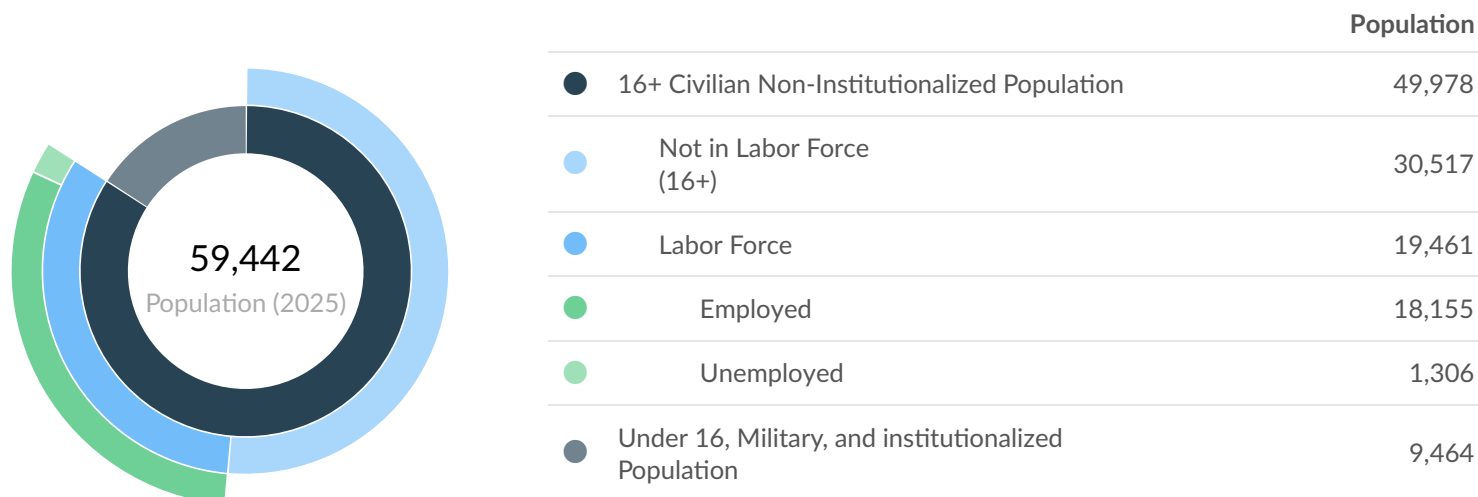
Median household income is **\$22.6K below** the national median household income of \$78.5K.

Takeaways

- As of 2024 the region's population **increased by 23.0%** since 2019, growing by 10,785. Population is expected to **increase by 15.0%** between 2024 and 2029, adding 8,648.
- From 2019 to 2024, jobs **increased by 10.1%** in Nye County, NV from 13,998 to **15,417**. This change **outpaced the national growth rate of 4.3% by 5.8%**. As the number of jobs increased, the **labor force participation rate decreased from 44.7% to 39.2% between 2019 and 2024**.
- Concerning educational attainment, **8.8% of Nye County, NV residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (12.7% below the national average), and **8.3% hold an Associate's Degree** (0.6% below the national average).
- The top three industries in 2024 are Scientific Research and Development Services, Education and Hospitals (Local Government), and Metal Ore Mining.

