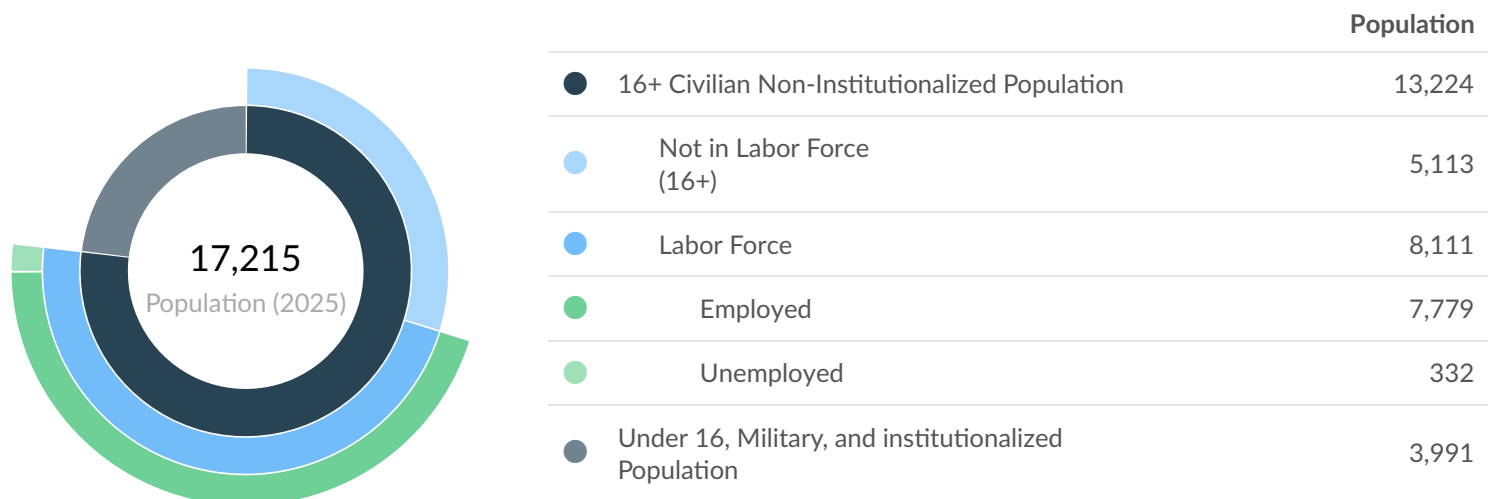
Median household income is **\$1.4K above** the national median household income of \$78.5K.

- As of 2024 the region's population **increased by 1.7%** since 2019, growing by 293. Population is expected to **increase by 0.7%** between 2024 and 2029, adding 118.
- From 2019 to 2024, jobs **increased by 2.1%** in Humboldt County, NV from 8,392 to **8,568**. This change **fell short of the national growth rate of 4.3% by 2.2%**. As the number of jobs increased, the **labor force participation rate decreased from 67.5% to 63.4% between 2019 and 2024**.
- Concerning educational attainment, **14.9% of Humboldt County, NV residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (6.6% below the national average), and **9.9% hold an Associate's Degree** (1.0% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2024 are Metal Ore Mining, Education and Hospitals (Local Government), and Restaurants and Other Eating Places.

