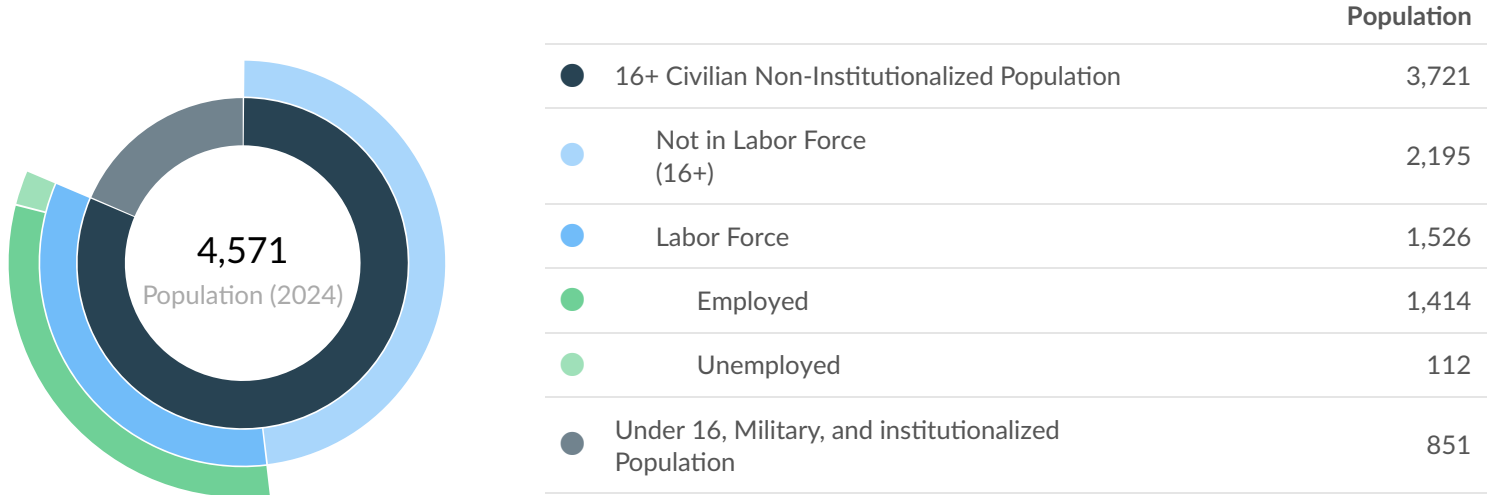
Median household income is **\$28.5K below** the national median household income of \$75.1K.

Takeaways

- As of 2024 the region's population **increased by 1.2%** since 2019, growing by 55. Population is expected to **increase by 3.3%** between 2024 and 2029, adding 153.
- From 2019 to 2024, jobs **declined by 27.1%** in Mineral County, NV from 1,783 to **1,299**. This change **fell short of the national growth rate of 3.9% by 31.0%**. As the number of jobs declined, the **labor force participation rate decreased from 55.4% to 41.0% between 2019 and 2024**.
- Concerning educational attainment, **11.2% of Mineral County, NV residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (10.2% below the national average), and **2.8% hold an Associate's Degree** (6.2% below the national average).
- The top three industries in 2024 are Education and Hospitals (Local Government), Local Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals, and Traveler Accommodation.

