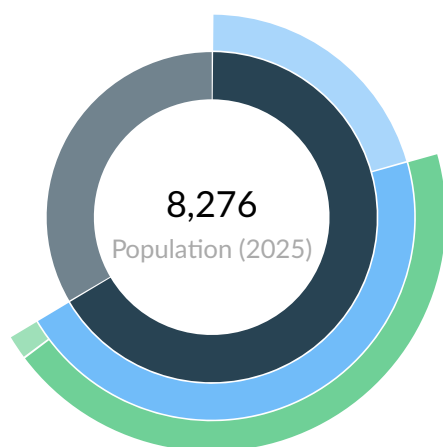
Median household income is **\$6.2K below** the national median household income of \$78.5K.

- As of 2024 the region's population **declined by 11.4%** since 2019, falling by 1,083. Population is expected to **decrease by 6.5%** between 2024 and 2029, losing 546.
- From 2019 to 2024, jobs **increased by 7.3%** in White Pine County, NV from 4,485 to **4,814**. This change **outpaced the national growth rate of 4.3% by 3.0%**. As the number of jobs increased, the **labor force participation rate increased from 58.4% to 64.8% between 2019 and 2024**.
- Concerning educational attainment, **11.2% of White Pine County, NV residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (10.3% below the national average), and **11.7% hold an Associate's Degree** (2.9% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2024 are Metal Ore Mining, Education and Hospitals (Local Government), and State Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals.

