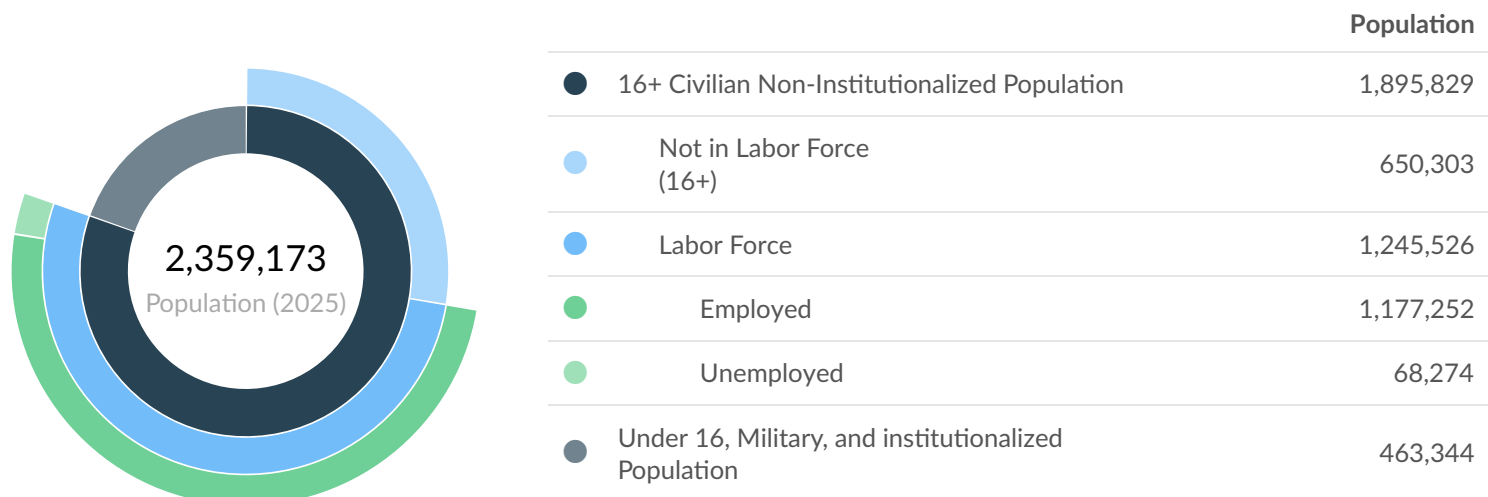
Median household income is **\$4.7K below** the national median household income of \$78.5K.

- From 2019 to 2024, jobs **increased by 10.4%** in Clark County, NV from 1,134,565 to **1,252,817**. This change **outpaced the national growth rate of 4.3% by 6.1%**. As the number of jobs increased, the **labor force participation rate increased from 62.4% to 65.1% between 2019 and 2024**.

- The top three industries in 2024 are Traveler Accommodation, Restaurants and Other Eating Places, and Education and Hospitals (Local Government).

