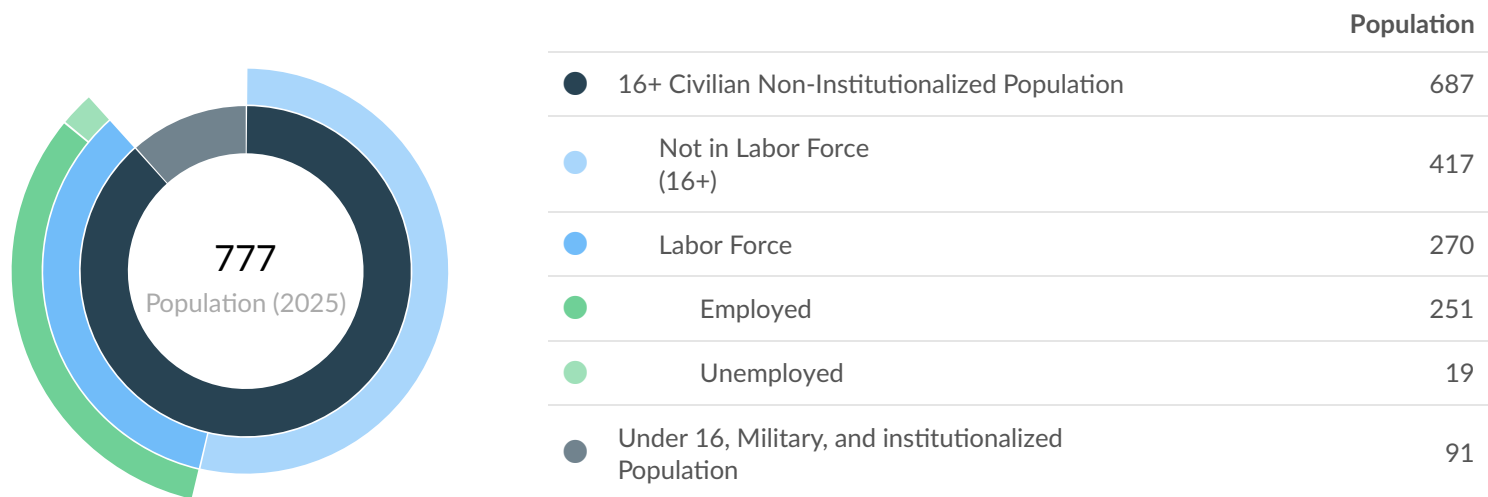

## Takeaways

- As of 2024 the region's population **declined by 12.9%** since 2019, falling by 112. Population is expected to **increase by 10.4%** between 2024 and 2029, adding 79.
- From 2019 to 2024, jobs **increased by 14.7%** in Esmeralda County, NV from 339 to **389**. This change **outpaced the national growth rate of 4.3% by 10.4%**. As the number of jobs increased, the **labor force participation rate increased from 37.7% to 43.2% between 2019 and 2024**.
- Concerning educational attainment, **15.0% of Esmeralda County, NV residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (6.5% below the national average), and **6.0% hold an Associate's Degree** (2.9% below the national average).
- The top three industries in 2024 are Nonmetallic Mineral Mining and Quarrying, Local Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals, and Support Activities for Mining.