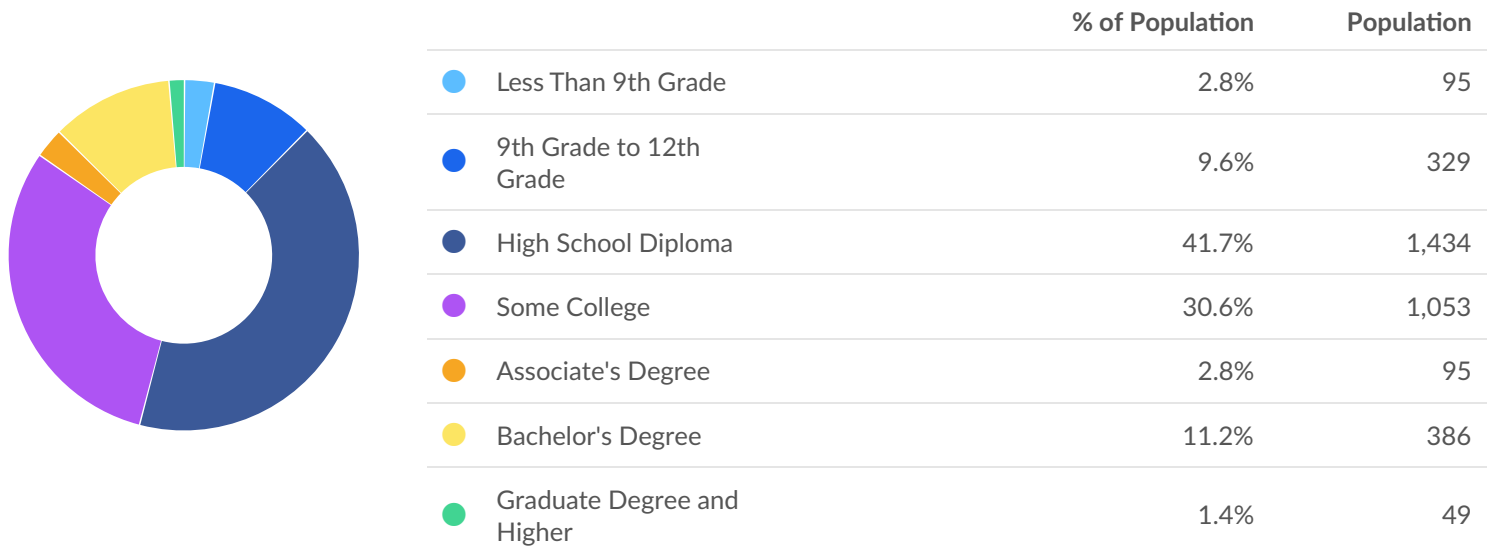

Dec 2024 Labor Force Breakdown



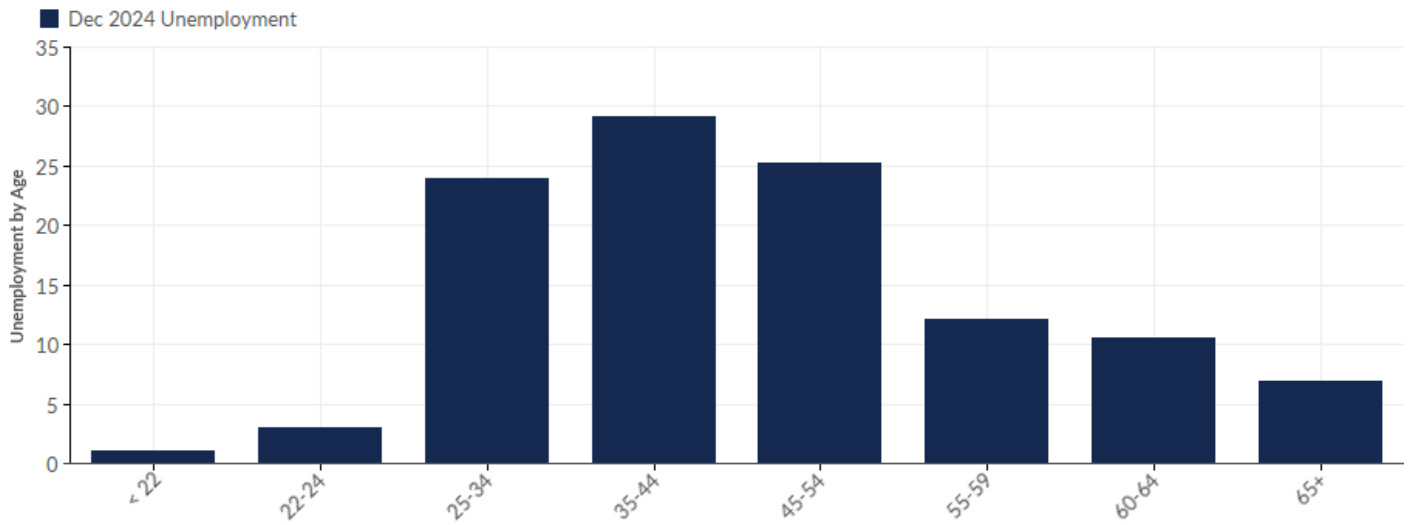
Educational Attainment

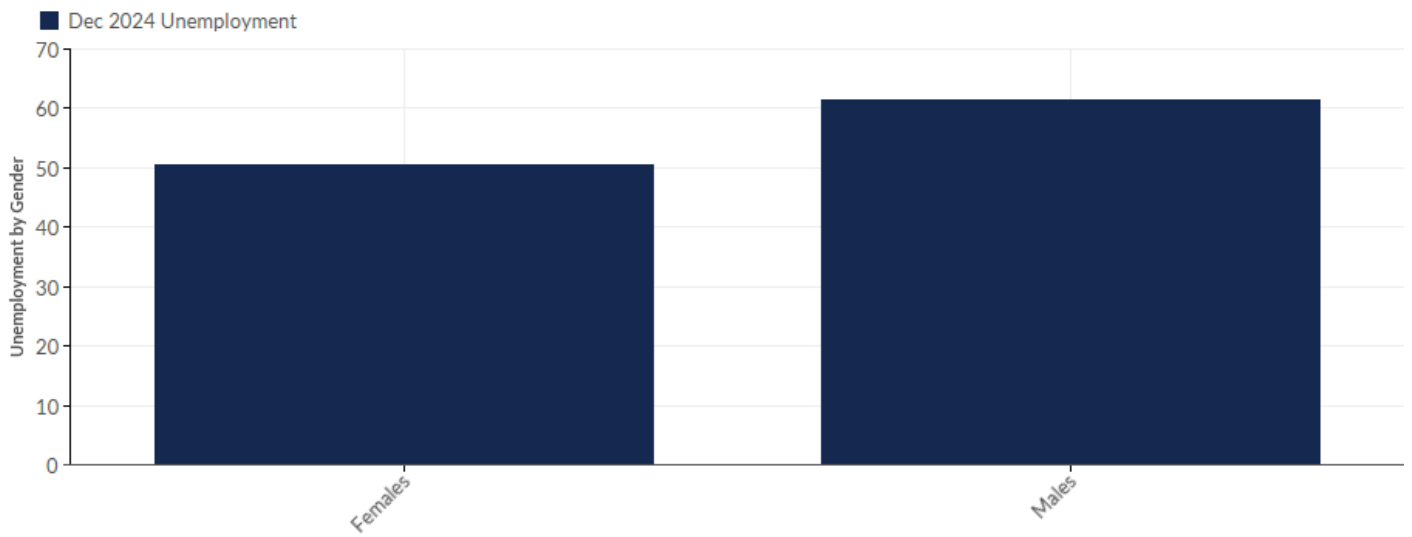

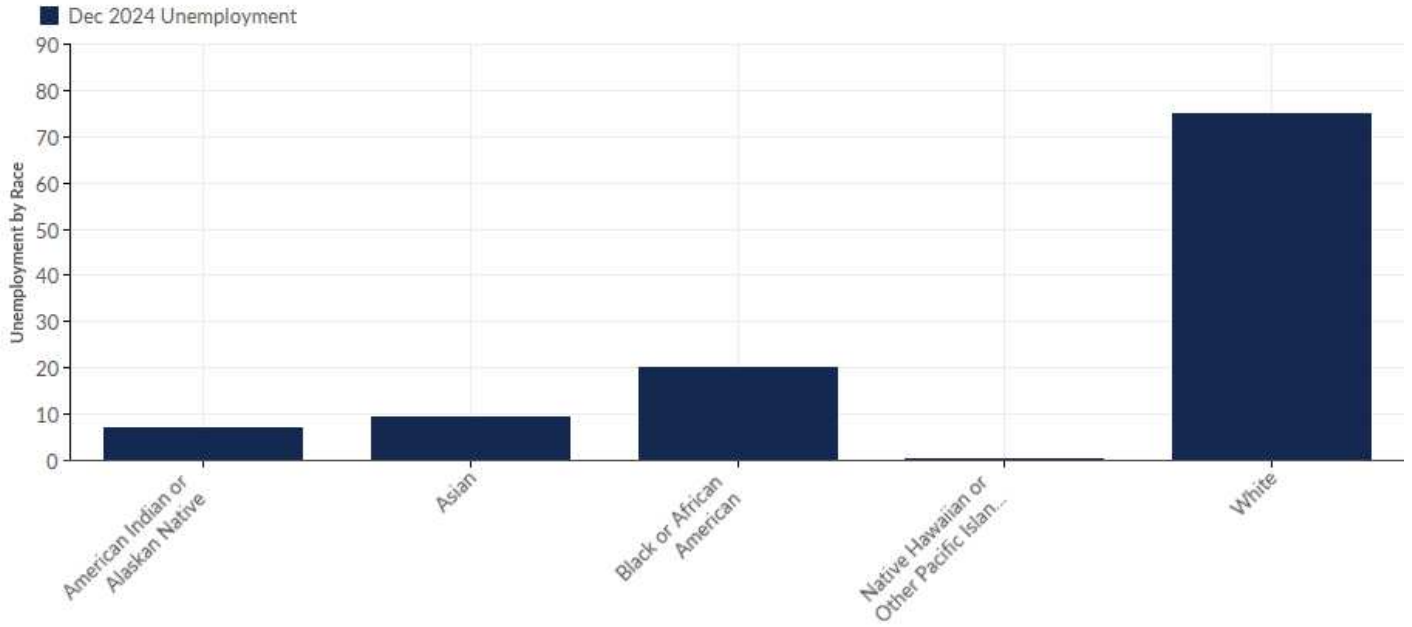

Unemployment by Gender



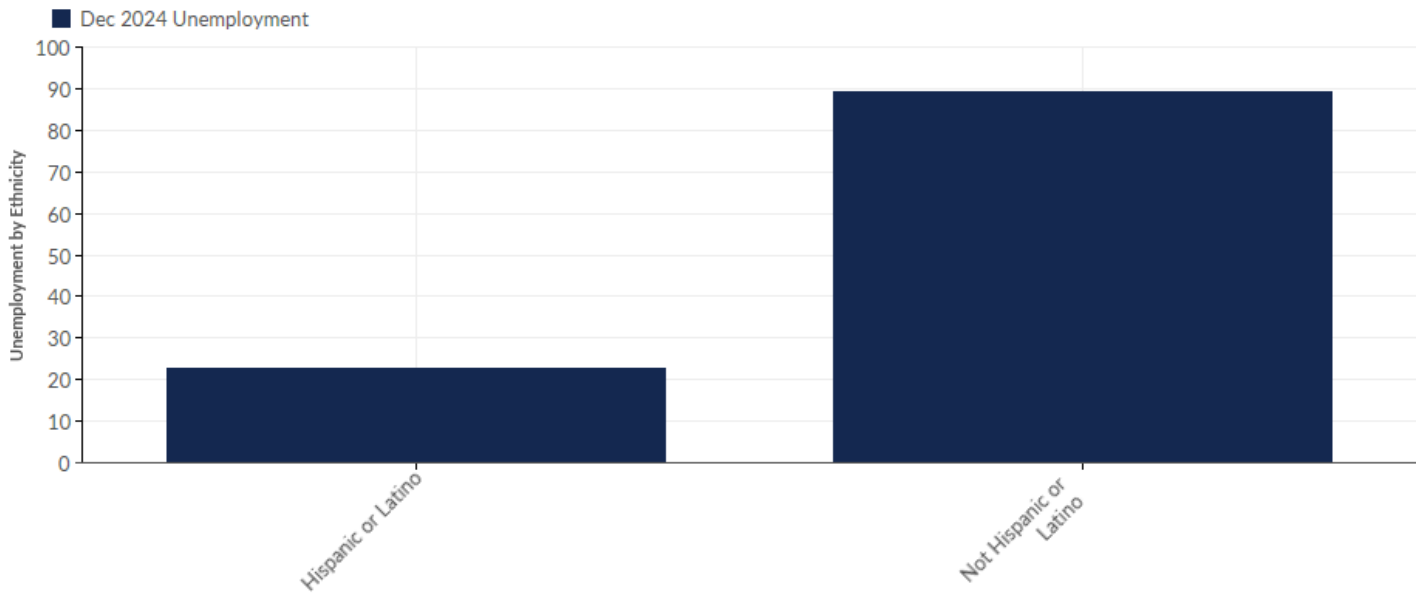

