




Overview

- Washoe County's positive economic momentum continues new jobs, investments & tax abatements help incentivize new projects
- Unprecedented level of industrial development activity
 - > 125 Million SF Industrial Base
 - > 8.5 Million SF Delivered in 2025
 - > 140% of 5-year Development Average
- > EDAWN's project pipeline and economic development prospect activity remain very strong
- Healthy job market and surging industrial economy continue to fuel residential, retail, and commercial demand/development
- > The tight labor force and housing market are two potential constraints on growth
- > Inflation and rising interest rates expected to slow development activity, but haven't yet