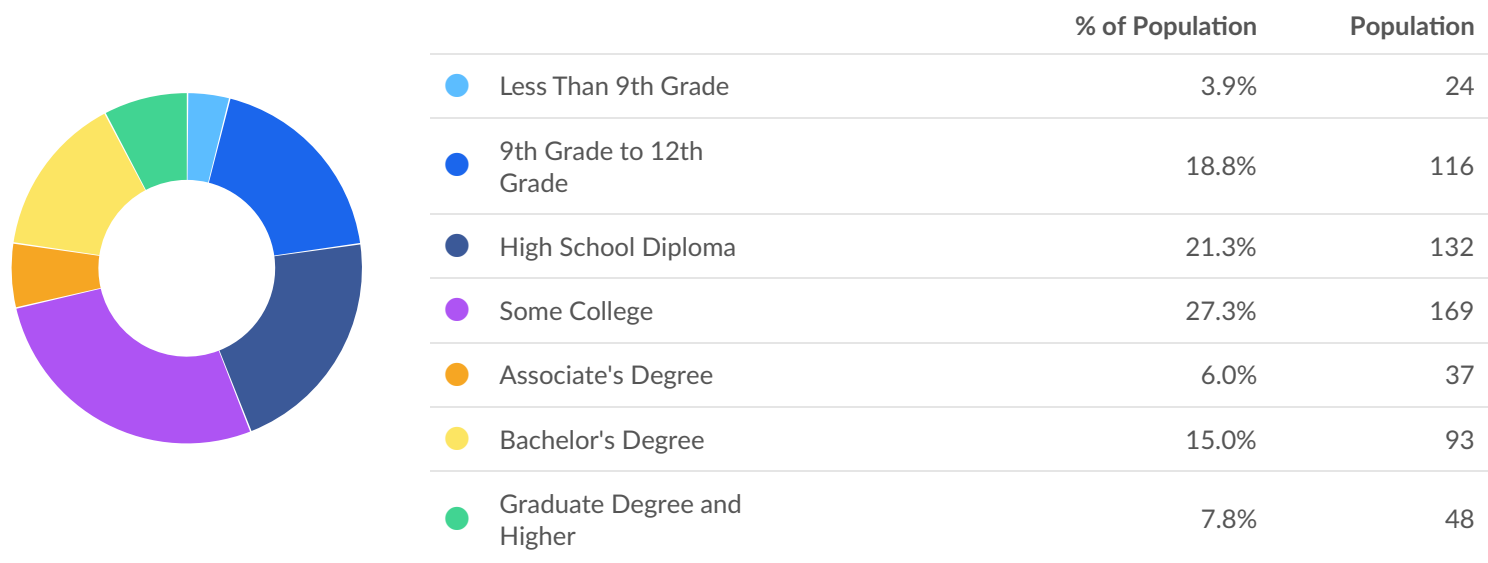

## May 2025 Labor Force Breakdown



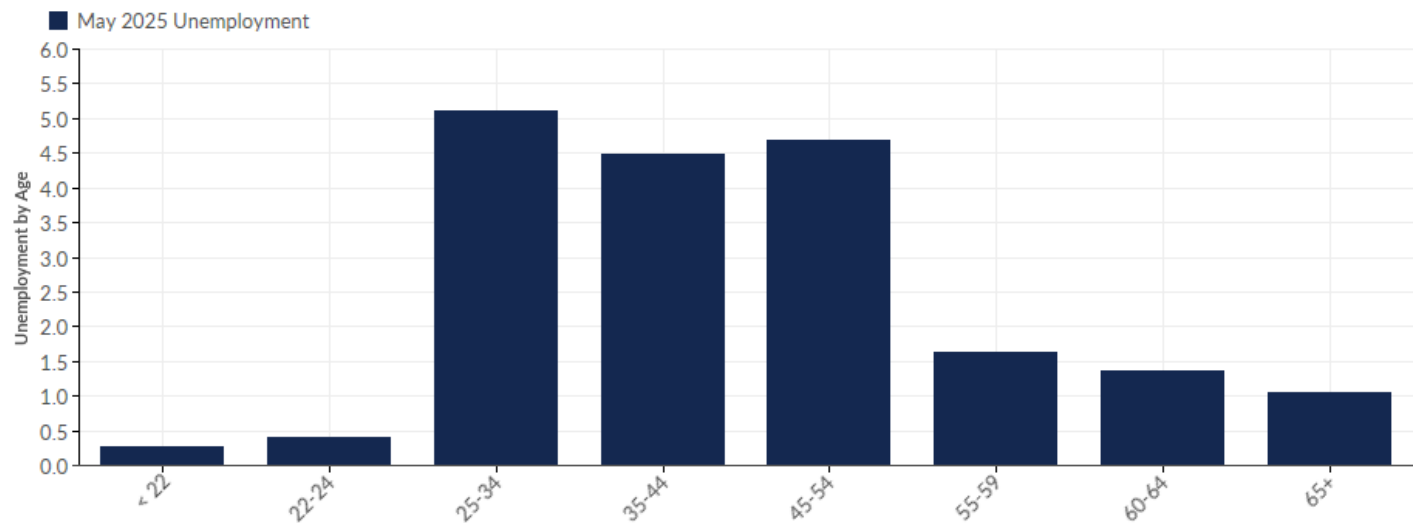
## Educational Attainment

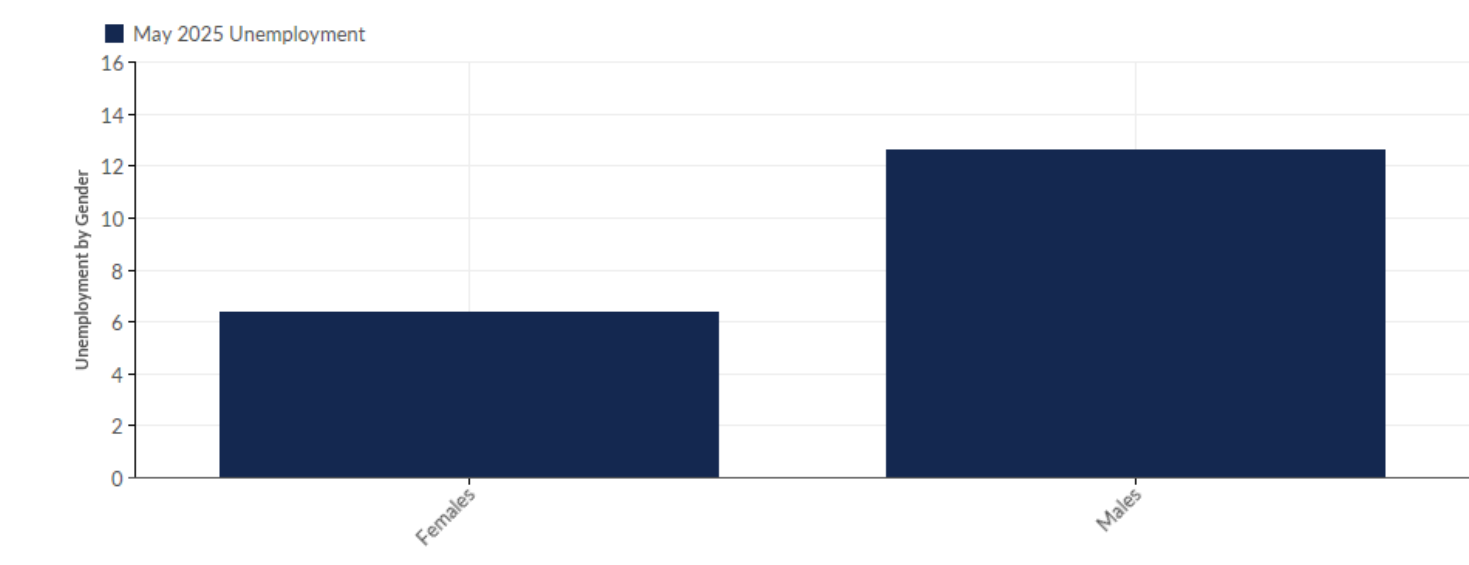

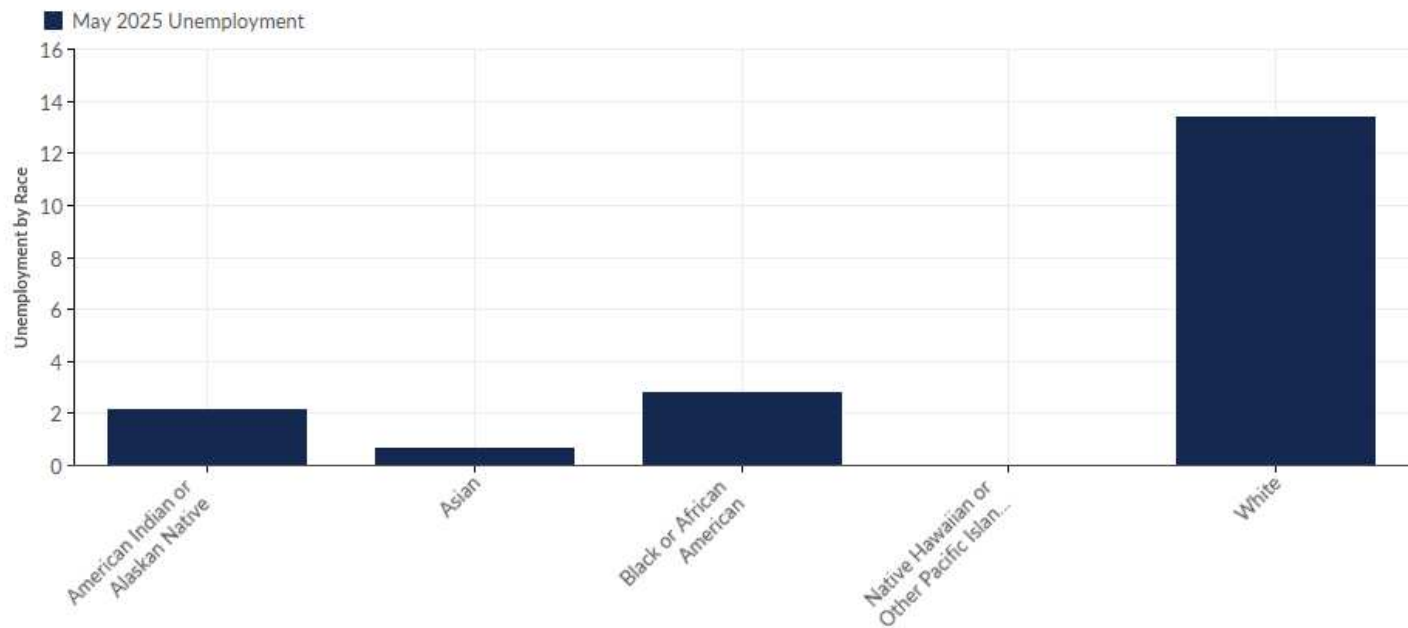

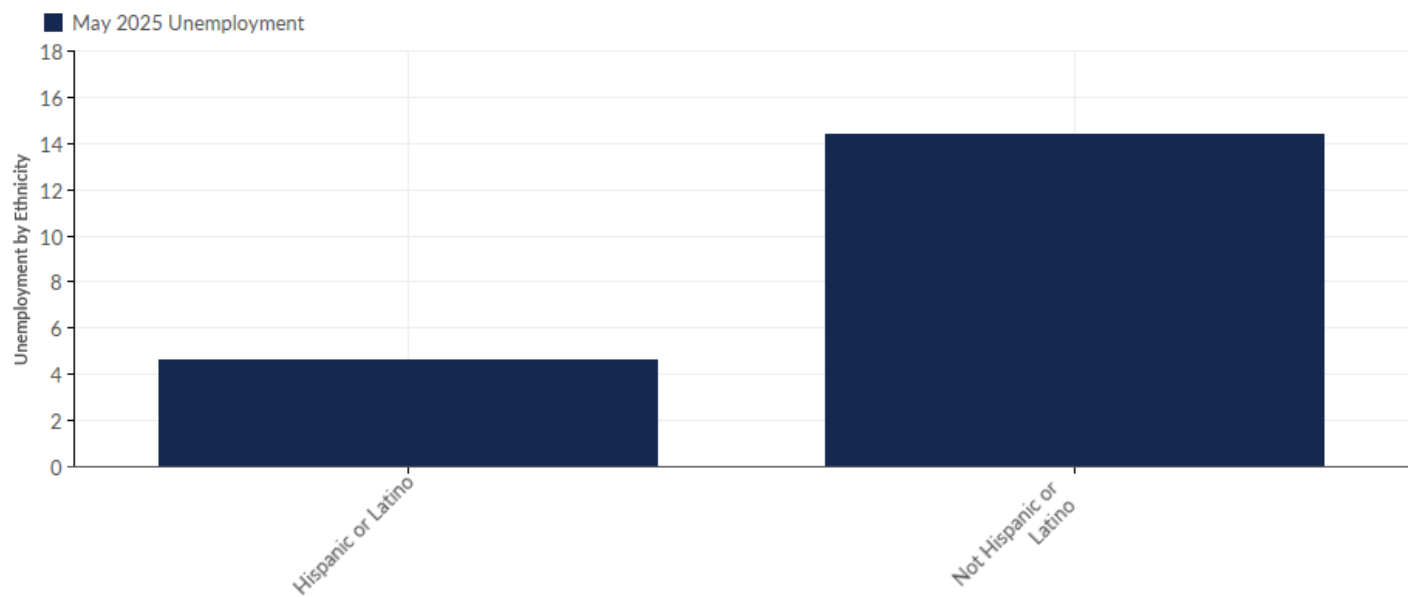