Unemployment by Ethnicity

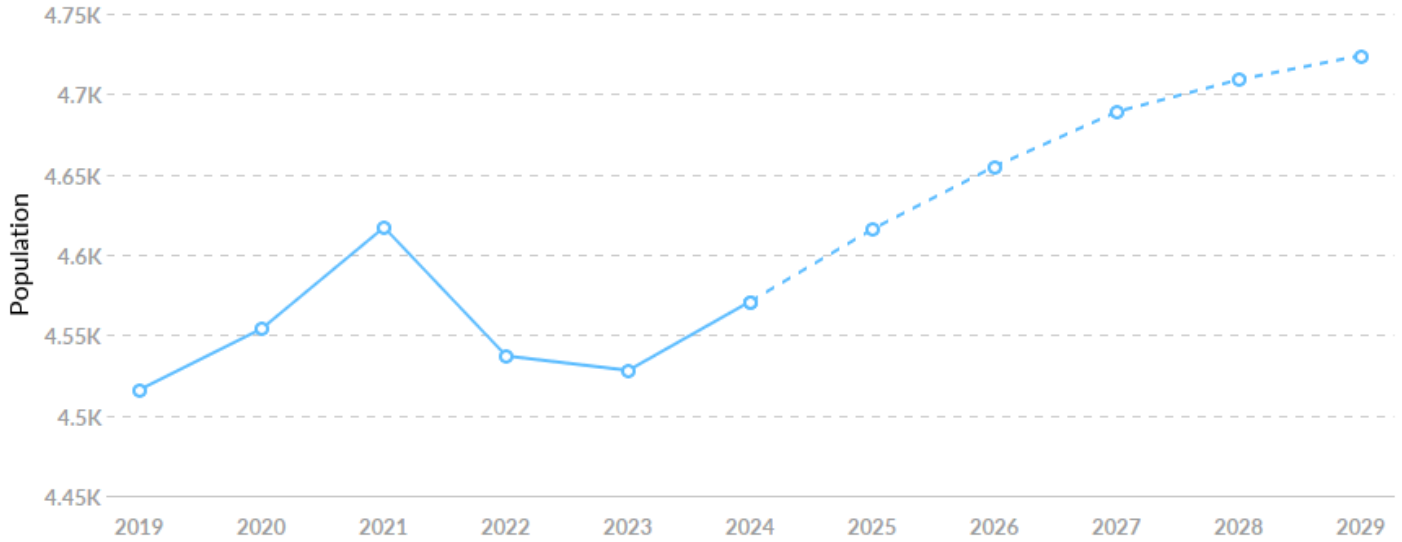

Population Trends

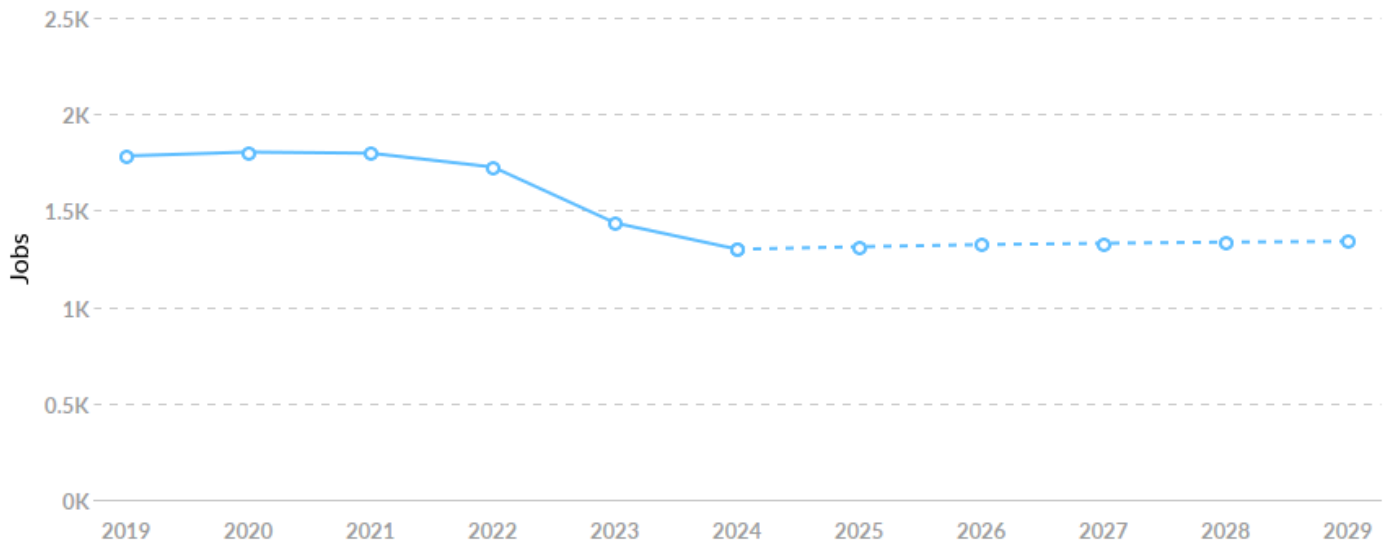
As of 2024 the region's population increased by 1.2% since 2019, growing by 55. Population is expected to increase by 3.3% between 2024 and 2029, adding 153.