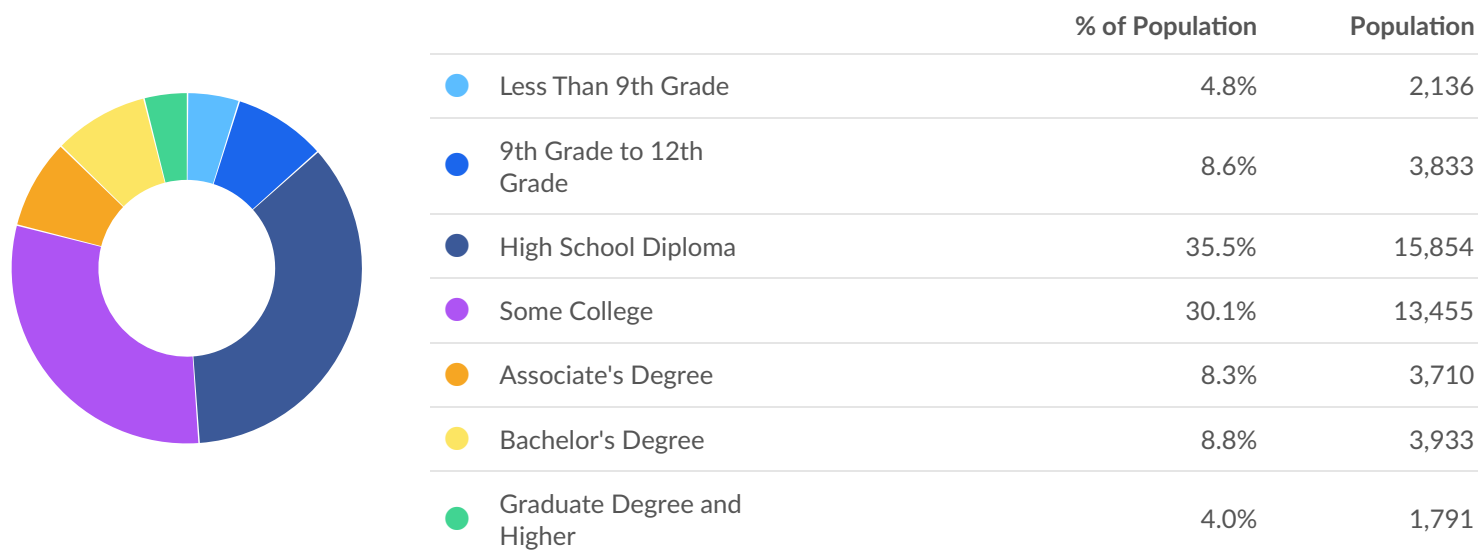

May 2025 Labor Force Breakdown



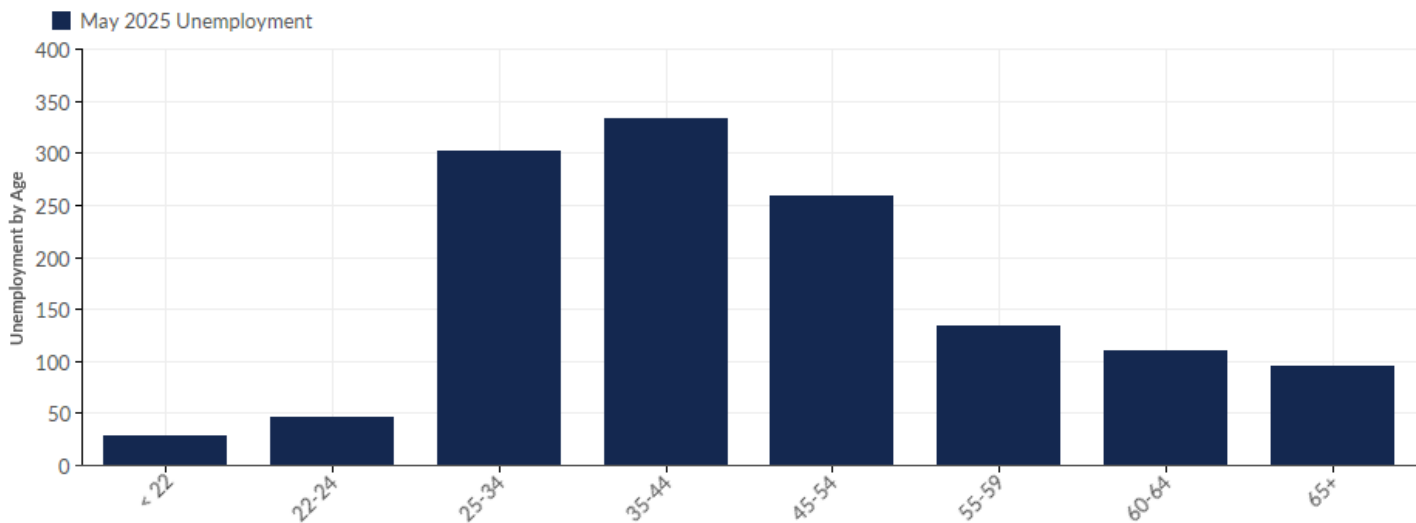
Educational Attainment

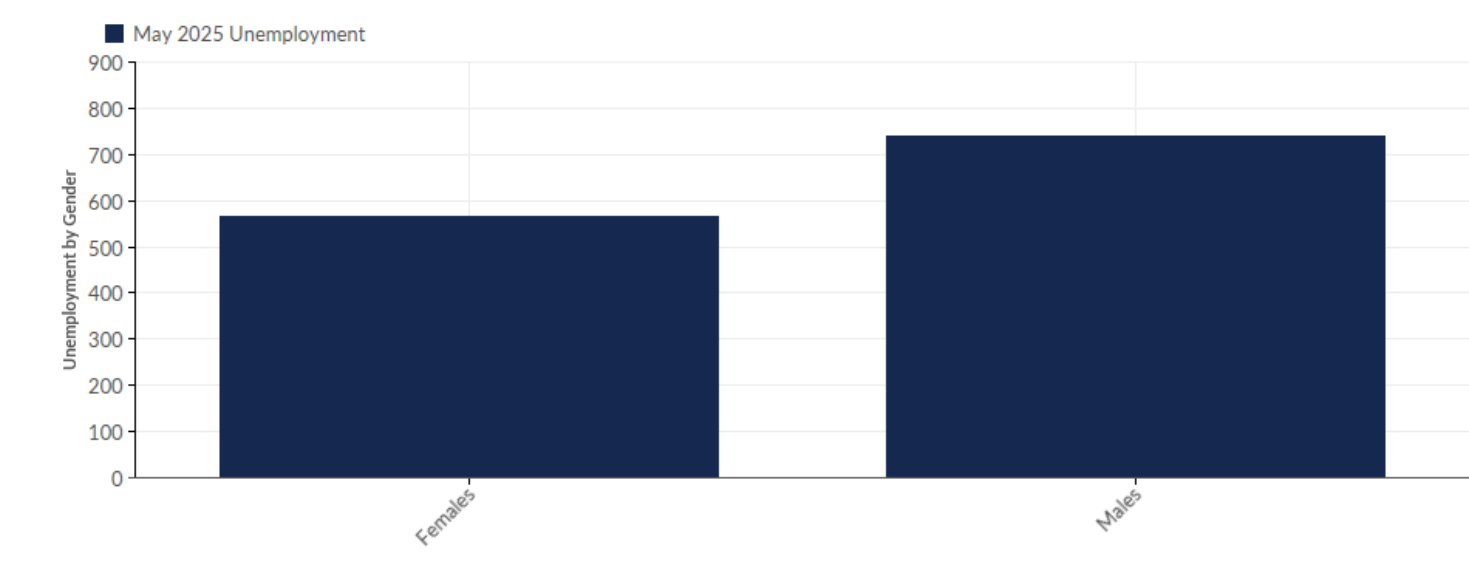

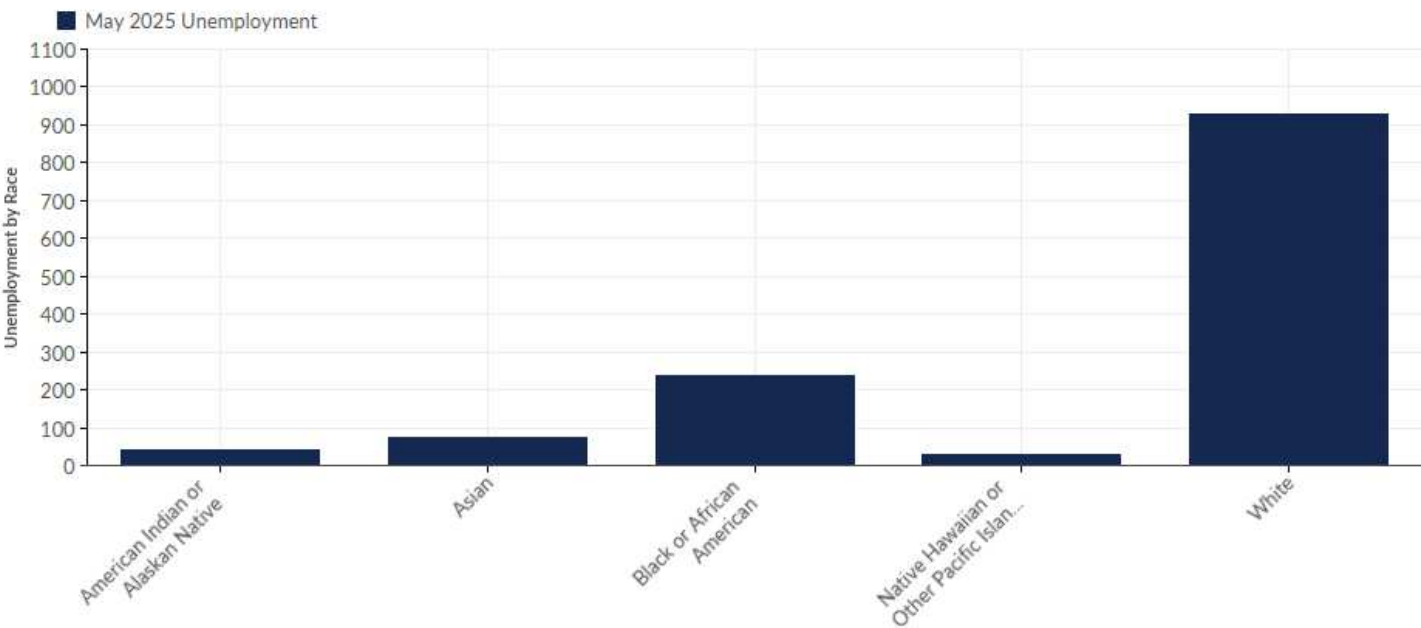

Unemployment by Gender



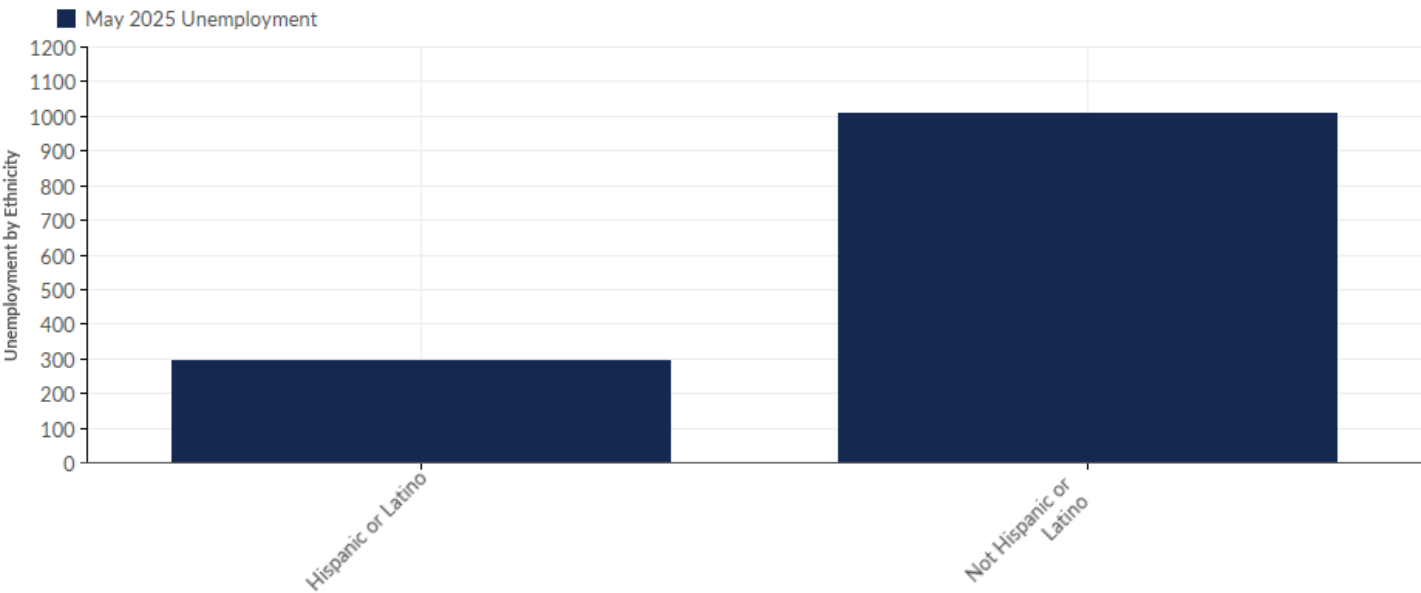

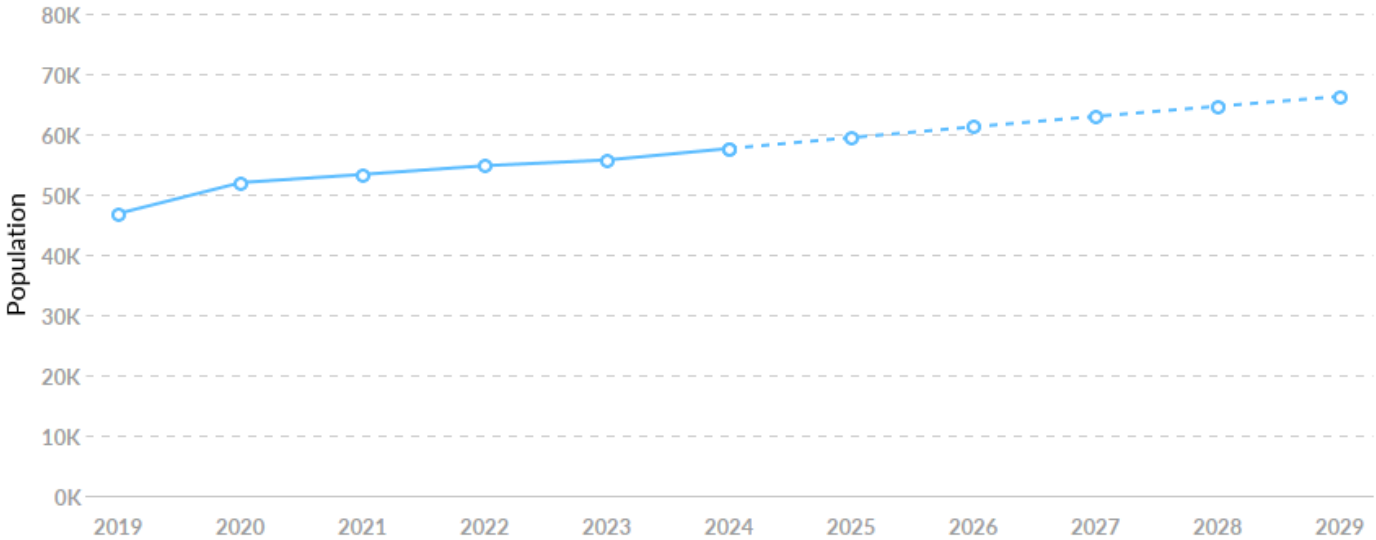