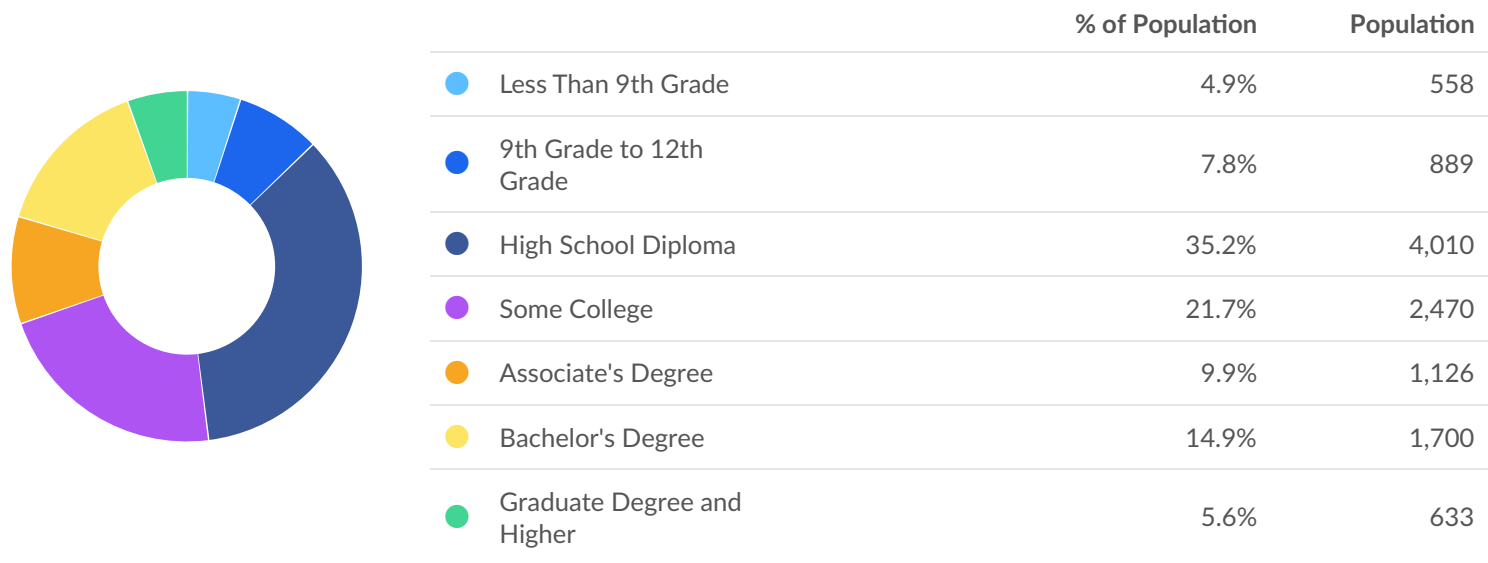

May 2025 Labor Force Breakdown



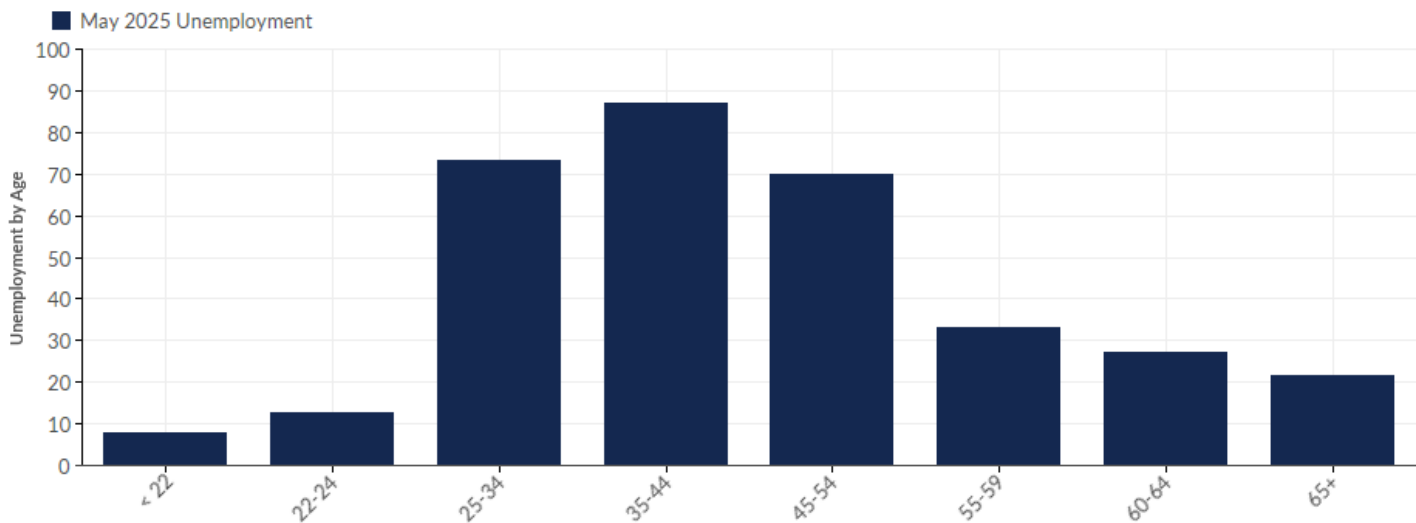
Educational Attainment

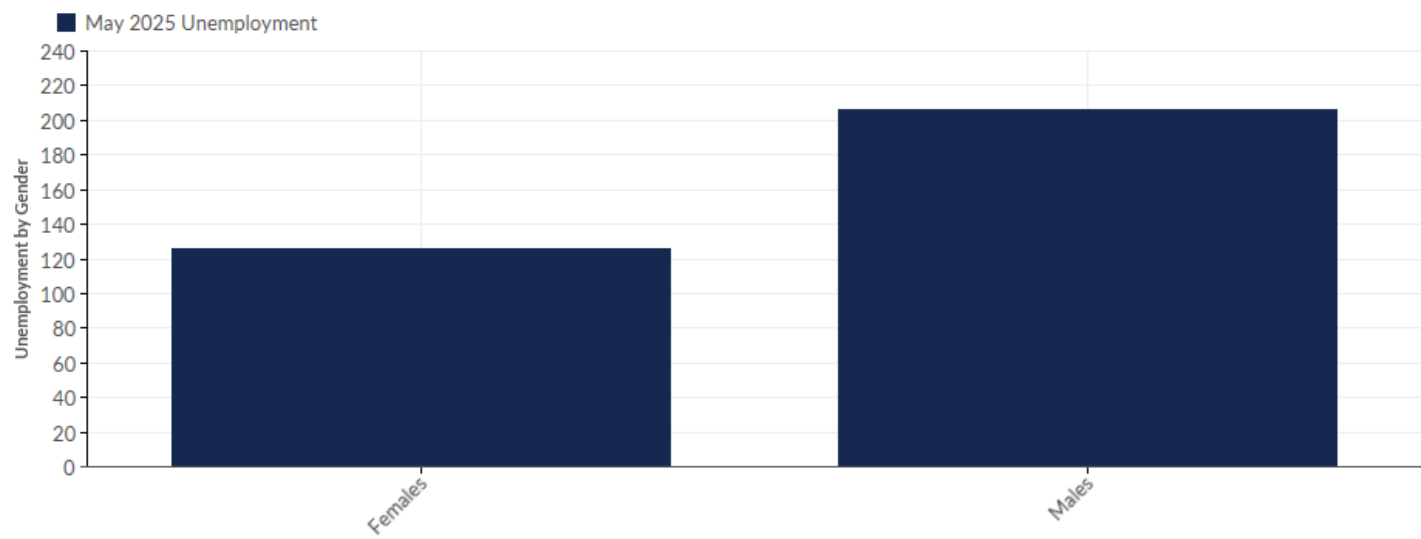

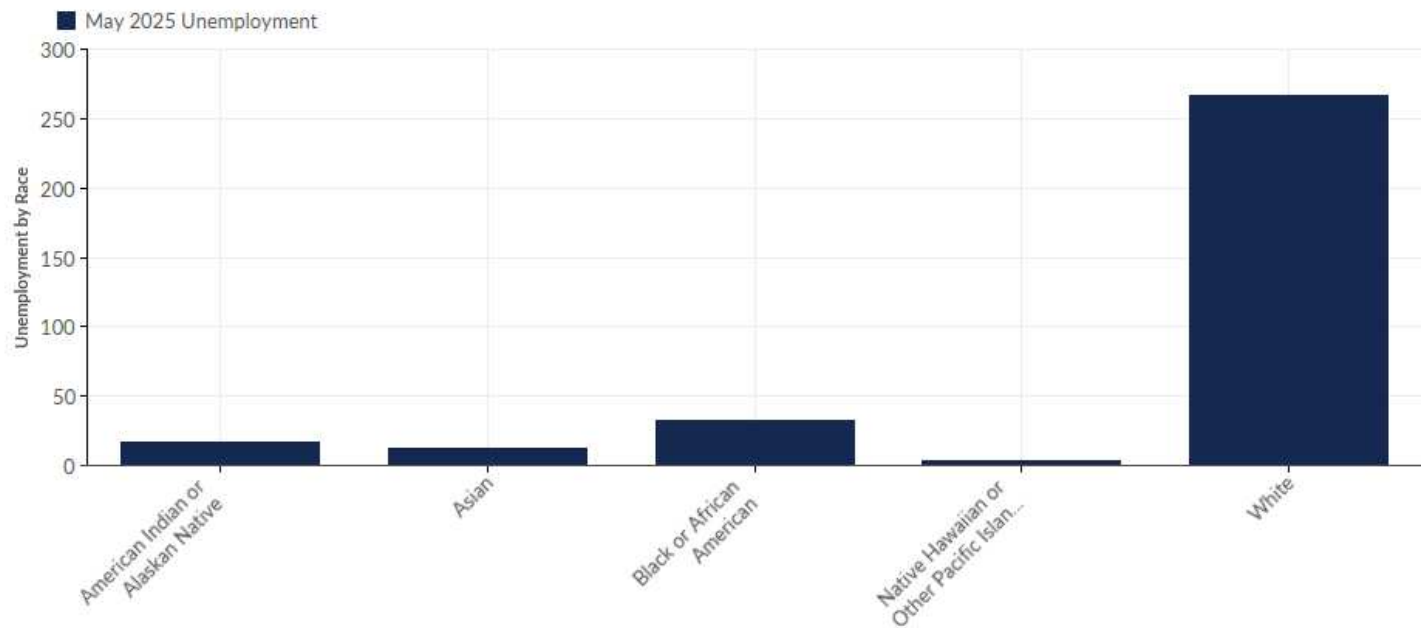

Unemployment by Gender



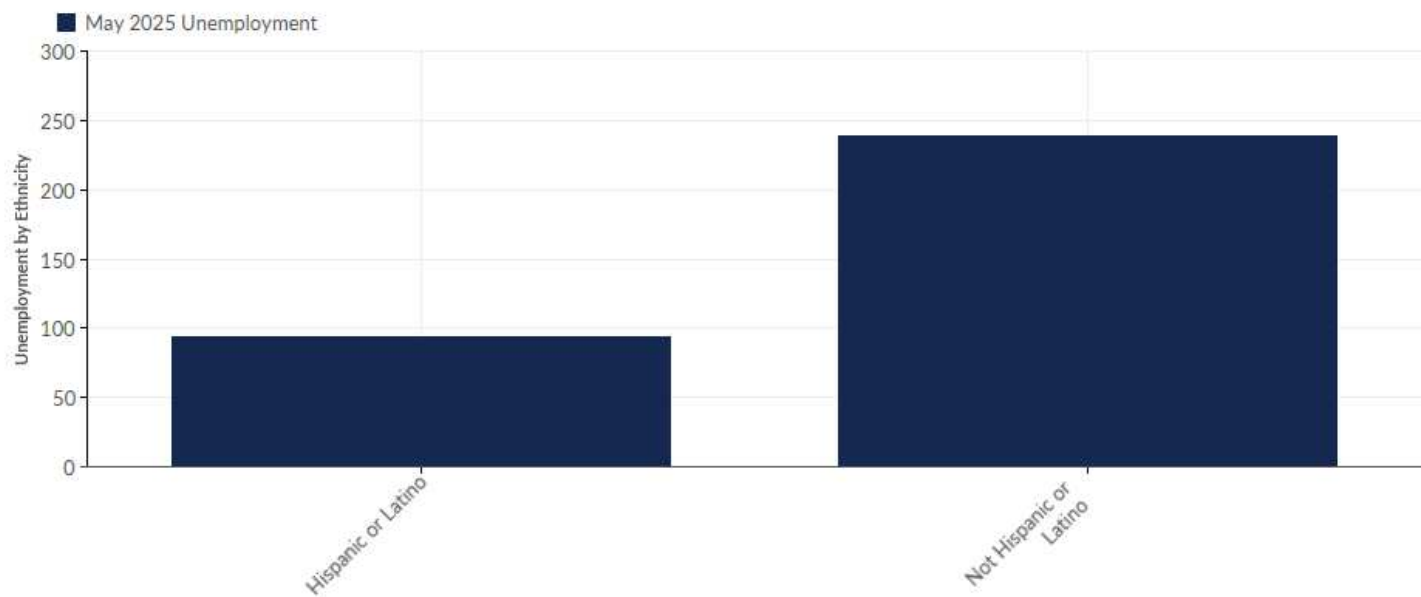

Unemployment by Ethnicity