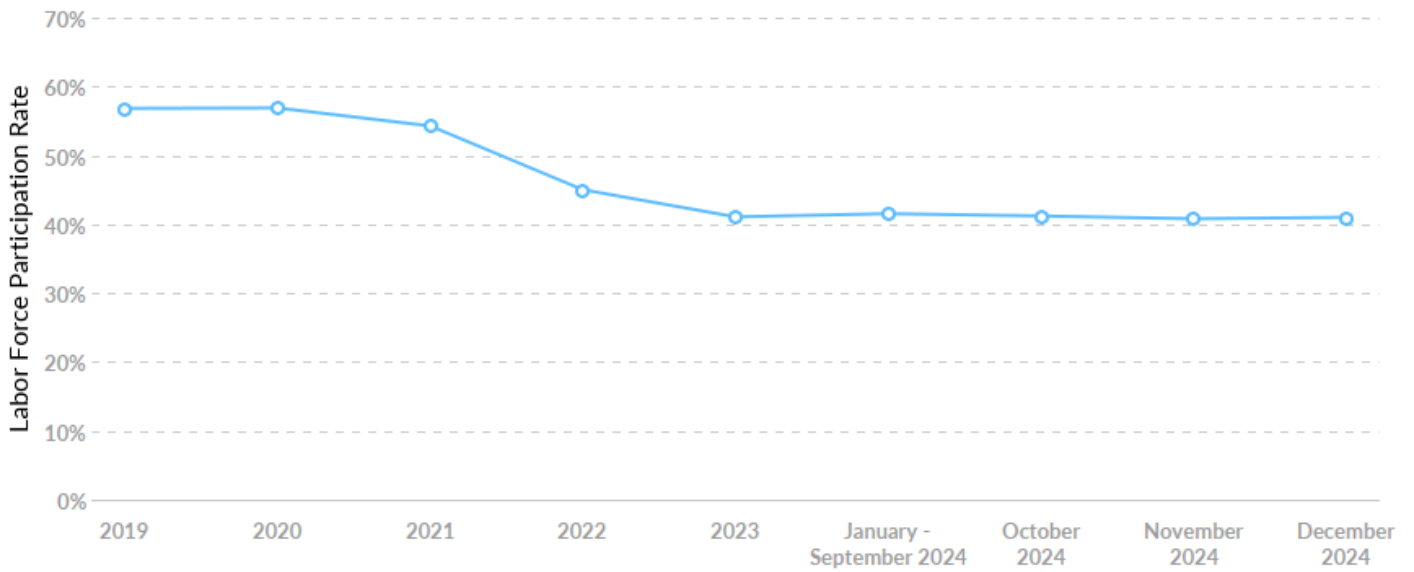
Job Trends

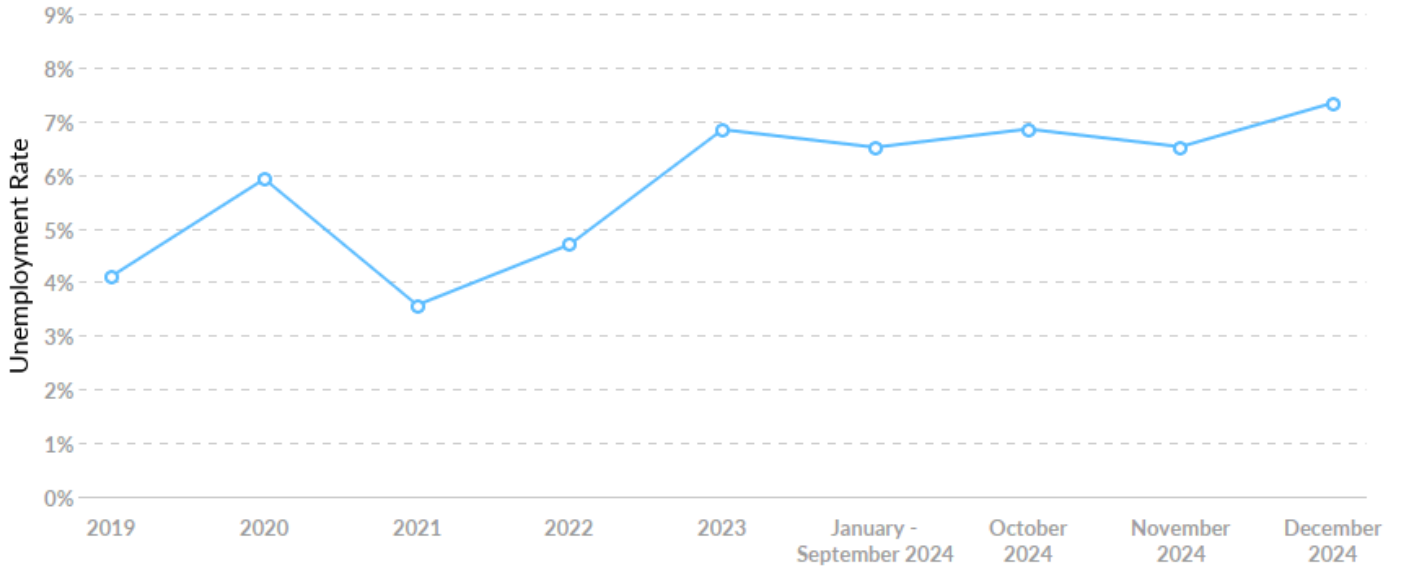

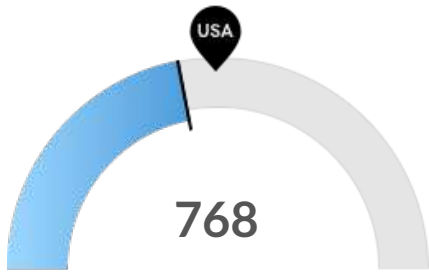
Unemployment Rate Trends

Mineral County, NV had a December 2024 unemployment rate of 7.34%, **increasing from 4.11%** 5 years before.



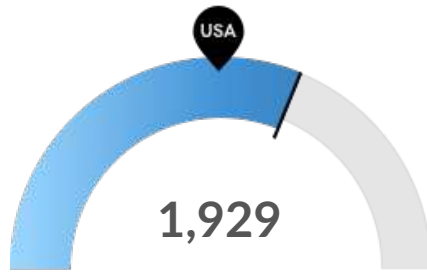

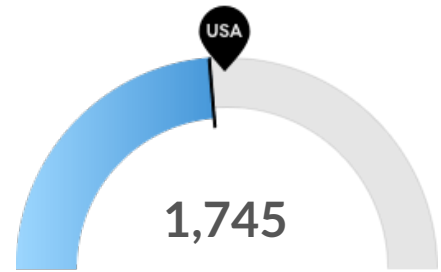
Millennials

Mineral County, NV has 768 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 920.



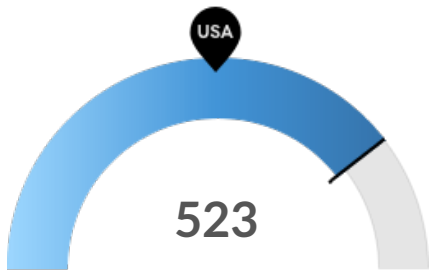
Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is high in Mineral County, NV. The national average for an area this size is 1,367 people 55 or older, while there are 1,929 here.



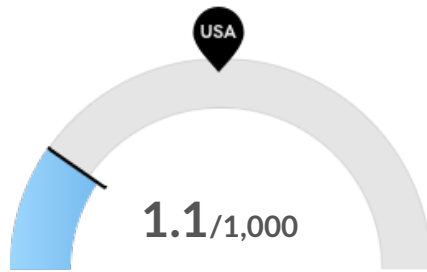
Racial Diversity

Racial diversity is about average in Mineral County, NV. The national average for an area this size is 1,886 racially diverse people, while there are 1,745 here.



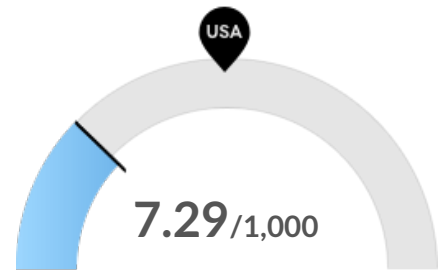
Veterans

Mineral County, NV has 1.1 violent crimes per 1,000 people. The national rate is 3.54 per 1,000 people.

