
Takeaways

- From 2019 to 2024, jobs increased by 3.8% in Douglas County, NV from 22,660 to 23,517. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 4.3% by 0.5%. As the number of jobs increased, the labor force participation rate decreased from 54.7% to 53.4% between 2019 and 2024.
- Concerning educational attainment, 20.8% of Douglas County, NV residents possess a Bachelor's Degree (0.7% below the national average), and 10.6% hold an Associate's Degree (1.8% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2024 are Traveler Accommodation, Local Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals, and Restaurants and Other Eating Places.








Unemployment by Gender



Unemployment by Ethnicity







Job Trends



Labor Force Participation Rate Trends




Douglas County, NV had a May 2025 unemployment rate of 4.41%, decreasing from 9.29% 5 years before.






Veterans

Douglas County, NV has 4,807 veterans. The national average for an area this size is 2,451.




Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is high in Douglas County, NV. The national average for an area this size is 14,956 people 55 or older, while there are 25,009 here.




Violent Crime

Racial diversity is low in Douglas County, NV. The national average for an area this size is 20,634 racially diverse people, while there are 9,904 here.




Property Crime










Top Growing Industries






Top Industry Employment Concentration






Top Industry GRP







Top Occupation Employment Concentration









