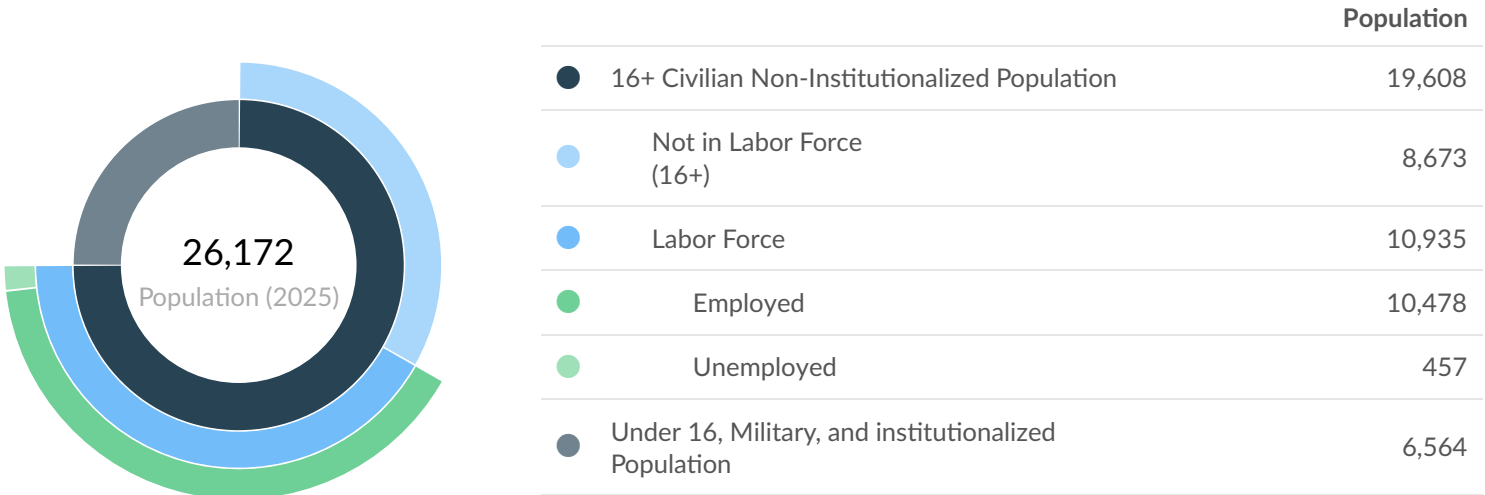
Median household income is **\$5.3K below** the national median household income of \$78.5K.

Takeaways

- As of 2024 the region's population **increased by 3.9%** since 2019, growing by 985. Population is expected to **increase by 2.8%** between 2024 and 2029, adding 724.
- From 2019 to 2024, jobs **increased by 8.7%** in Churchill County, NV from 10,295 to **11,186**. This change **outpaced the national growth rate of 4.4% by 4.3%**. As the number of jobs increased, the **labor force participation rate increased from 55.1% to 55.6% between 2019 and 2024**.
- Concerning educational attainment, **13.0% of Churchill County, NV residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (8.5% below the national average), and **13.5% hold an Associate's Degree** (4.6% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2024 are Federal Government, Military, Federal Government, Civilian, and Local Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals.