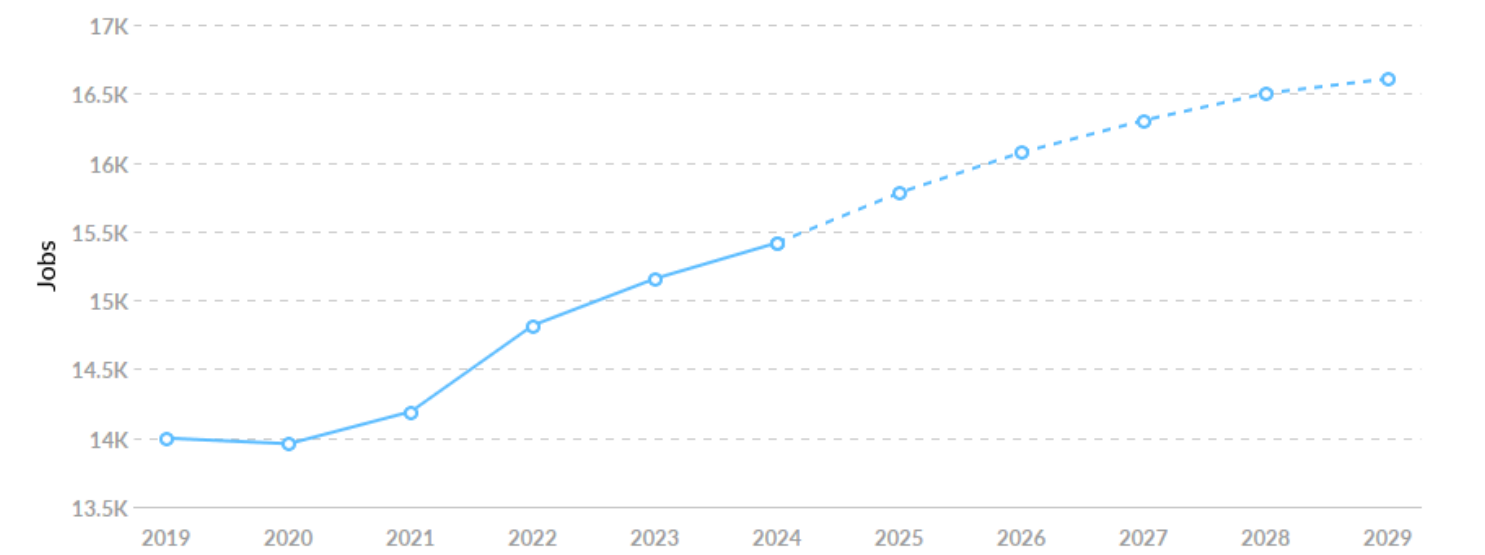

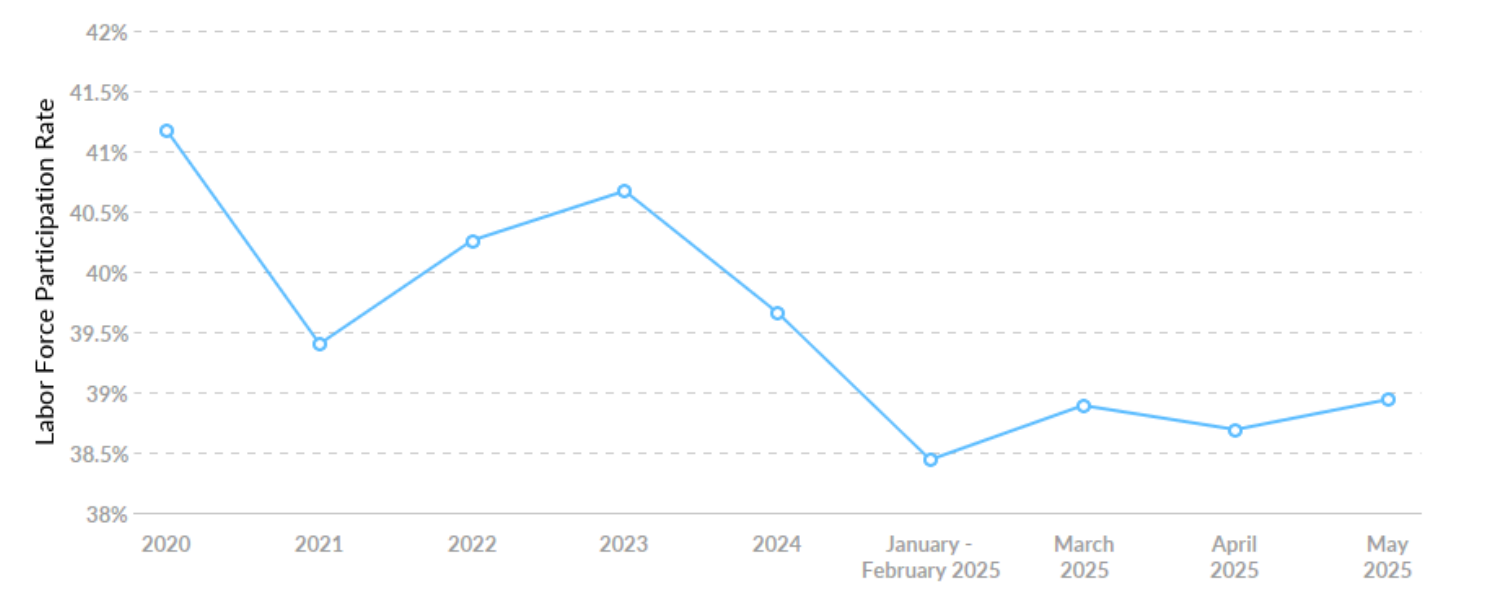
Job Trends

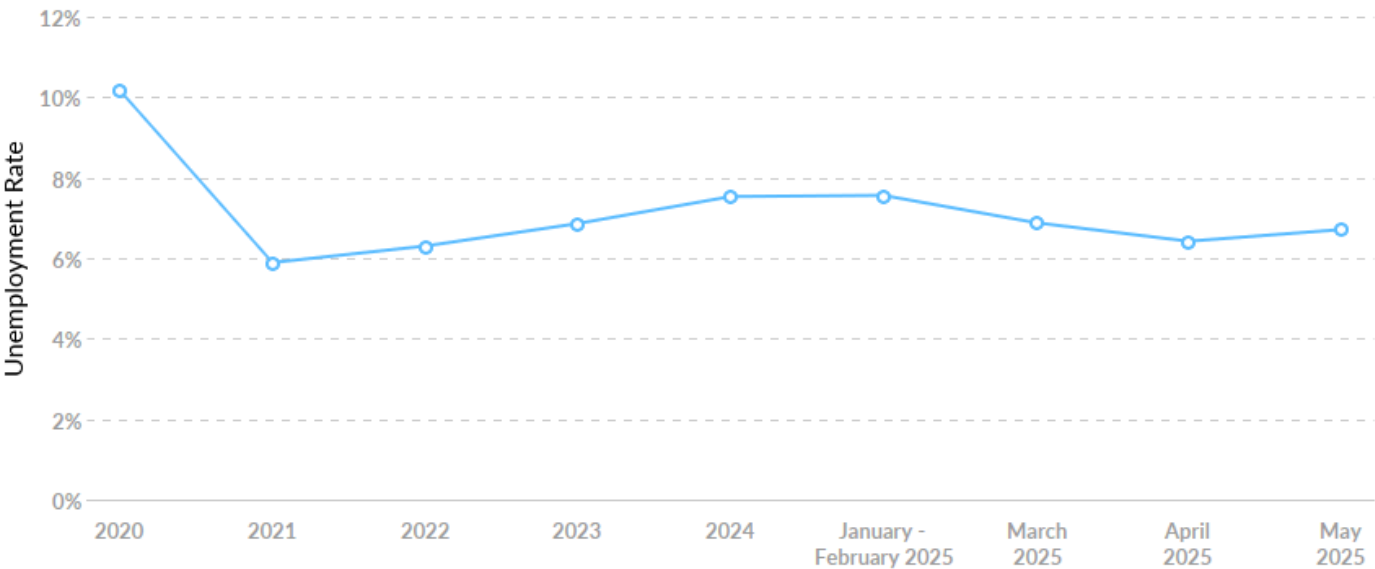

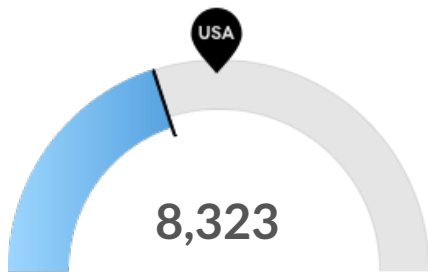
Unemployment Rate Trends

Nye County, NV had a May 2025 unemployment rate of 6.71%, **decreasing from 10.17%** 5 years before.