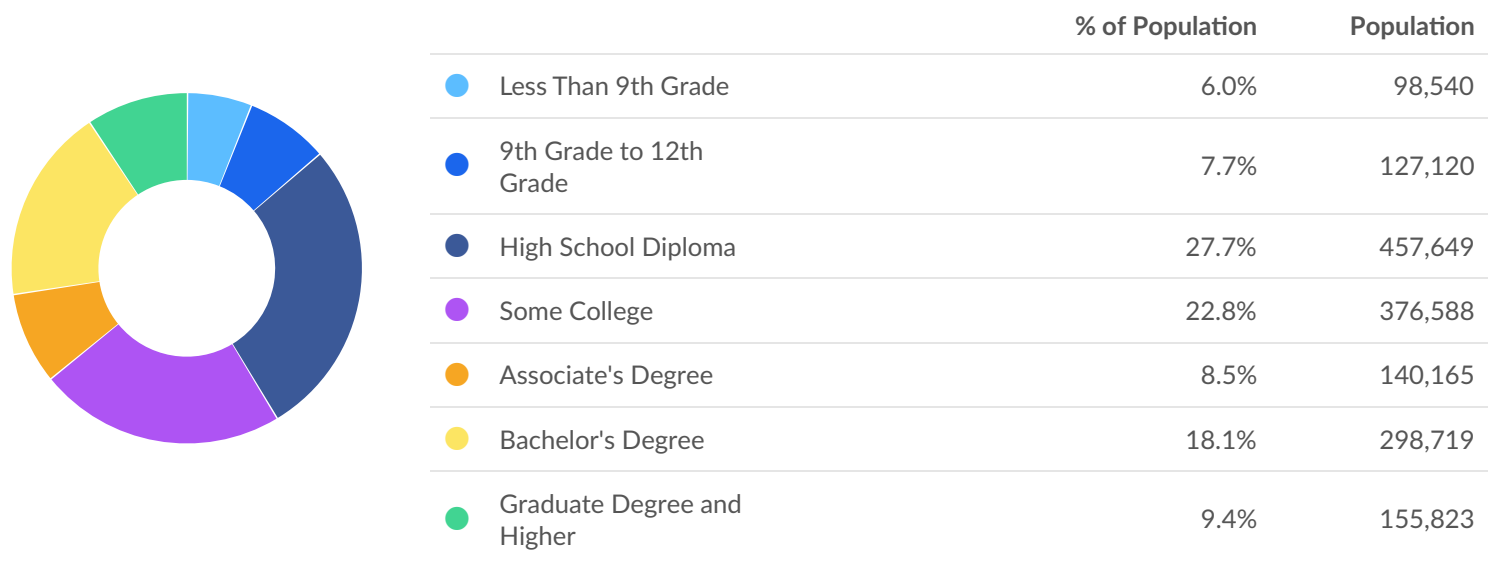

## May 2025 Labor Force Breakdown



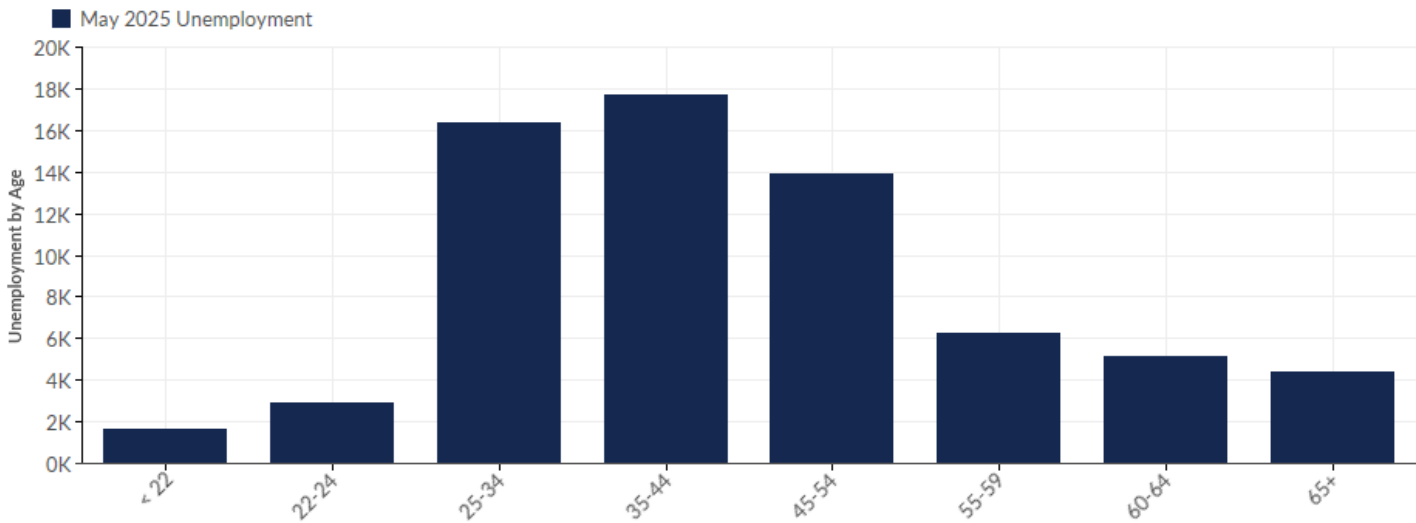
## Educational Attainment

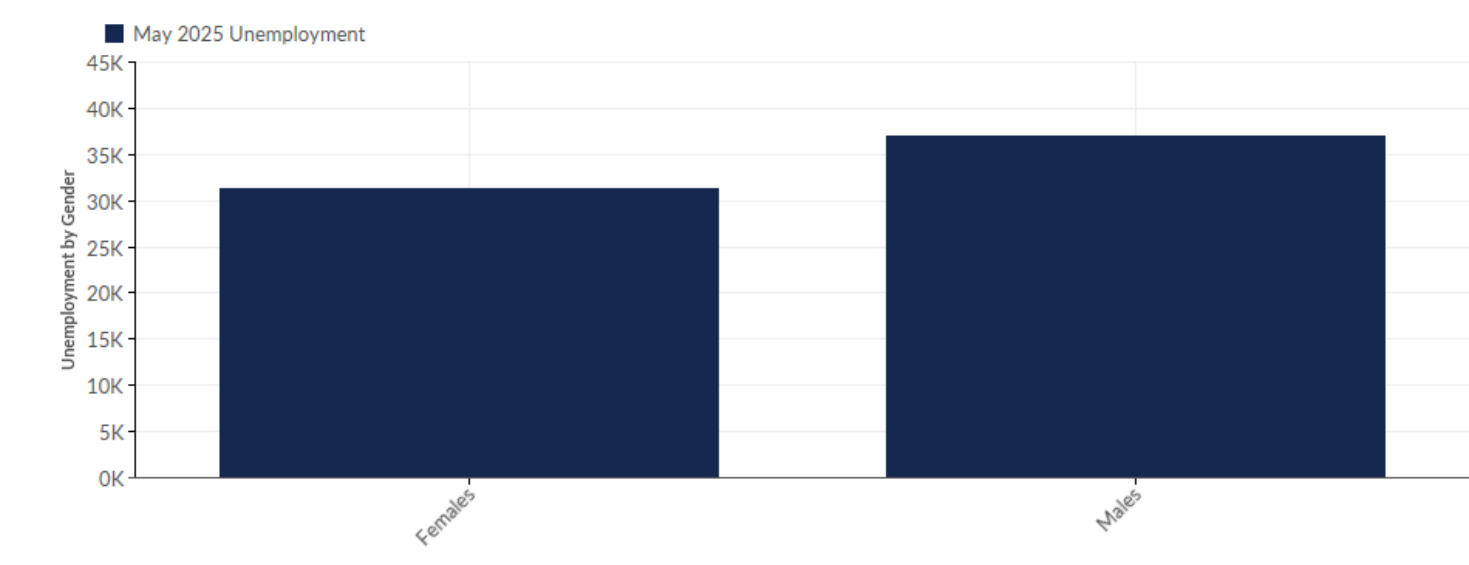

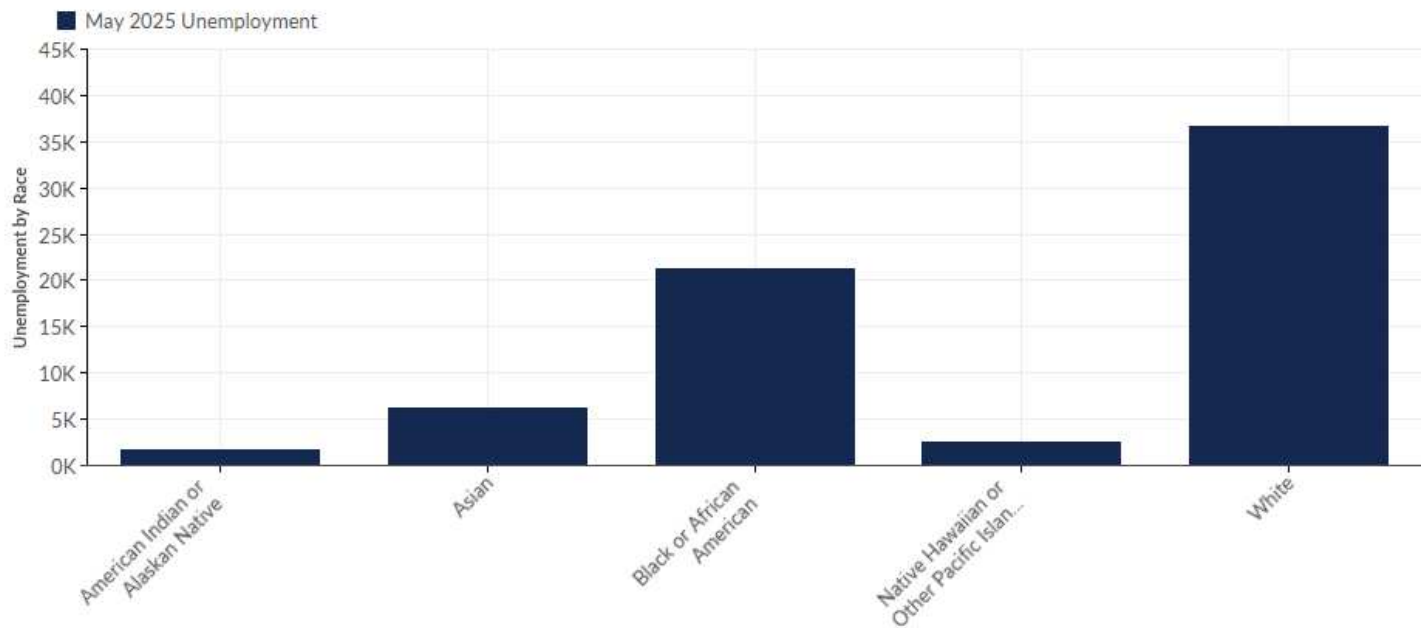

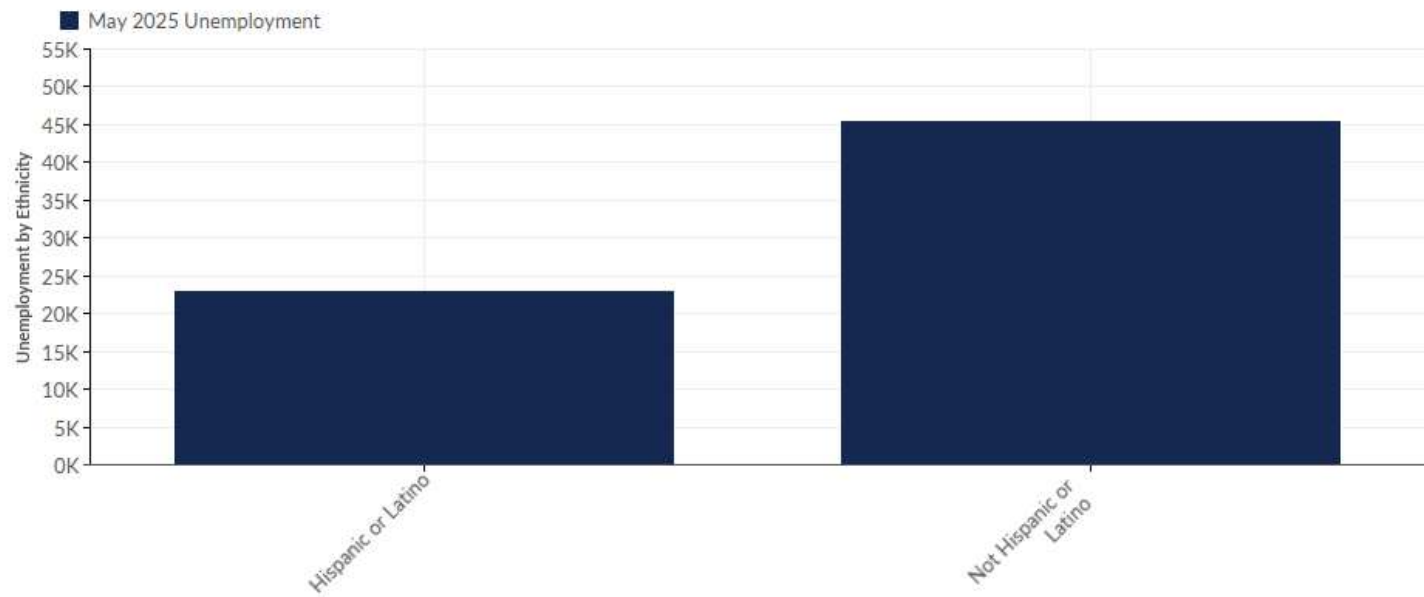

Unemployment by Ethnicity

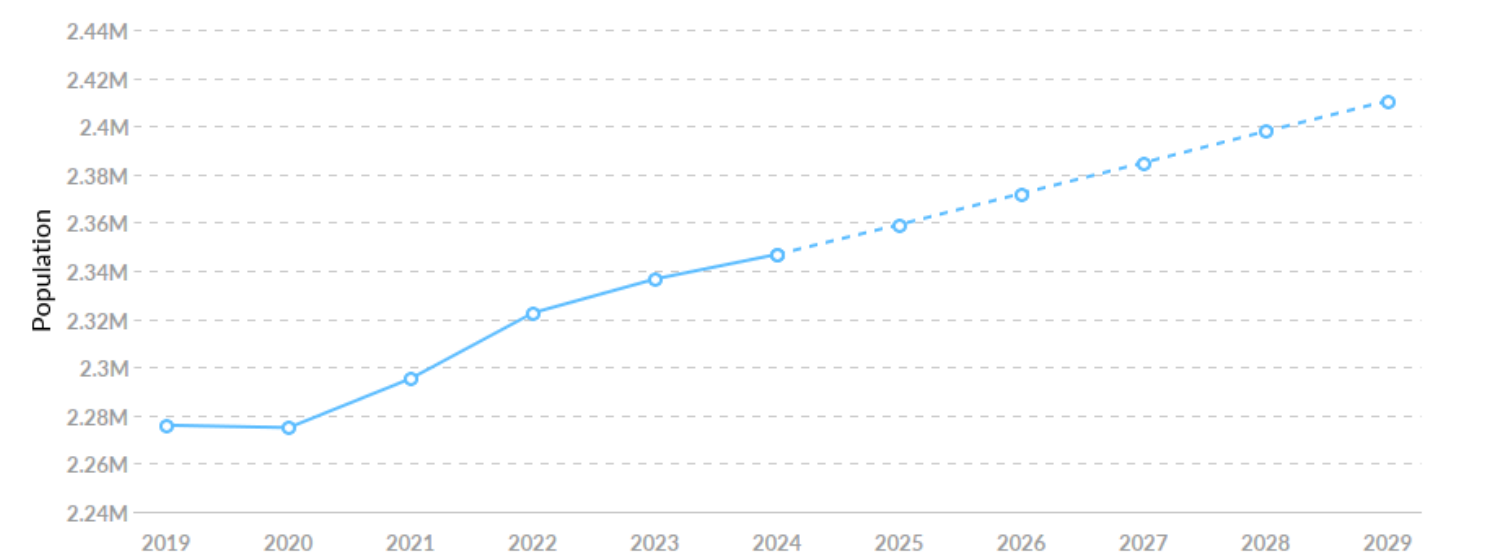

## Population Trends

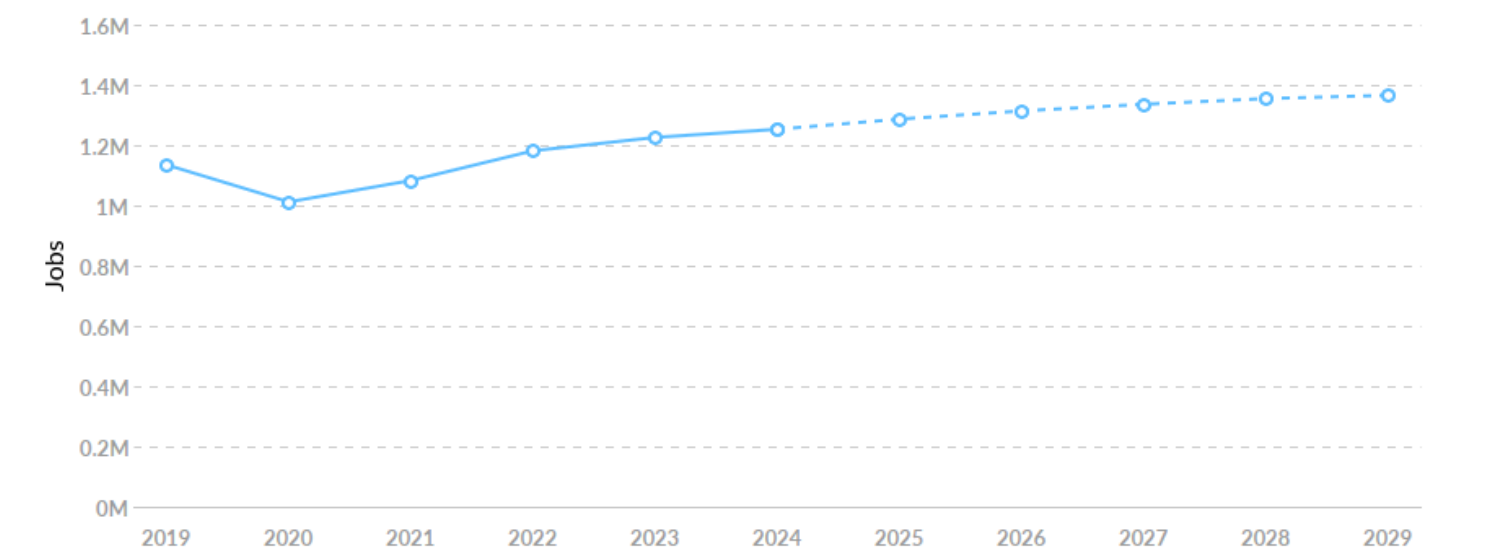

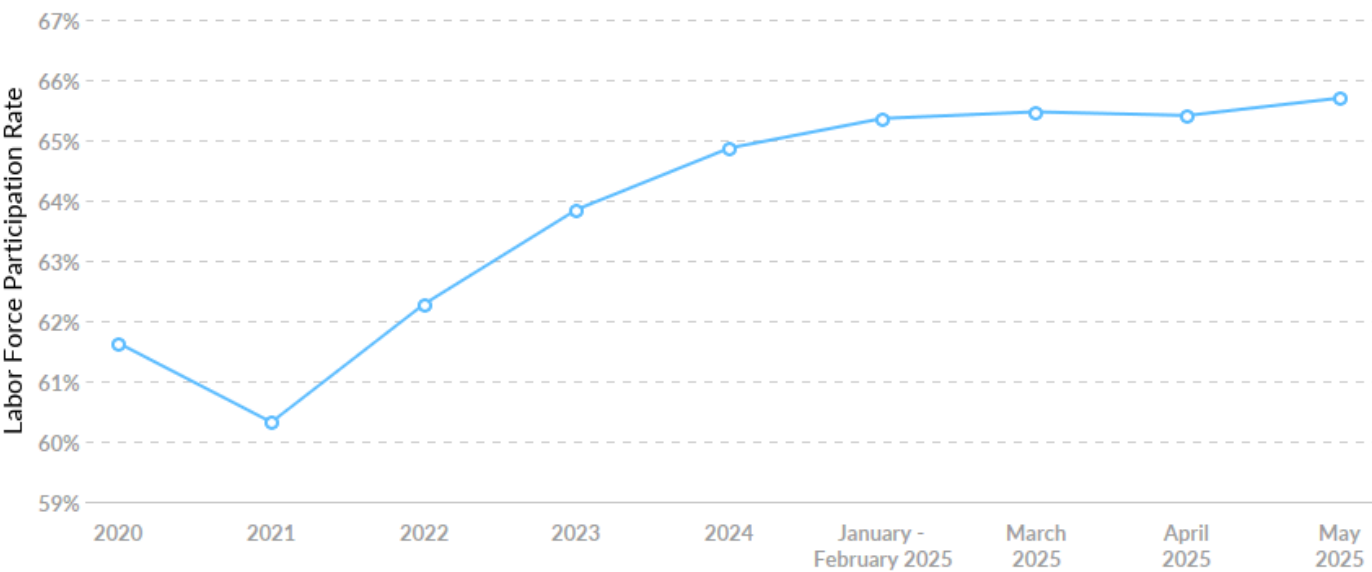
## Job Trends

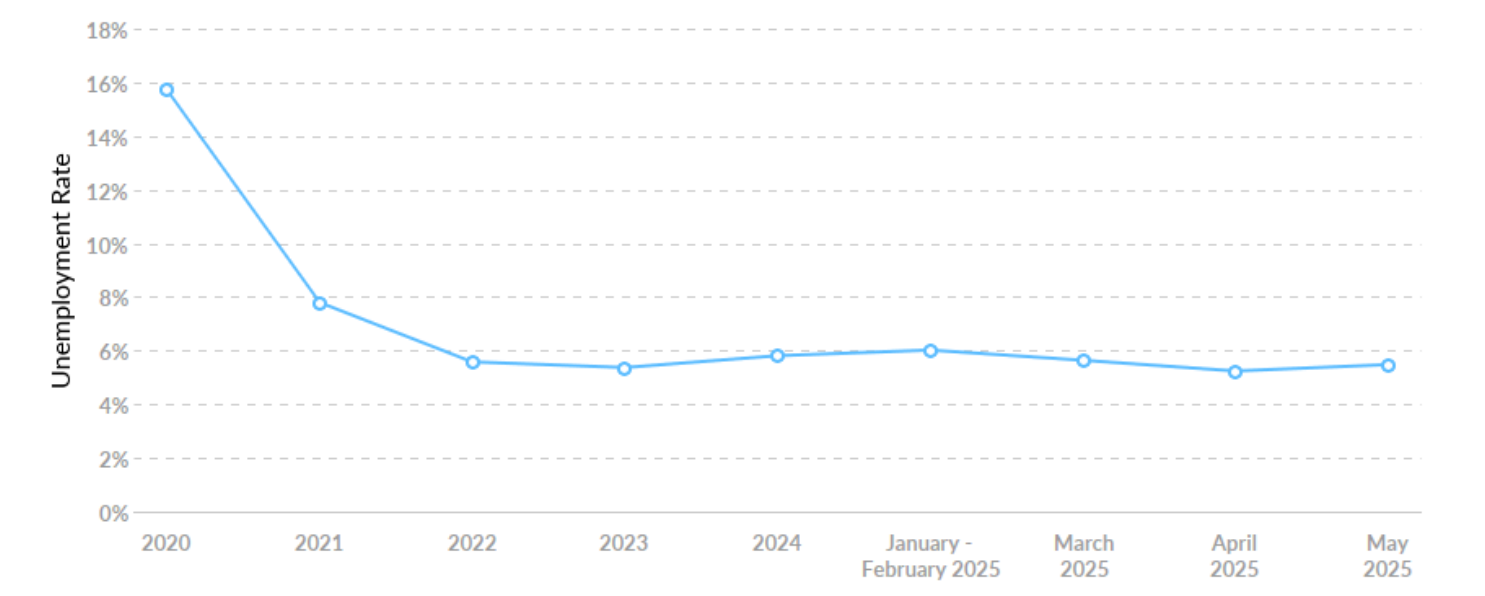

