
Takeaways

- As of 2024 the region's population **declined by 6.8%** since 2019, falling by 142. Population is expected to **increase by 2.4%** between 2024 and 2029, adding 46.
- From 2019 to 2024, jobs increased by 4.8% in Eureka County, NV from 4,576 to 4,795. This change outpaced the national growth rate of 4.3% by 0.5%. As the number of jobs increased, the labor force participation rate increased from 44.4% to 44.7% between 2019 and 2024.
- Concerning educational attainment, **8.5% of Eureka County, NV residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (13.0% below the national average), and **4.3% hold an Associate's Degree** (4.5% below the national average).
- The top three industries in 2024 are Metal Ore Mining, Support Activities for Mining, and Local Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals.








Unemployment by Gender



Unemployment by Ethnicity







Job Trends






Eureka County, NV had a May 2025 unemployment rate of 5.80%, increasing from 5.20% 5 years before.





Millennials


Eureka County, NV has 317 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 390.

Retirement risk is high in Eureka County, NV. The national average for an area this size is 579 people 55 or older, while there are 689 here.


Racial Diversity

Racial diversity is low in Eureka County, NV. The national average for an area this size is 798 racially diverse people, while there are 387 here.




Veterans

Eureka County, NV has 7.82 violent crimes per 1,000 people. The national rate is 3.54 per 1,000 people.




Property Crime










Top Growing Industries




Top Industry Employment Concentration






Top Growing Occupations






Top Occupation Employment Concentration