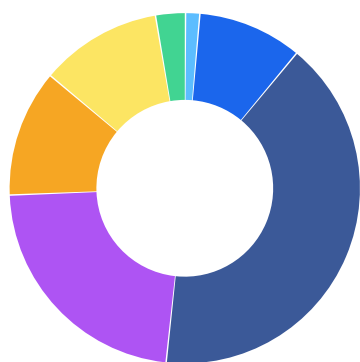

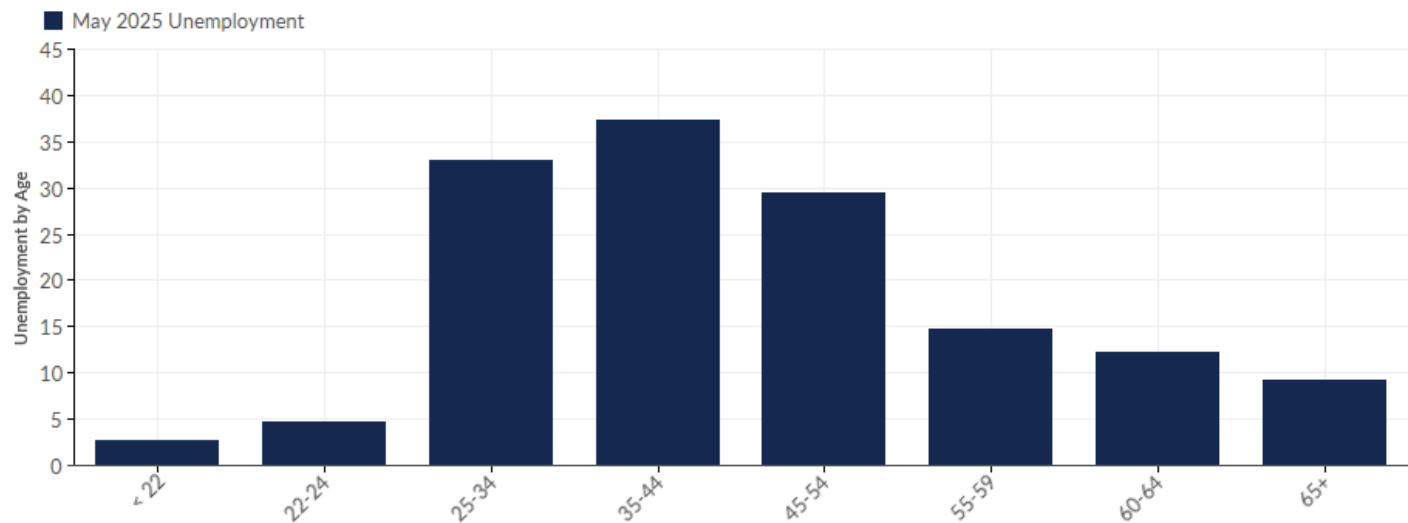

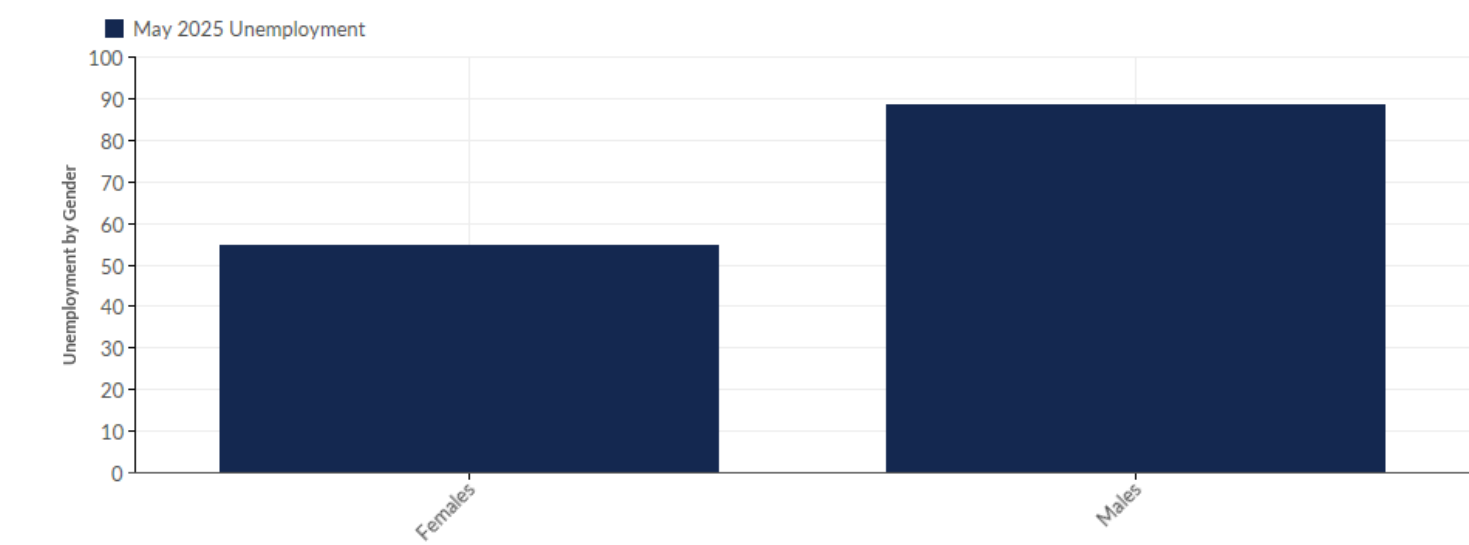

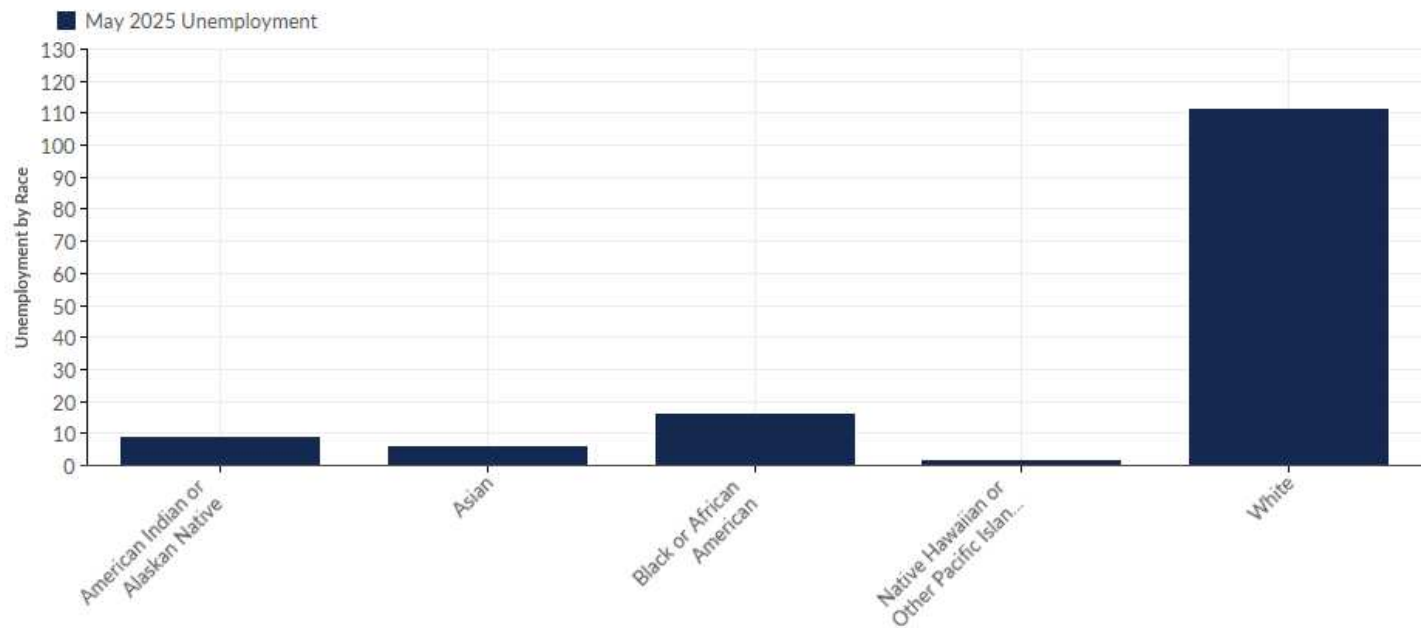

Unemployment by Gender



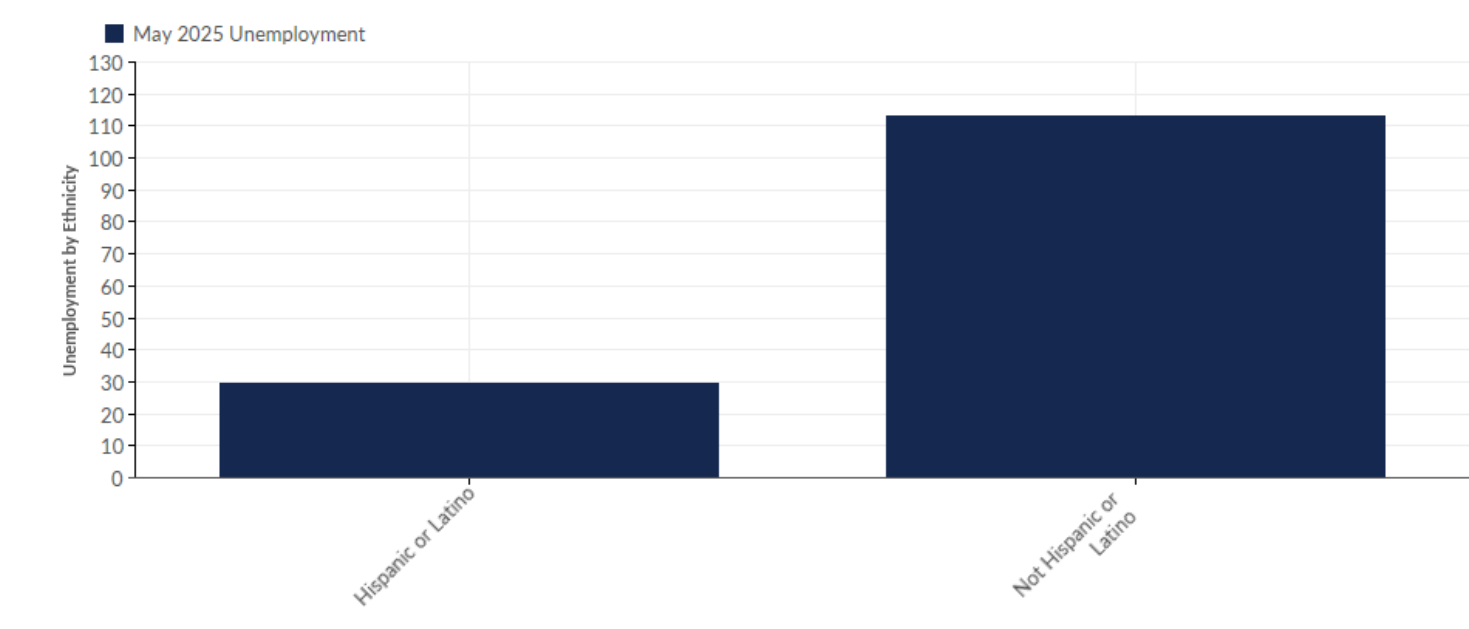

Unemployment by Ethnicity

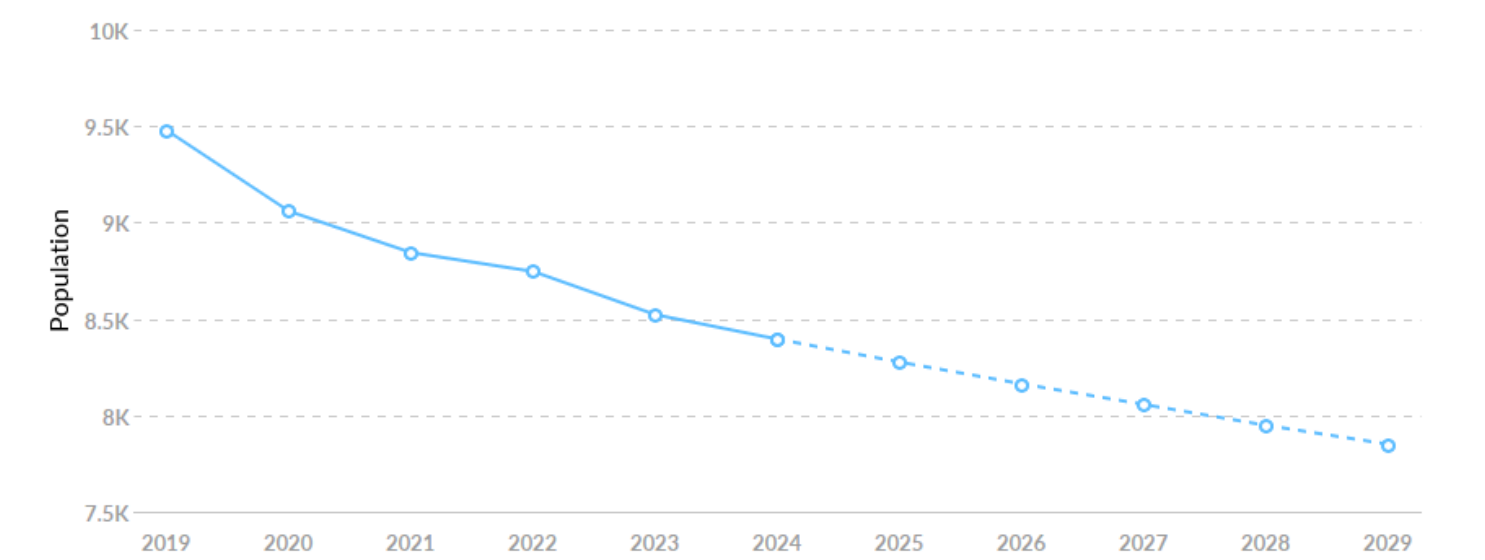

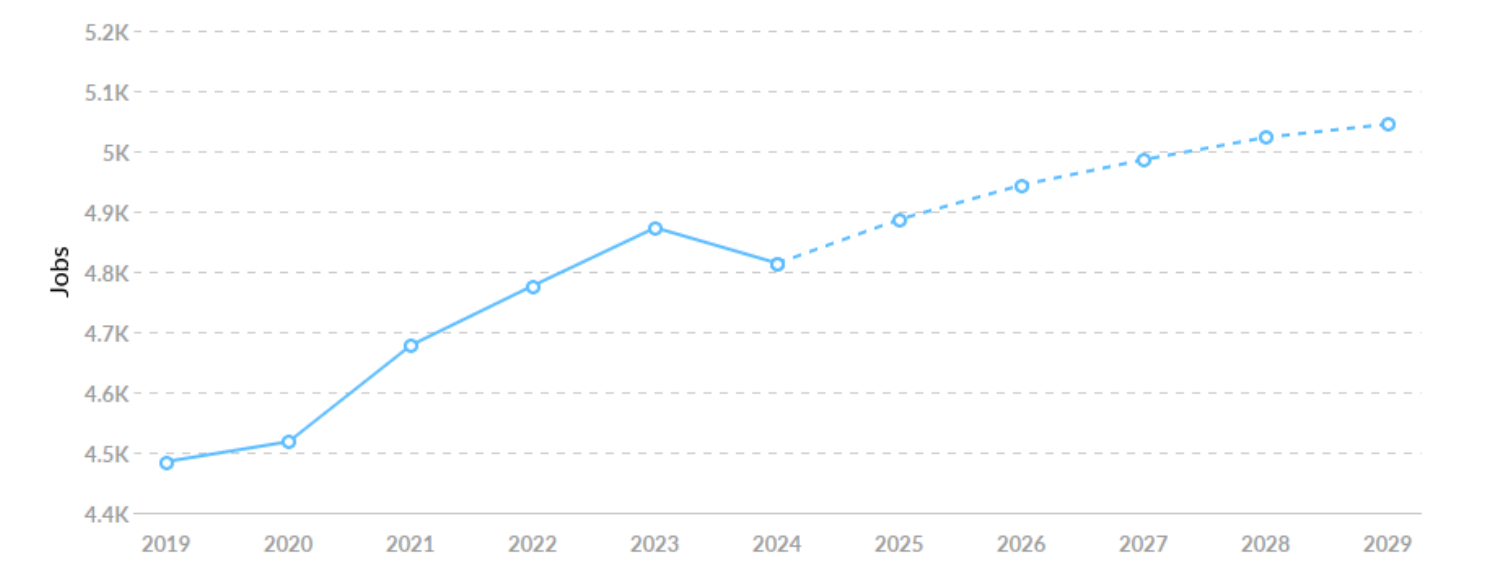

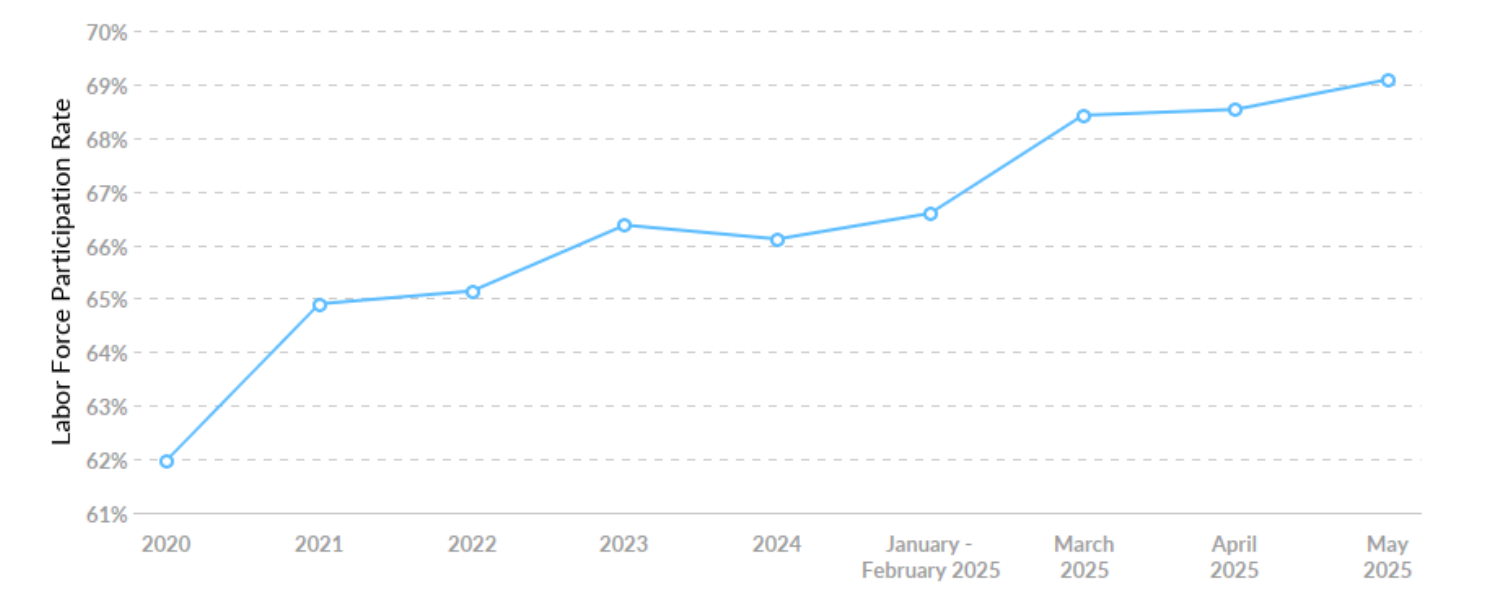
Job Trends