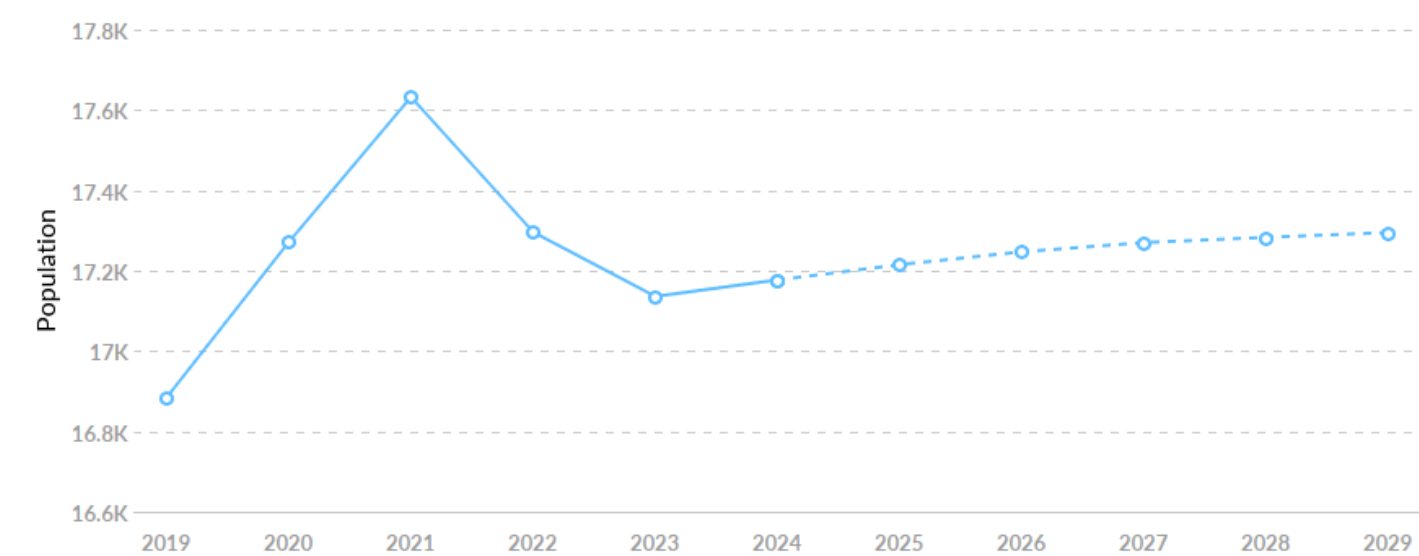

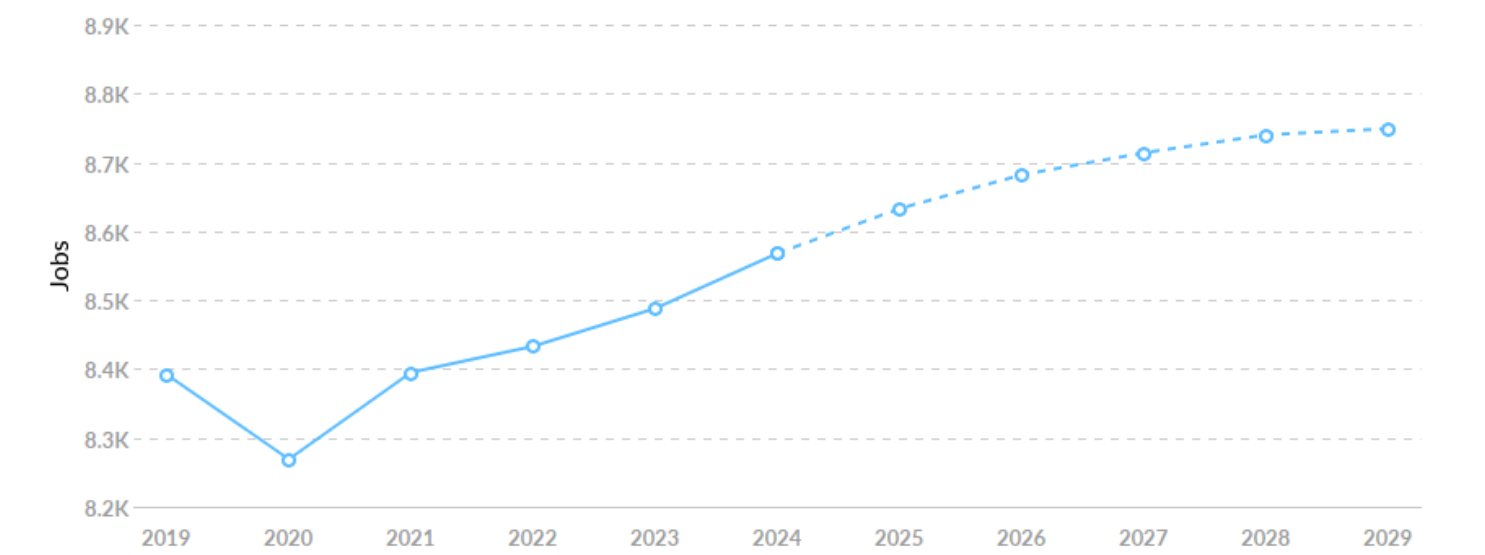

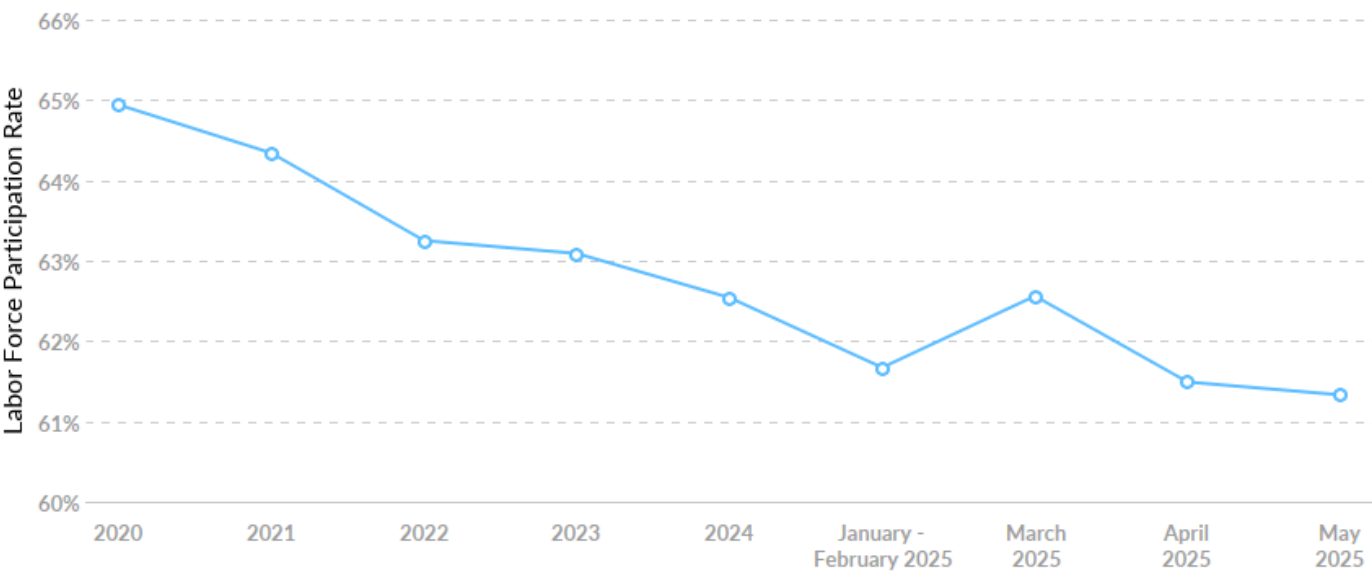
Job Trends

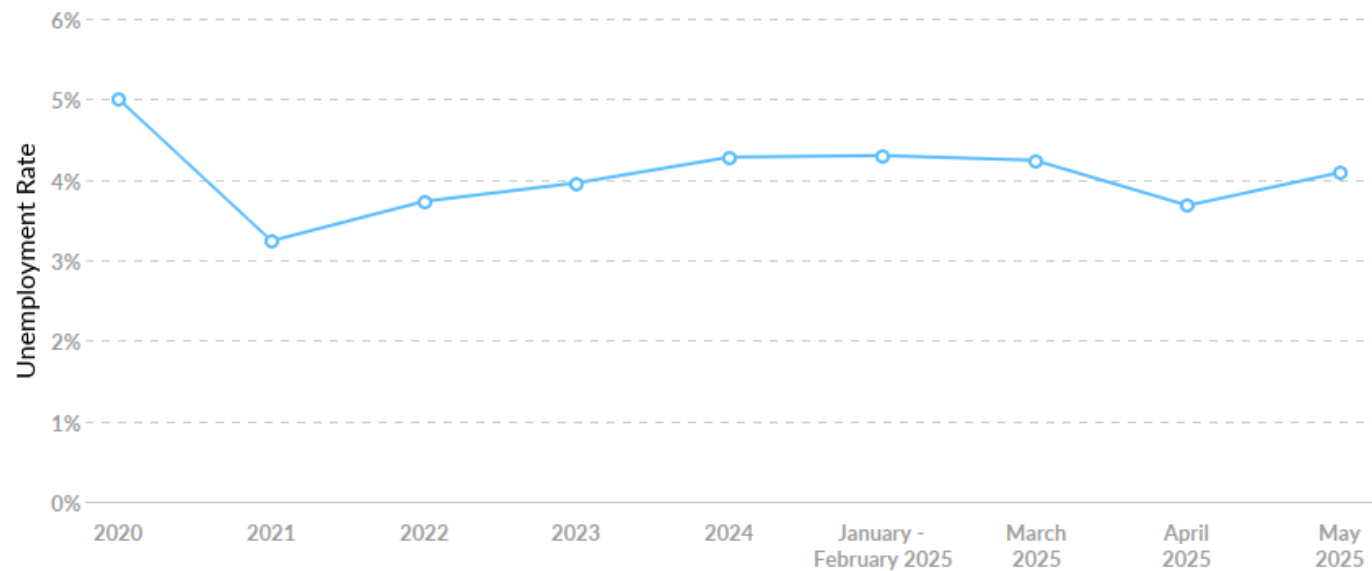

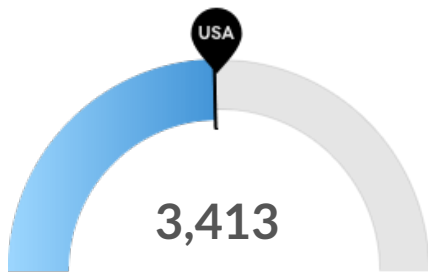
Unemployment Rate Trends

Humboldt County, NV had a May 2025 unemployment rate of 4.09%, **decreasing from 5.00%** 5 years before.