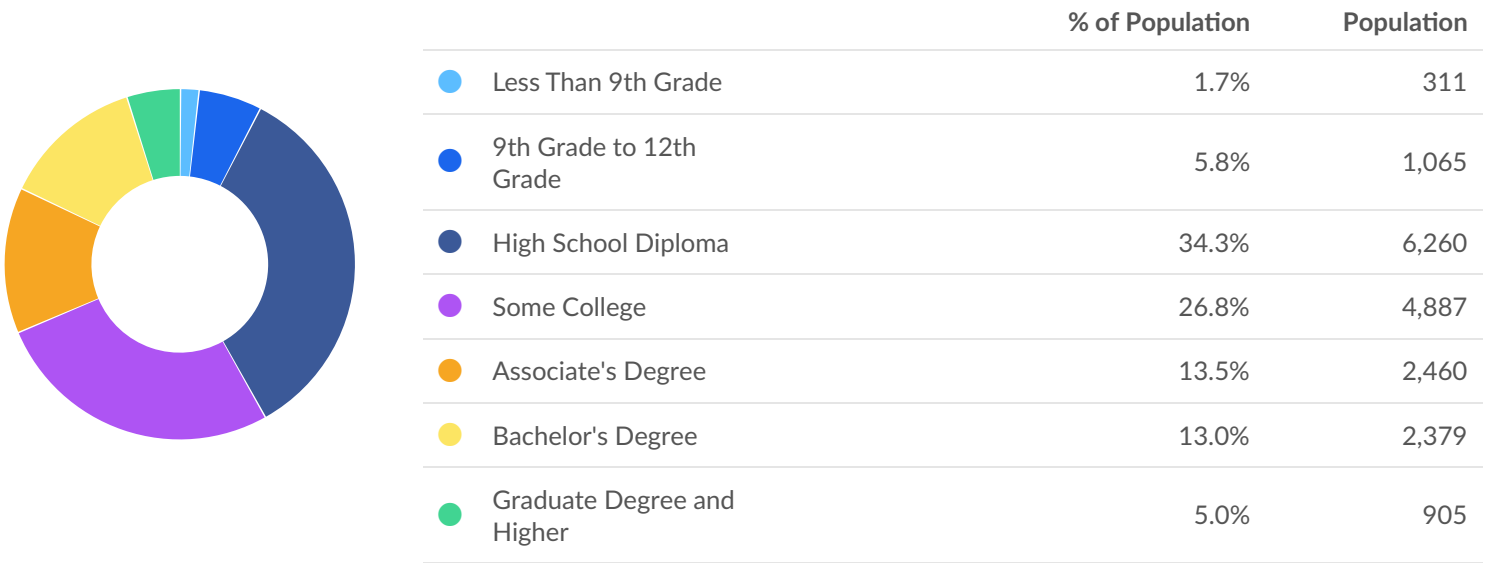

Aug 2025 Labor Force Breakdown



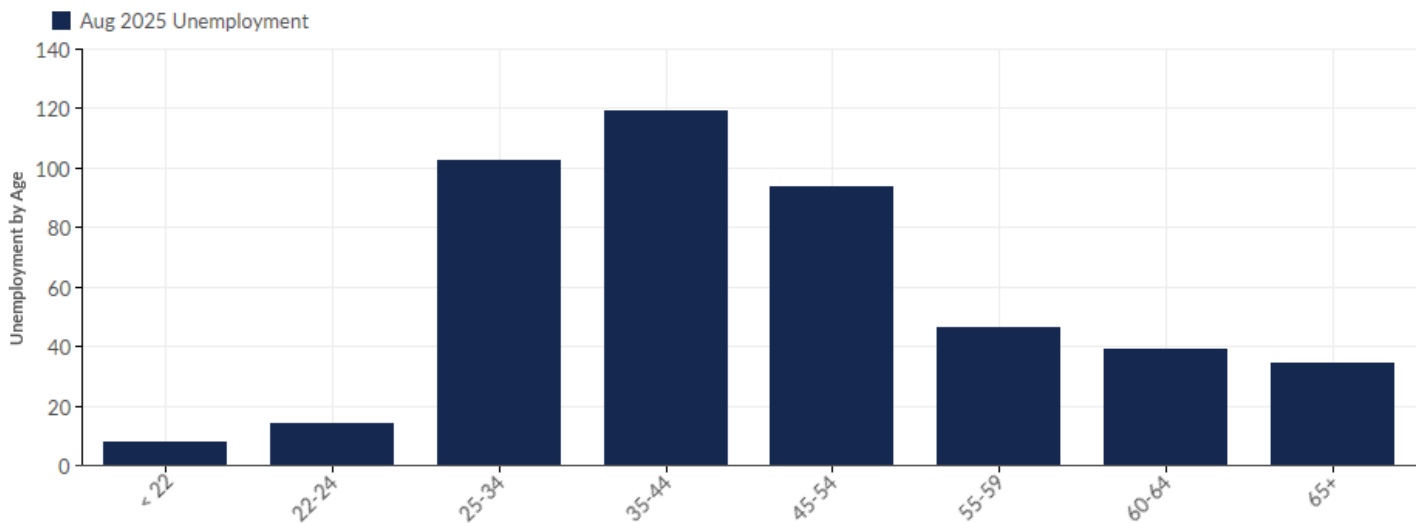
Educational Attainment

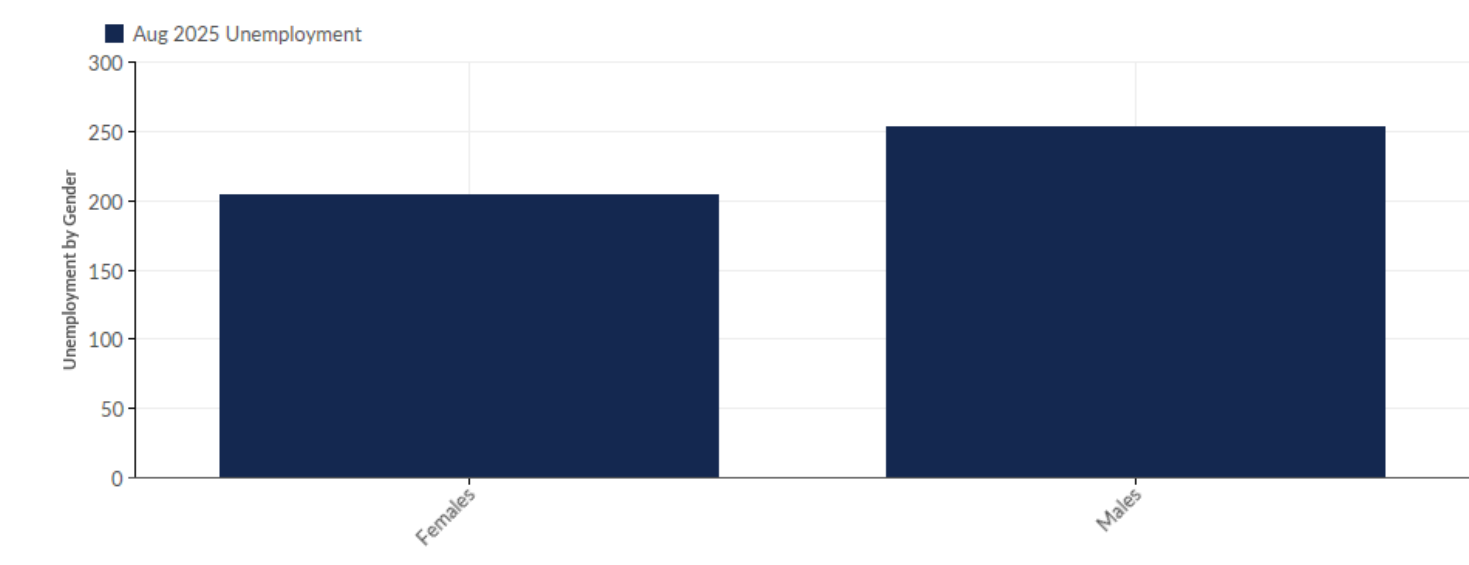

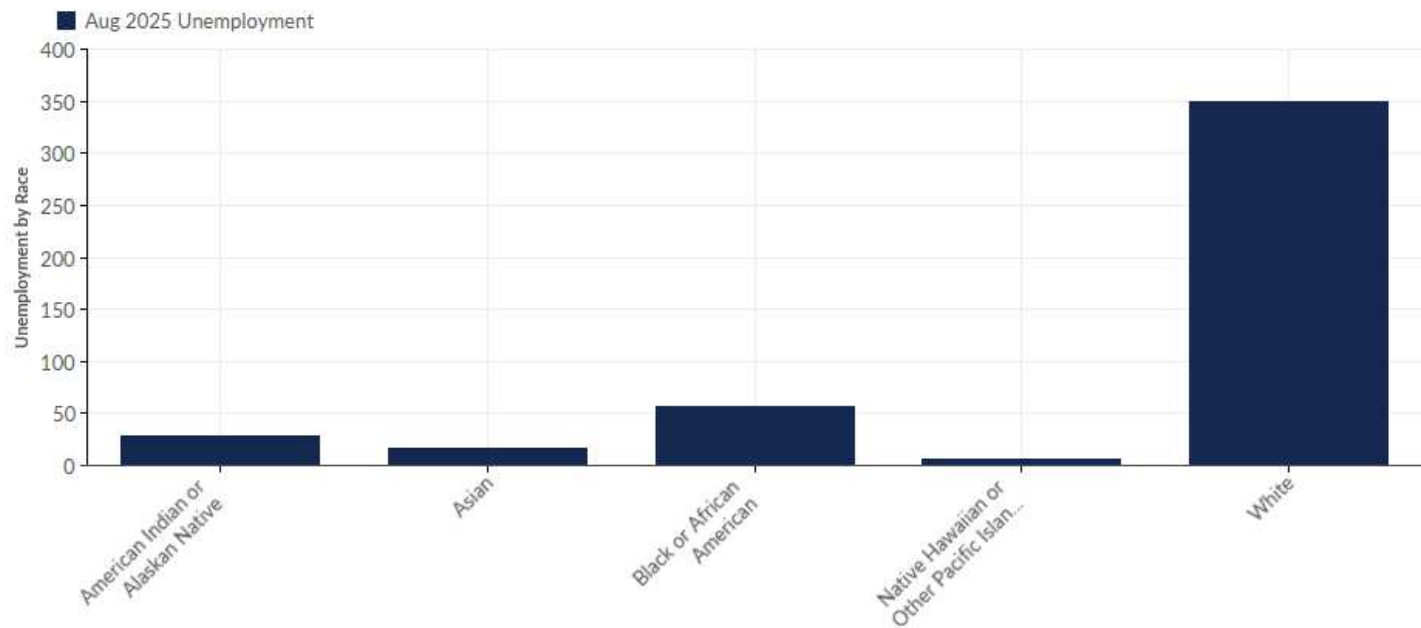

Unemployment by Gender



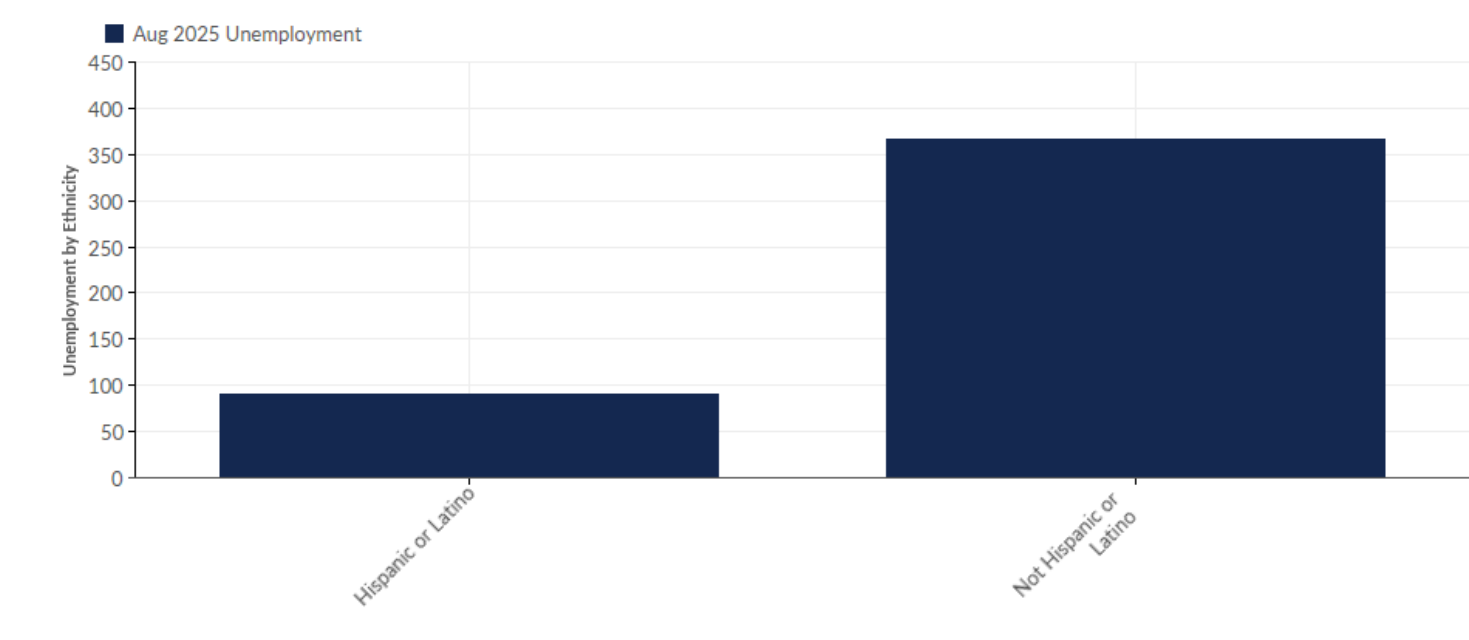

Unemployment by Ethnicity

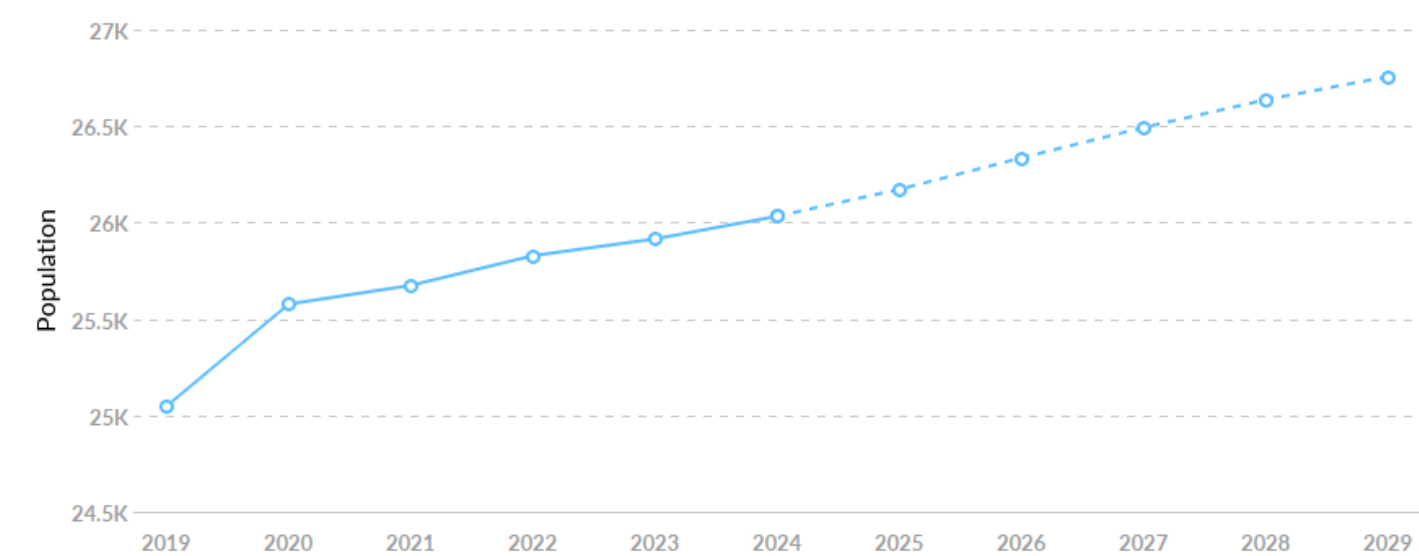