## Unemployment by Ethnicity

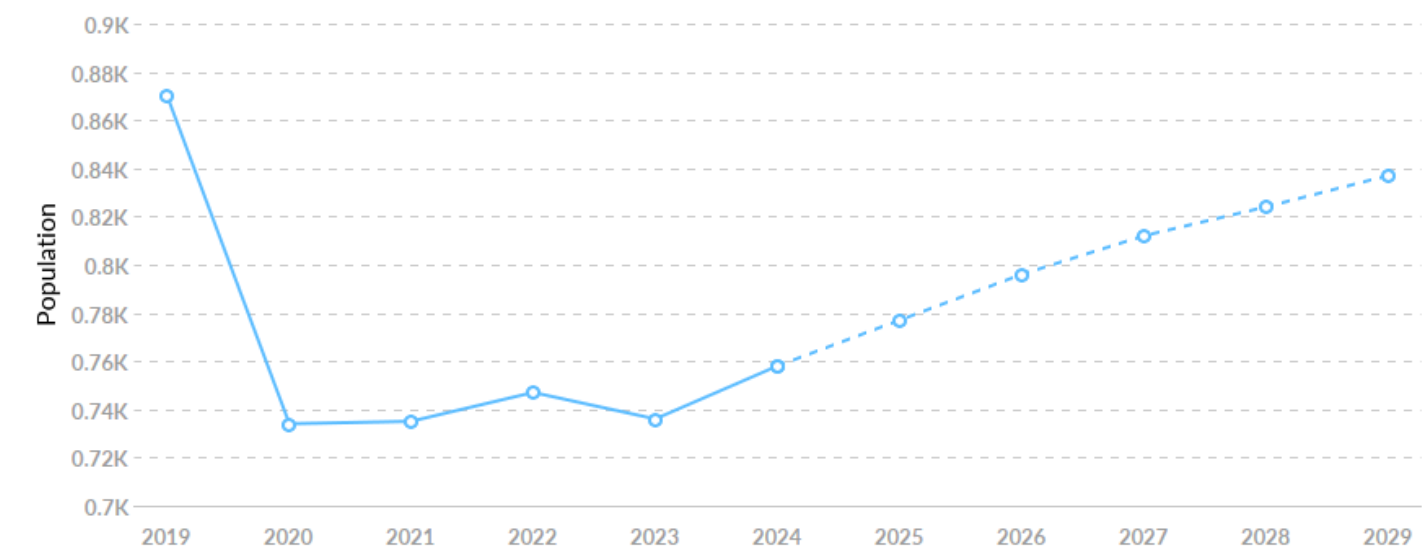

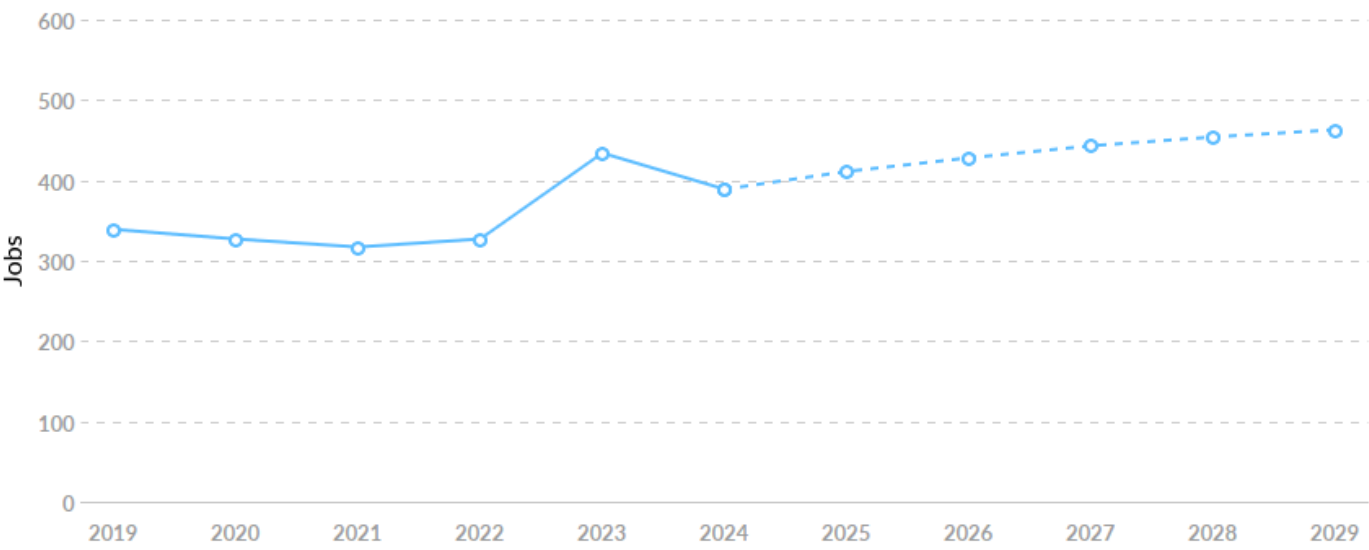

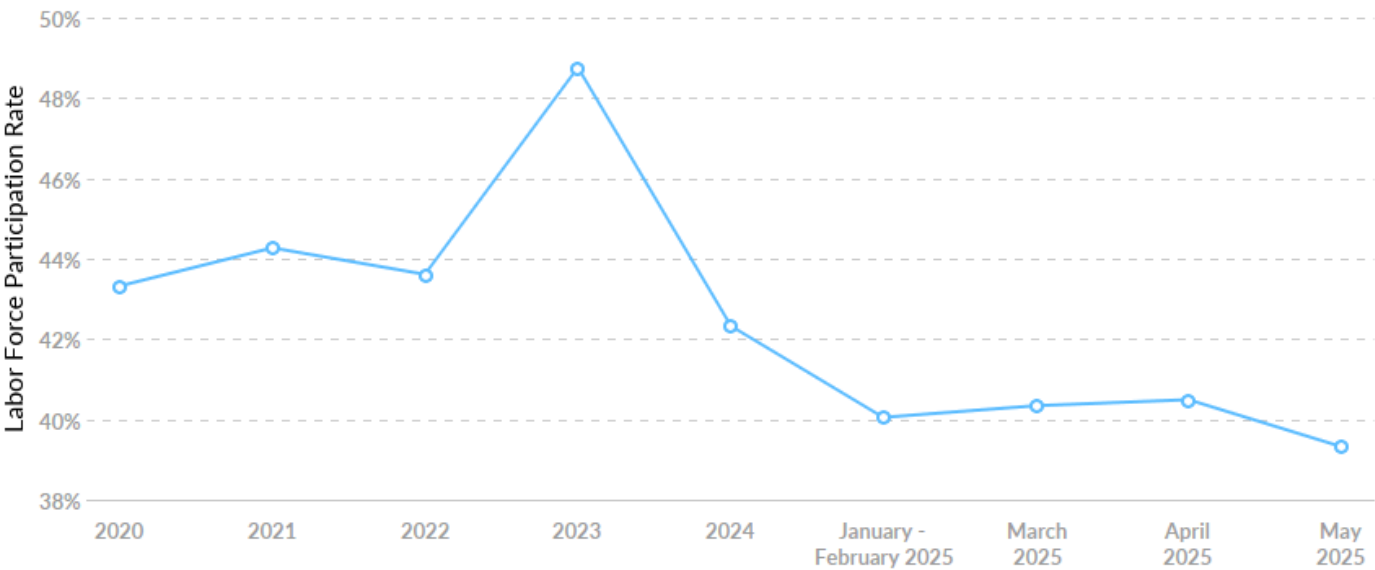
Job Trends

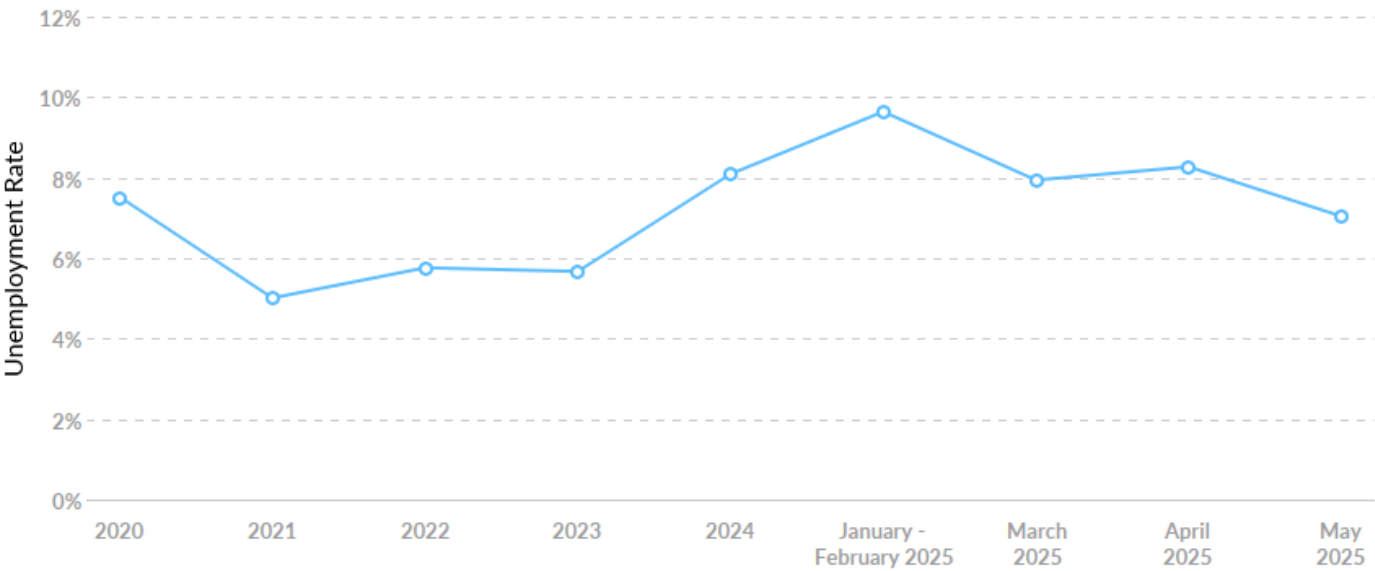

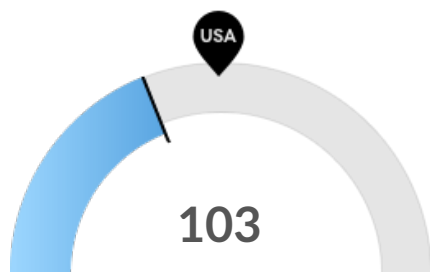
## Unemployment Rate Trends

Esmeralda County, NV had a May 2025 unemployment rate of 7.04%, **decreasing from 7.52% 5 years before.**



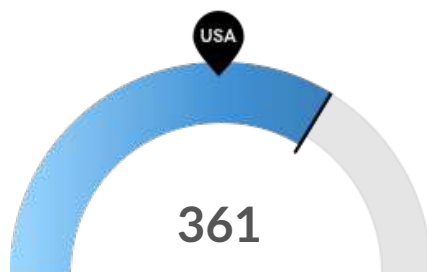

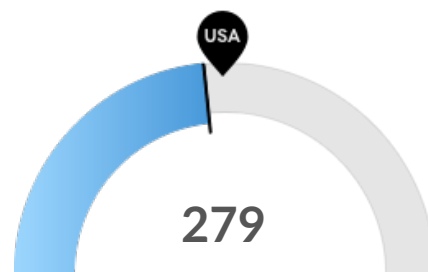
**Millennials**

Esmeralda County, NV has 103 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 150.