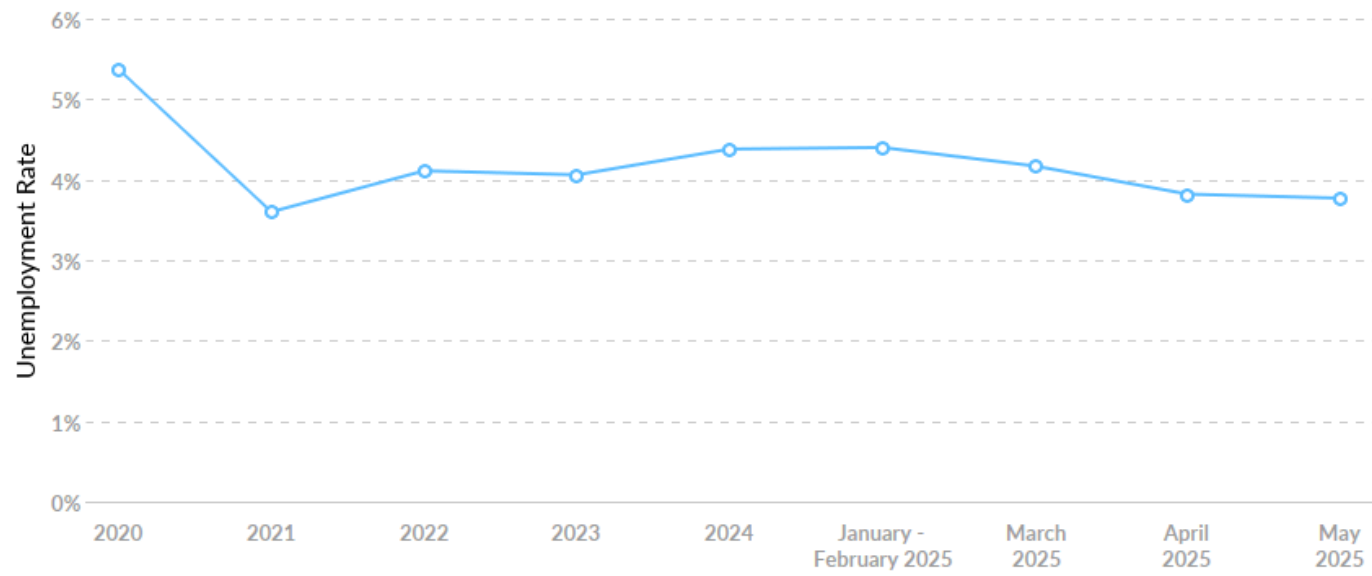

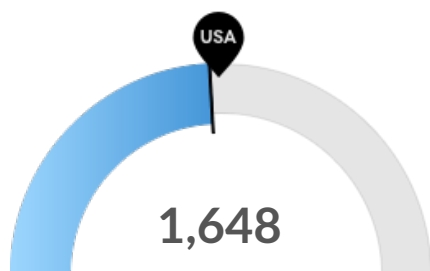
Unemployment Rate Trends

White Pine County, NV had a May 2025 unemployment rate of 3.77%, **decreasing from 5.37%** 5 years before.



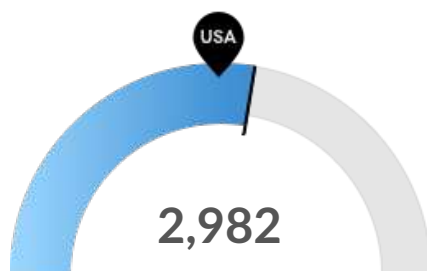

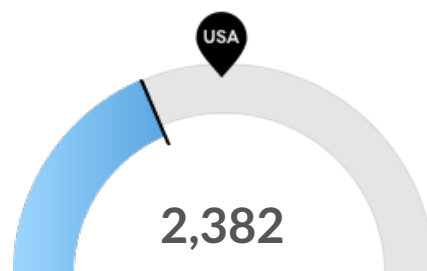
Millennials

White Pine County, NV has 1,648 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 1,732.