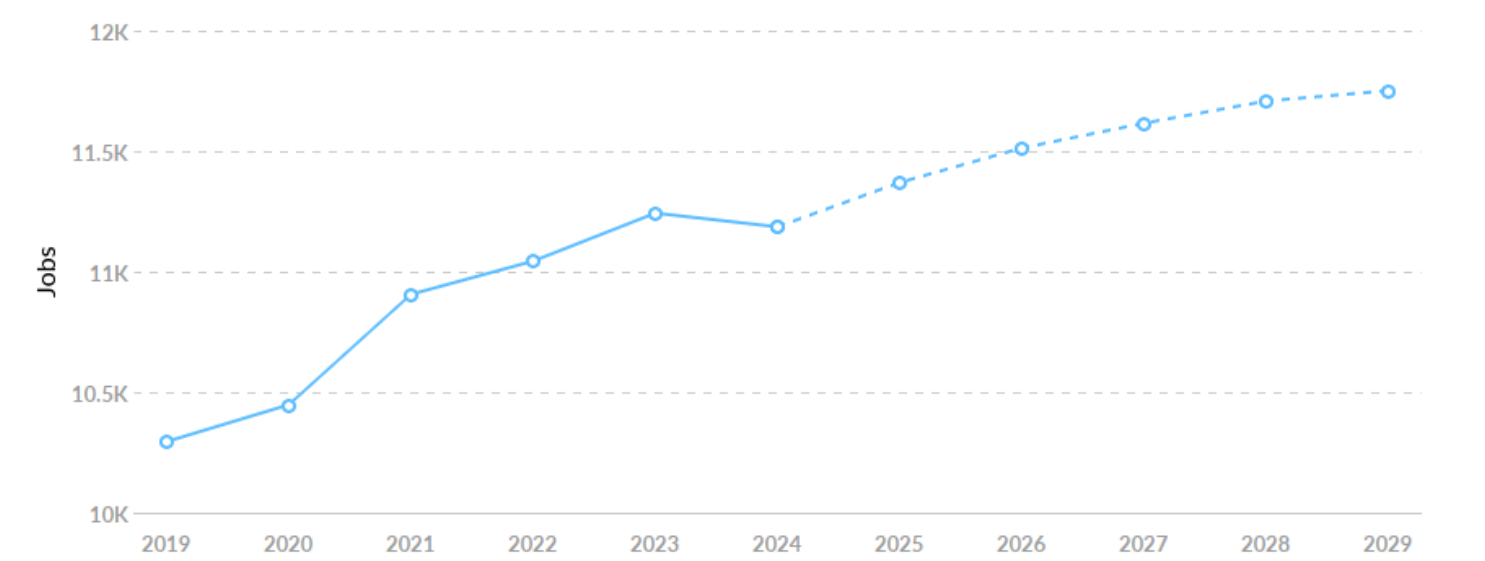

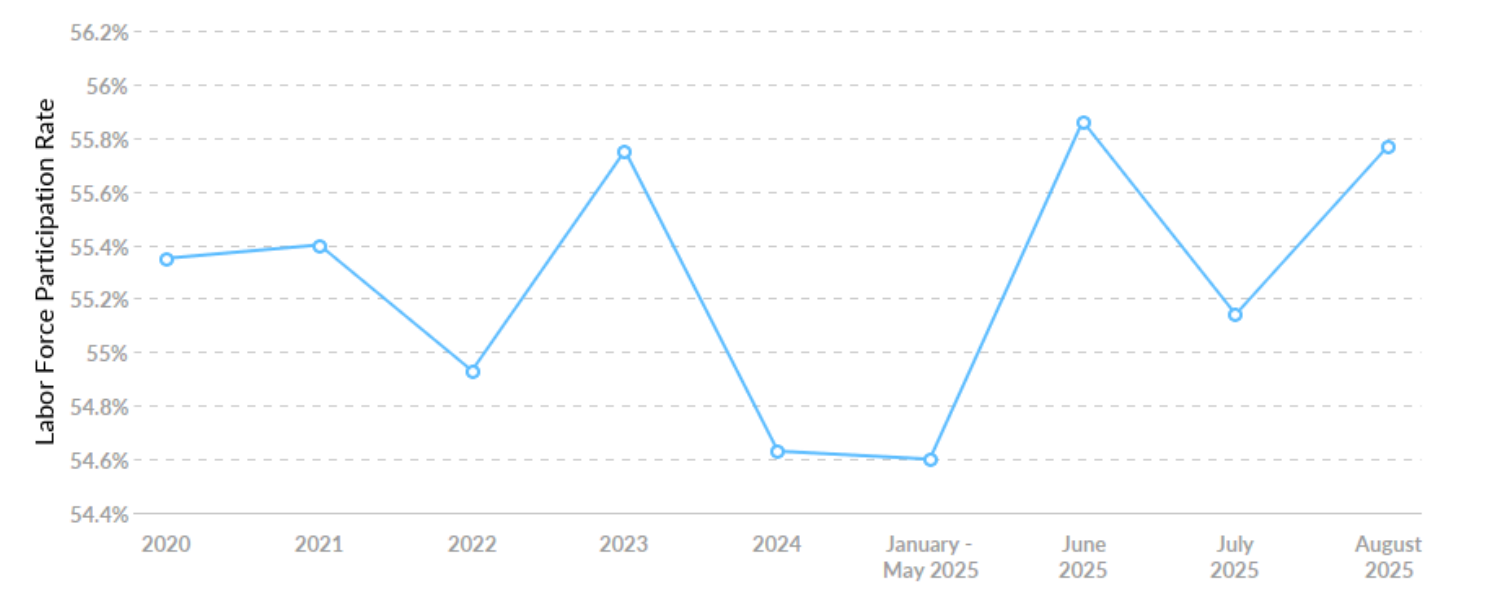
Job Trends

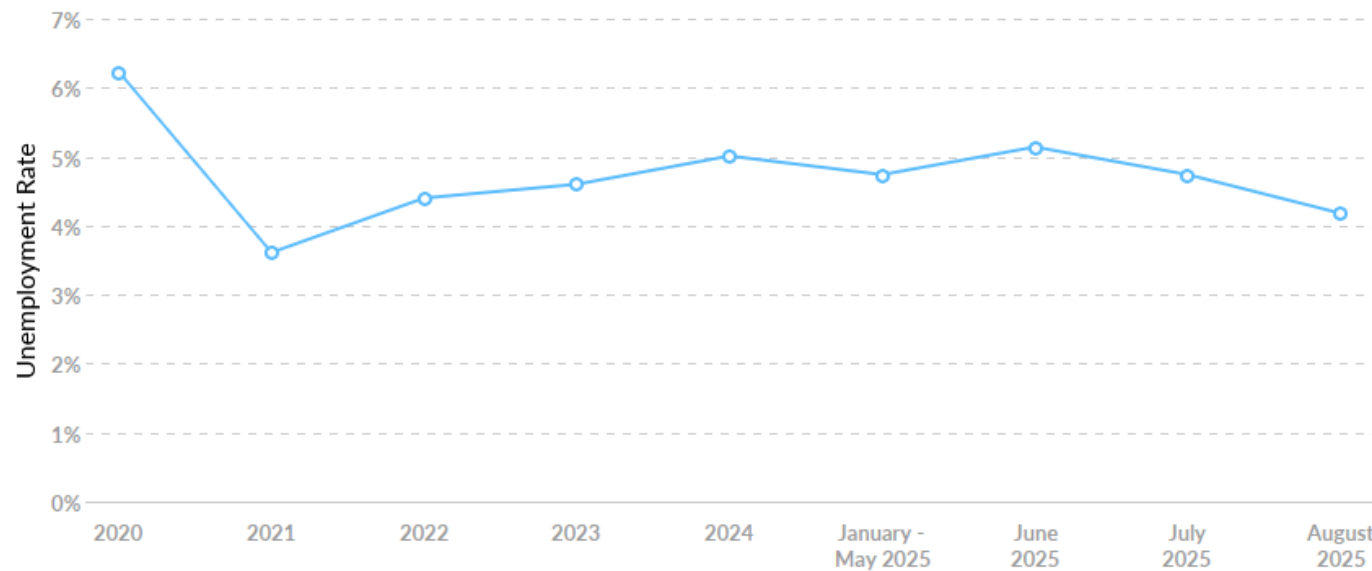

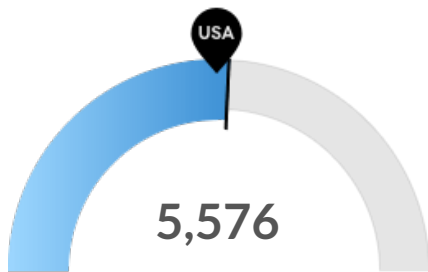
Unemployment Rate Trends

Churchill County, NV had an August 2025 unemployment rate of 4.18%, **decreasing from 6.23%** 5 years before.



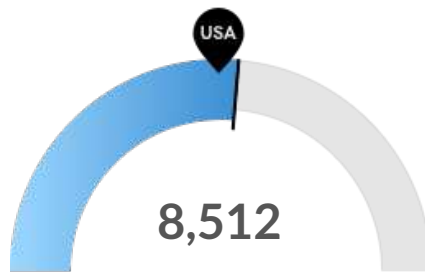

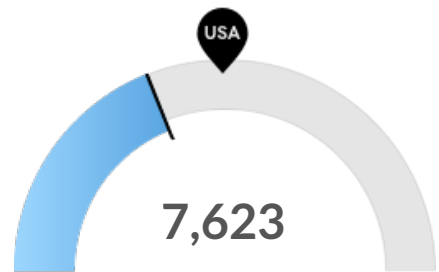