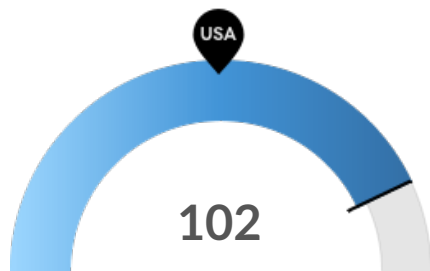
**Retiring Soon**

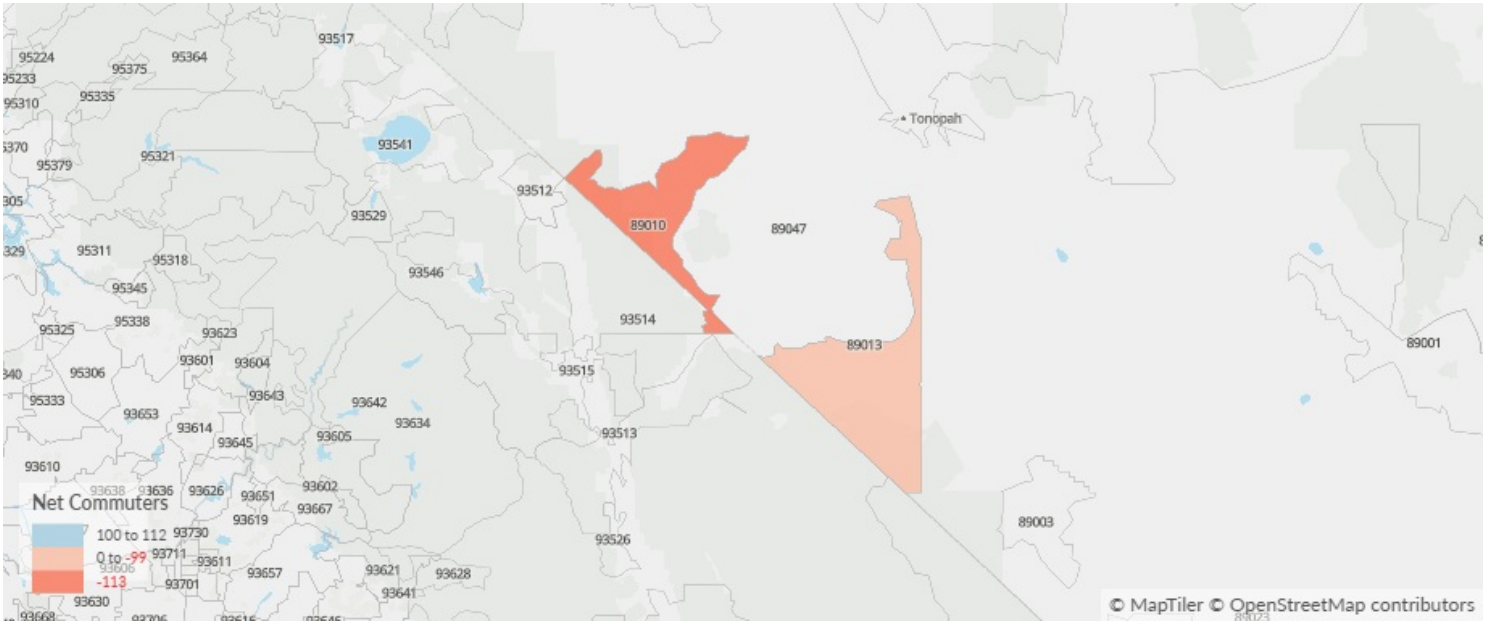

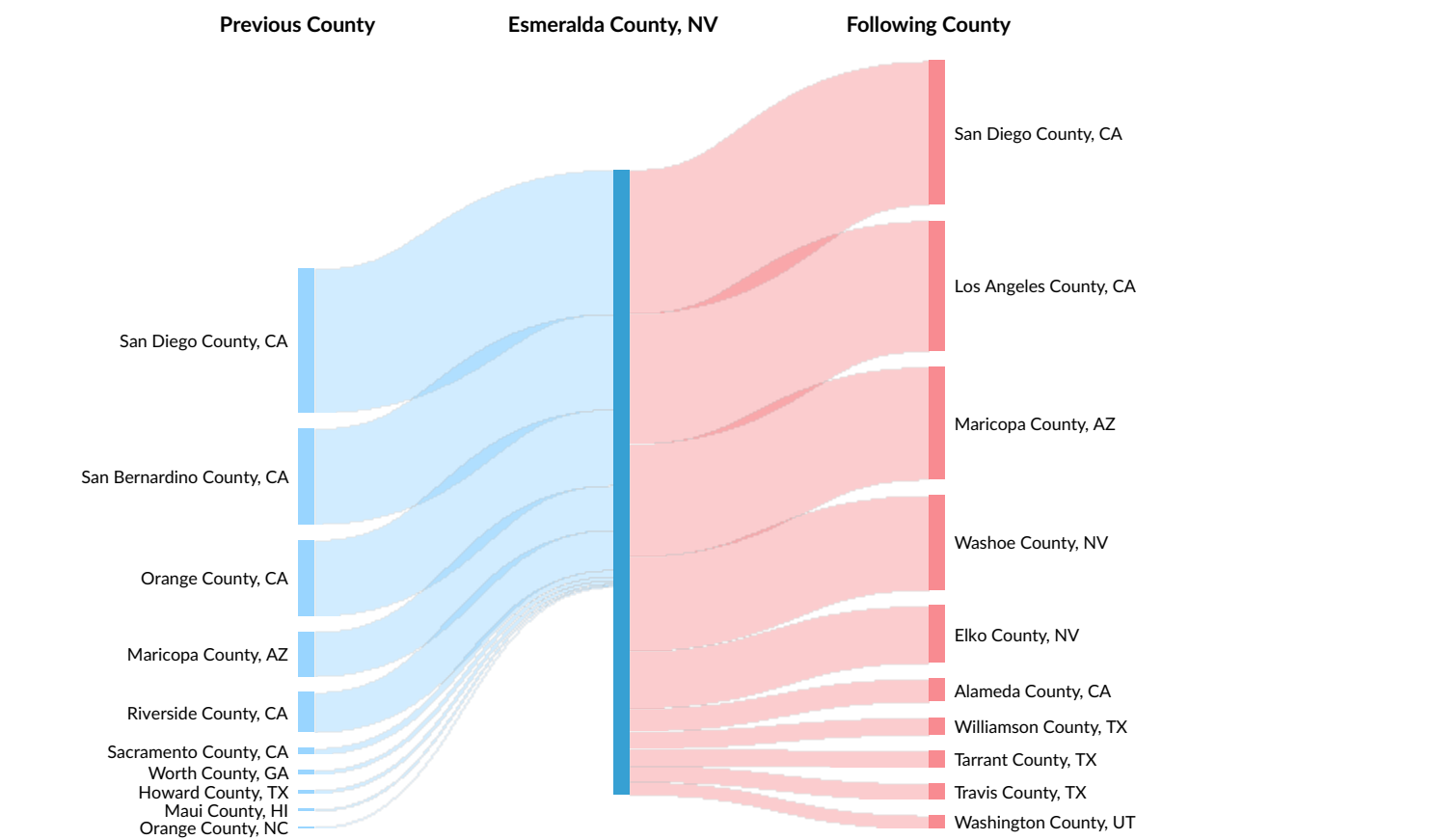

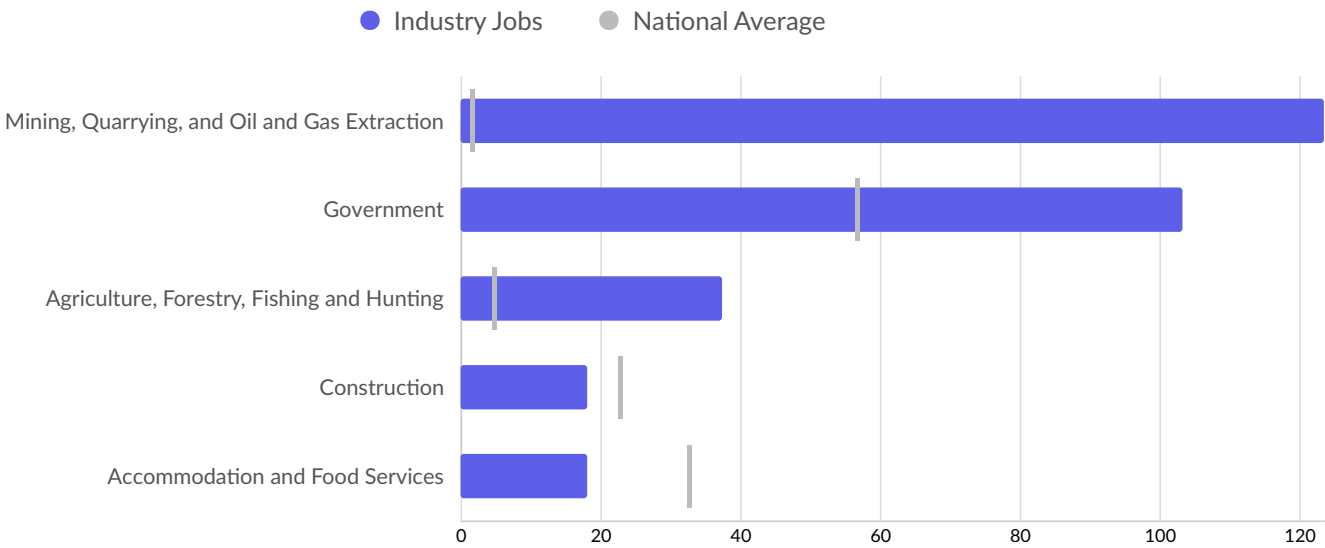