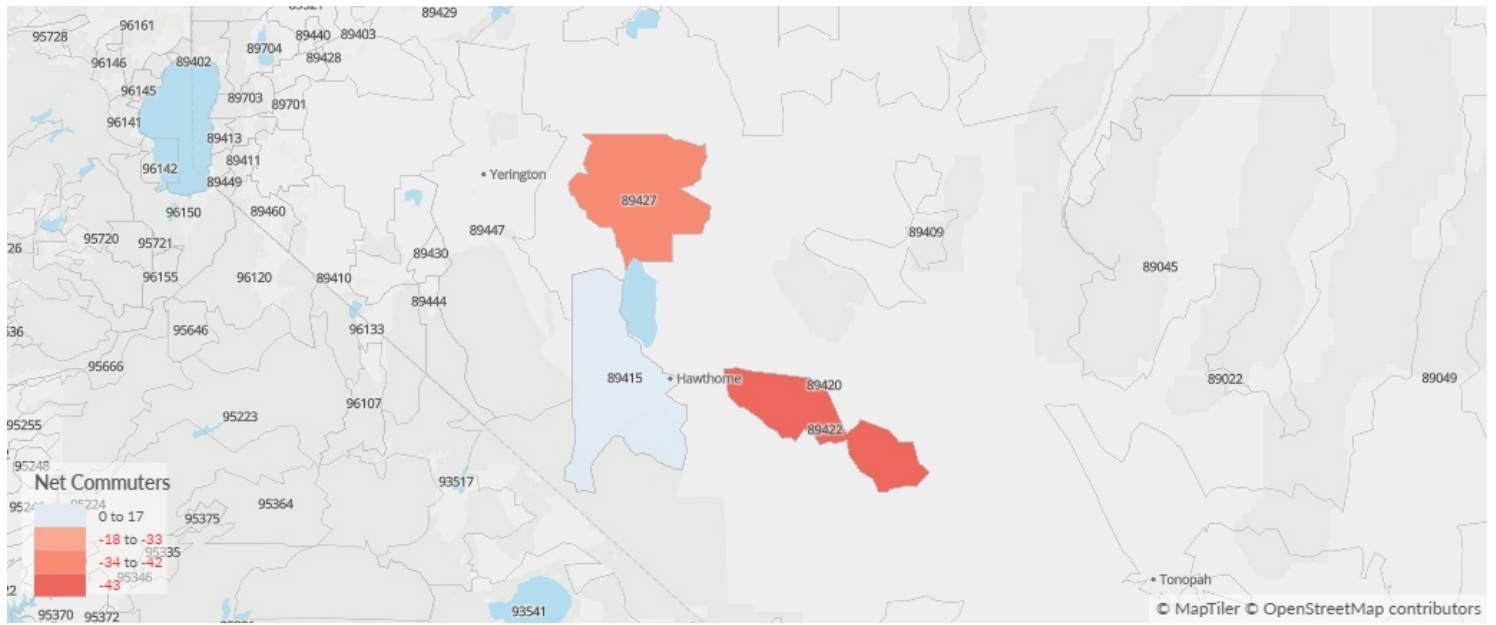


Property Crime

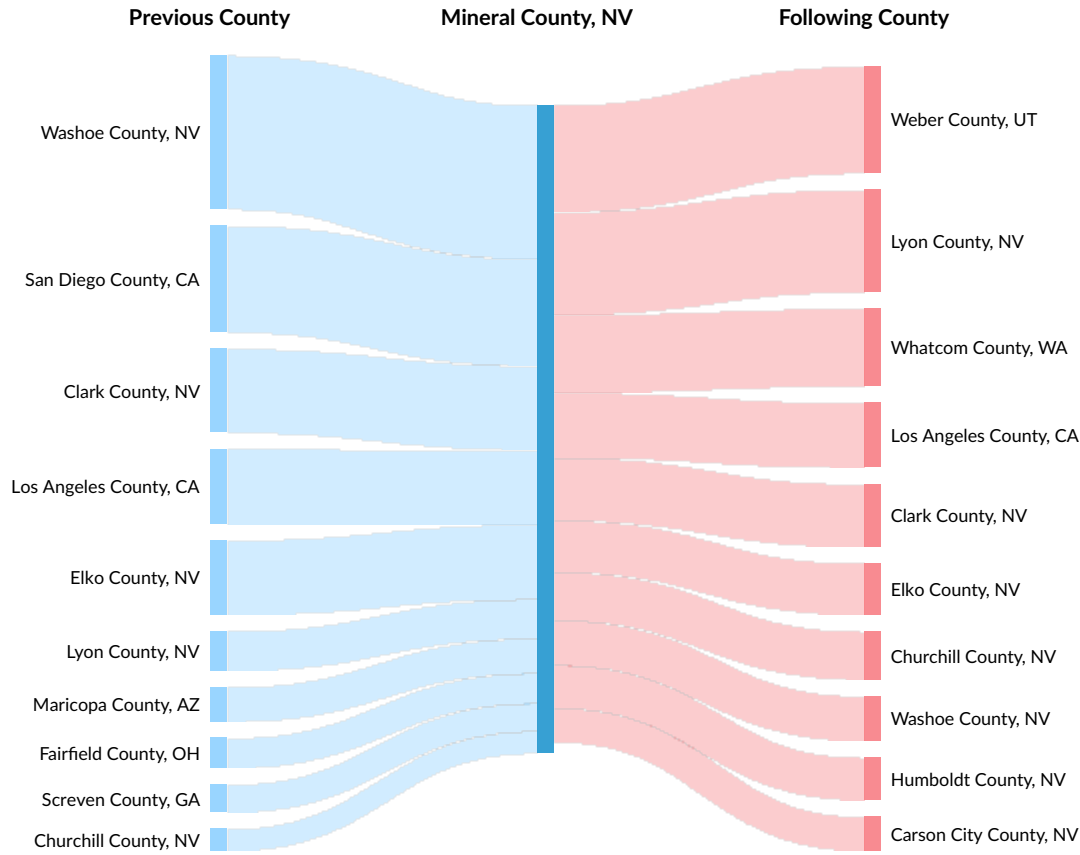

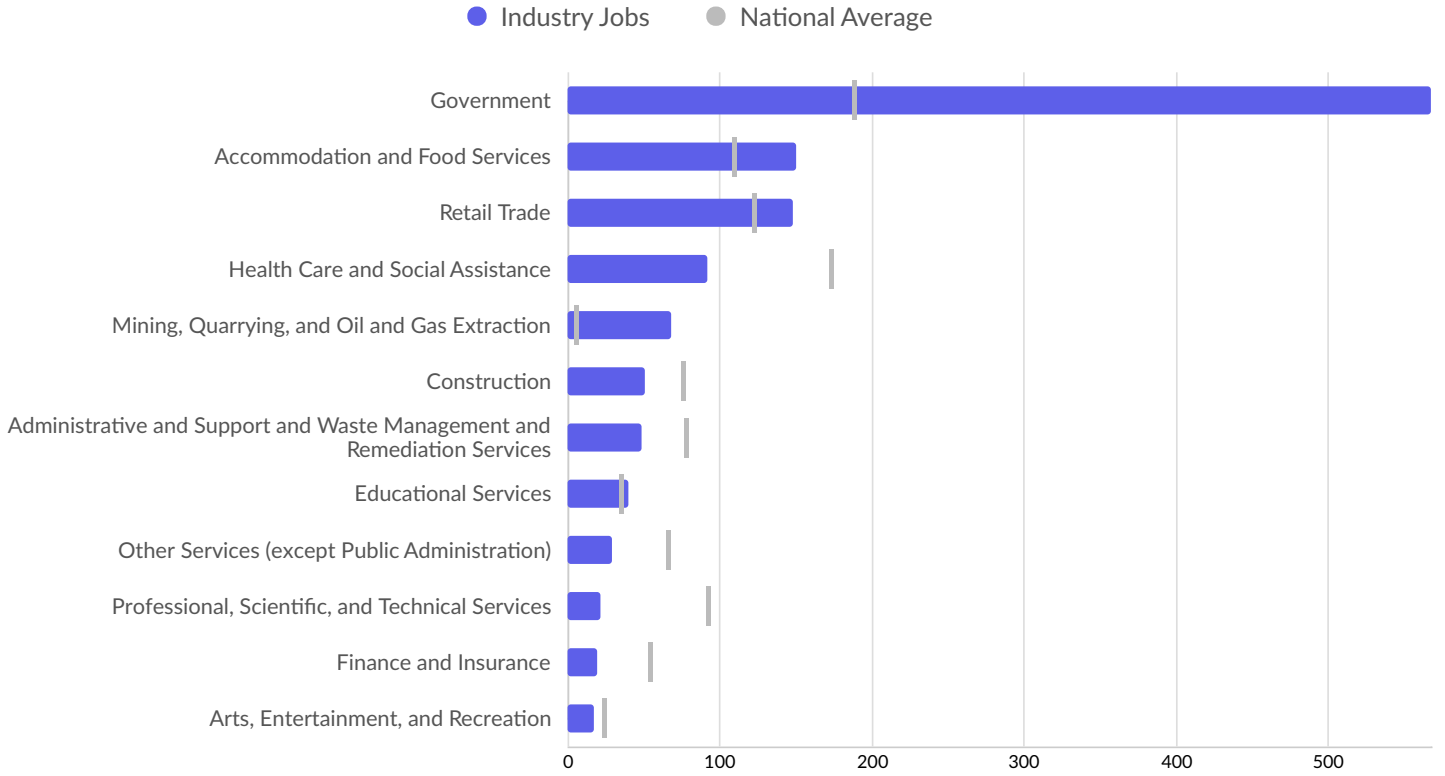