Millennials

Churchill County, NV has 5,576 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 5,329.



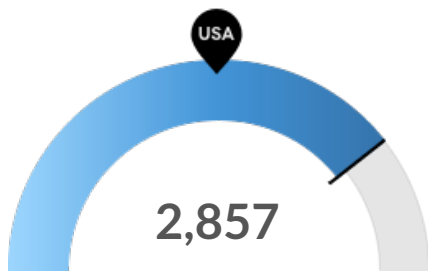
Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is about average in Churchill County, NV. The national average for an area this size is 7,872 people 55 or older, while there are 8,512 here.



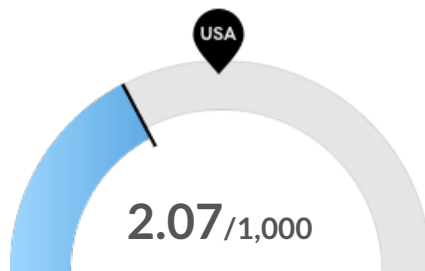
Racial Diversity

Racial diversity is low in Churchill County, NV. The national average for an area this size is 11,074 racially diverse people, while there are 7,623 here.



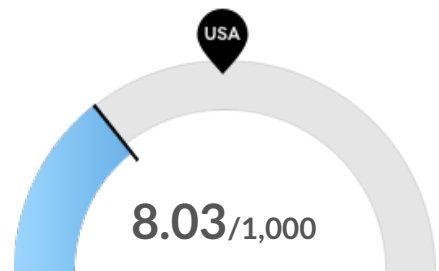
Veterans

Churchill County, NV has 2.07 violent crimes per 1,000 people. The national rate is 3.38 per 1,000 people.