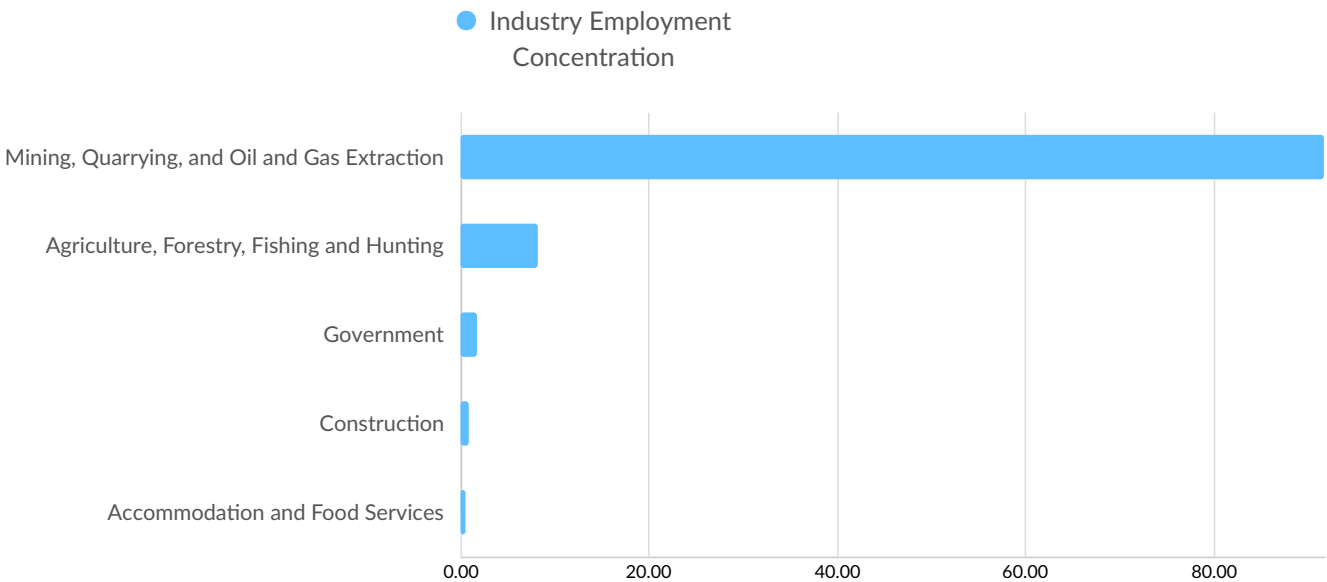

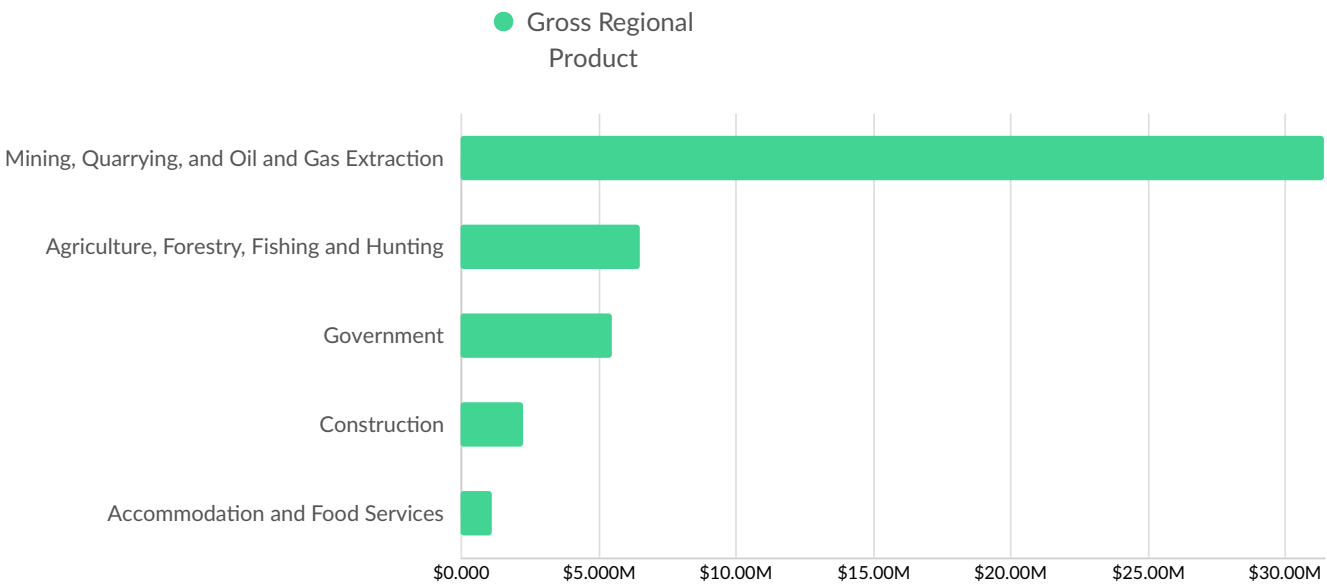

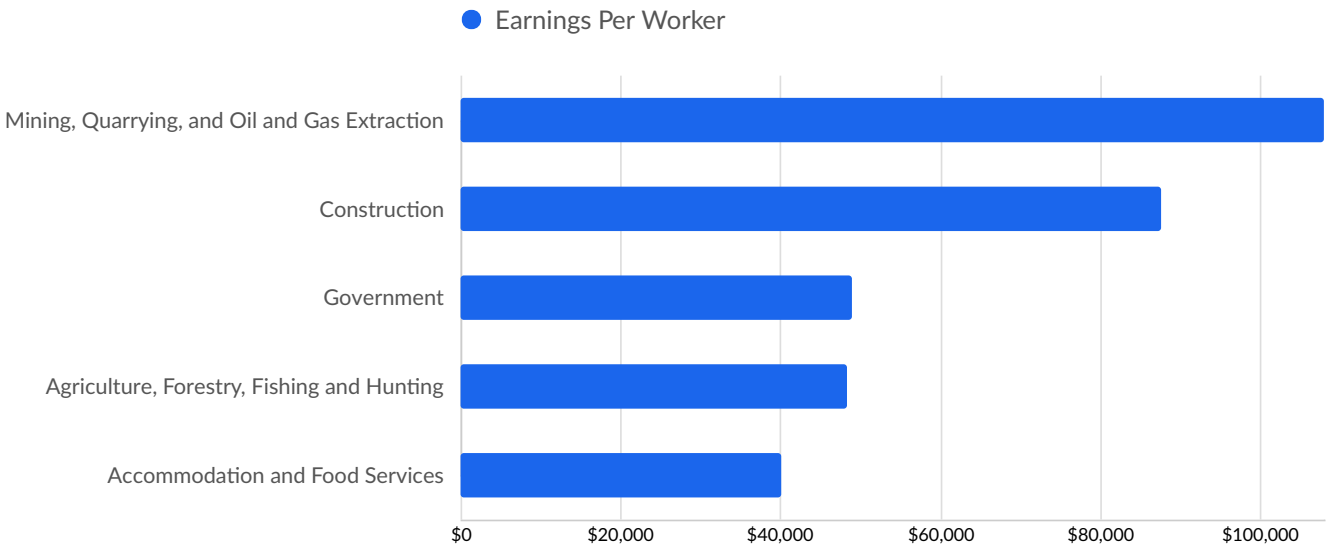
## Top Industry Employment Concentration