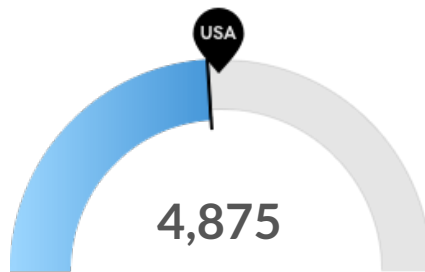

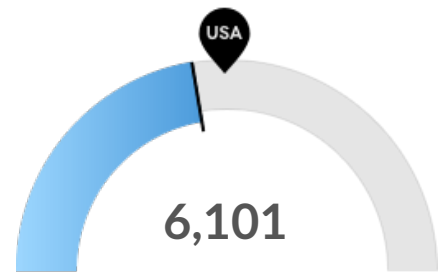
Millennials

Humboldt County, NV has 3,413 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 3,482.



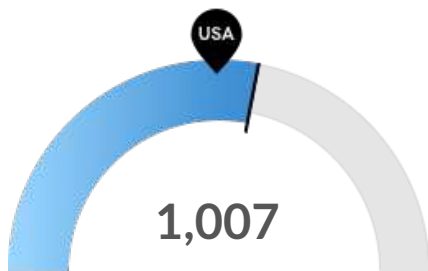
Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is about average in Humboldt County, NV. The national average for an area this size is 5,173 people 55 or older, while there are 4,875 here.



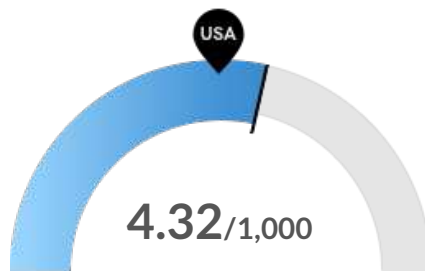
Racial Diversity

Racial diversity is low in Humboldt County, NV. The national average for an area this size is 7,137 racially diverse people, while there are 6,101 here.



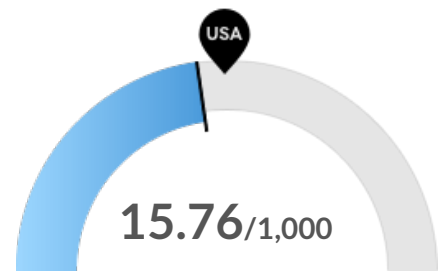
Veterans

Humboldt County, NV has 4.32 violent crimes per 1,000 people. The national rate is 3.54 per 1,000 people.