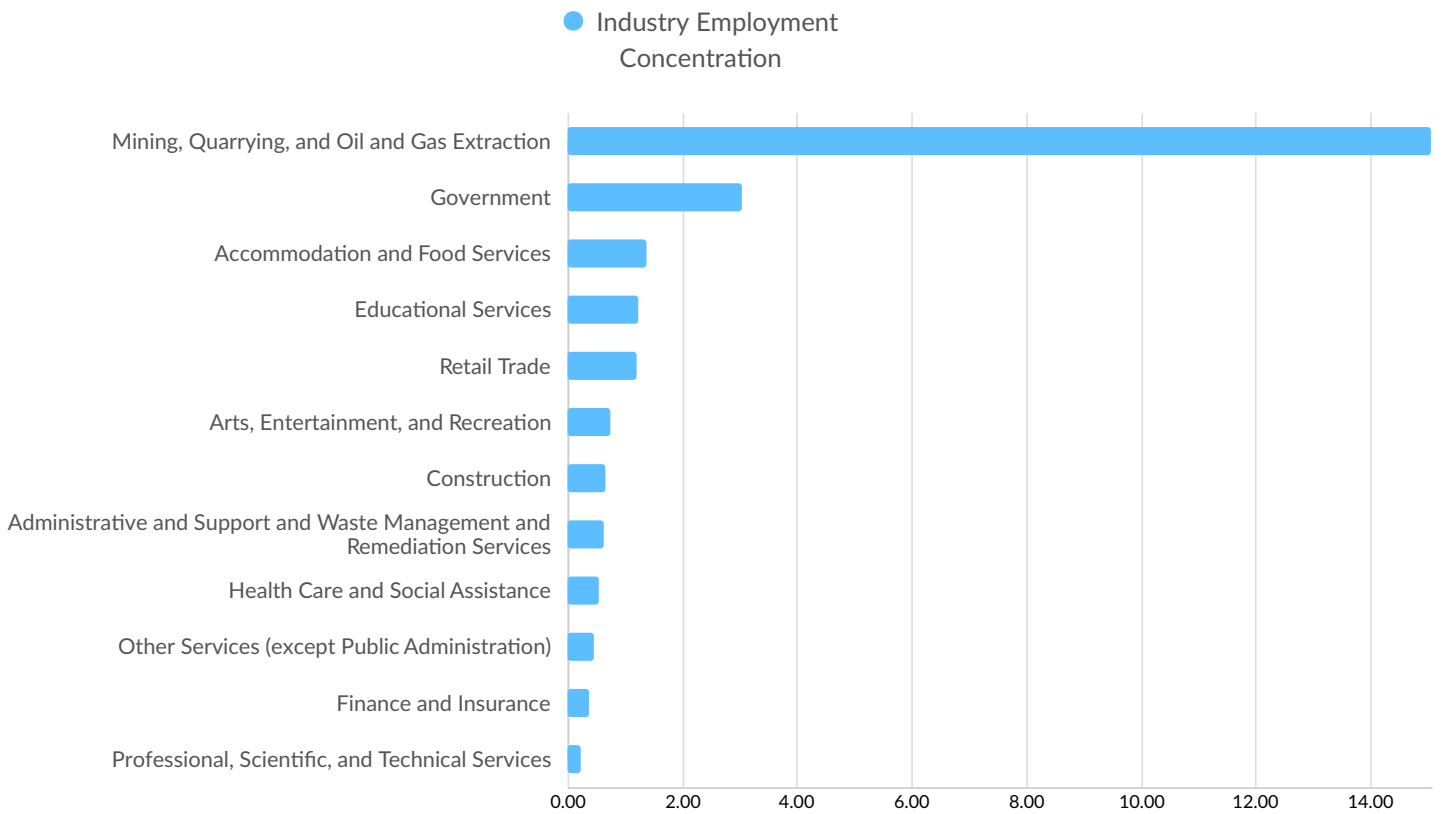

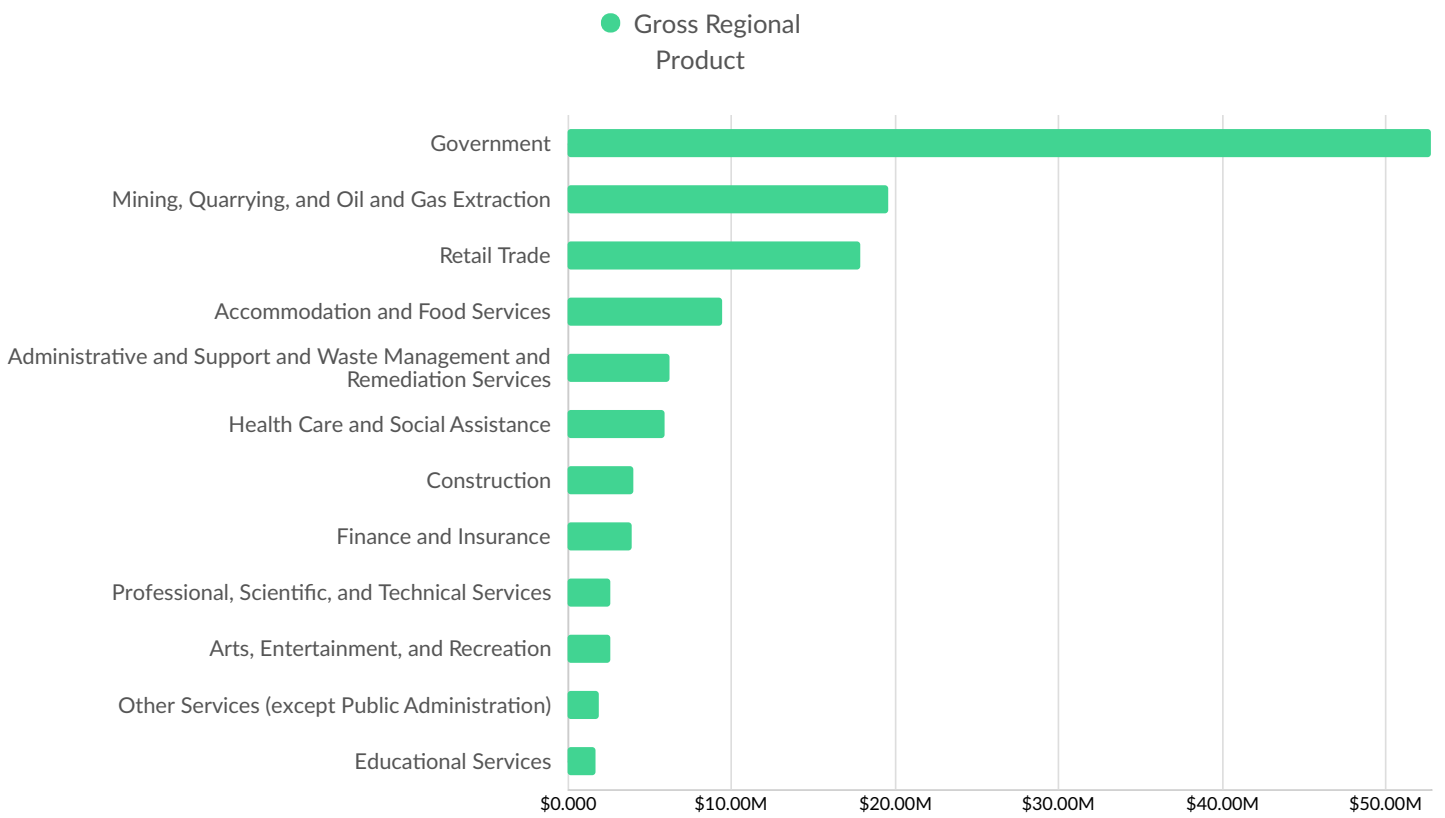
Top Growing Industries



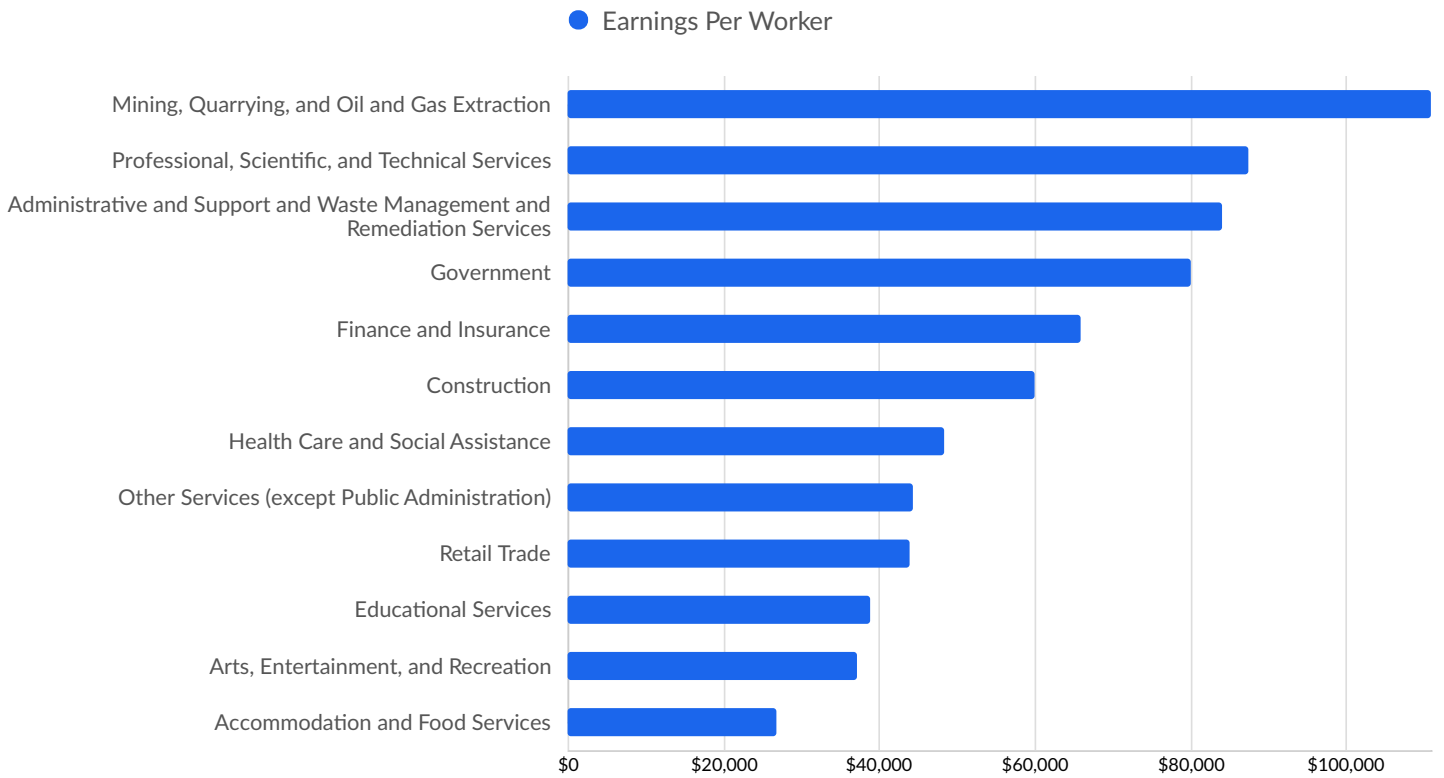
Top Industry Employment Concentration