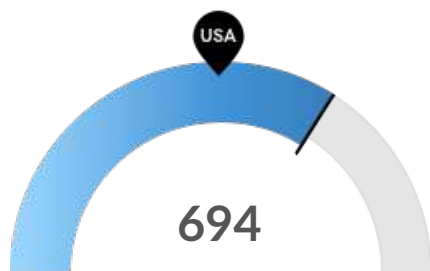
Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is high in White Pine County, NV. The national average for an area this size is 2,573 people 55 or older, while there are 2,982 here.



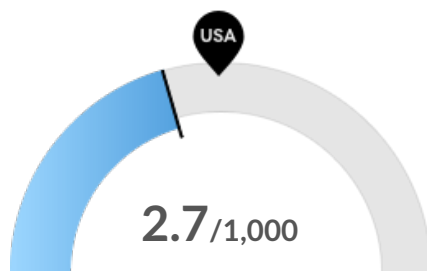
Racial Diversity

Racial diversity is low in White Pine County, NV. The national average for an area this size is 3,549 racially diverse people, while there are 2,382 here.



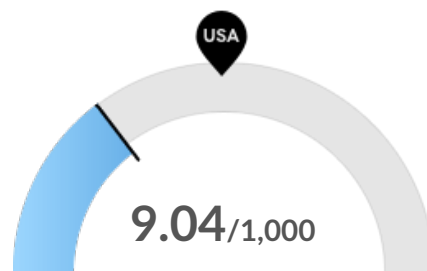
Veterans

White Pine County, NV has 2.7 violent crimes per 1,000 people. The national rate is 3.54 per 1,000 people.