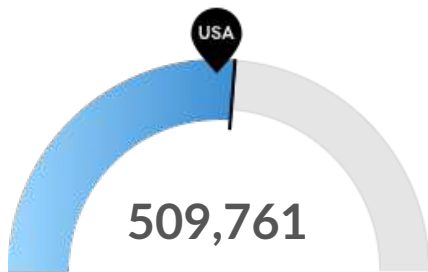
## Unemployment Rate Trends

Clark County, NV had a May 2025 unemployment rate of 5.48%, **decreasing from 15.72%** 5 years before.



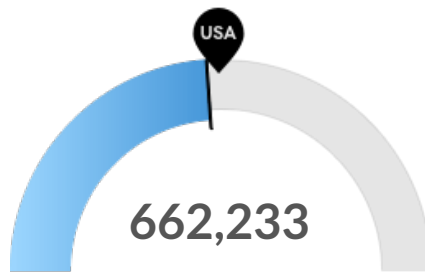

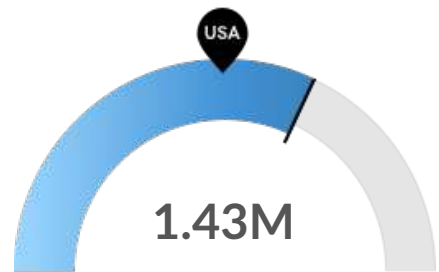
Millennials

Clark County, NV has 509,761 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 474,753.



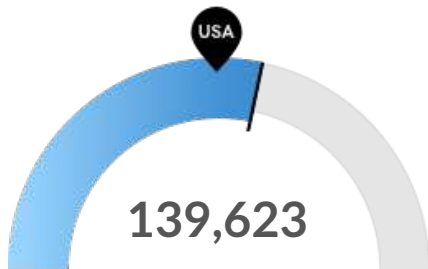
Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is about average in Clark County, NV. The national average for an area this size is 705,355 people 55 or older, while there are 662,233 here.



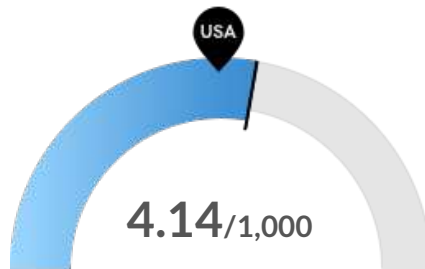
Racial Diversity

Racial diversity is high in Clark County, NV. The national average for an area this size is 973,115 racially diverse people, while there are 1,434,103 here.



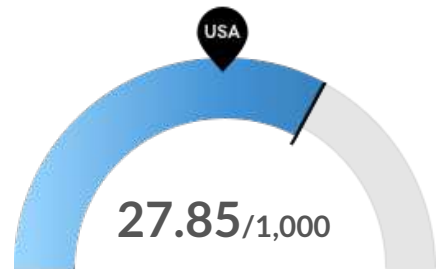
Veterans

Clark County, NV has 4.14 violent crimes per 1,000 people. The national rate is 3.54 per 1,000 people.