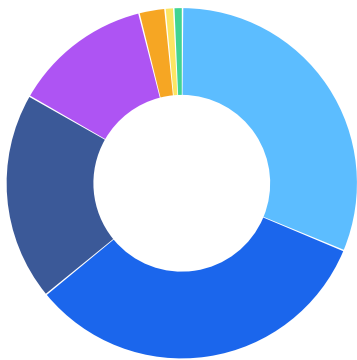

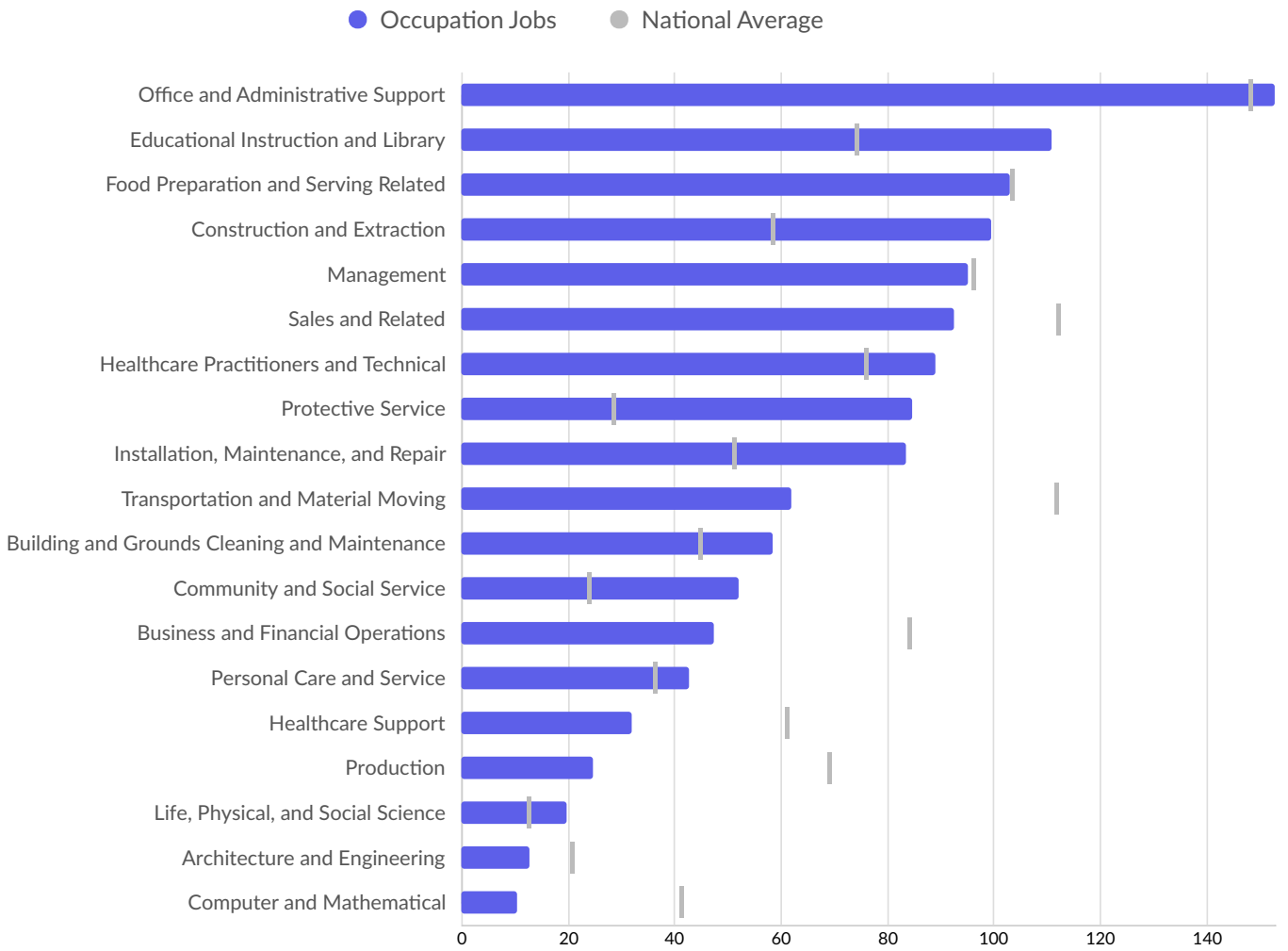

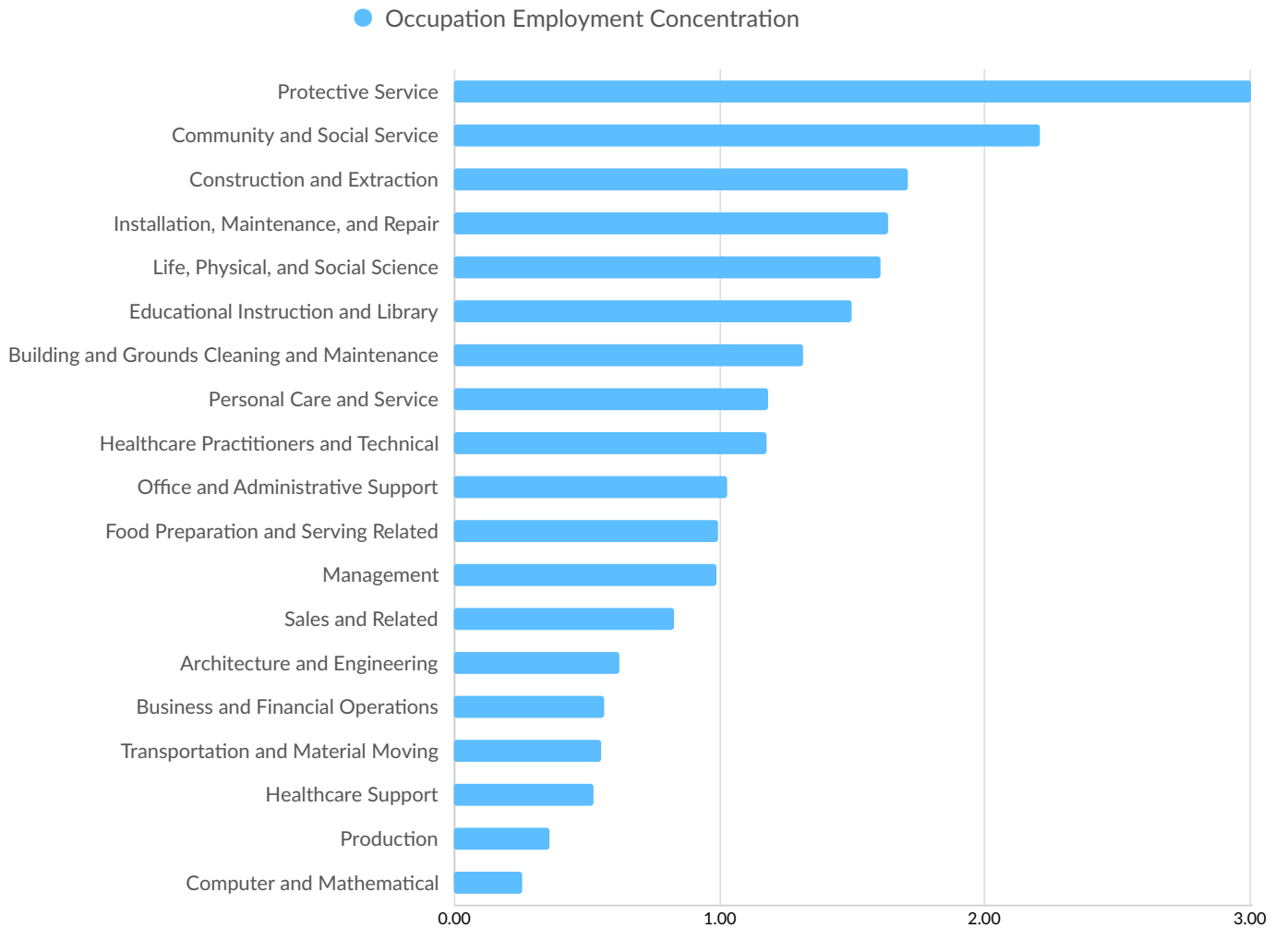

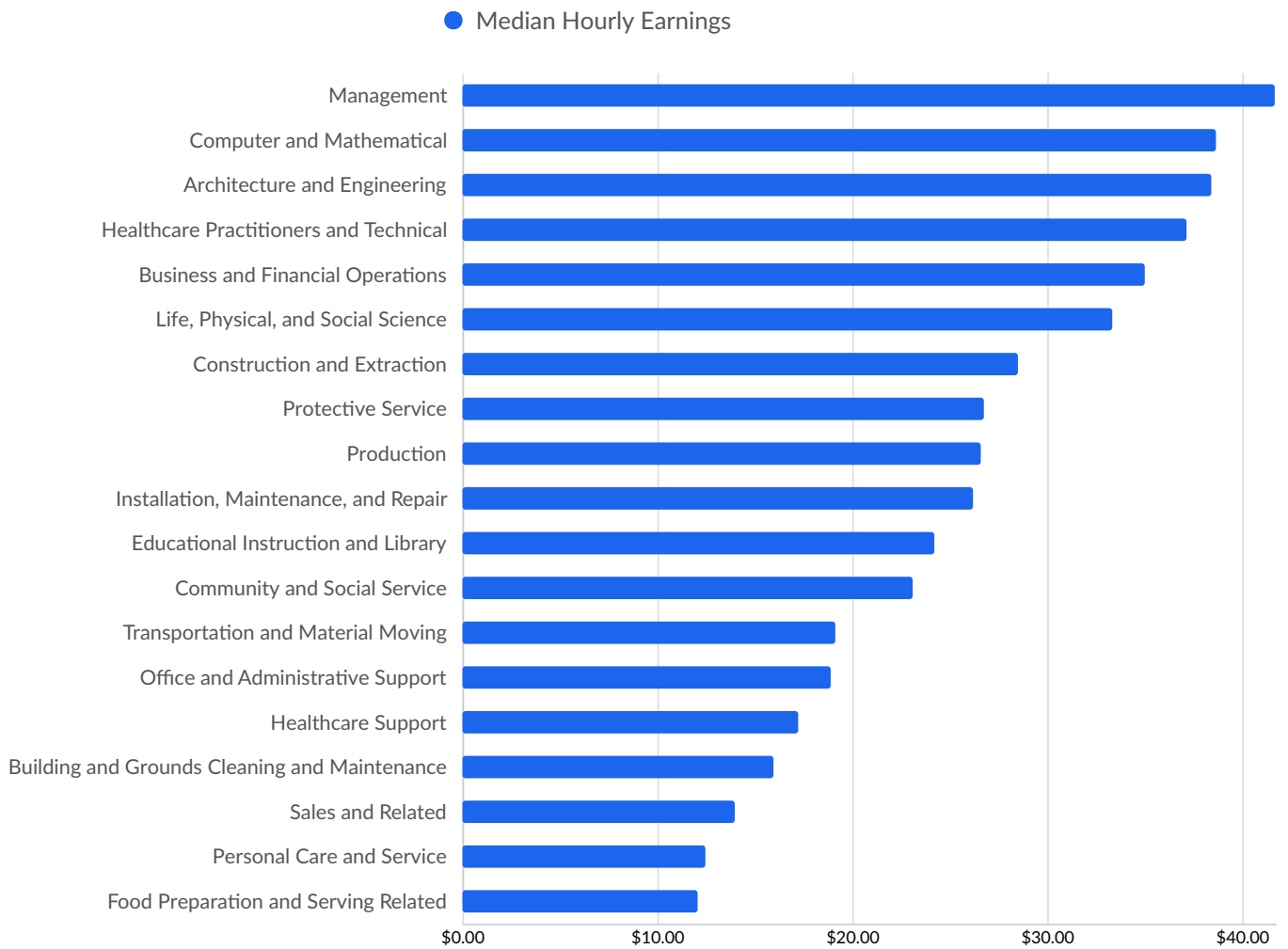