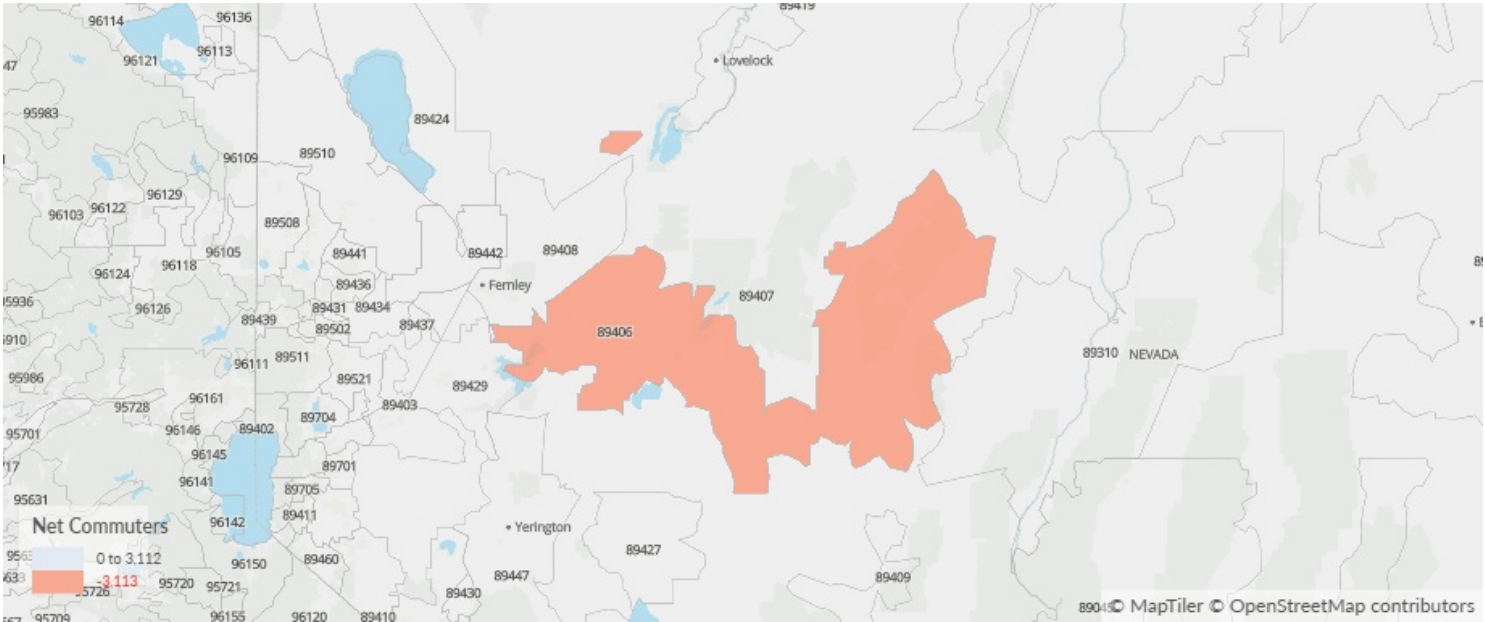


Property Crime

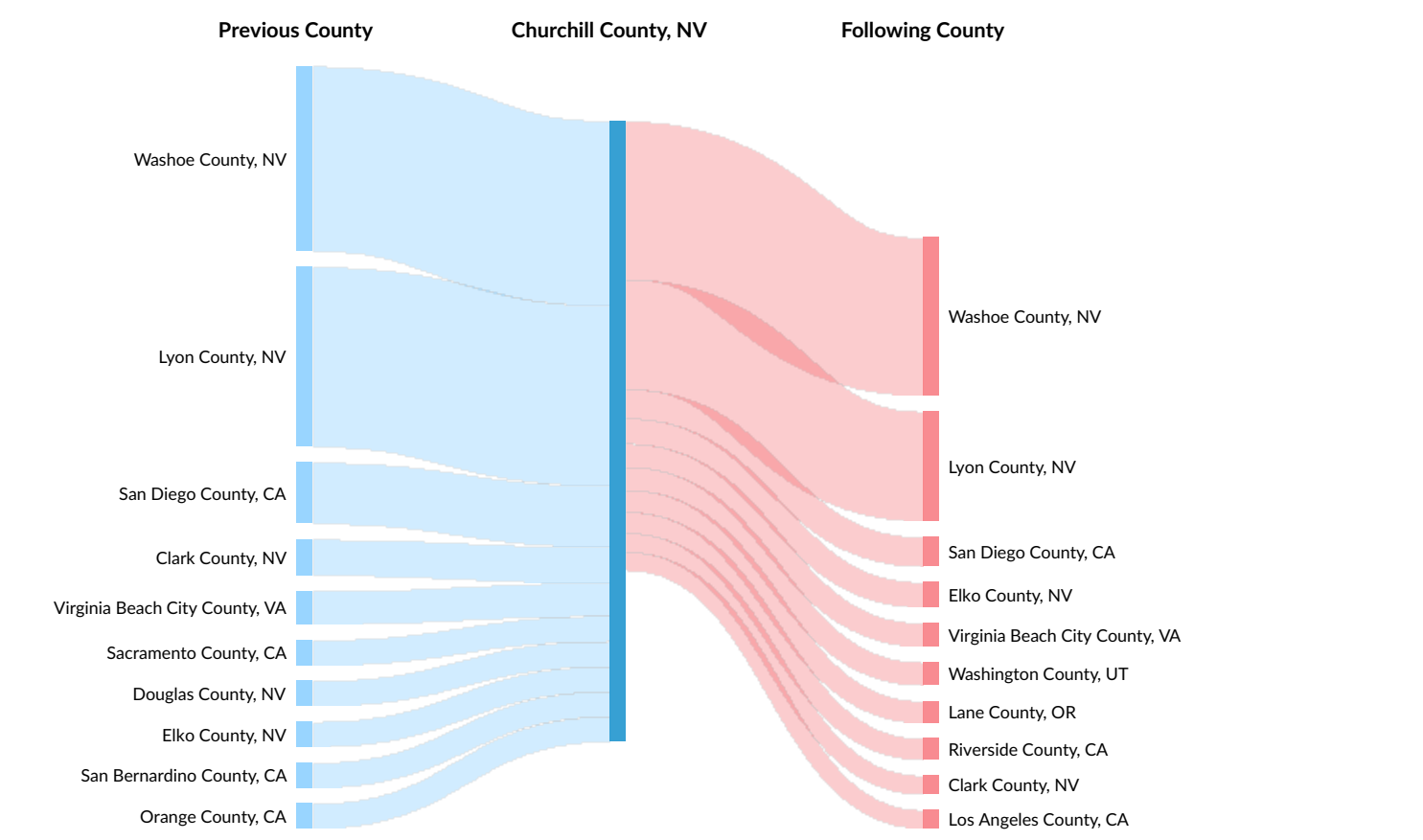

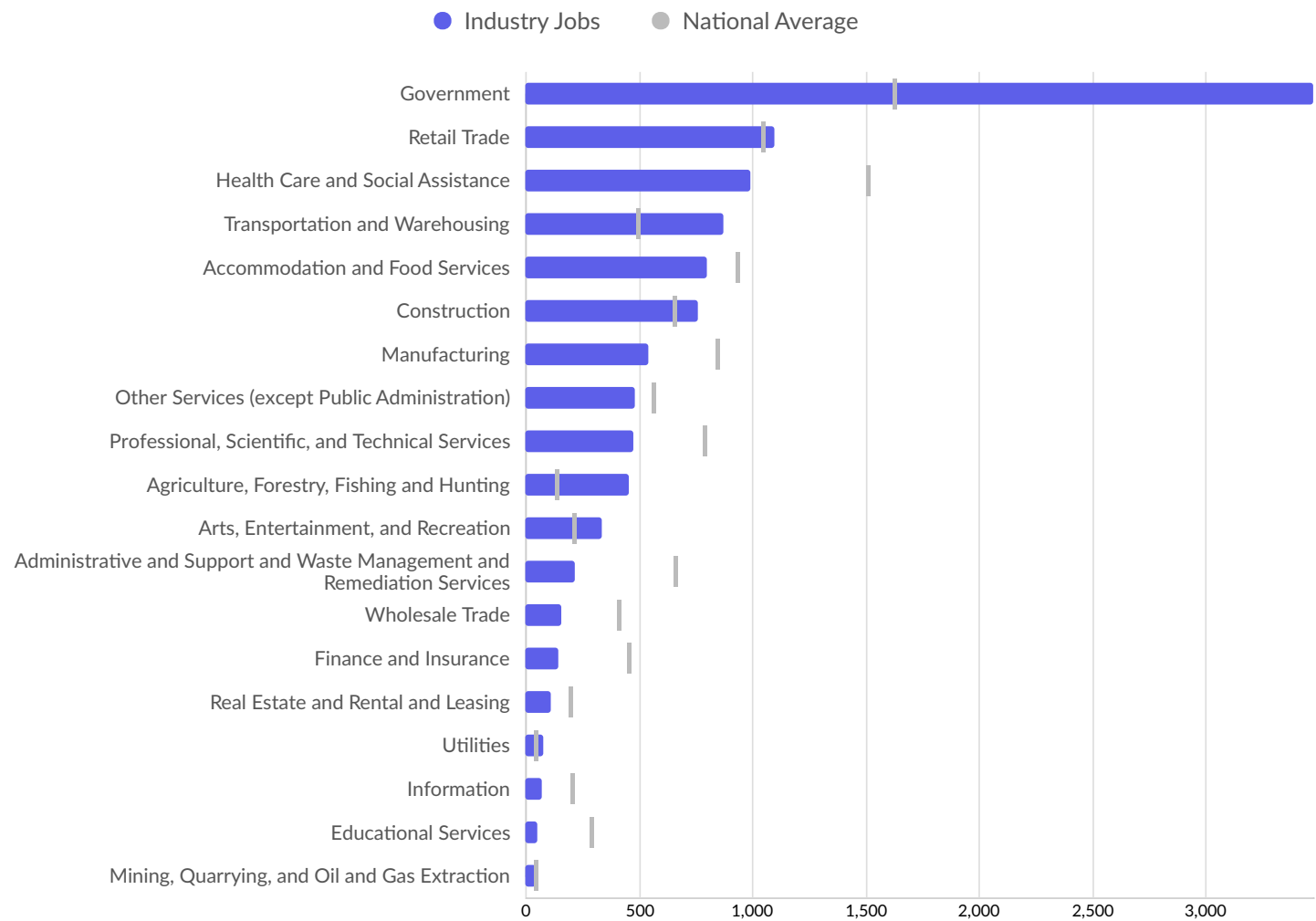