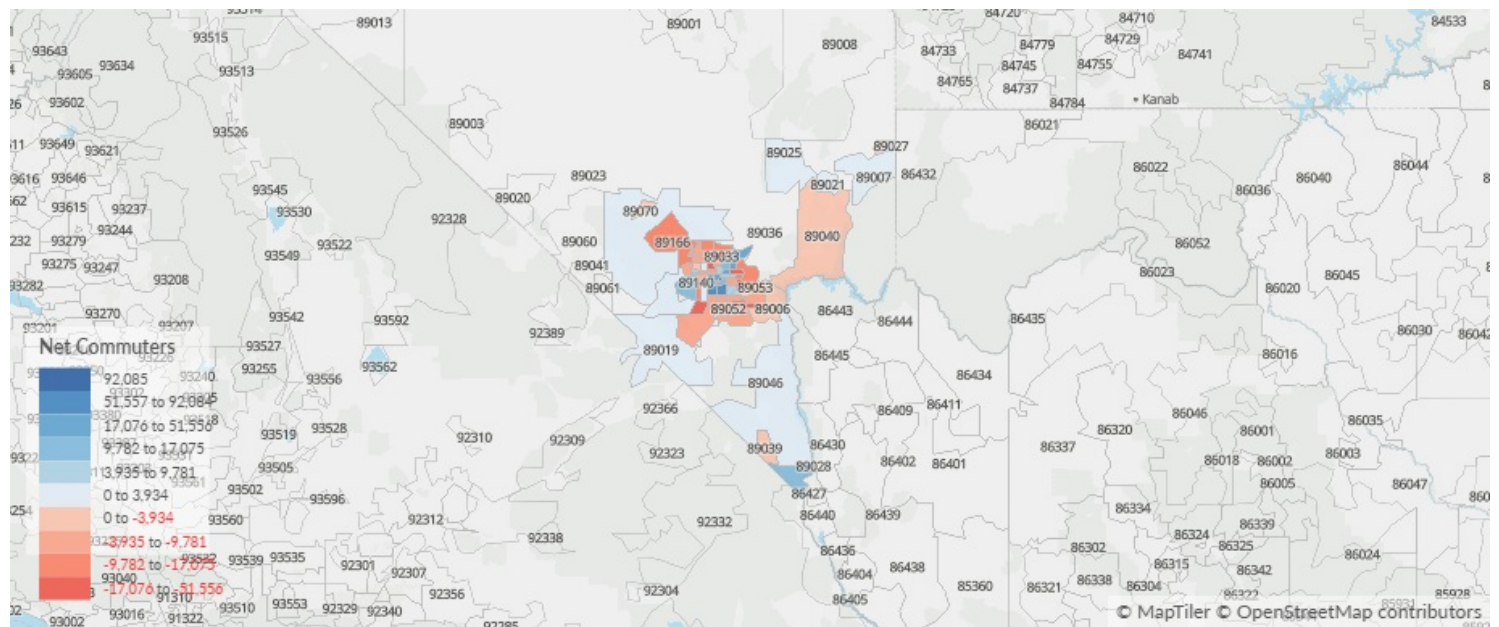


Property Crime

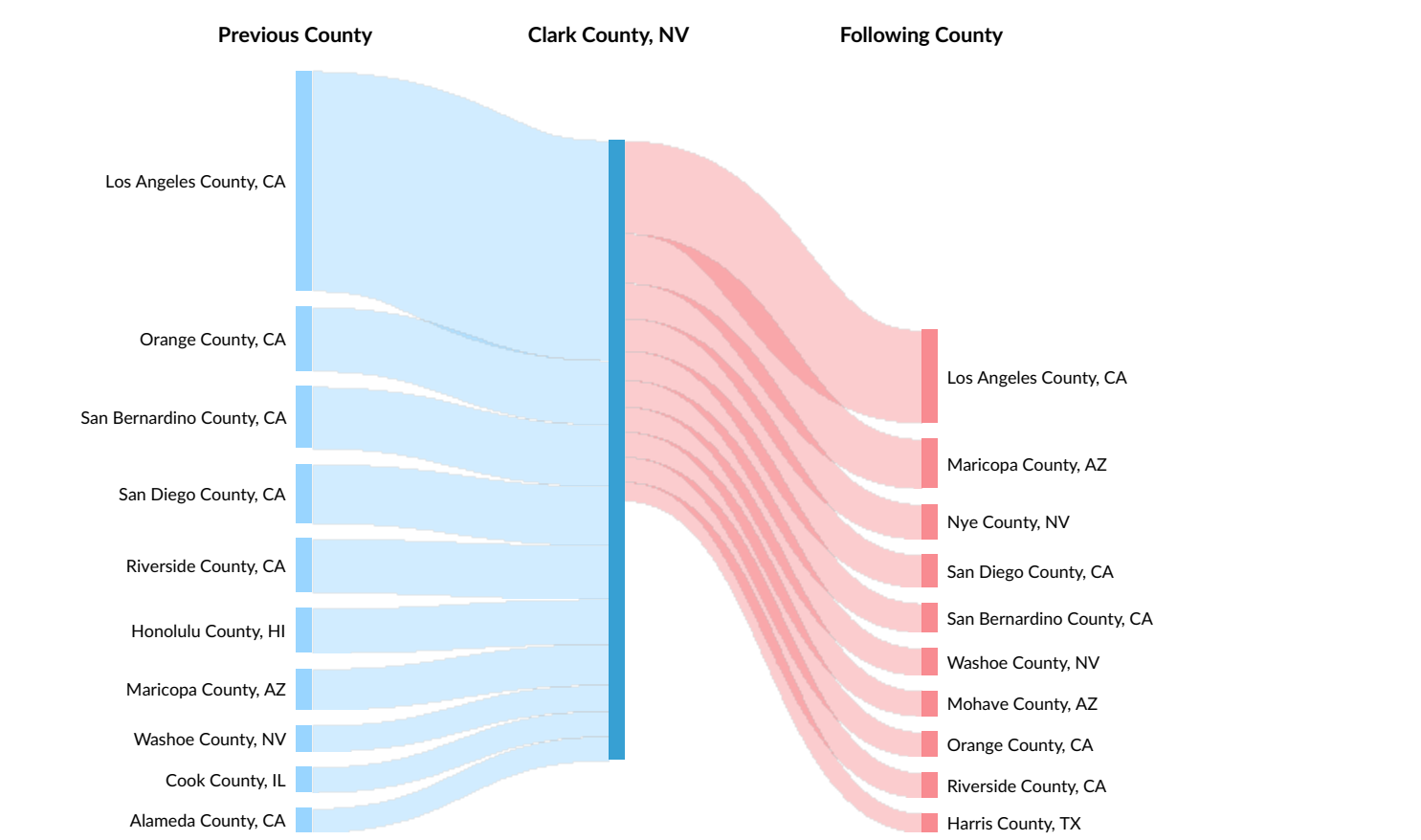

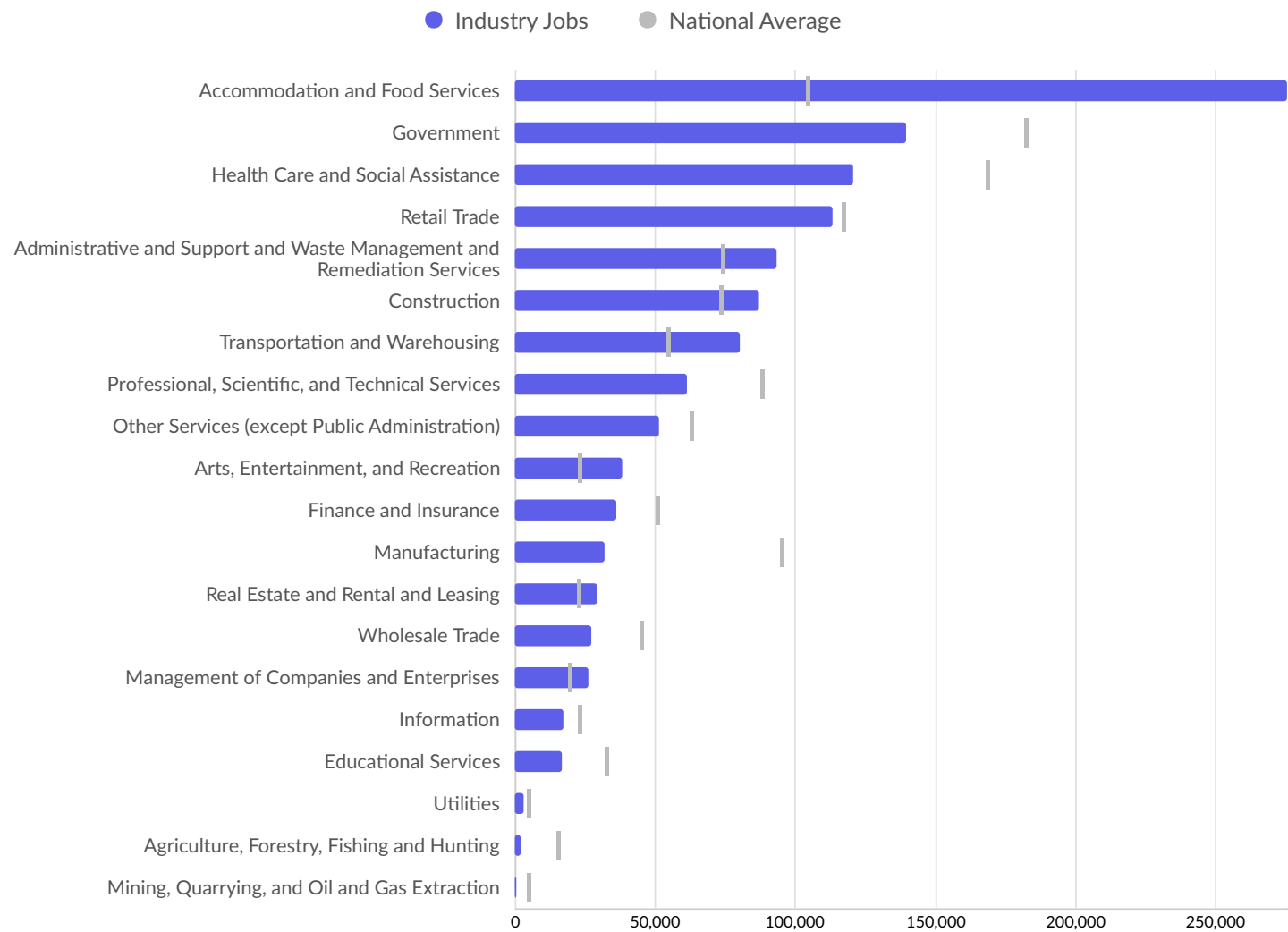