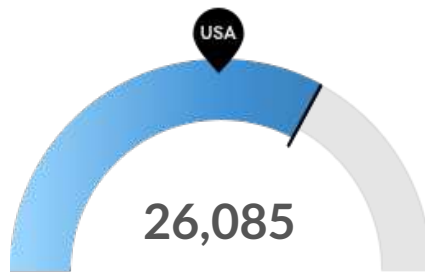

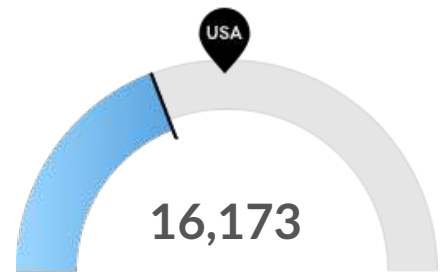
Millennials

Nye County, NV has 8,323 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 11,321.



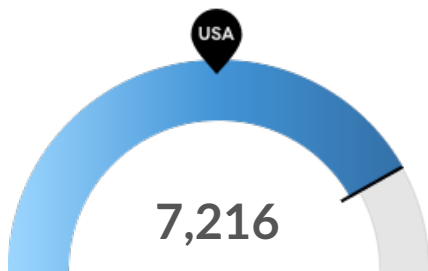
Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is high in Nye County, NV. The national average for an area this size is 16,821 people 55 or older, while there are 26,085 here.



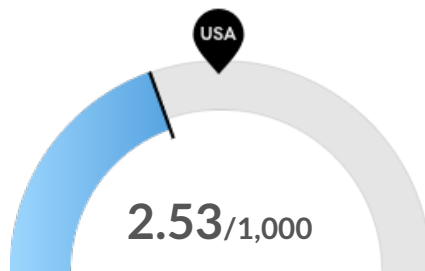
Racial Diversity

Racial diversity is low in Nye County, NV. The national average for an area this size is 23,206 racially diverse people, while there are 16,173 here.



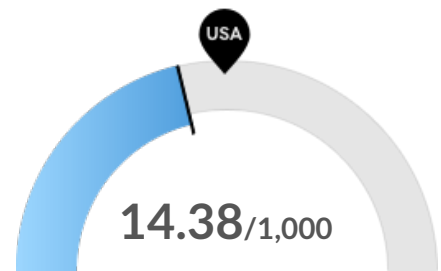
Veterans

Nye County, NV has 2.53 violent crimes per 1,000 people. The national rate is 3.54 per 1,000 people.