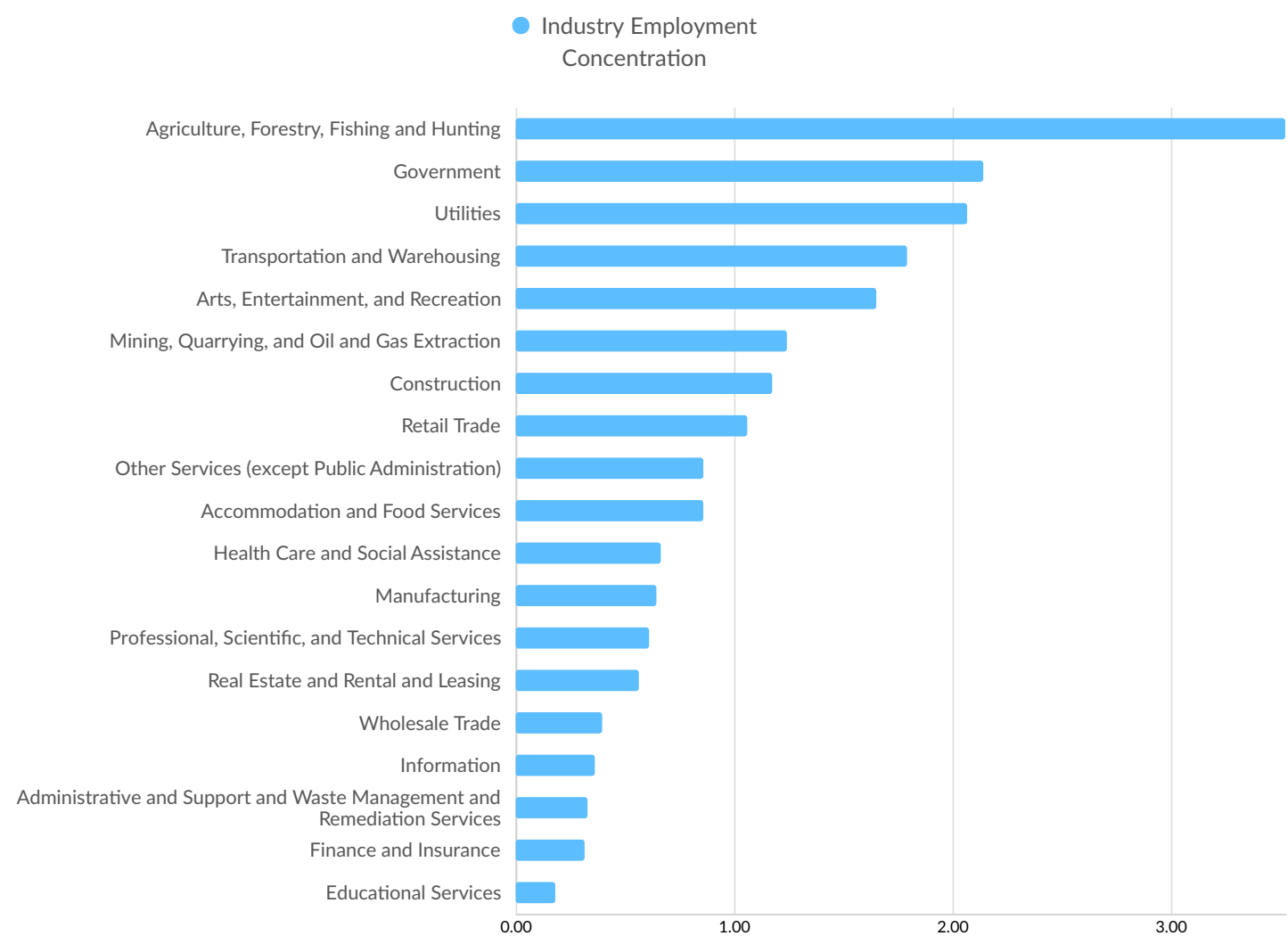

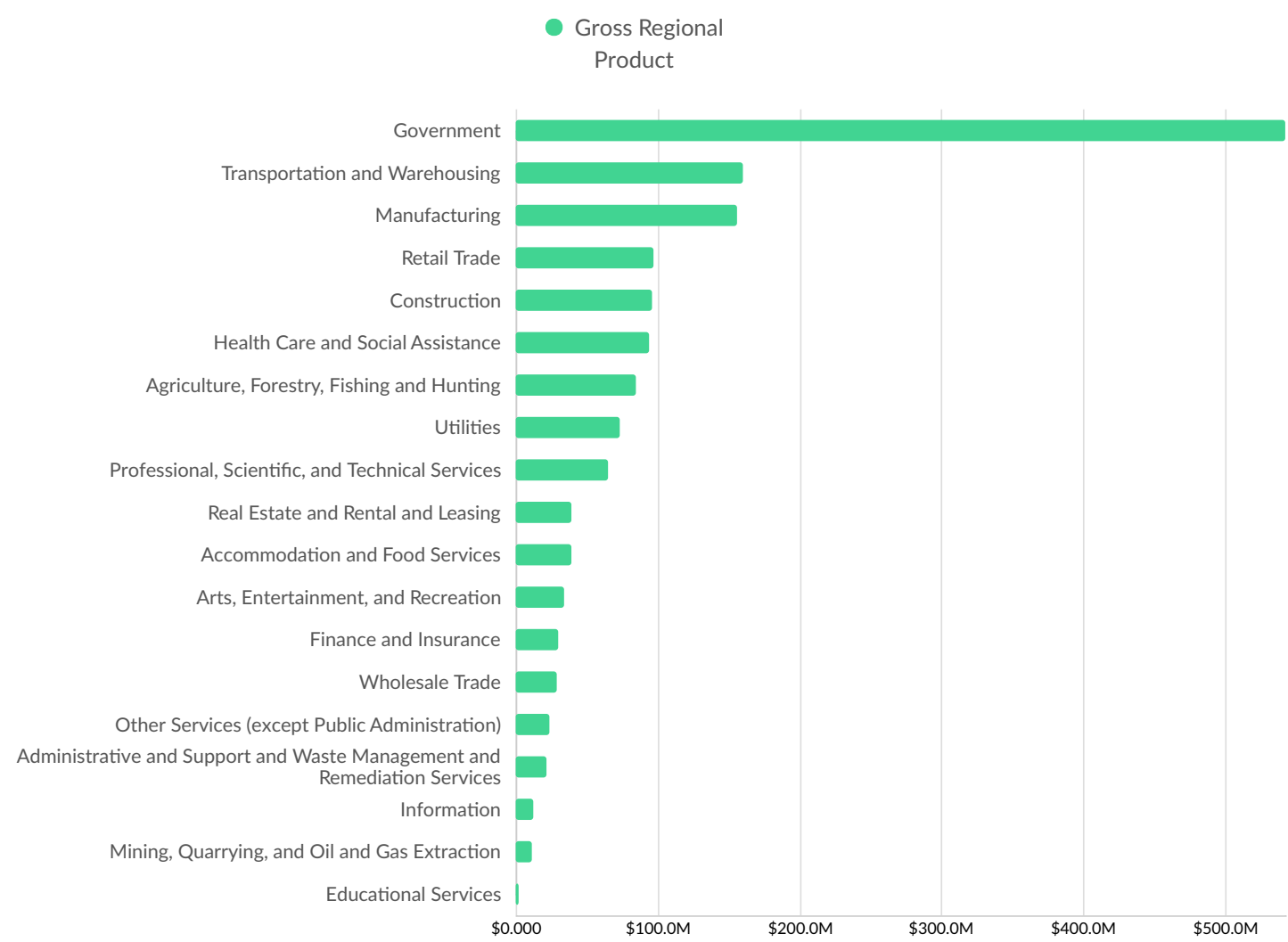
Top Growing Industries



