Takeaways

- As of 2024 the region's population **declined by 4.6%** since 2019, falling by 306. Population is expected to **decrease by 4.0%** between 2024 and 2029, losing 251.
- From 2019 to 2024, jobs increased by 3.1% in Pershing County, NV from 2,120 to 2,186. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 4.3% by 1.2%. As the number of jobs increased, the labor force participation rate increased from 61.5% to 62.2% between 2019 and 2024.
- Concerning educational attainment, **4.3% of Pershing County, NV residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (17.2% below the national average), and **7.1% hold an Associate's Degree** (1.8% below the national average).
- The top three industries in 2024 are Metal Ore Mining, Education and Hospitals (Local Government), and State Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals.




May 2025 Labor Force Breakdown








Unemployment by Gender



Unemployment by Ethnicity







Job Trends





Unemployment Rate Trends


Pershing County, NV had a May 2025 unemployment rate of 4.32%, decreasing from 5.71% 5 years before.






Millennials


Pershing County, NV has 1,403 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 1,293.

Pershing County, NV has 0.79 violent crimes per 1,000 people. The national rate is 3.54 per 1,000 people.


Property Crime







Top Growing Industries




Top Industry Employment Concentration






Top Industry GRP






Top Growing Occupations






Top Occupation Employment Concentration








Top Occupation Earnings