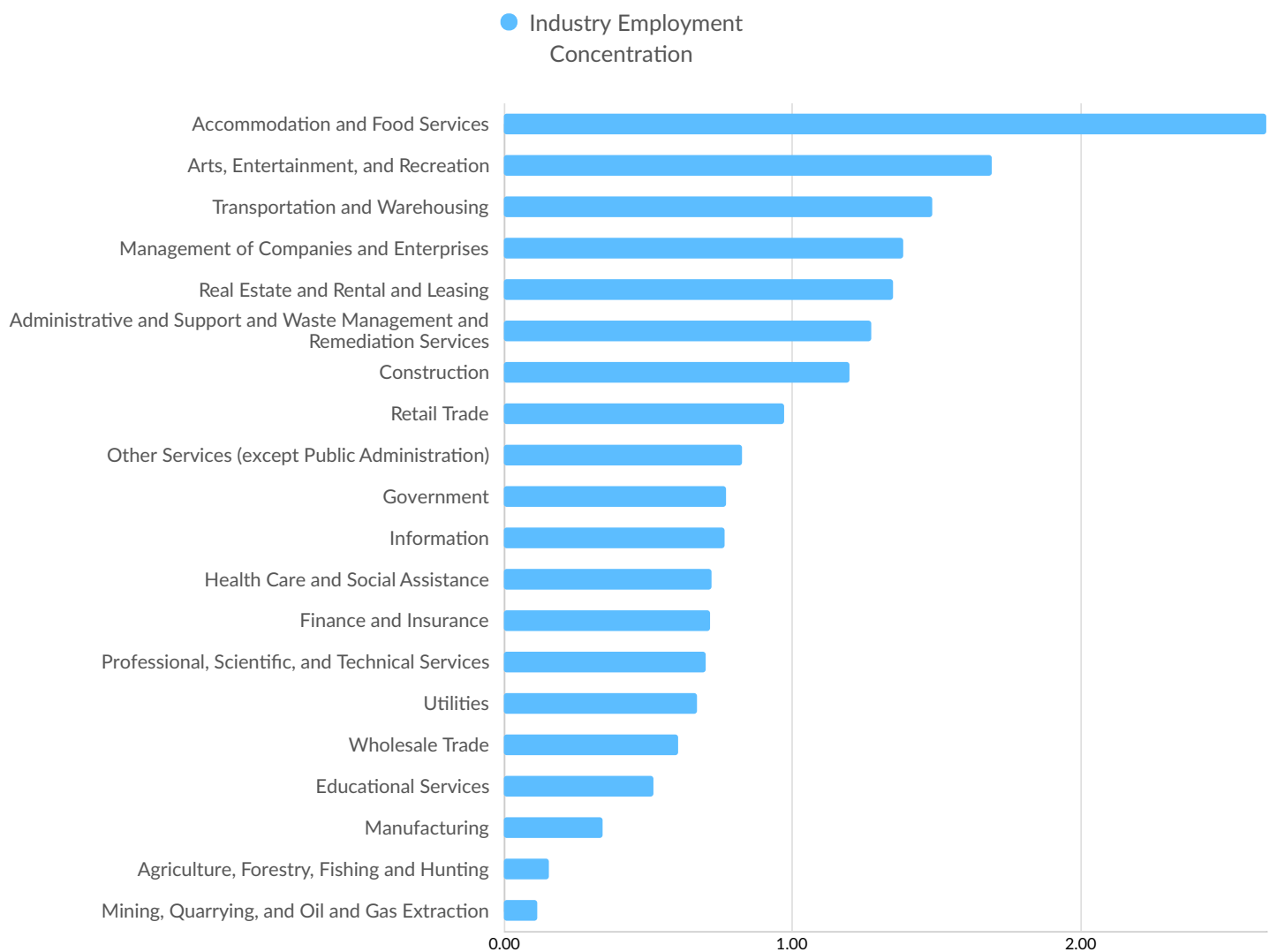

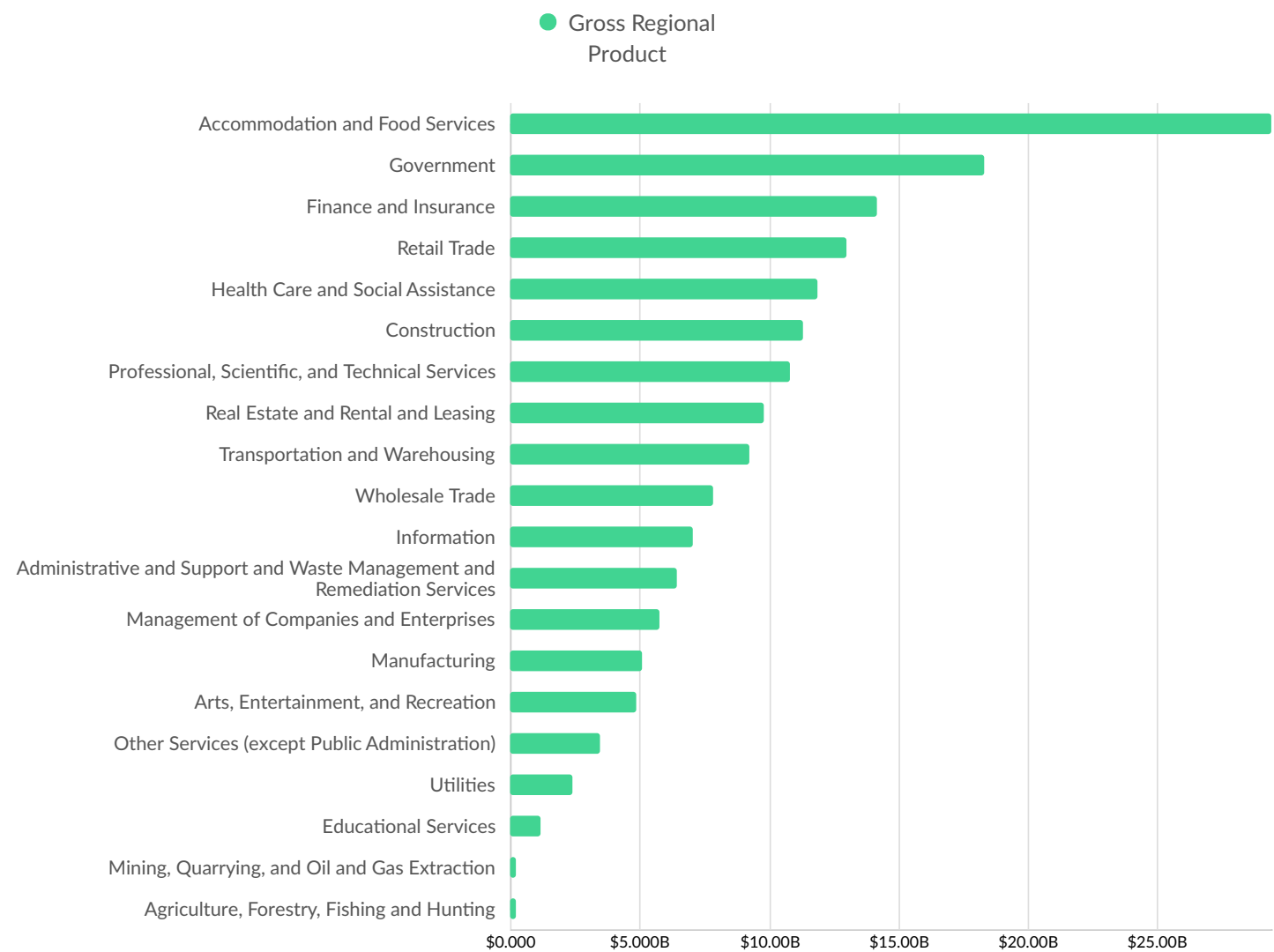

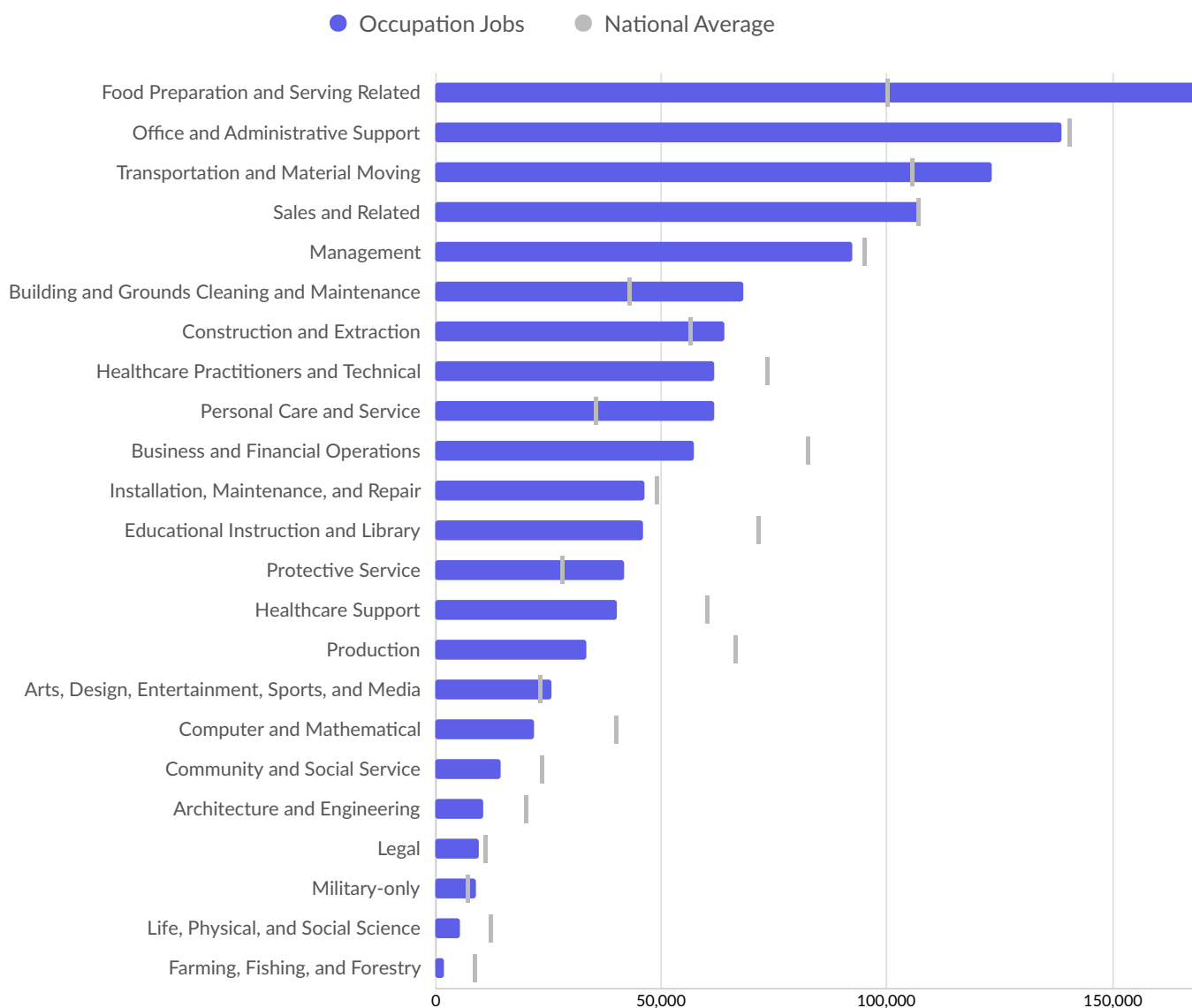