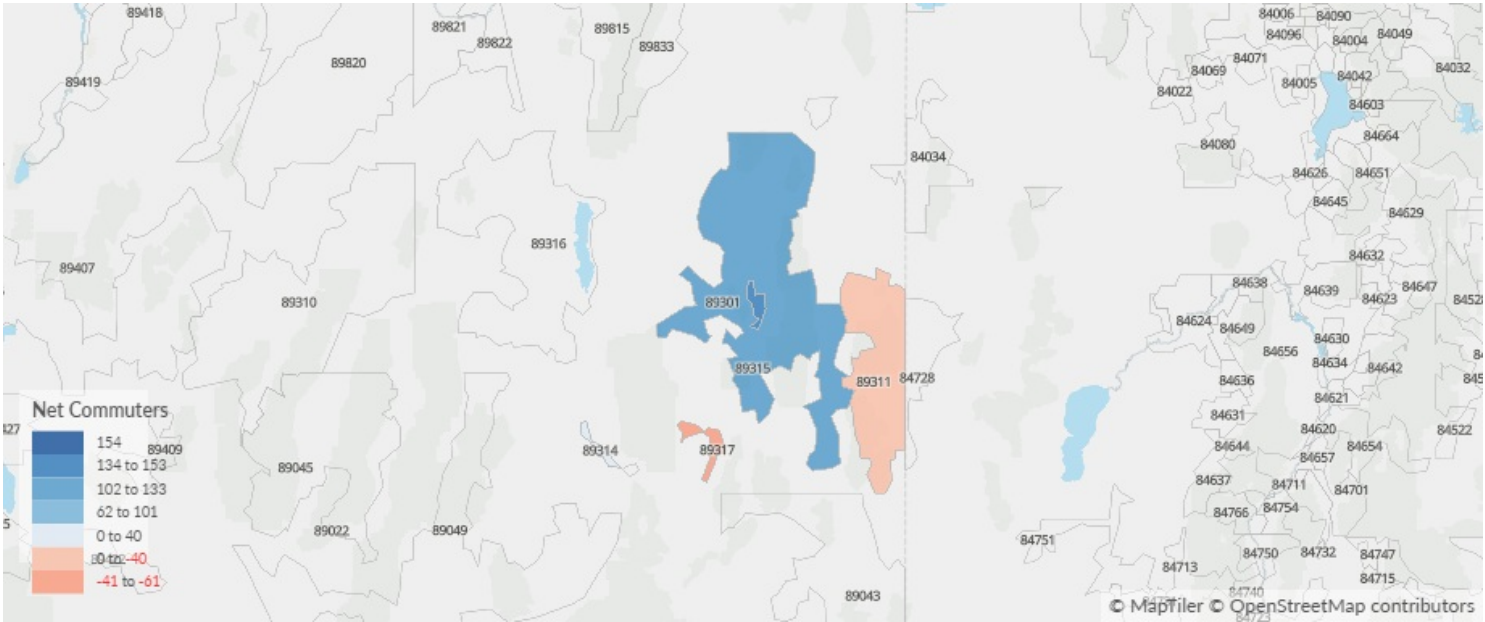


Property Crime

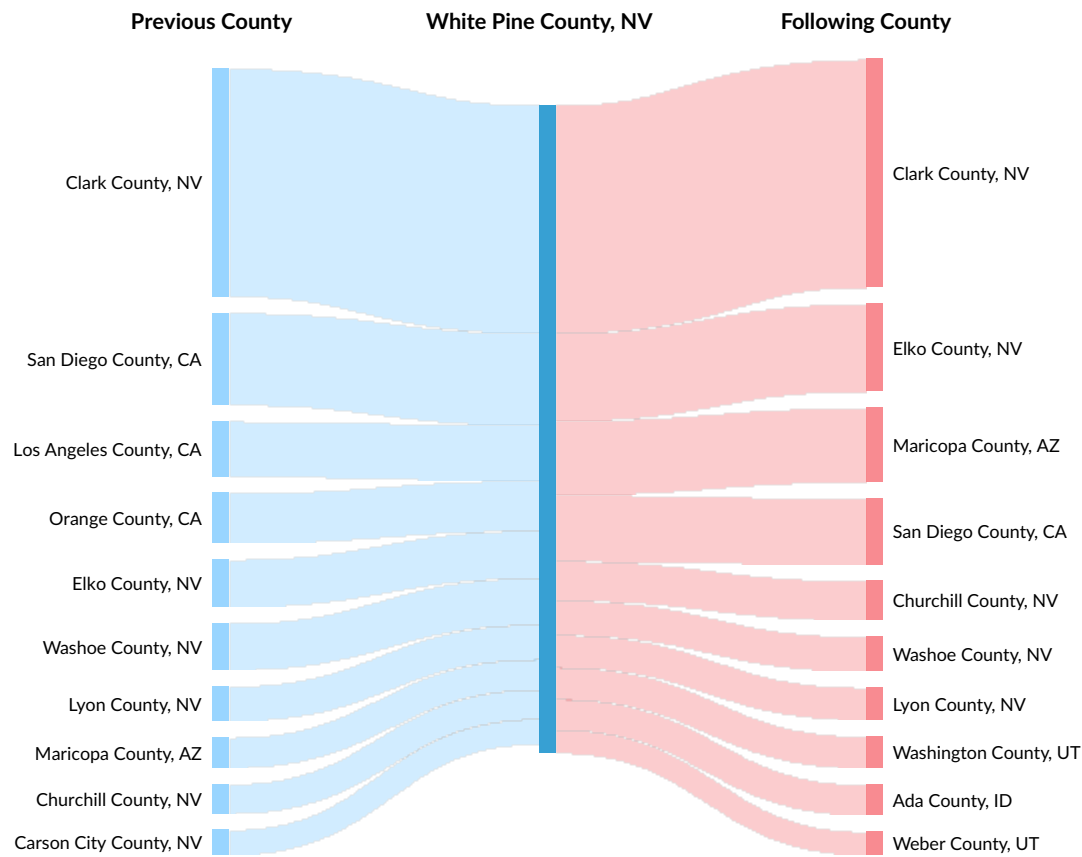

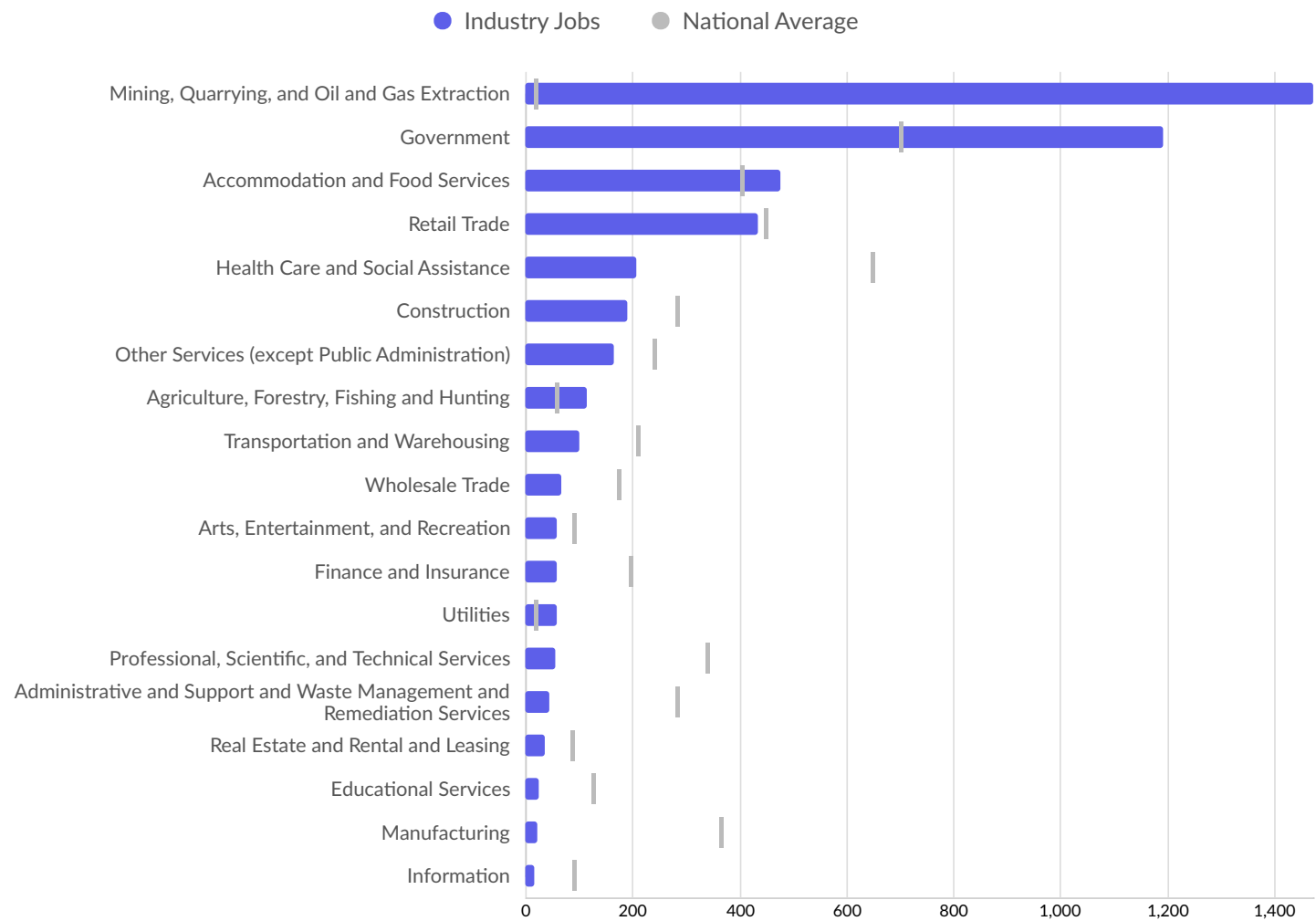