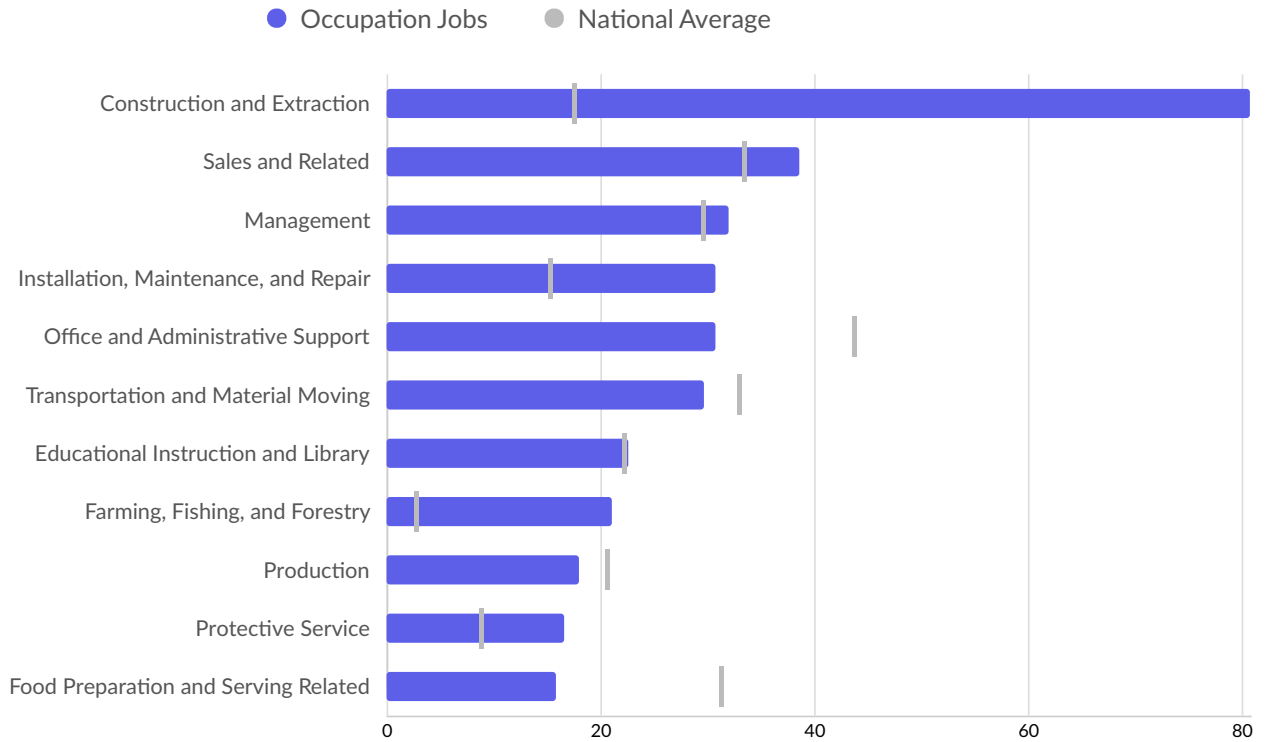

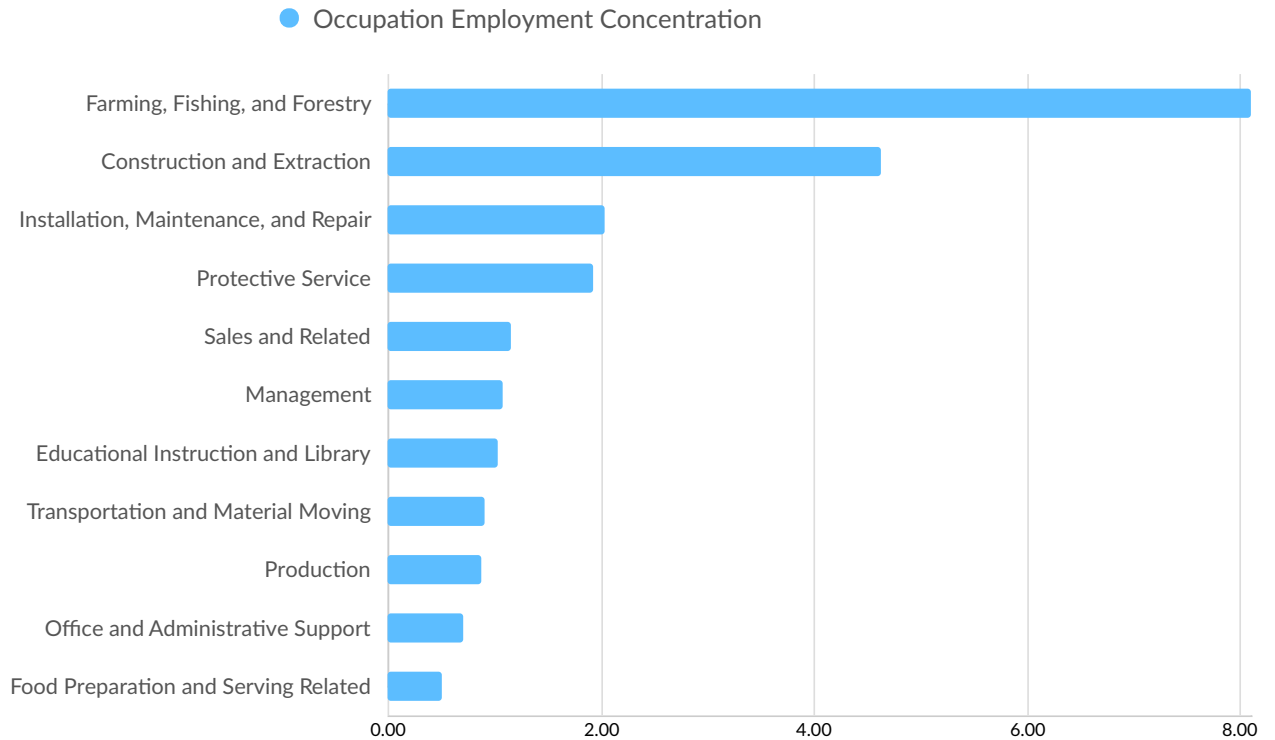
## Largest Occupations



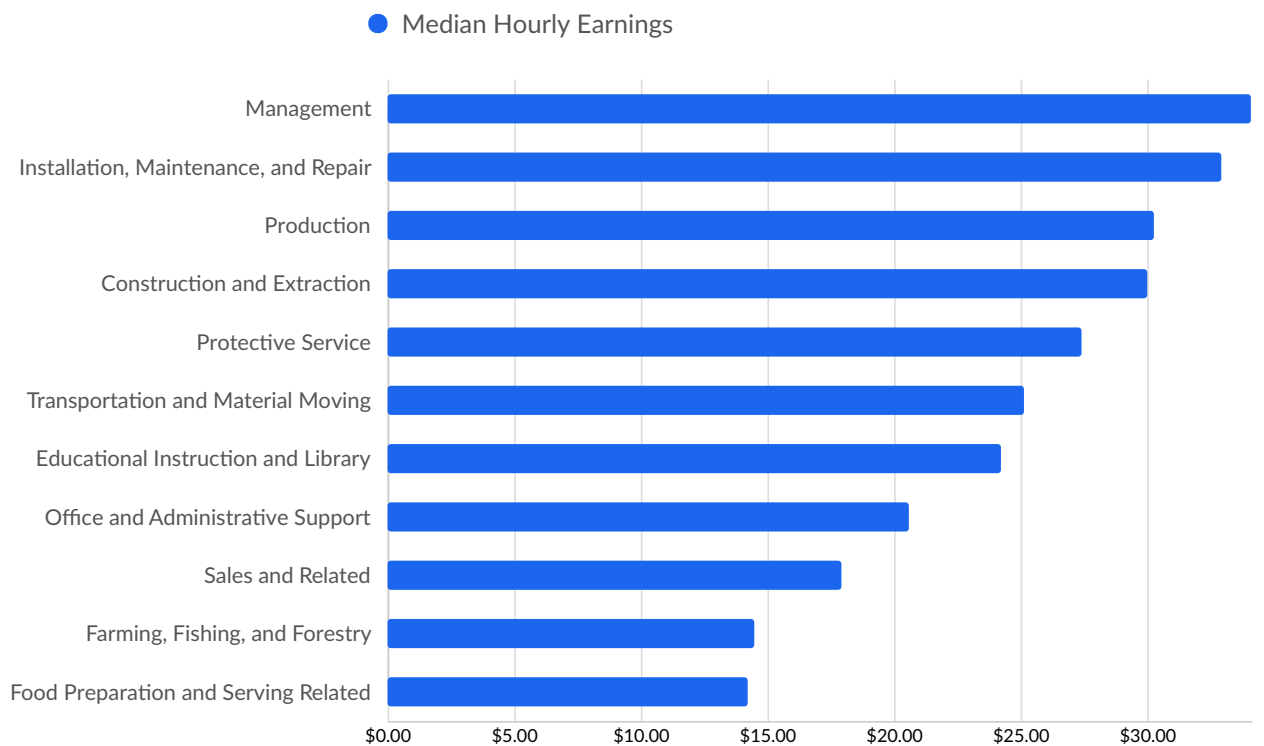