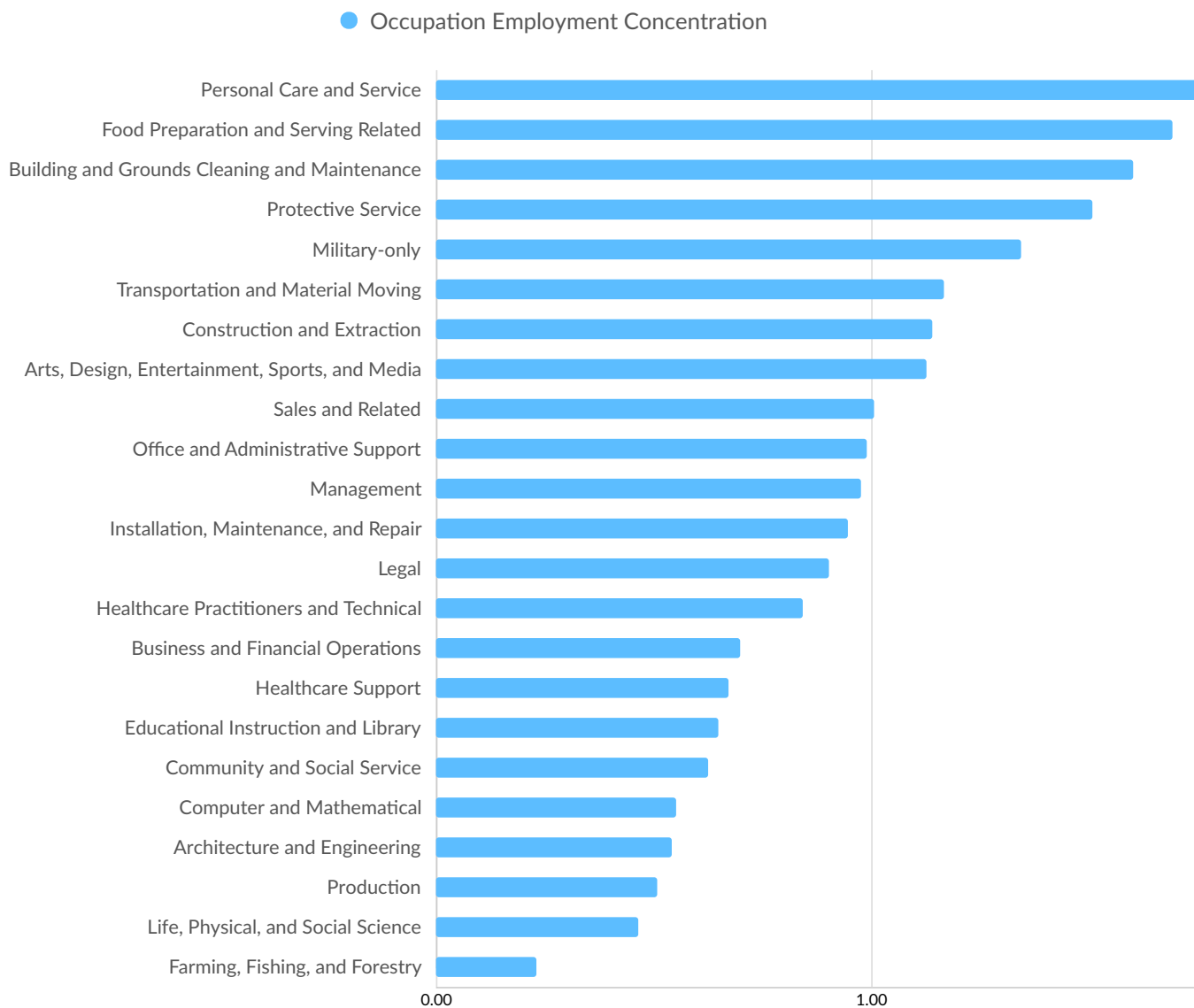
## Largest Occupations



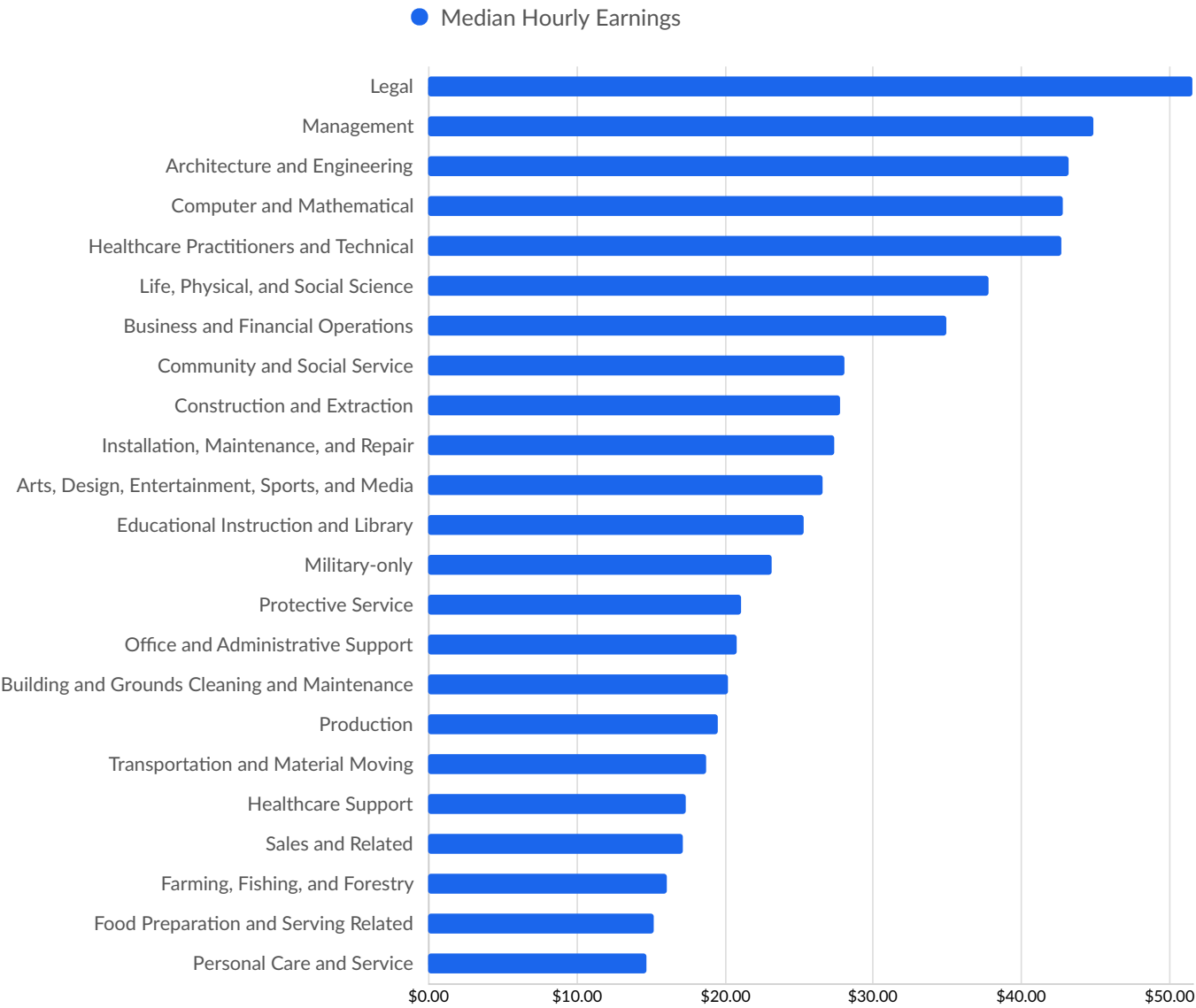
## Top Growing Occupations



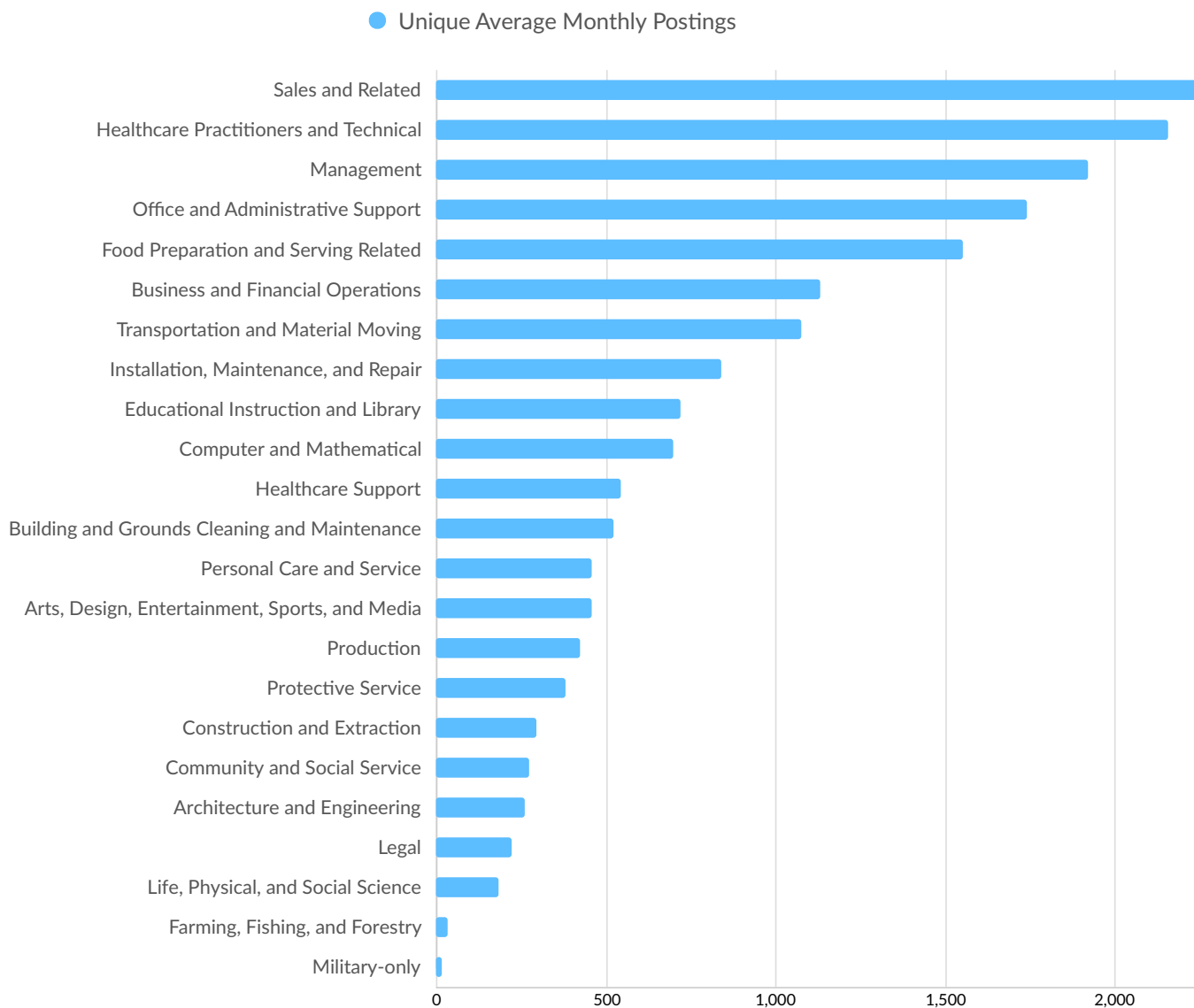