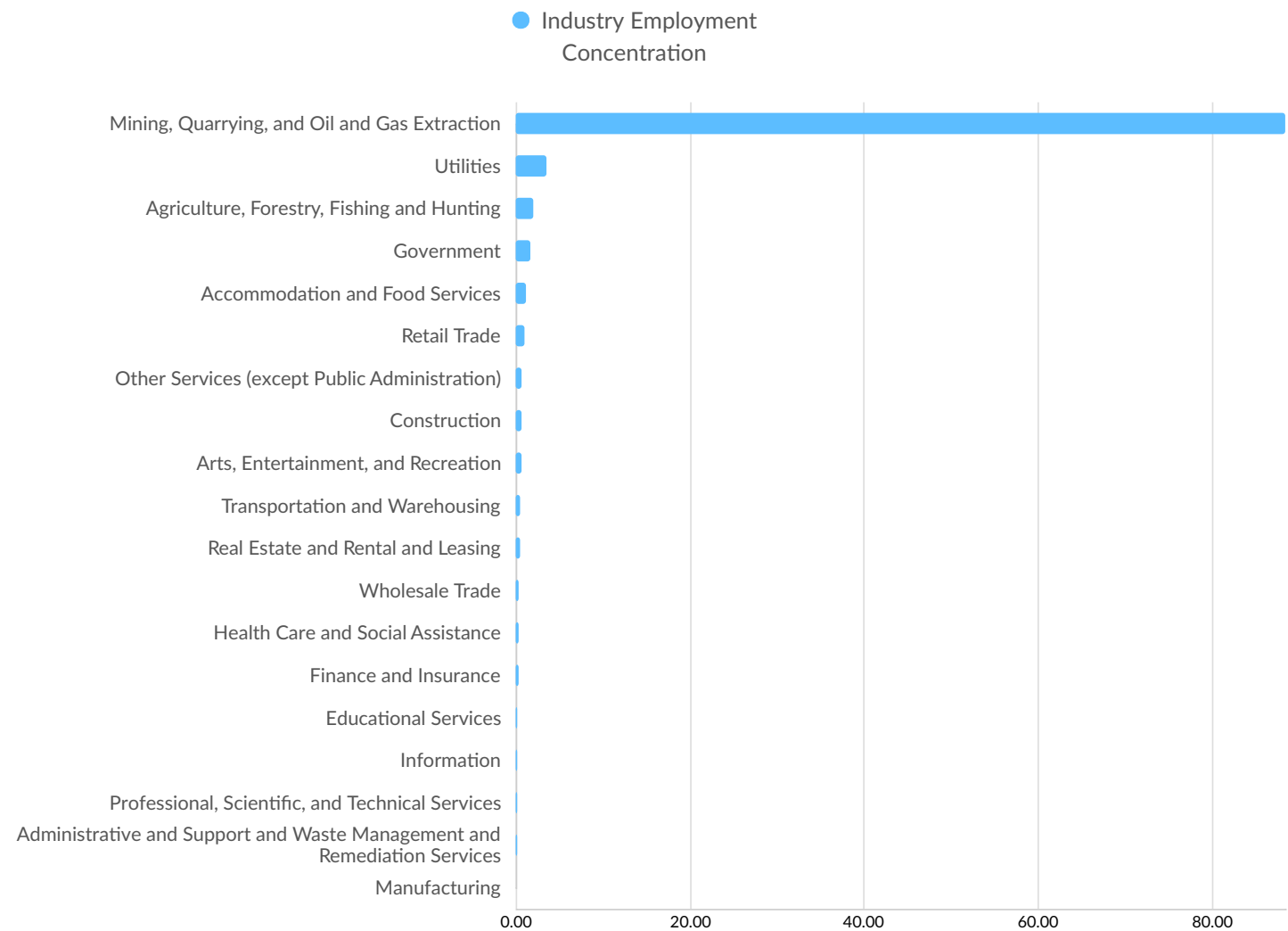

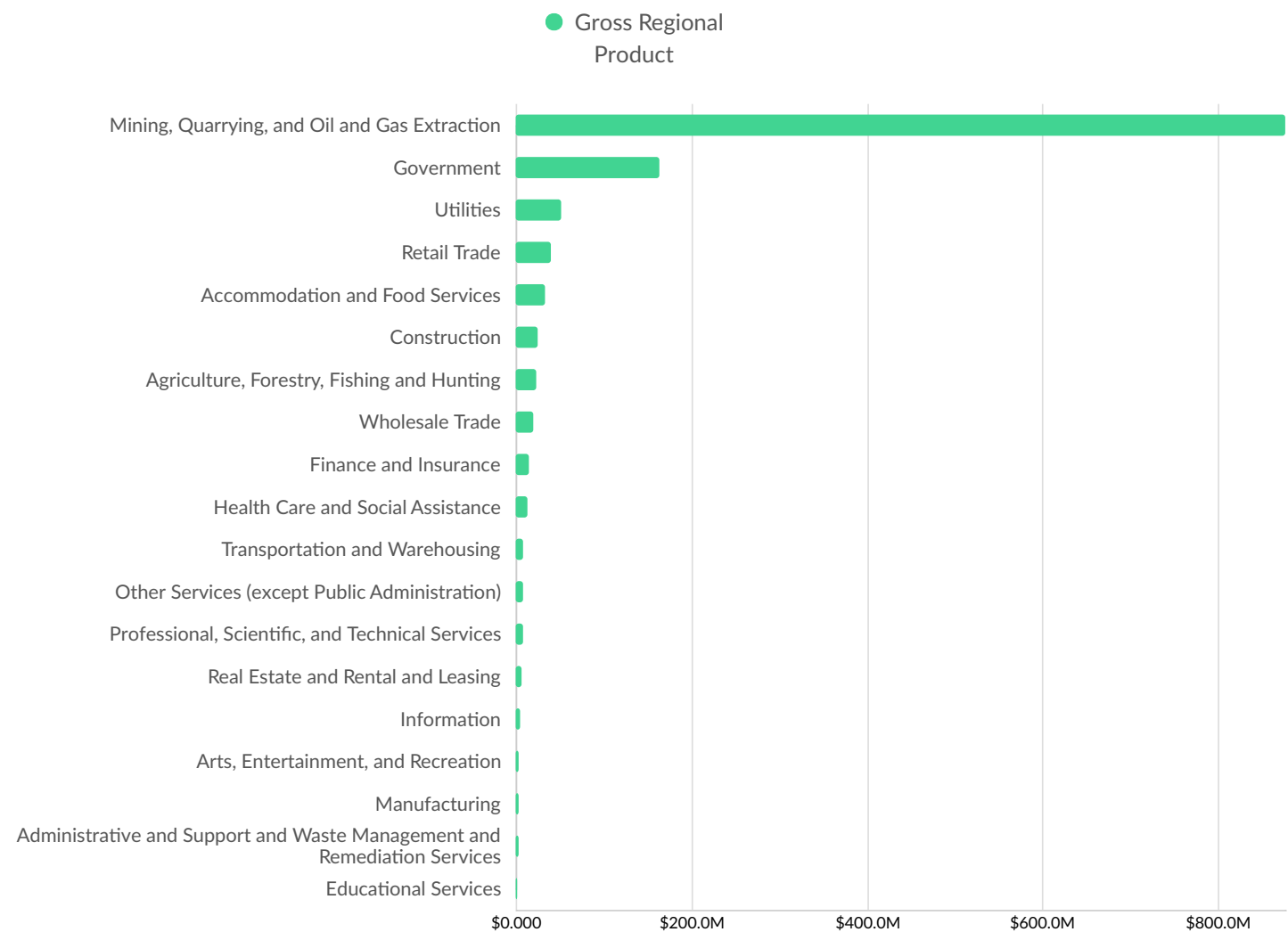
Top Growing Industries



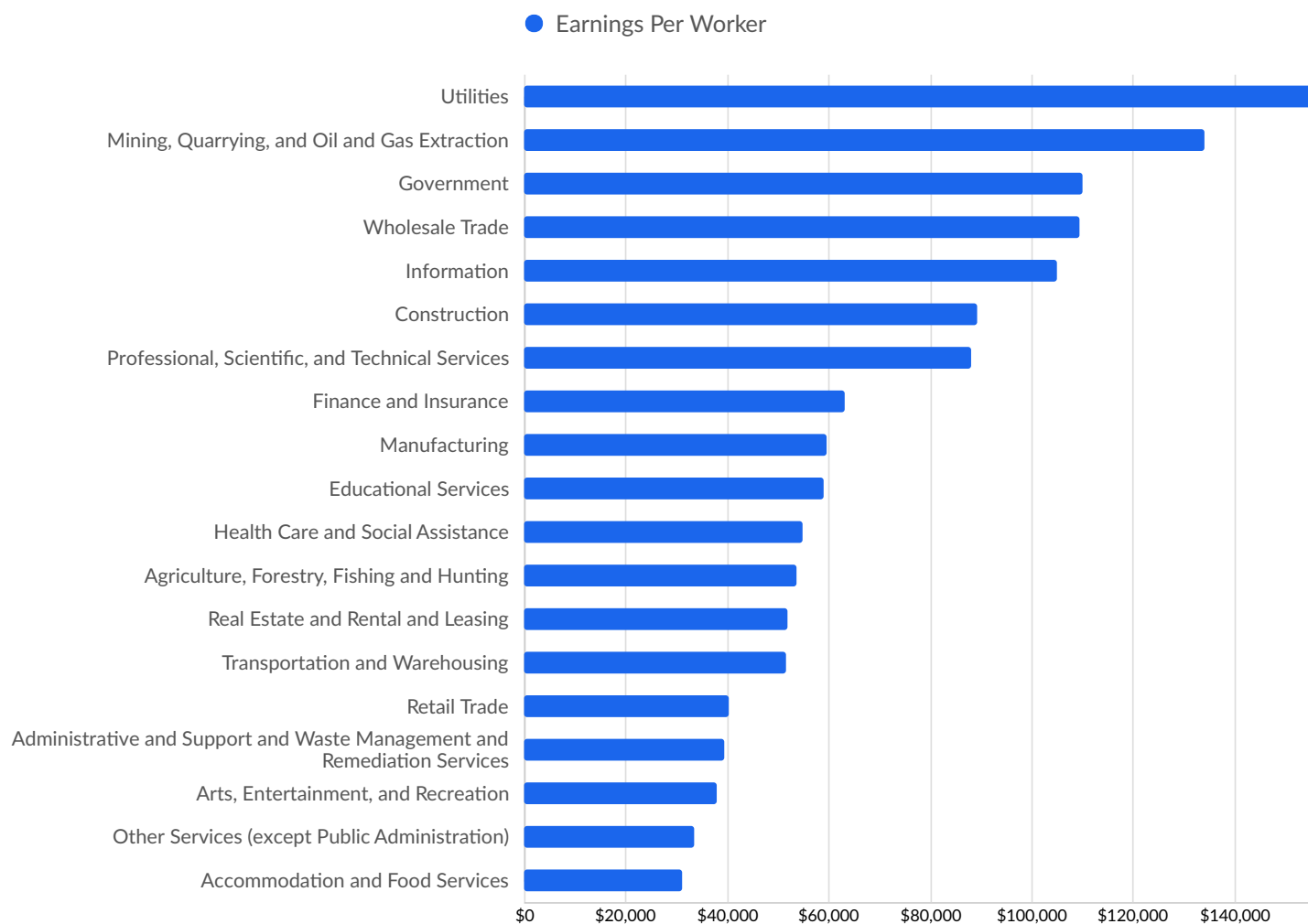
Top Industry Employment Concentration