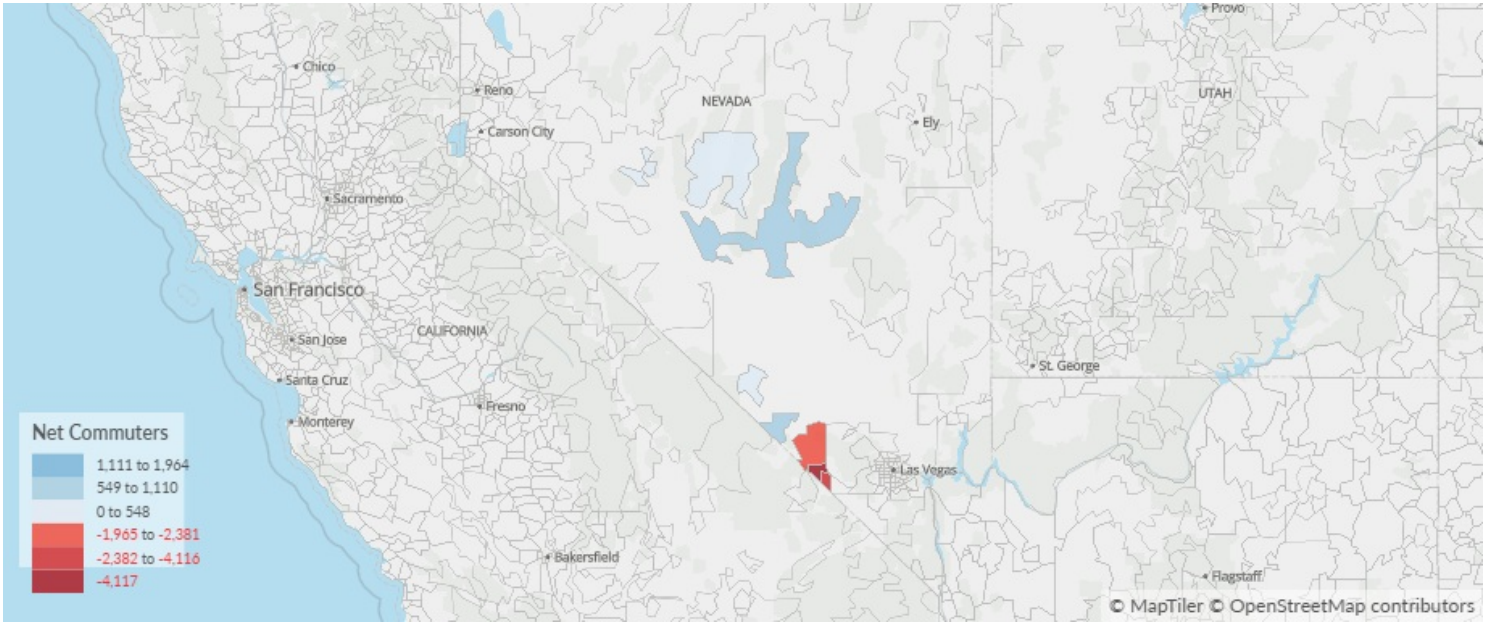


Property Crime

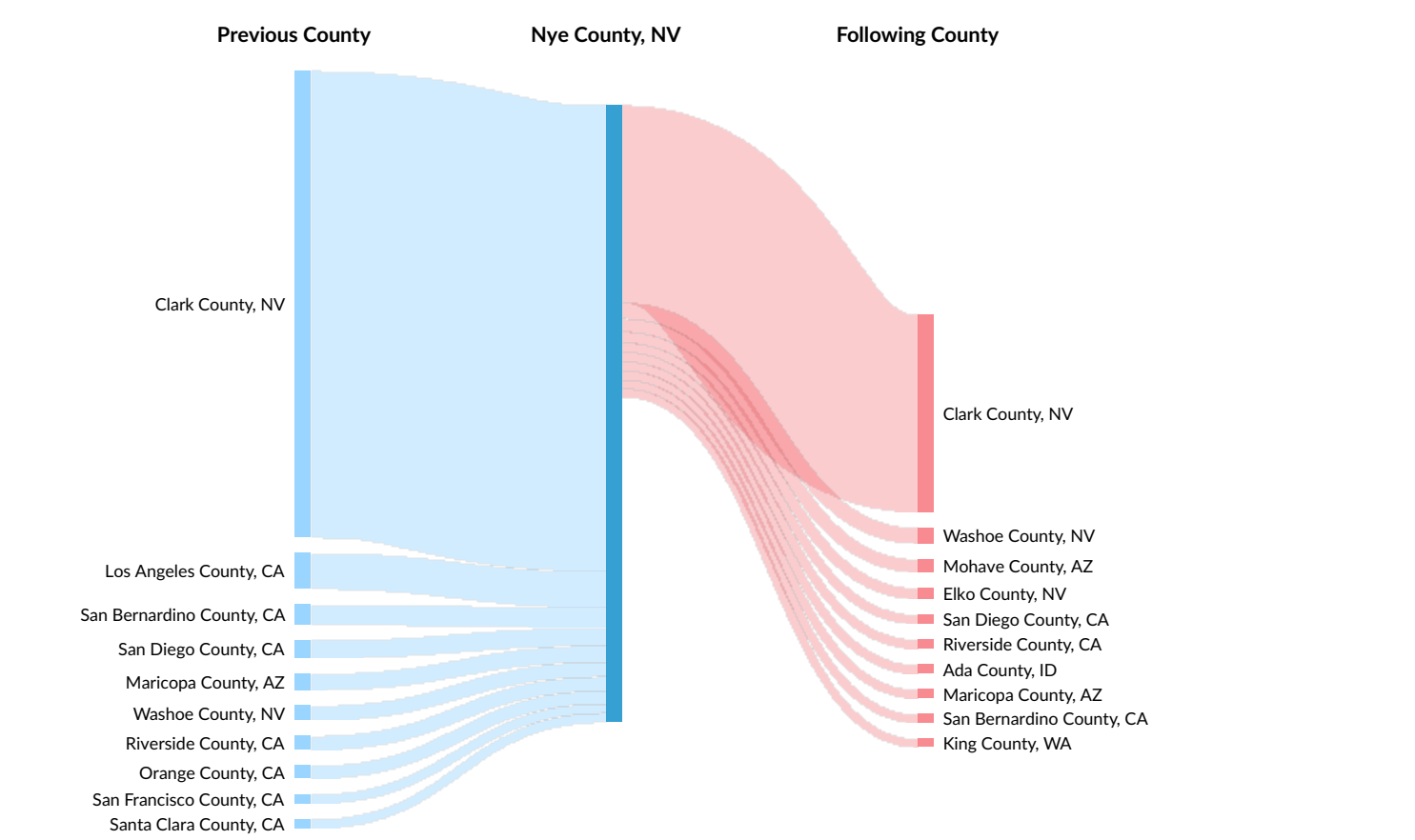

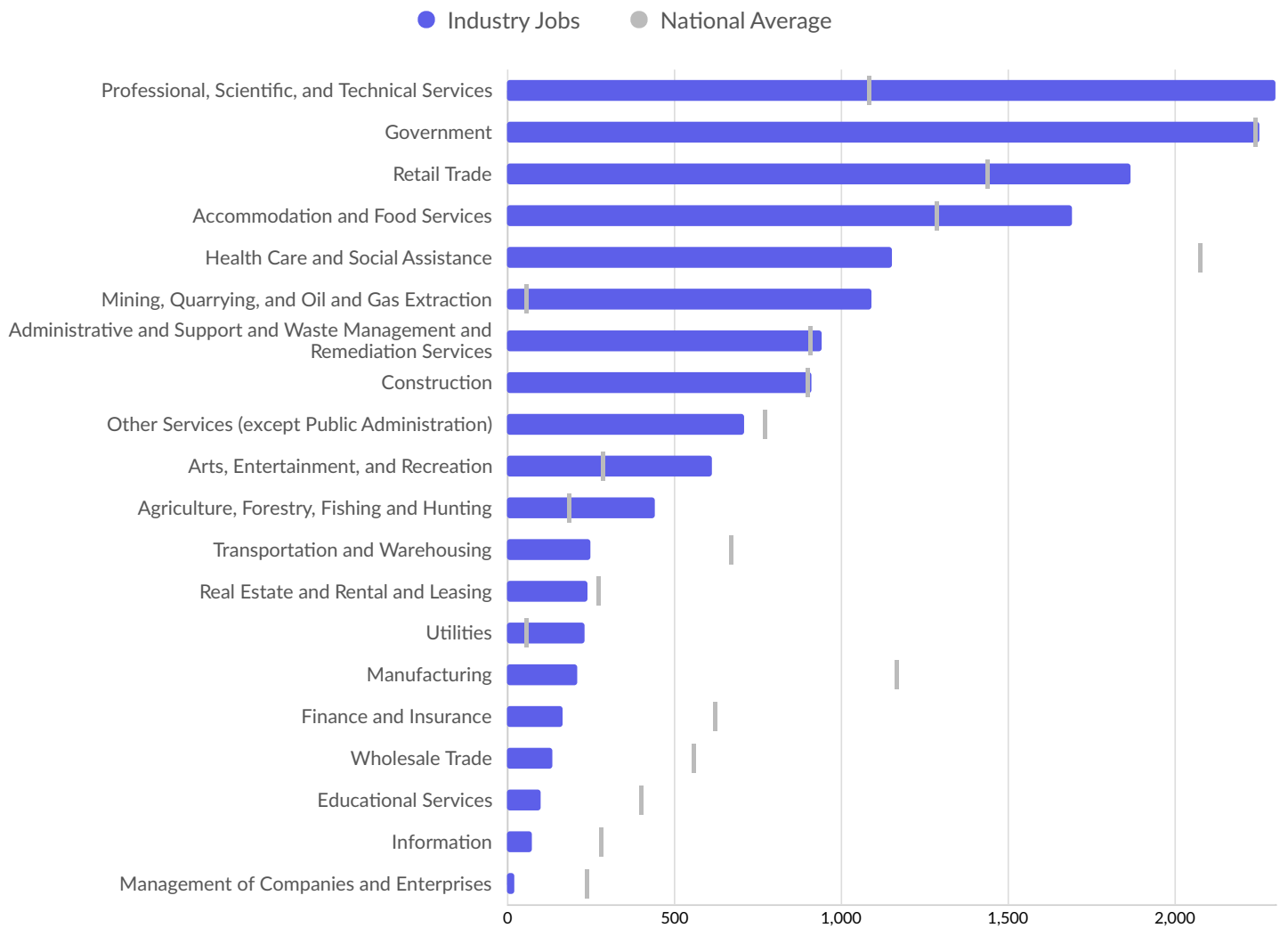