Top Growing Occupations



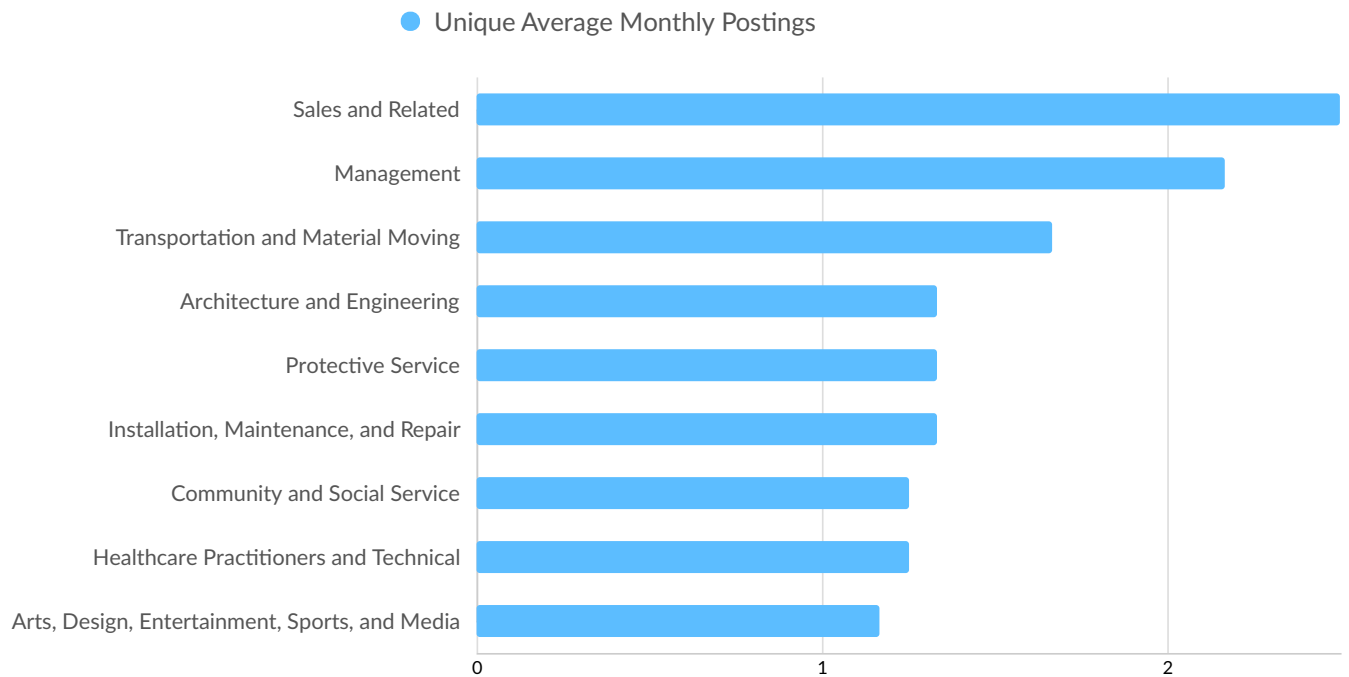
Top Occupation Employment Concentration



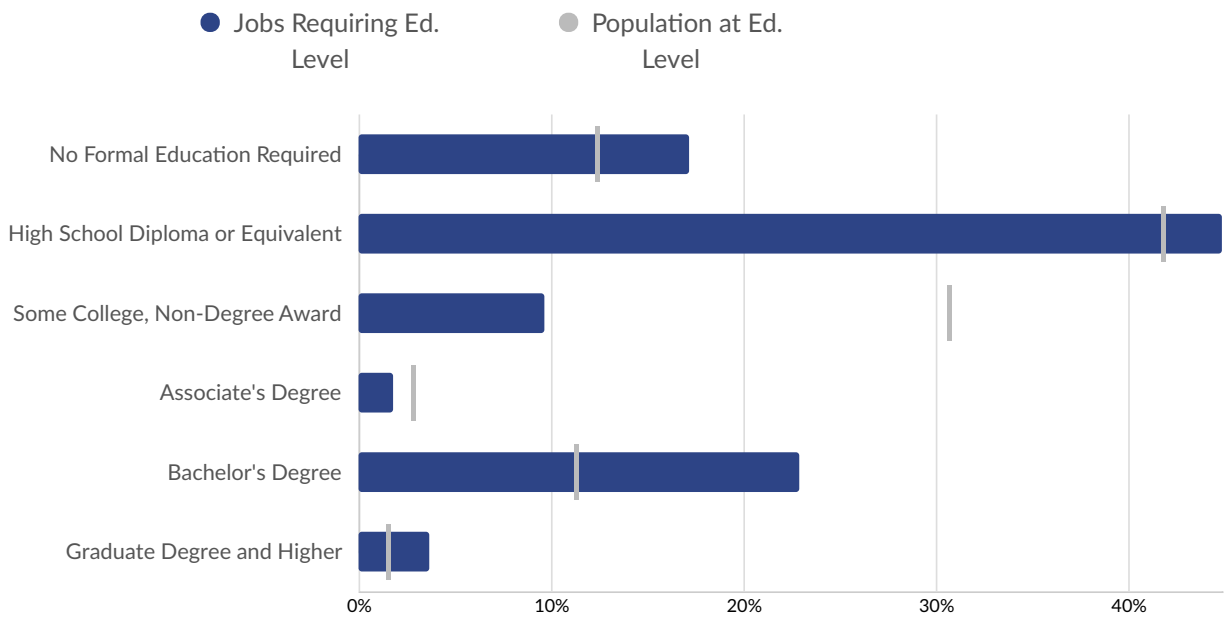