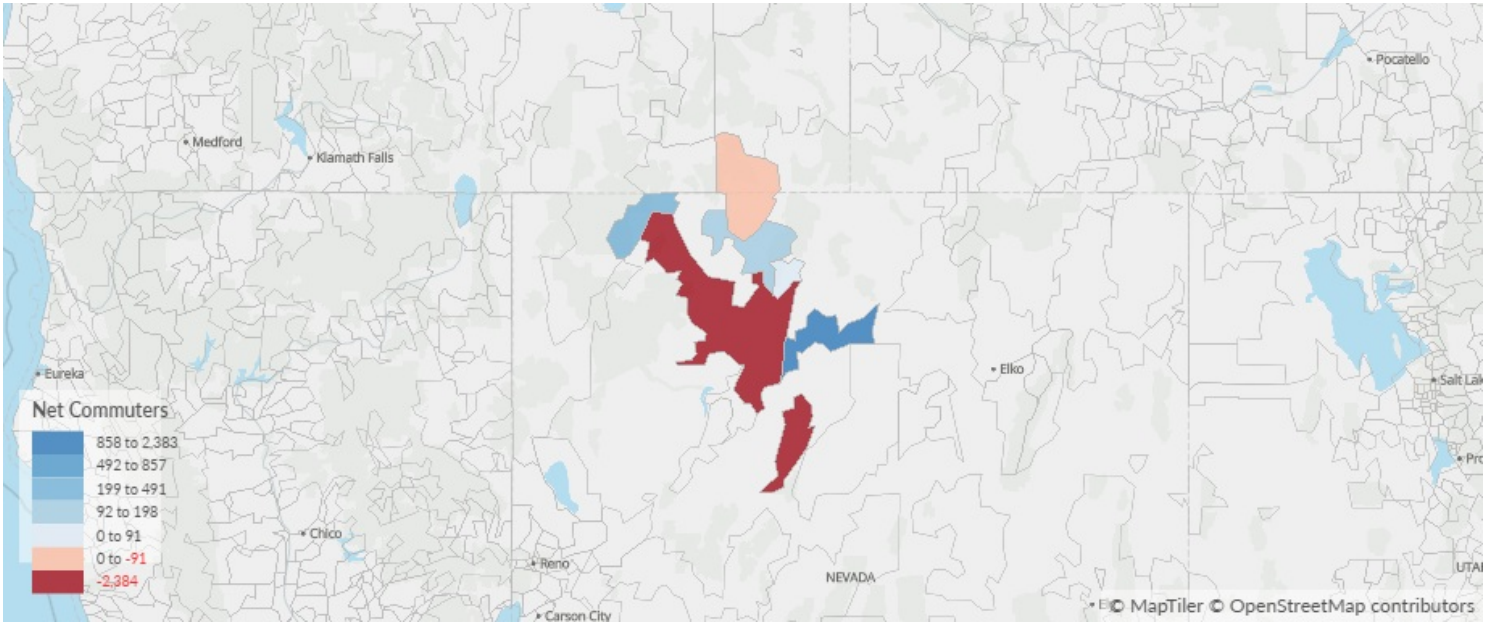


Property Crime

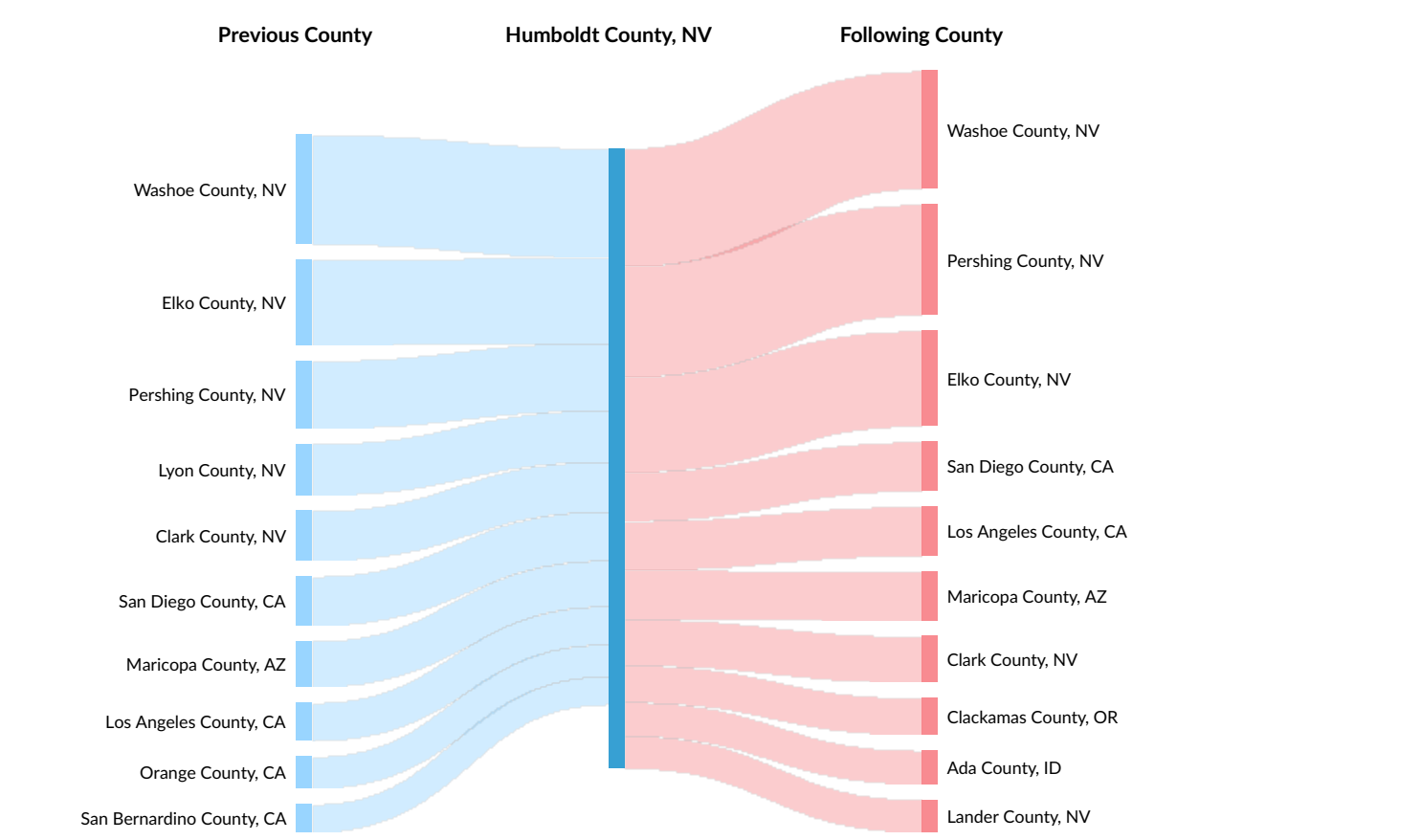

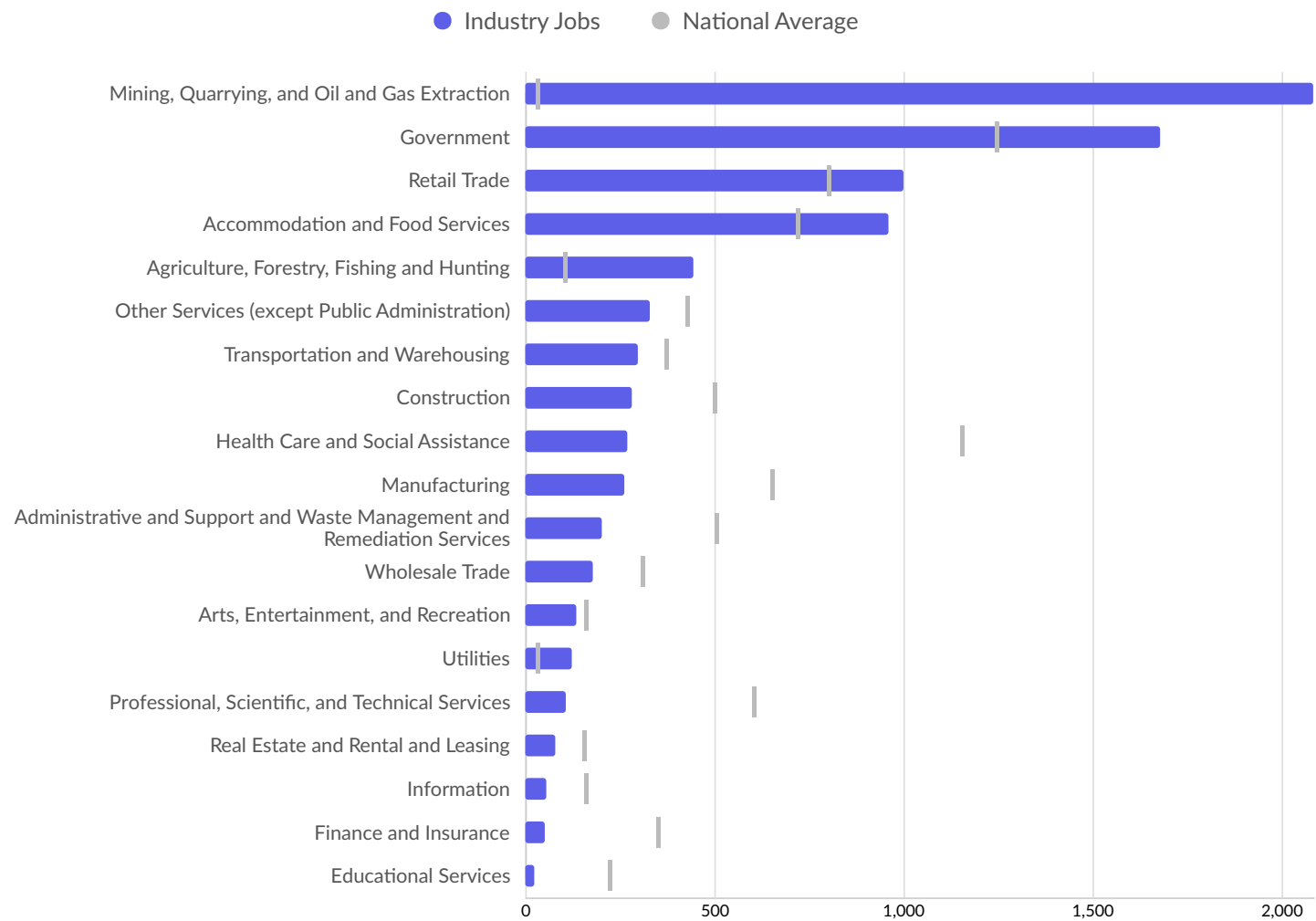

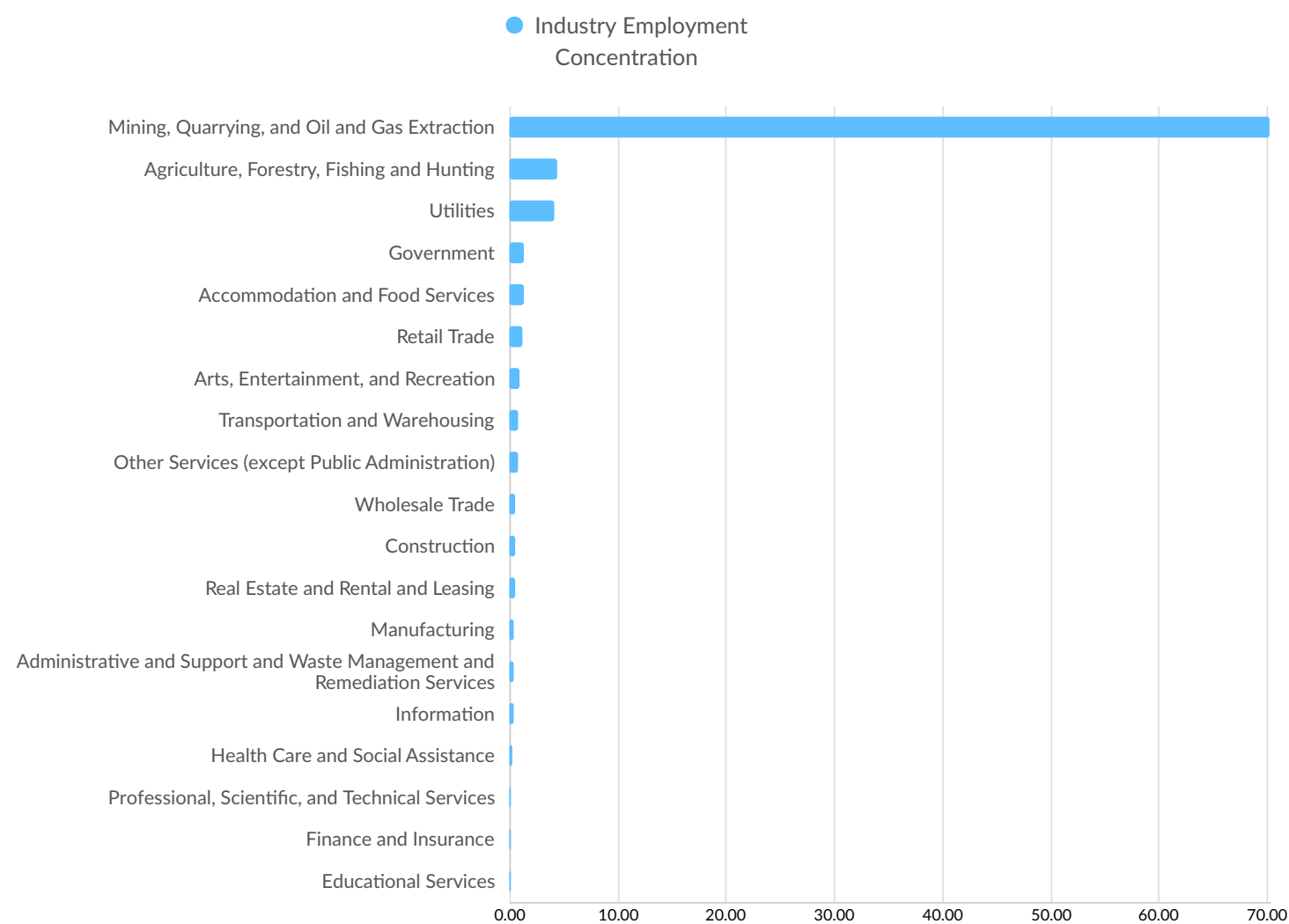

