
#### **Takeaways**

- As of 2024 the region's population increased by 6.3% since 2019, growing by 348. Population is expected to increase by 6.6% between 2024 and 2029, adding 388.
- From 2019 to 2024, jobs increased by 5.9% in Lander County, NV from 3,732 to 3,952. This change outpaced the national growth rate of 4.3% by 1.6%. As the number of jobs increased, the labor force participation rate decreased from 60.1% to 53.8% between 2019 and 2024.
- Concerning educational attainment, **6.2% of Lander County, NV residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (15.3% below the national average), and **15.6% hold an Associate's Degree** (6.7% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2024 are Metal Ore Mining, Education and Hospitals (Local Government), and Local Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals.















# **Job Trends**






Lander County, NV had a May 2025 unemployment rate of 4.71%, decreasing from 6.52% 5 years before.




#### Millennials

Lander County, NV has 229 veterans. The national average for an area this size is 285.




#### **Retiring Soon**

Retirement risk is about average in Lander County, NV. The national average for an area this size is 1,742 people 55 or older, while there are 1,712 here.




#### **Violent Crime**










### **Top Industry Employment Concentration**







### **Top Occupation Employment Concentration**