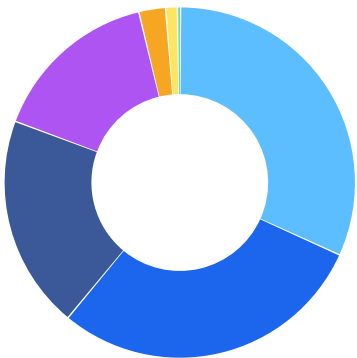

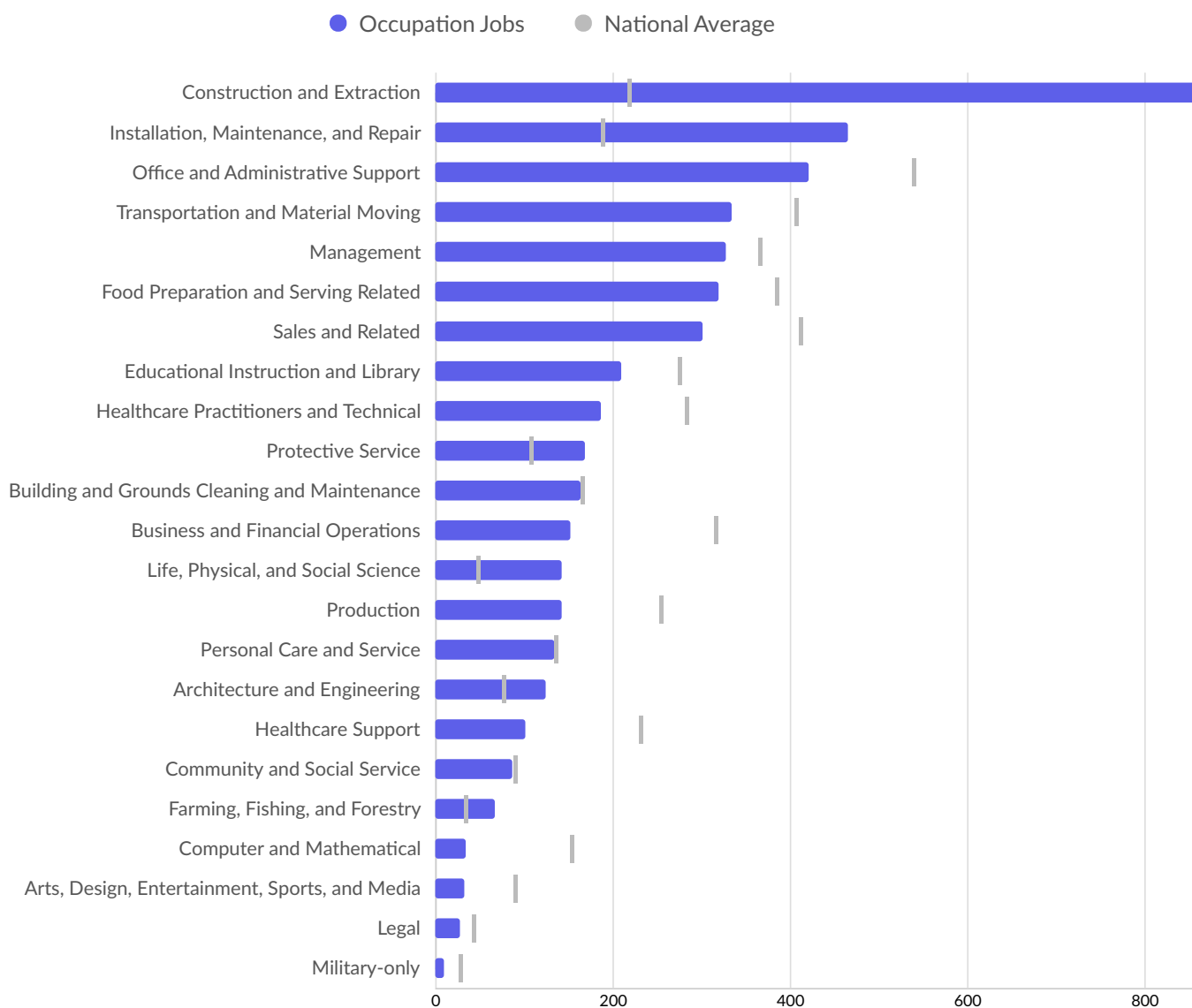

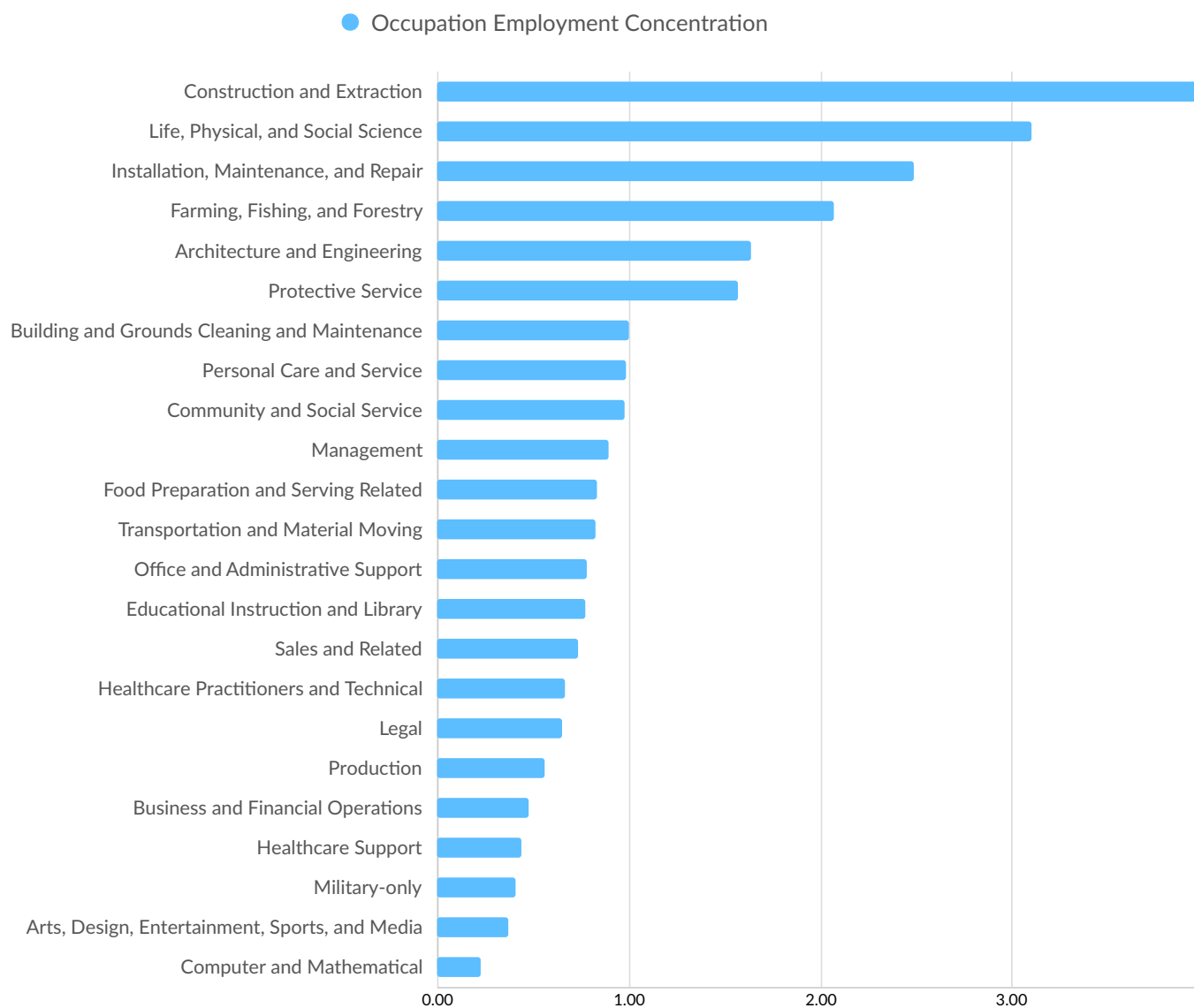

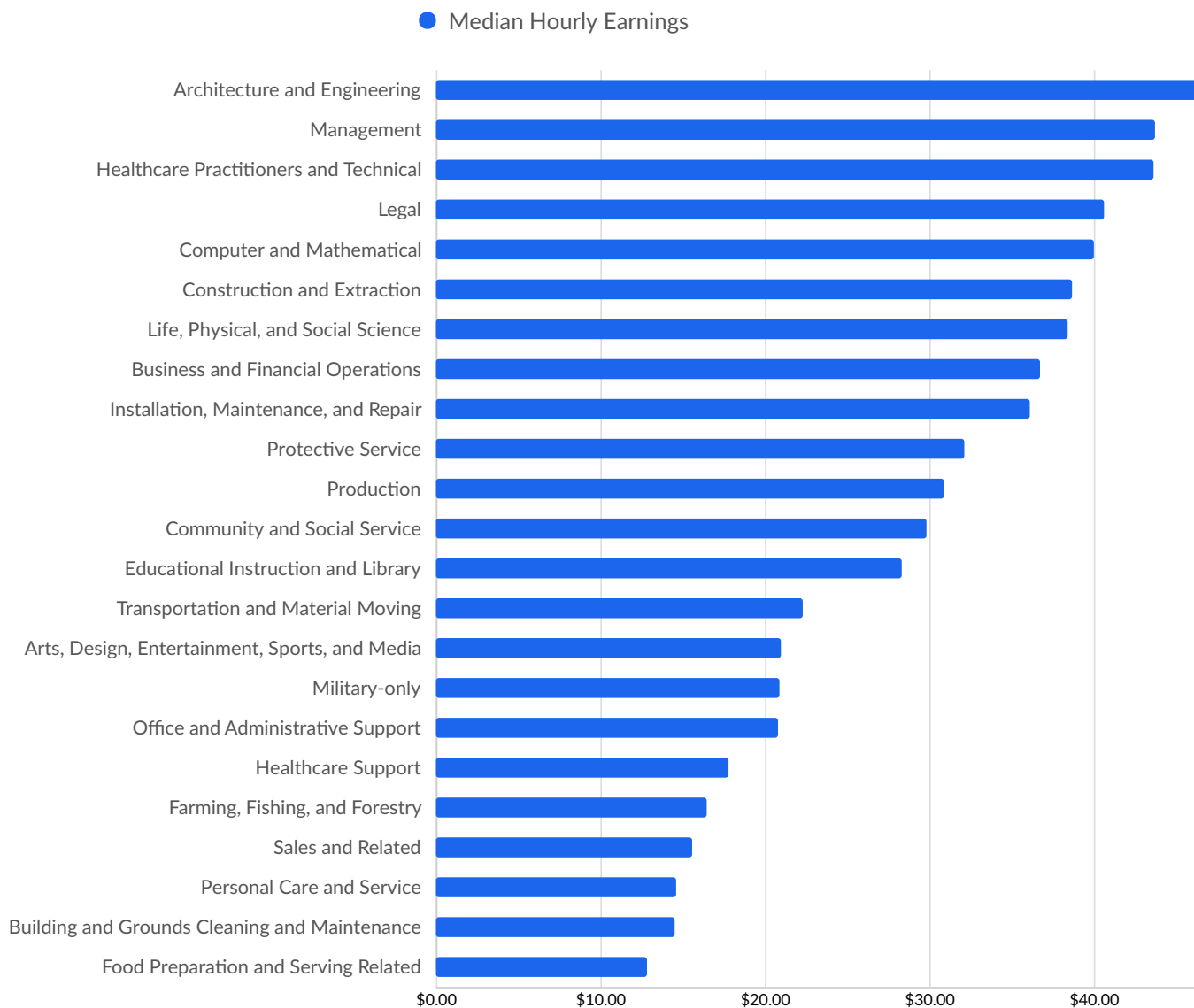