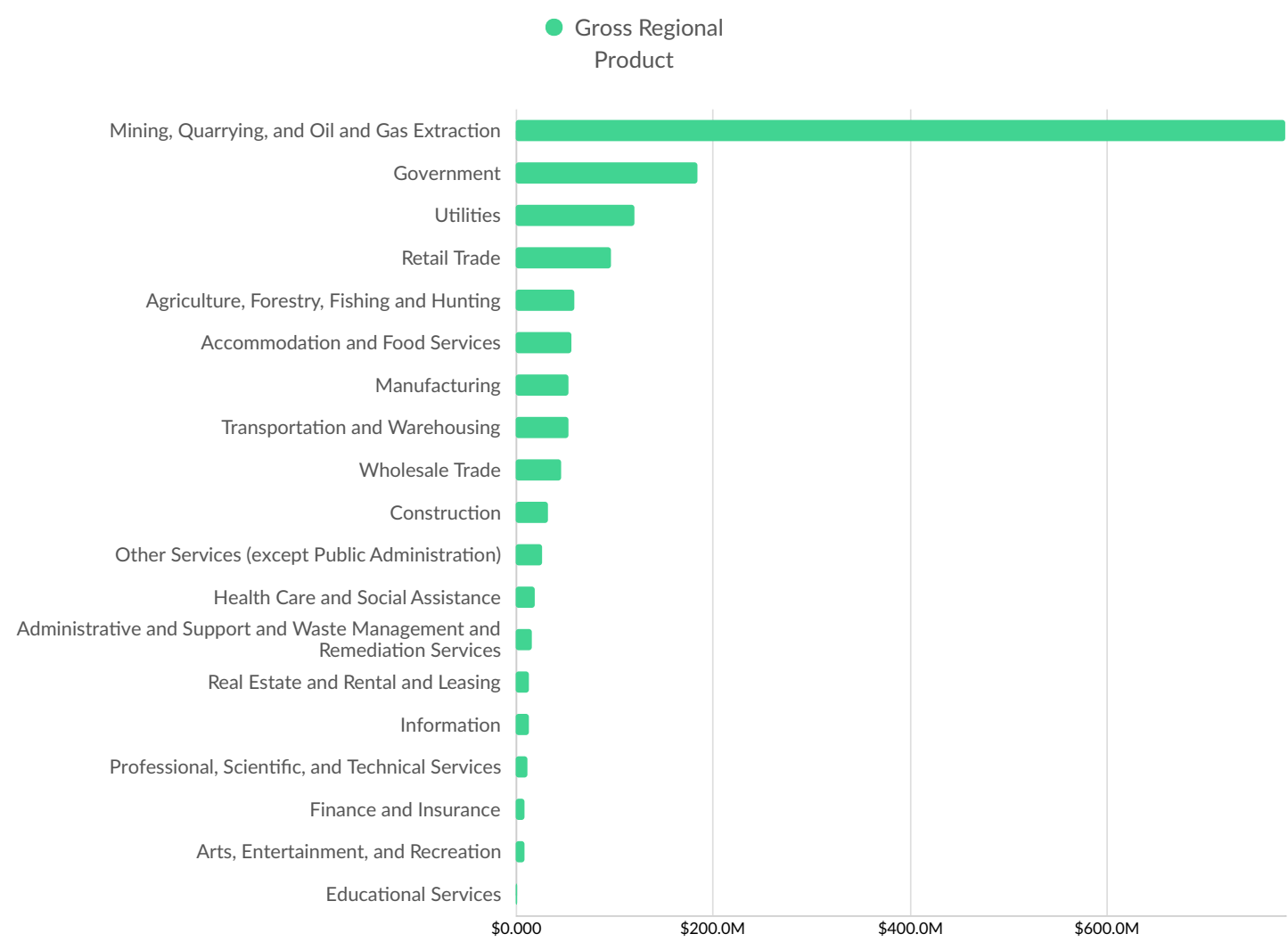
Top Growing Industries



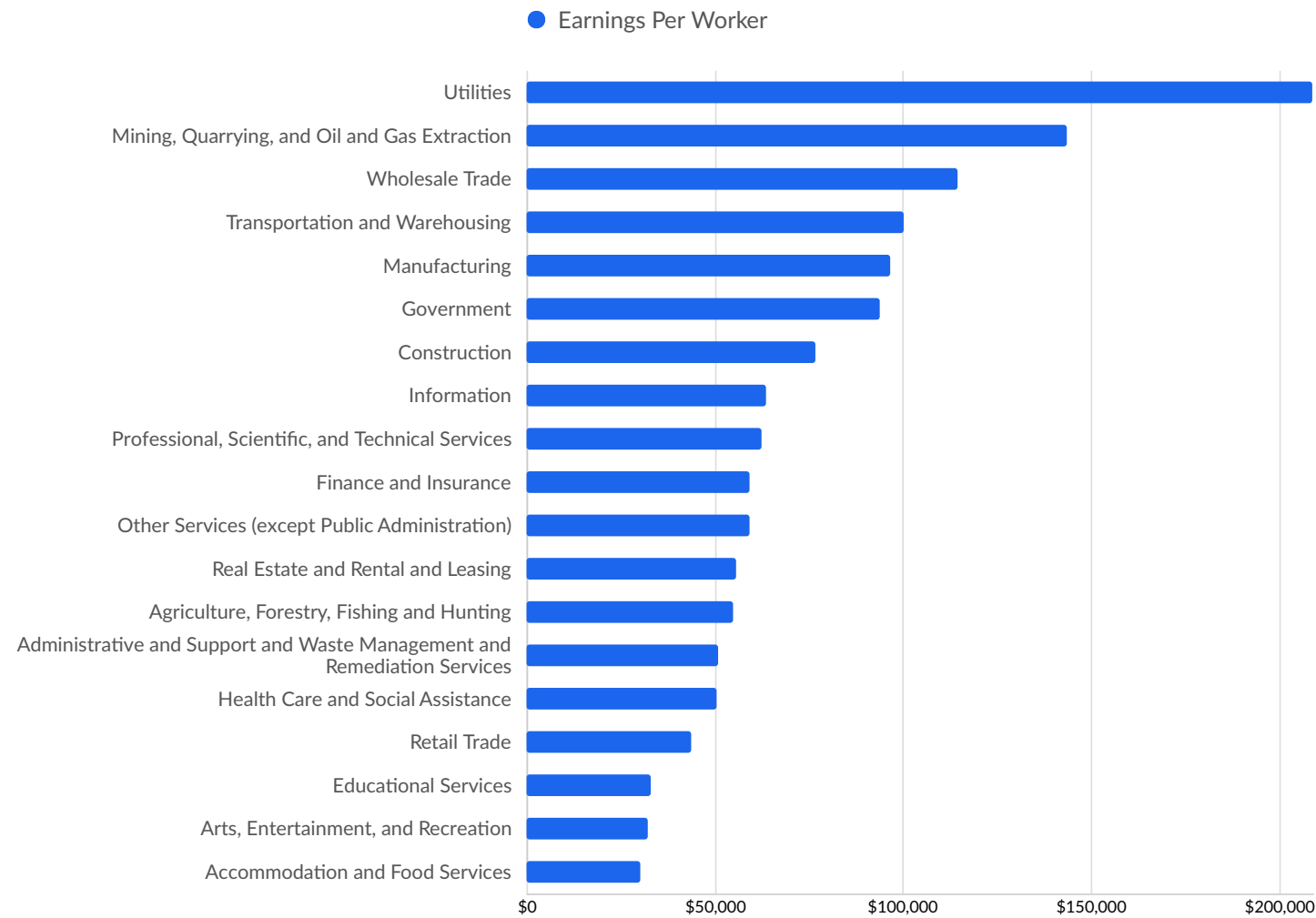
Top Industry Employment Concentration

