has 12,557 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 12,716.




**Retiring Soon**

#### Violent Crime


Lyon County, NV has 2.97 violent crimes per 1,000 people. The national rate is 3.54 per 1,000 people.








#### **Top Industry Employment Concentration**