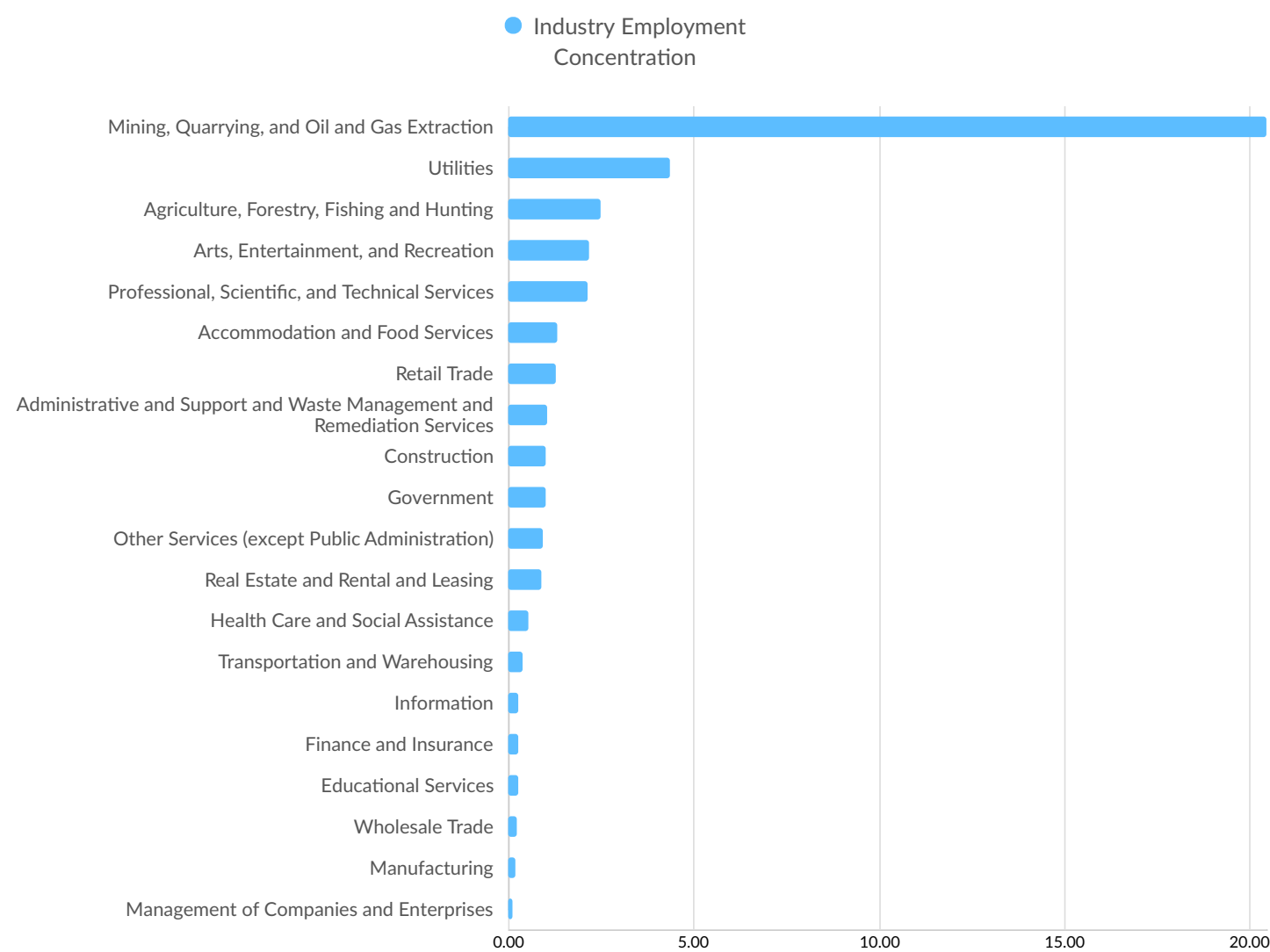

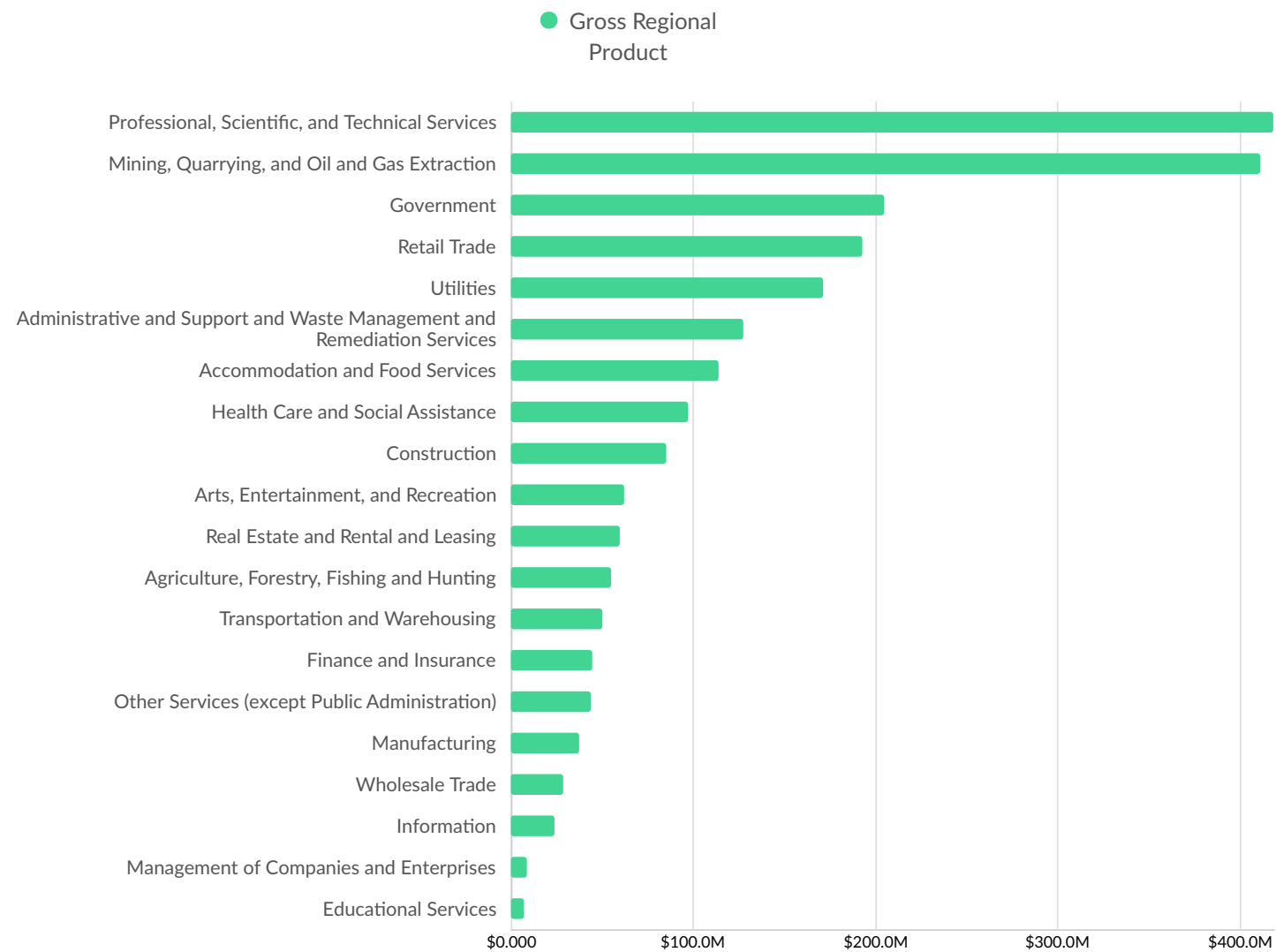
Top Growing Industries



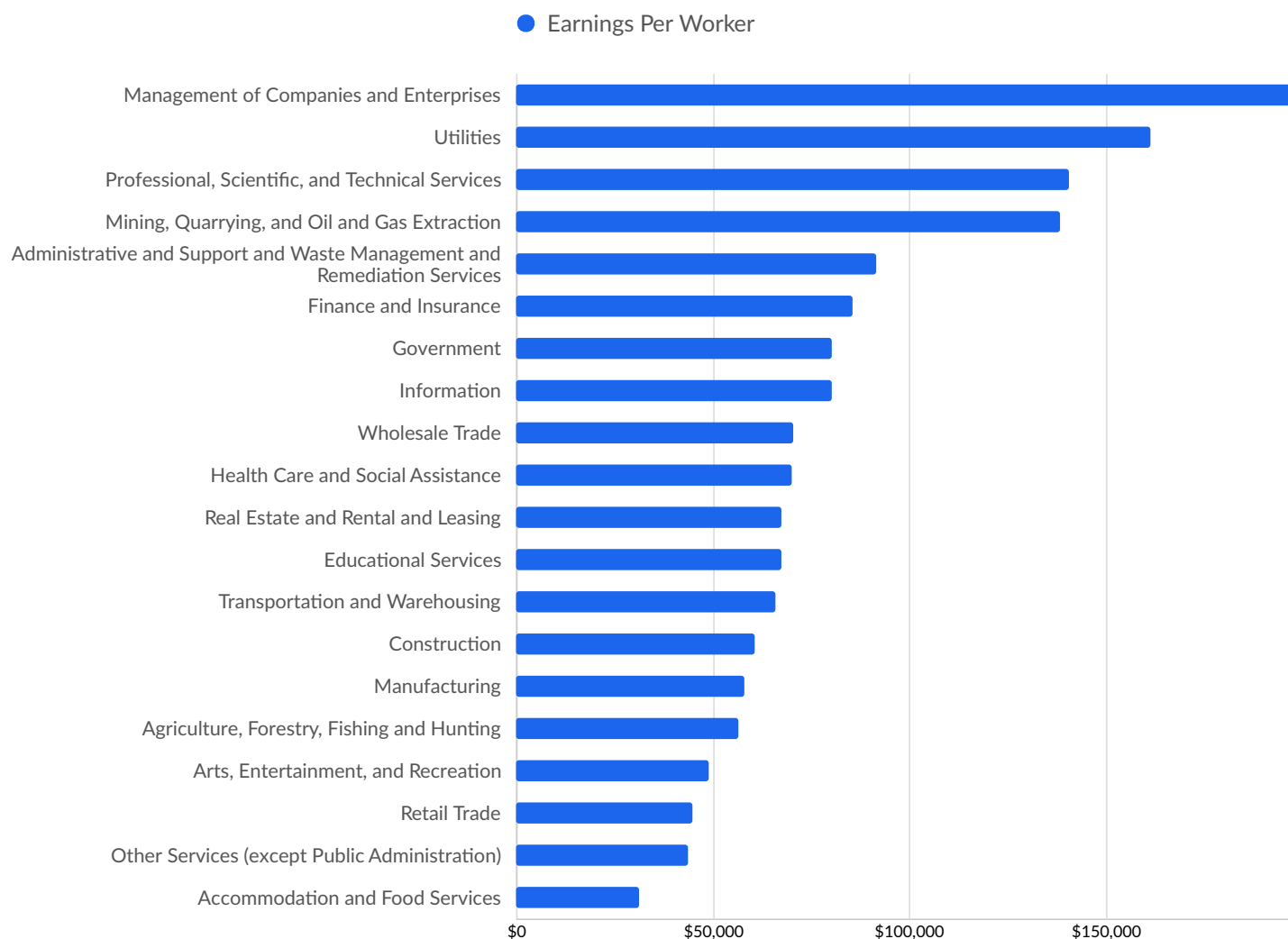
Top Industry Employment Concentration