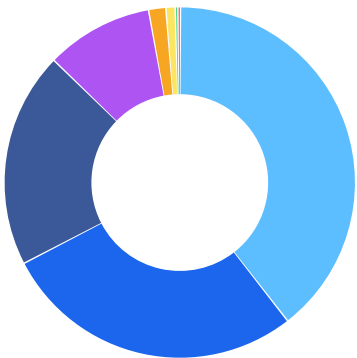

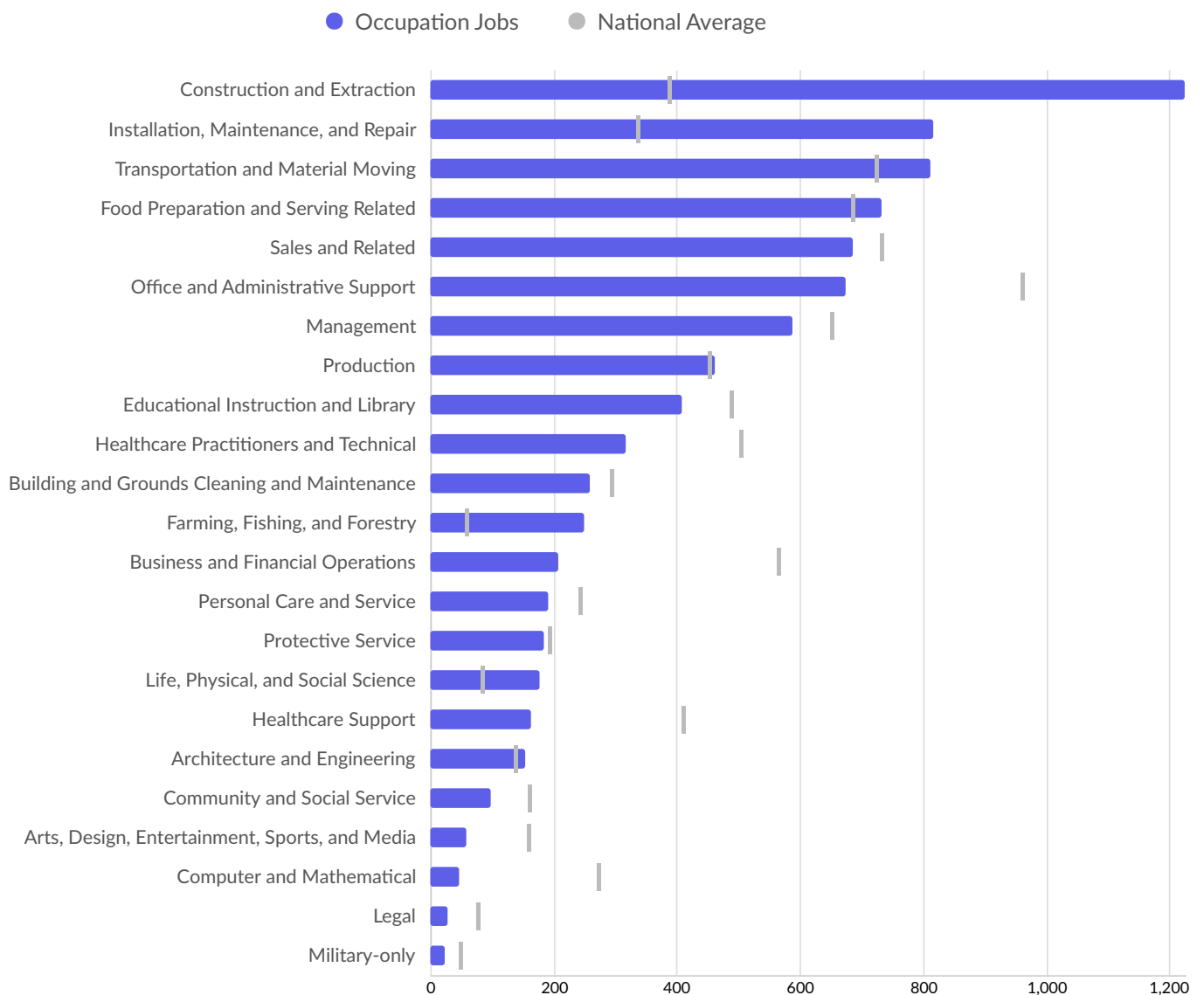

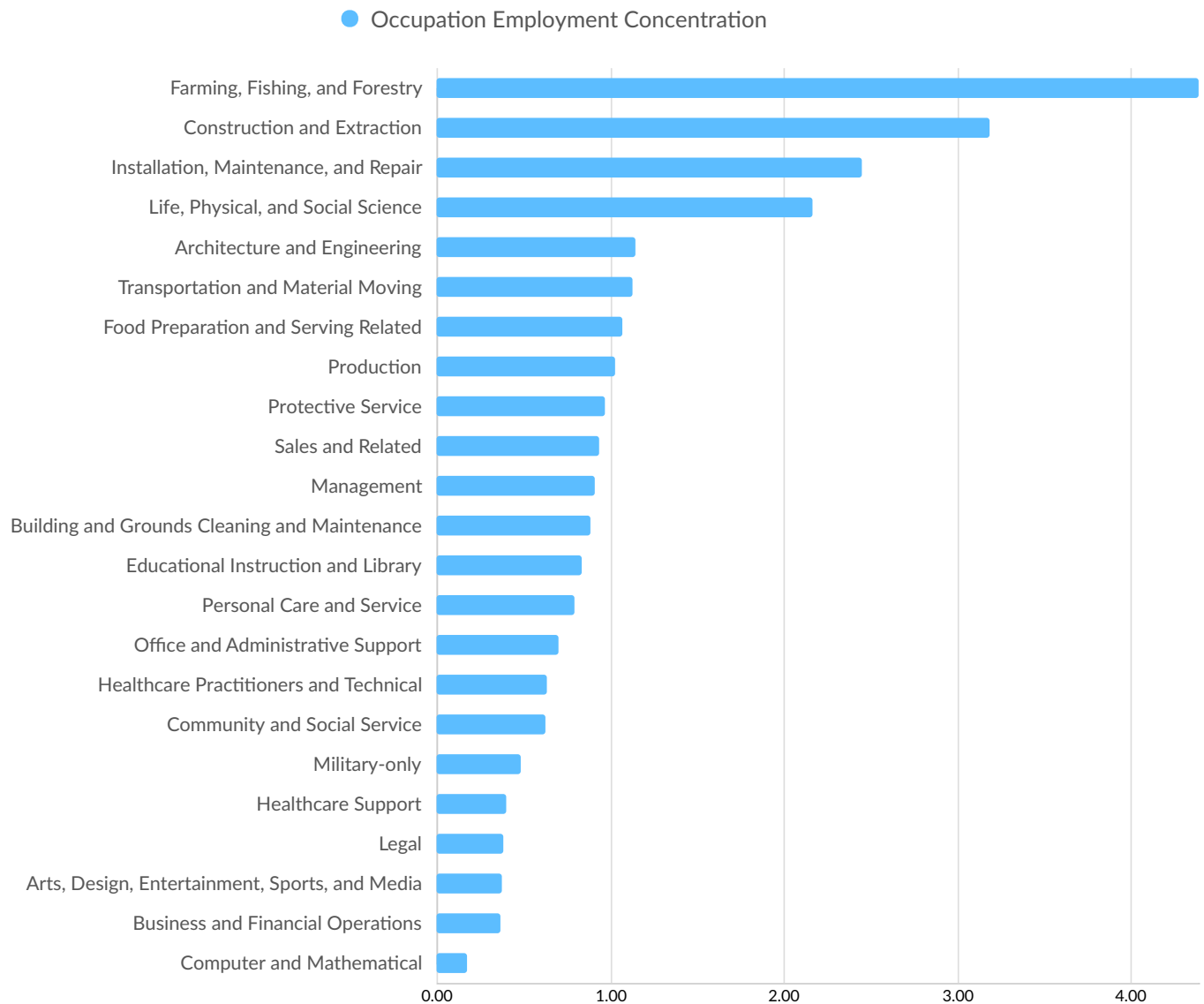
Largest Occupations



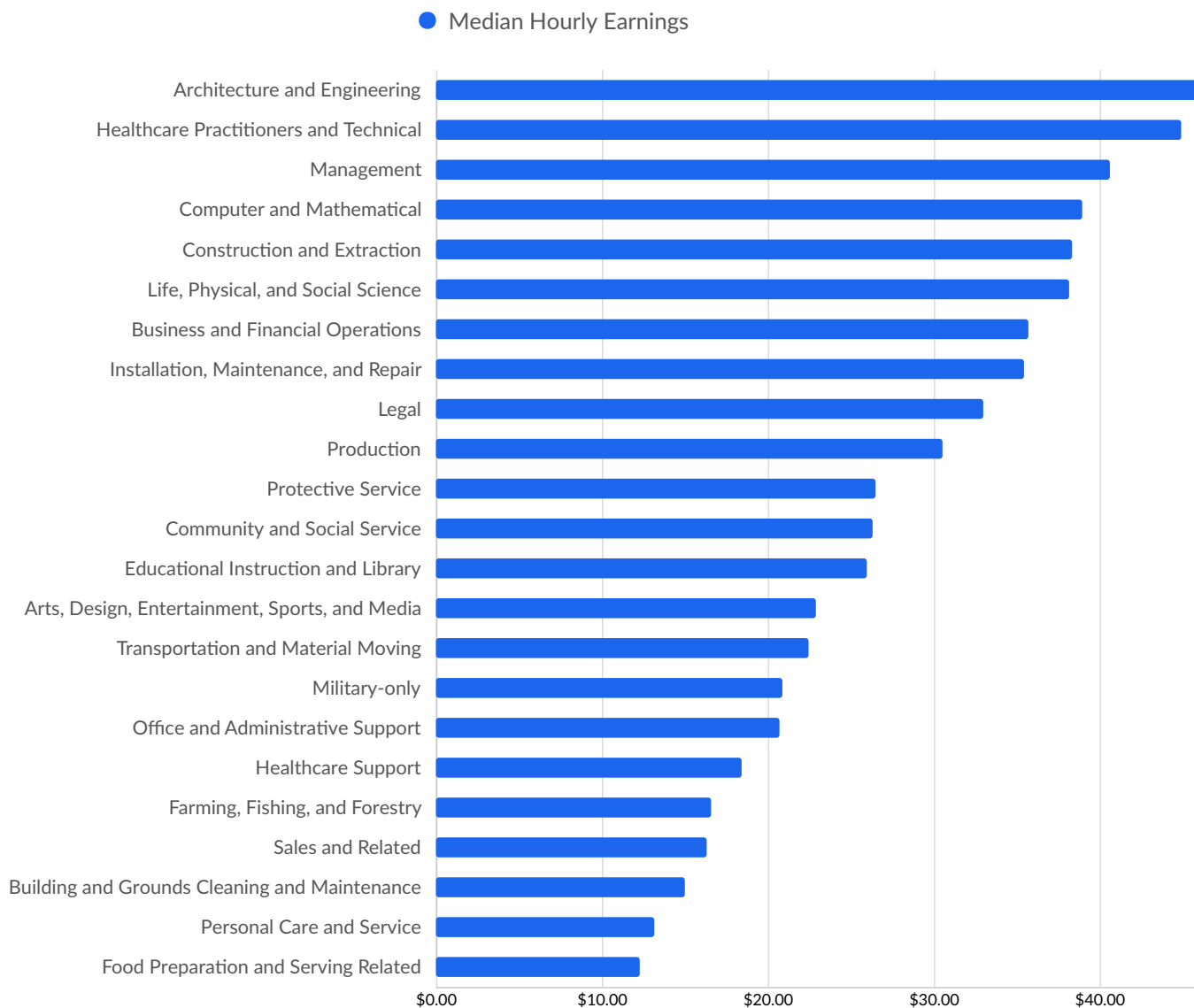