## Top Occupation Employment Concentration



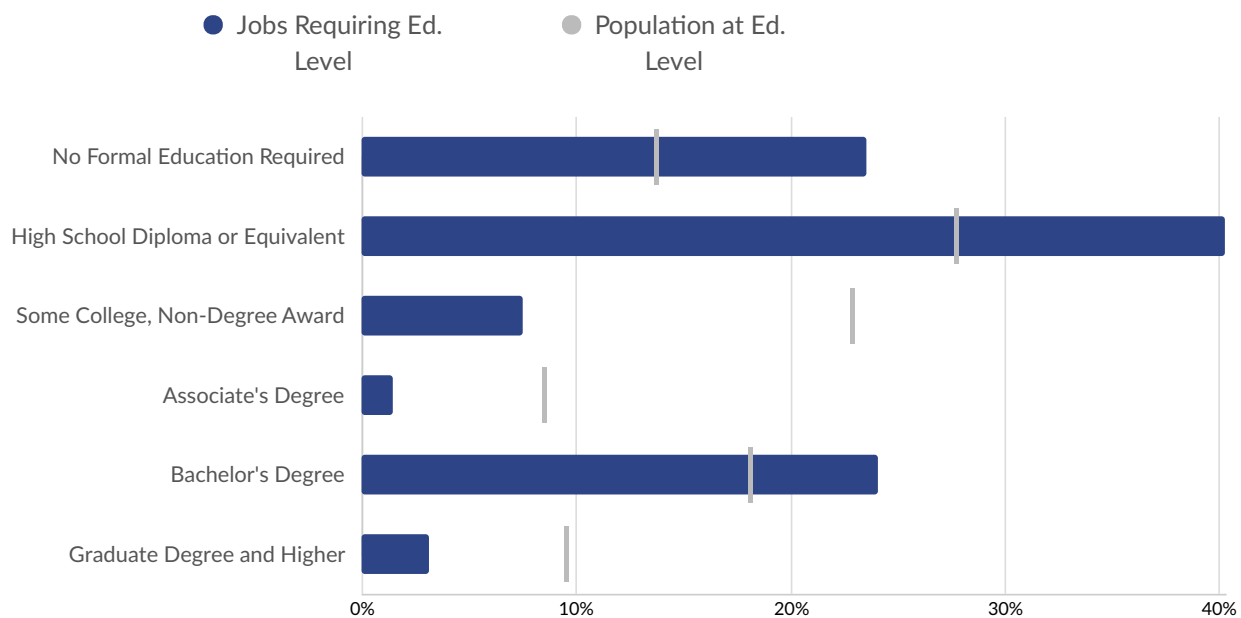

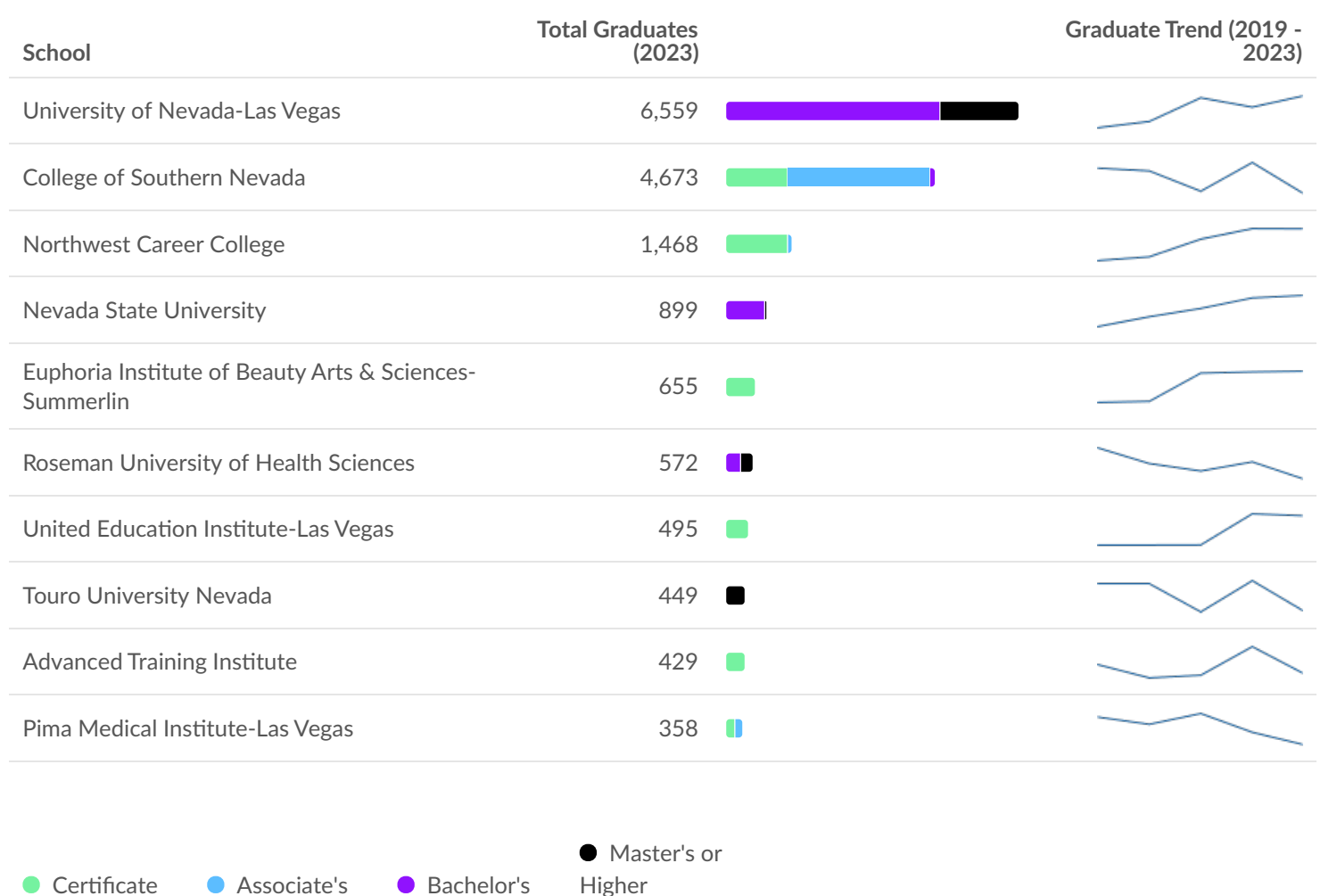