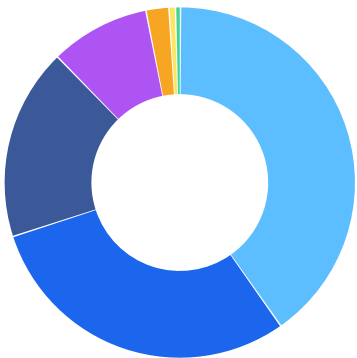

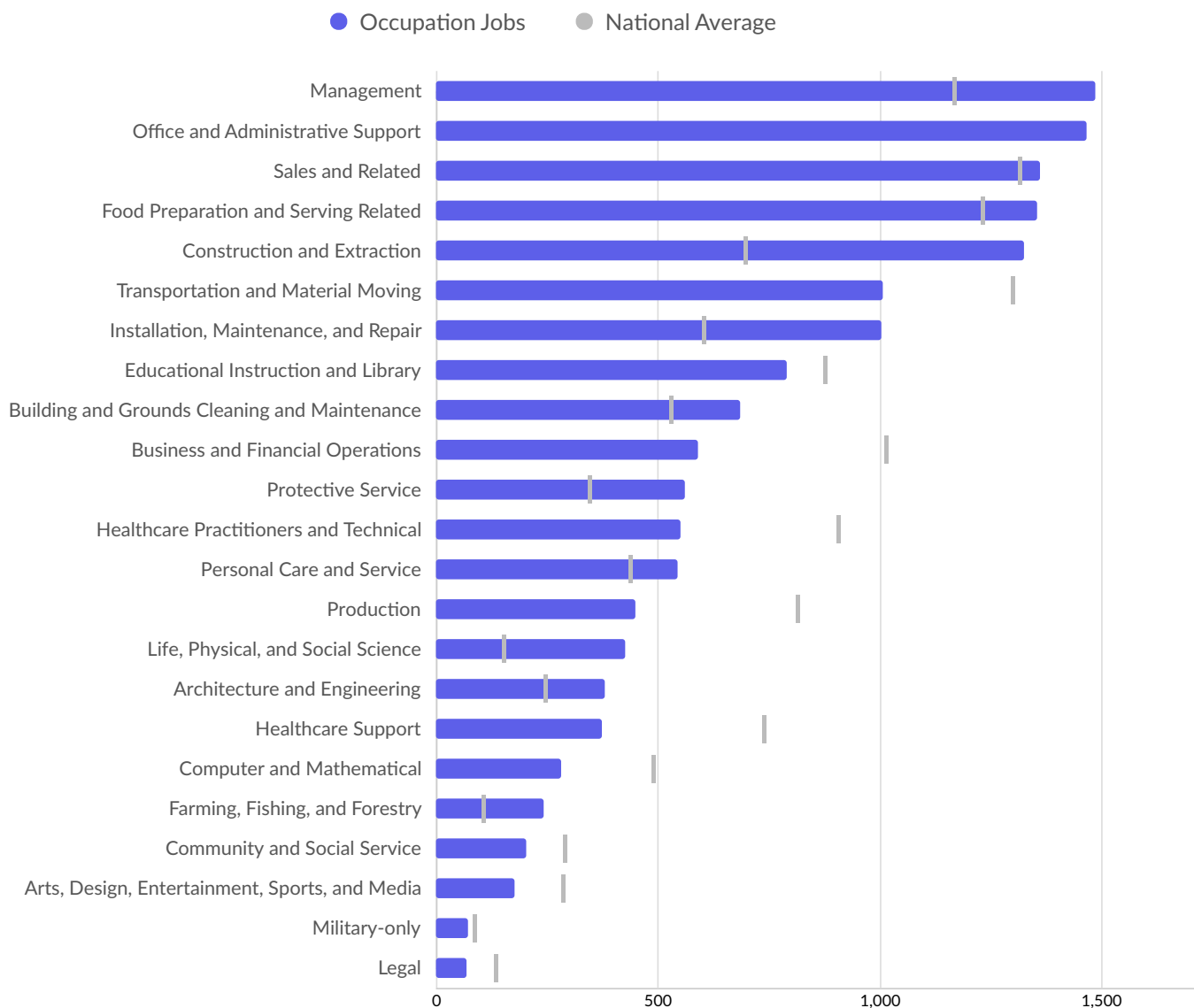

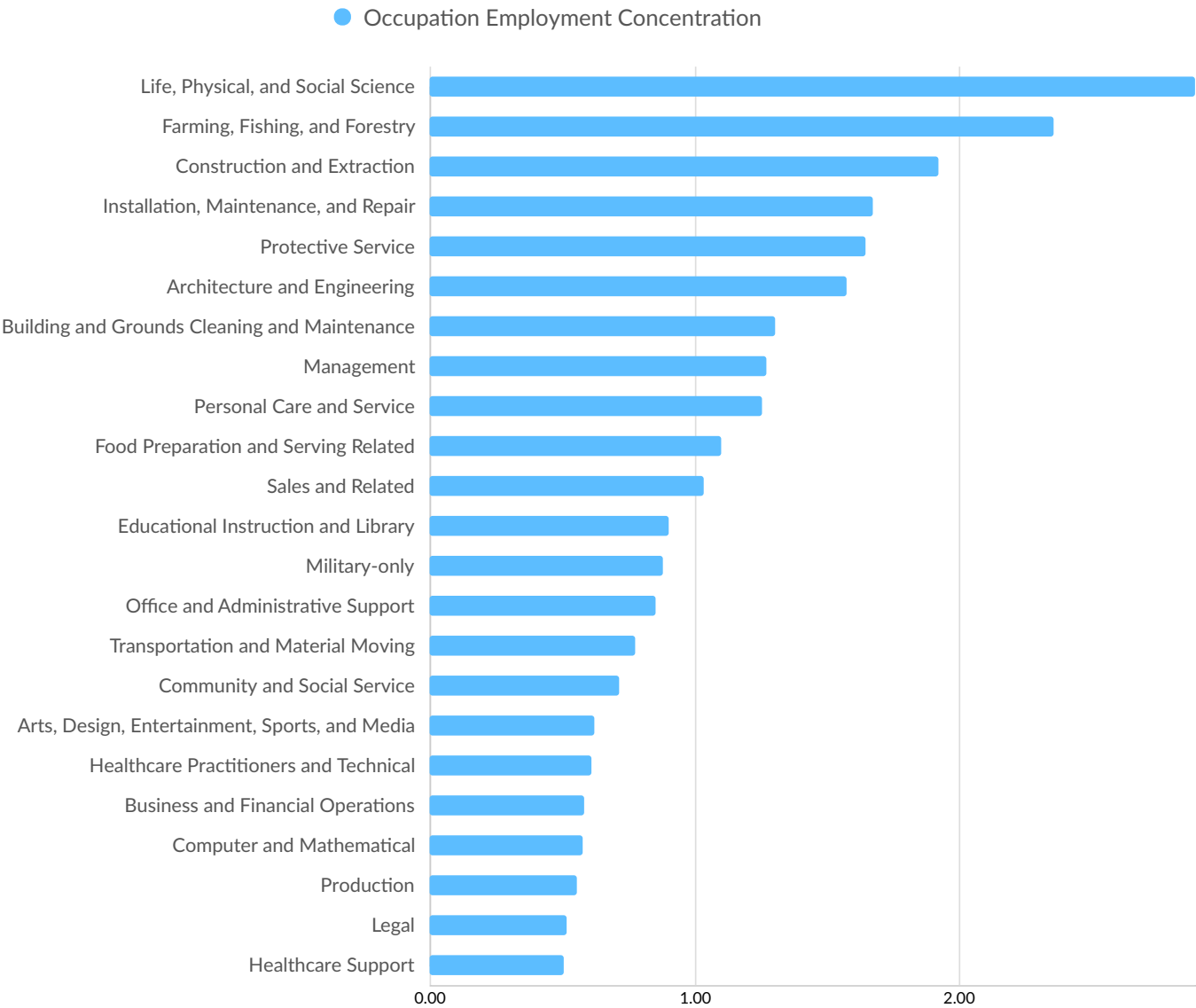

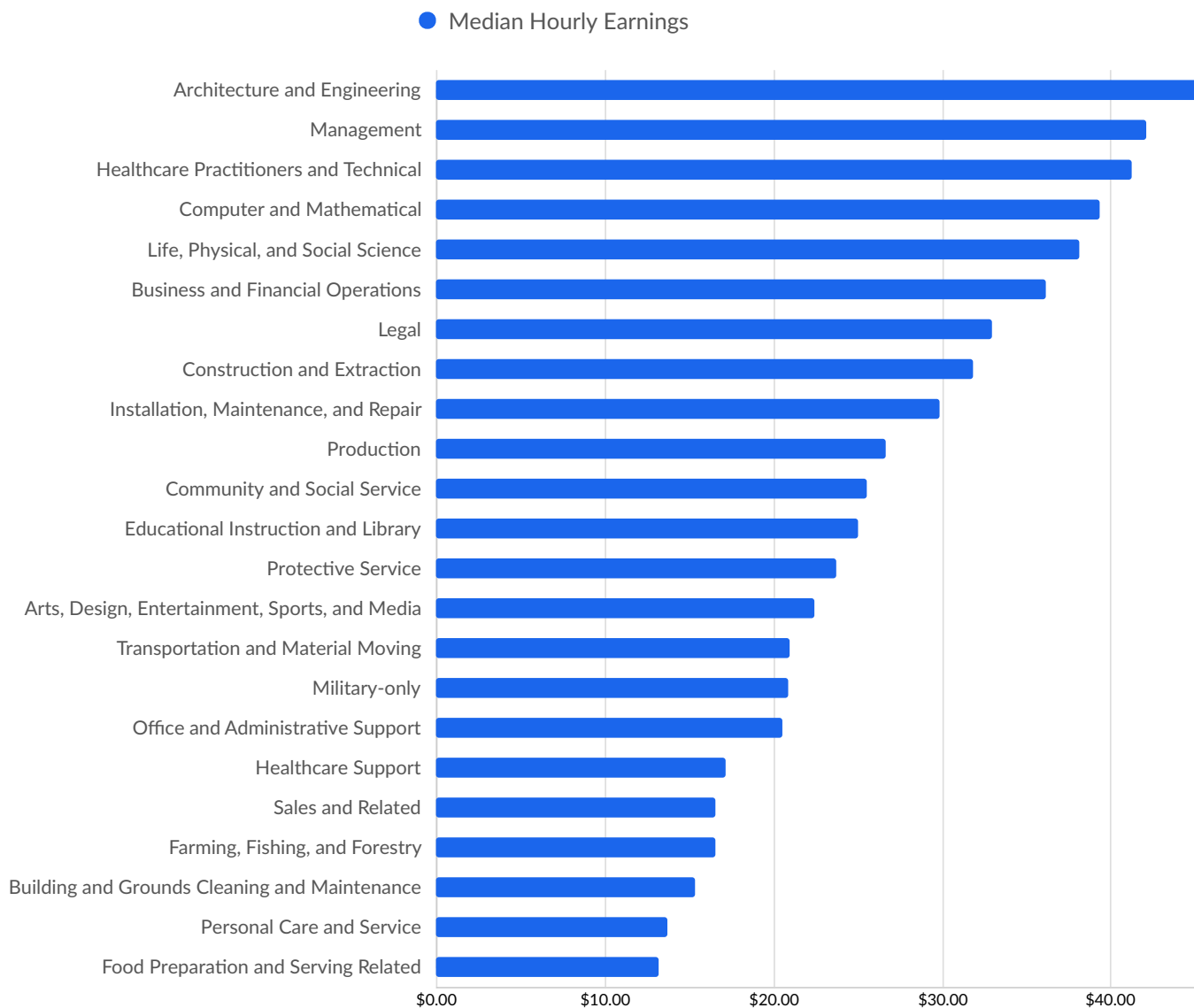
