
#### **Takeaways**

- As of 2024 the region's population **declined by 14.9%** since 2019, falling by 773. Population is expected to **decrease by 5.9%** between 2024 and 2029, losing 261.
- From 2019 to 2024, jobs increased by 5.1% in Lincoln County, NV from 1,510 to 1,587. This change outpaced the national growth rate of 4.3% by 0.8%. As the number of jobs increased, the labor force participation rate increased from 45.7% to 54.7% between 2019 and 2024.
- Concerning educational attainment, **11.9% of Lincoln County, NV residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (9.6% below the national average), and **6.5% hold an Associate's Degree** (2.4% below the national average).
- The top three industries in 2024 are Education and Hospitals (Local Government), Local Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals, and State Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals.















### **Job Trends**






Lincoln County, NV had a May 2025 unemployment rate of 4.84%, decreasing from 5.93% 5 years before.




#### Millennials














### **Top Industry Employment Concentration**