Top Growing Occupations



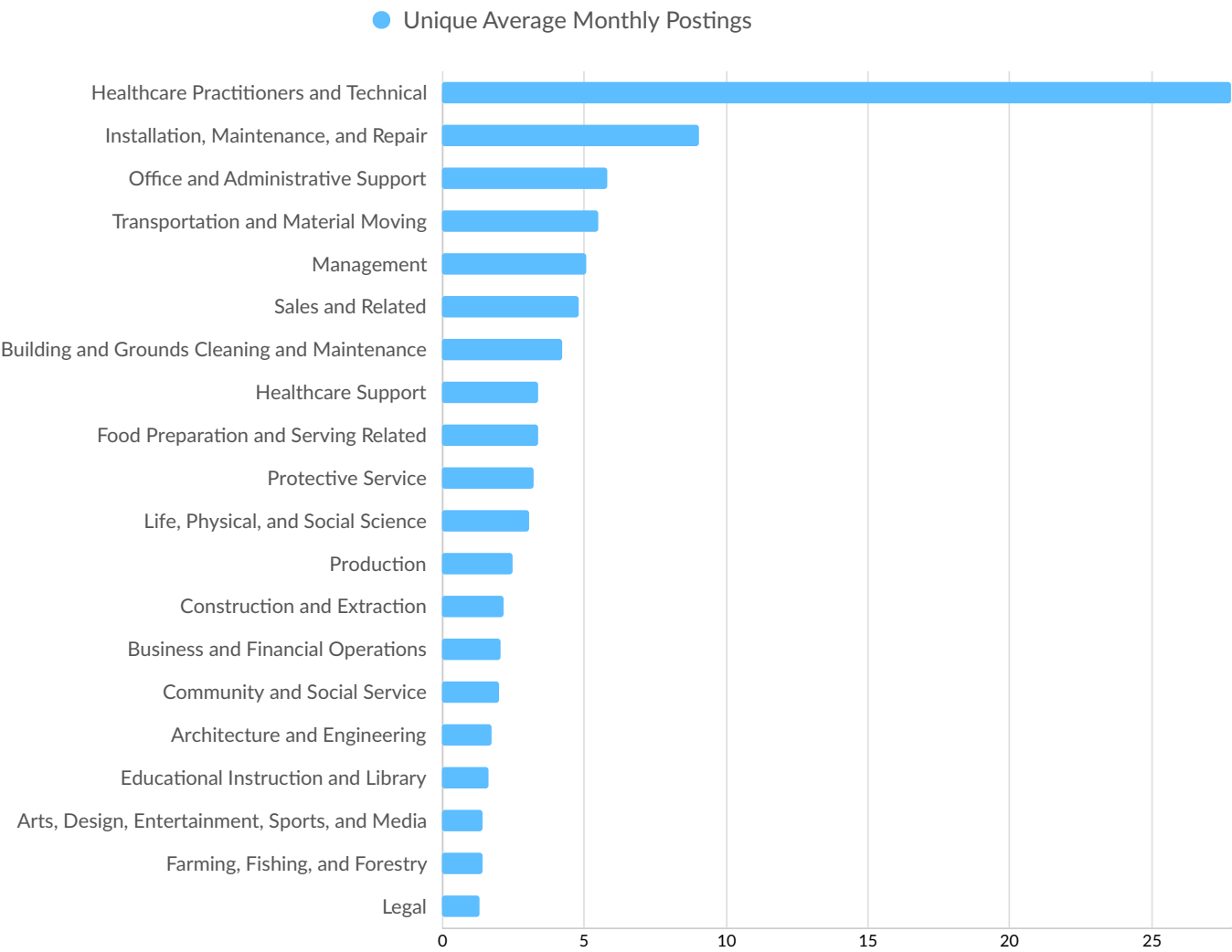
Top Occupation Employment Concentration



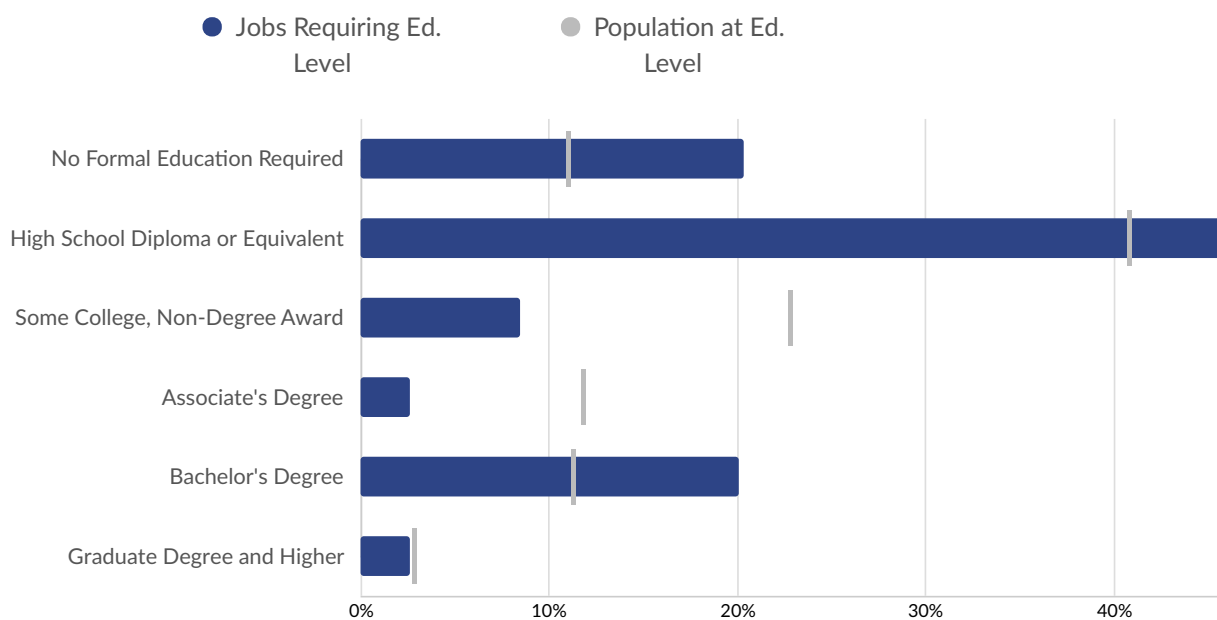
