- From 2019 to 2024, jobs declined by 0.6% in Elko County, NV from 24,237 to 24,093. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 4.3% by 4.9%. As the number of jobs declined, the labor force participation rate decreased from 71.7% to 64.9% between 2019 and 2024.
- Concerning educational attainment, **11.2% of Elko County, NV residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (10.3% below the national average), and **11.0% hold an Associate's Degree** (2.2% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2024 are Traveler Accommodation, Restaurants and Other Eating Places, and Education and Hospitals (Local Government).




May 2025 Labor Force Breakdown







Unemployment by Gender





Unemployment by Ethnicity







Job Trends






Elko County, NV had a May 2025 unemployment rate of 3.87%, decreasing from 5.98% 5 years before.




Millennials

Elko County, NV has 11,985 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 11,031.




Veterans

Elko County, NV has 2,726 veterans. The national average for an area this size is 2,686.




Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is low in Elko County, NV. The national average for an area this size is 16,390 people 55 or older, while there are 13,809 here.




Violent Crime

Property Crime










Top Growing Industries






Top Industry Employment Concentration






Top Industry GRP






Top Growing Occupations





Top Occupation Employment Concentration












Unique Average Monthly Postings