Top Growing Occupations



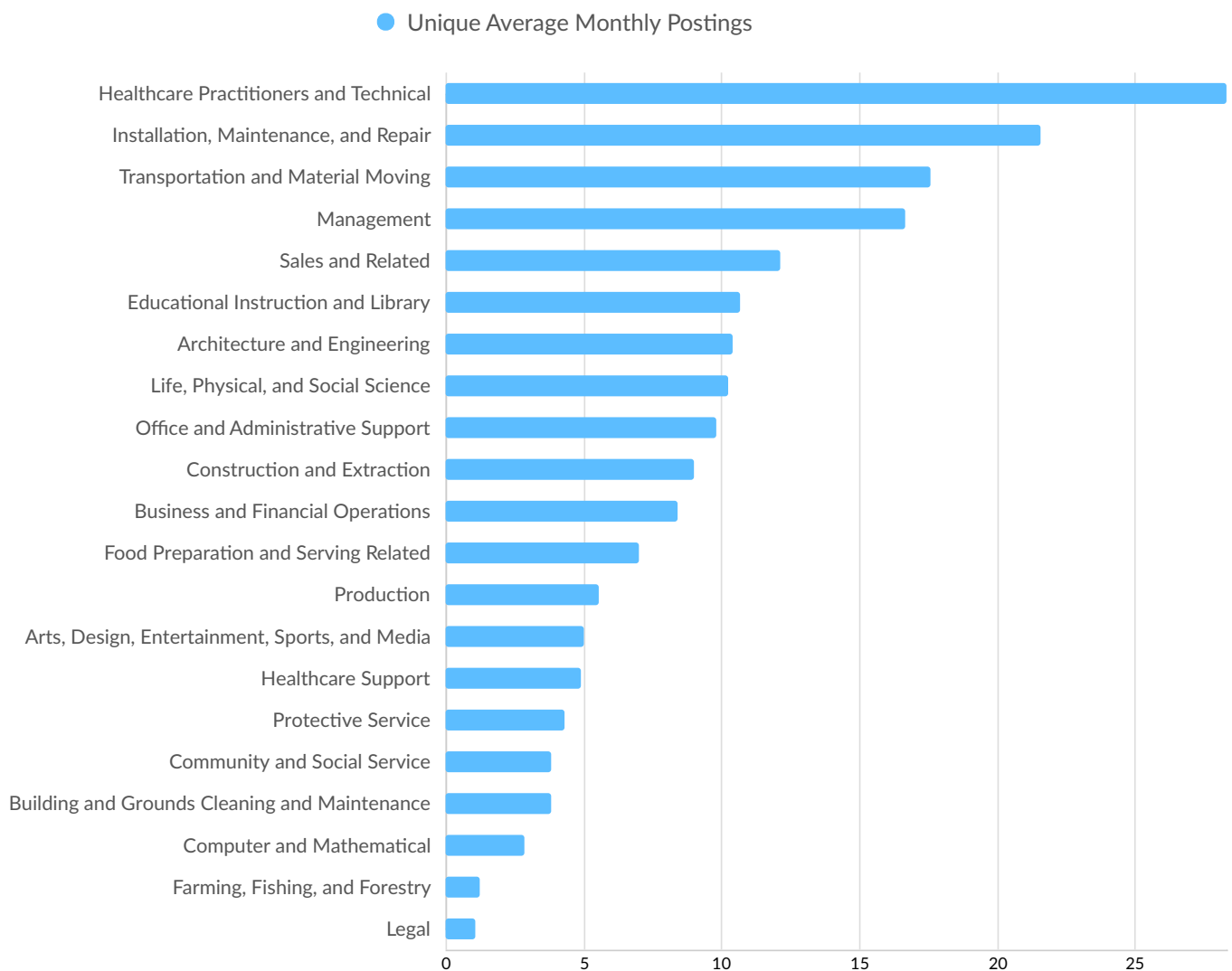
Top Occupation Employment Concentration



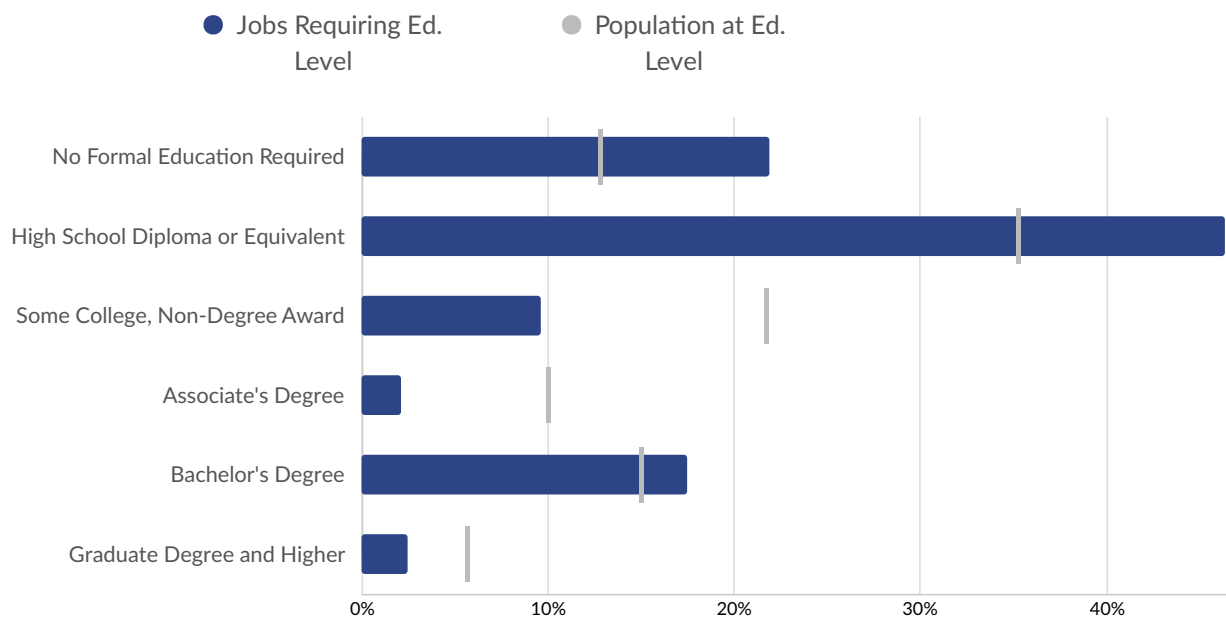