Top Growing Occupations



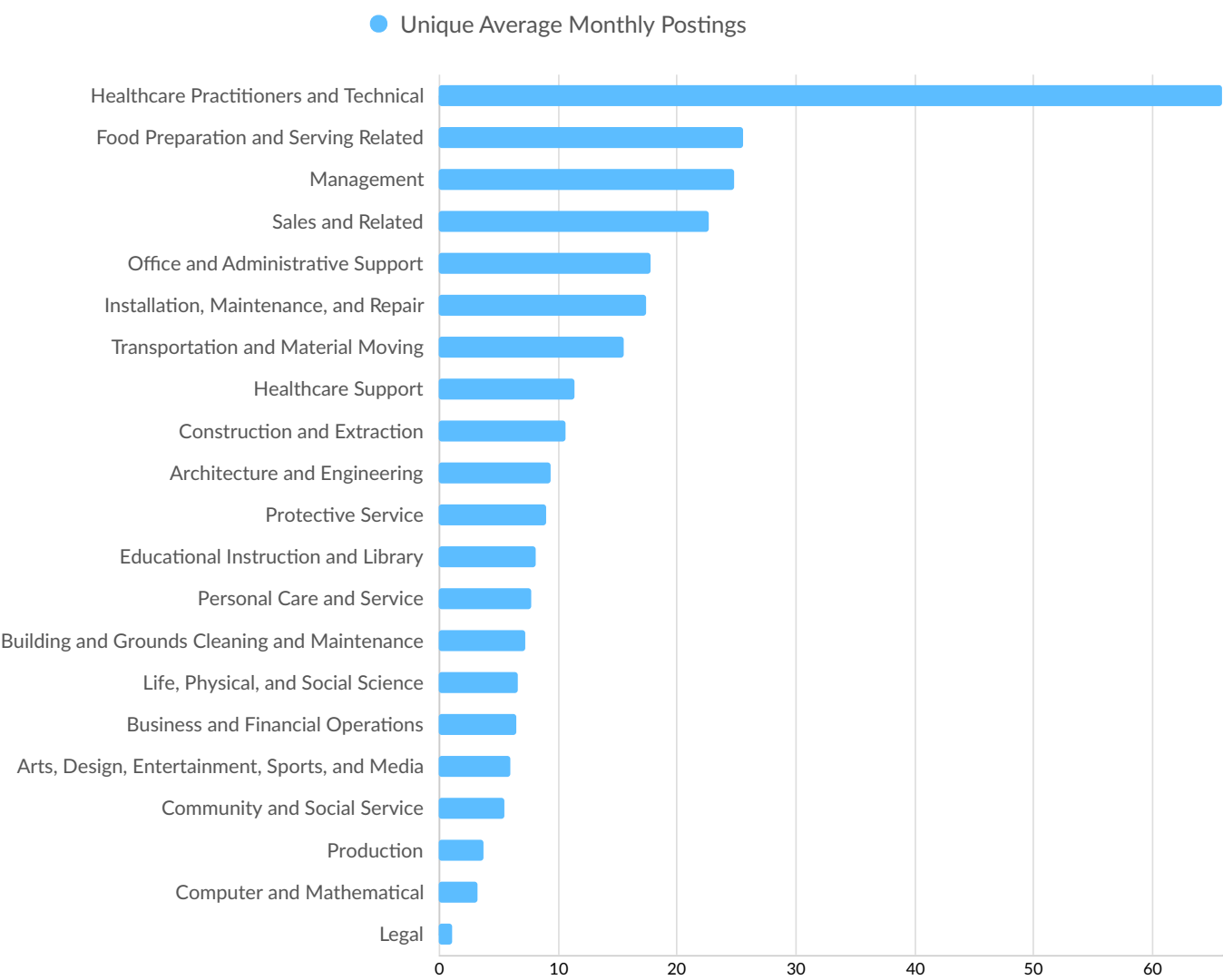
Top Occupation Employment Concentration



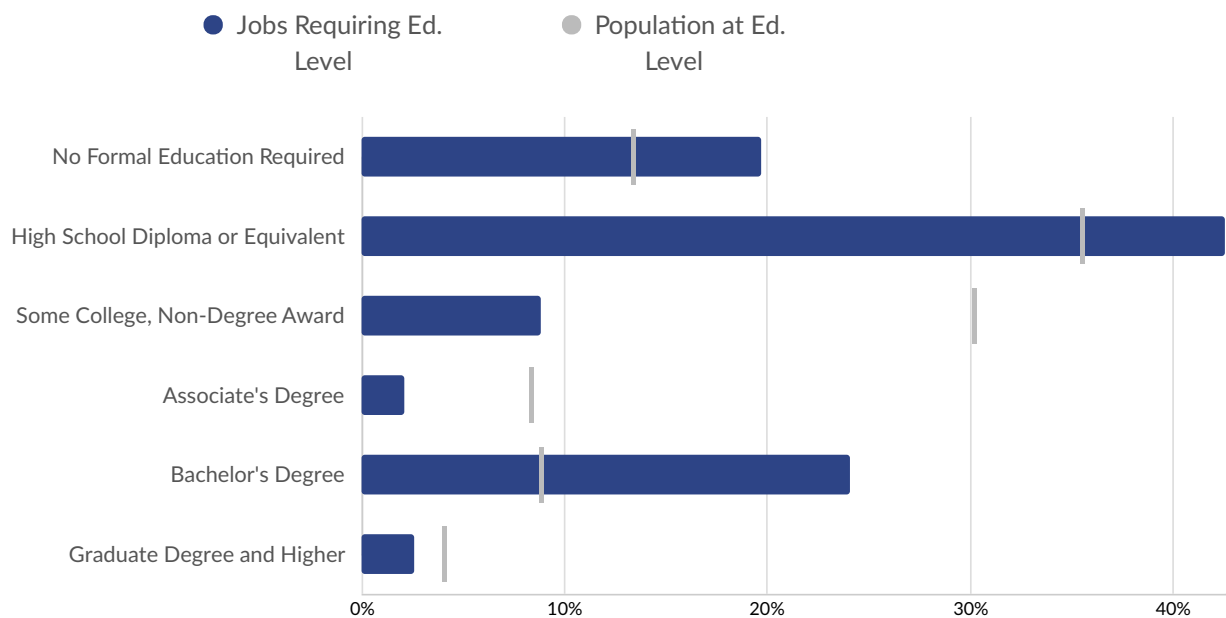