## Top Growing Occupations



## Top Occupation Employment Concentration



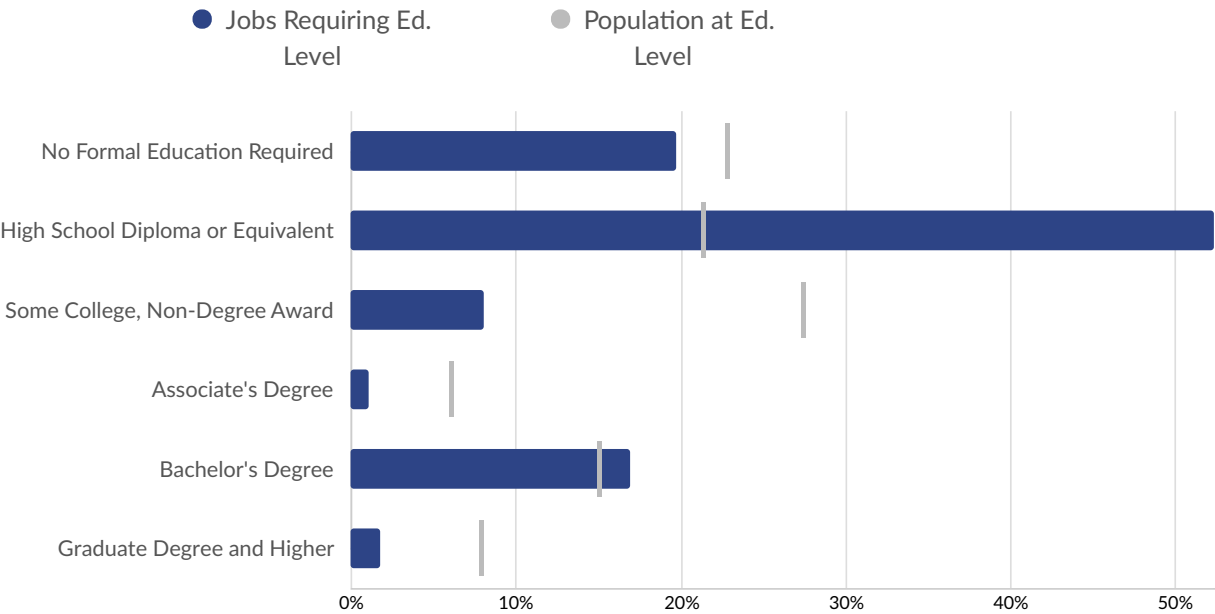