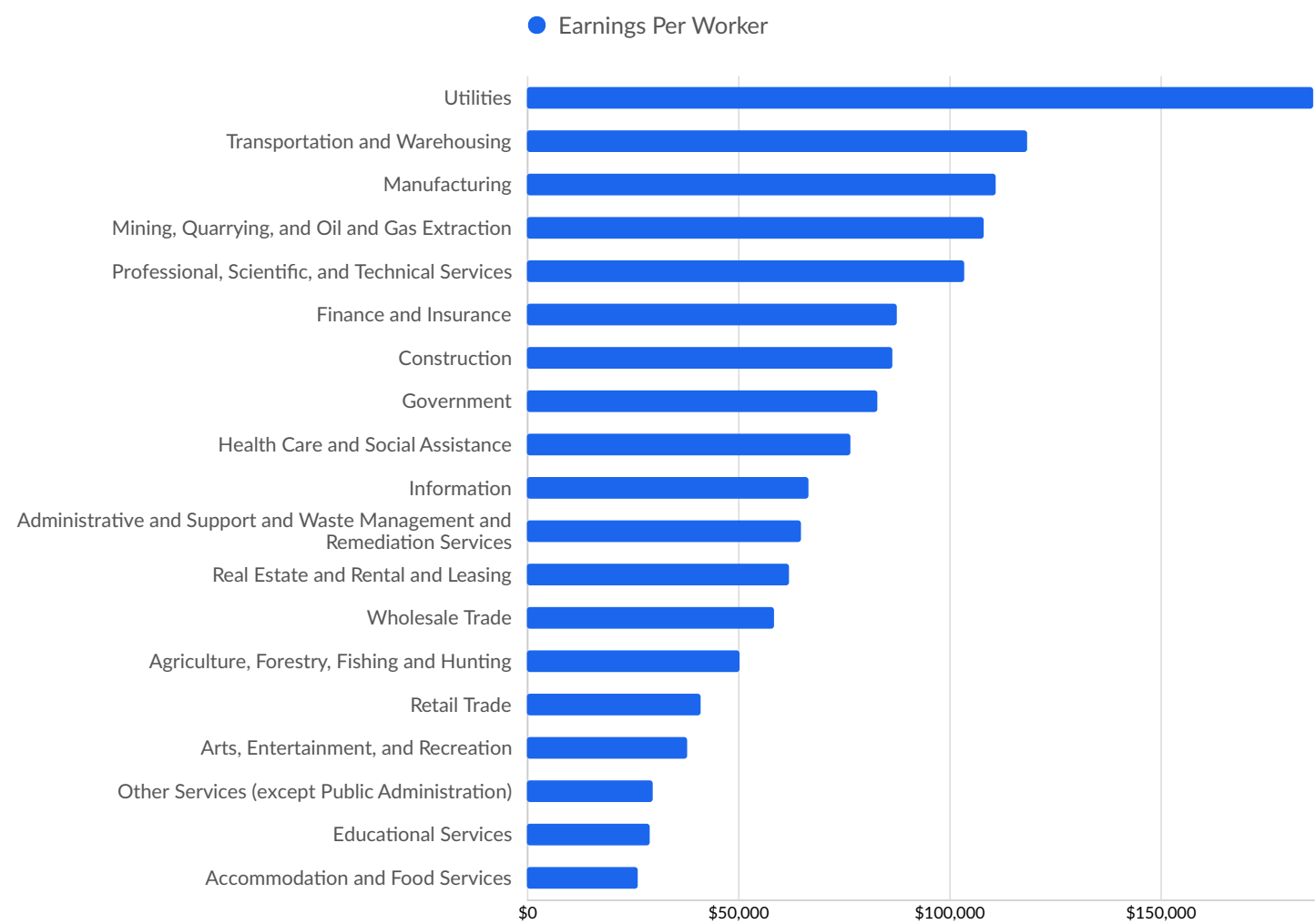
Top Industry Employment Concentration

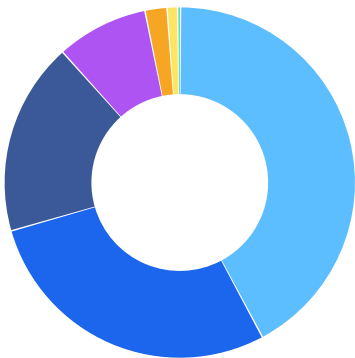

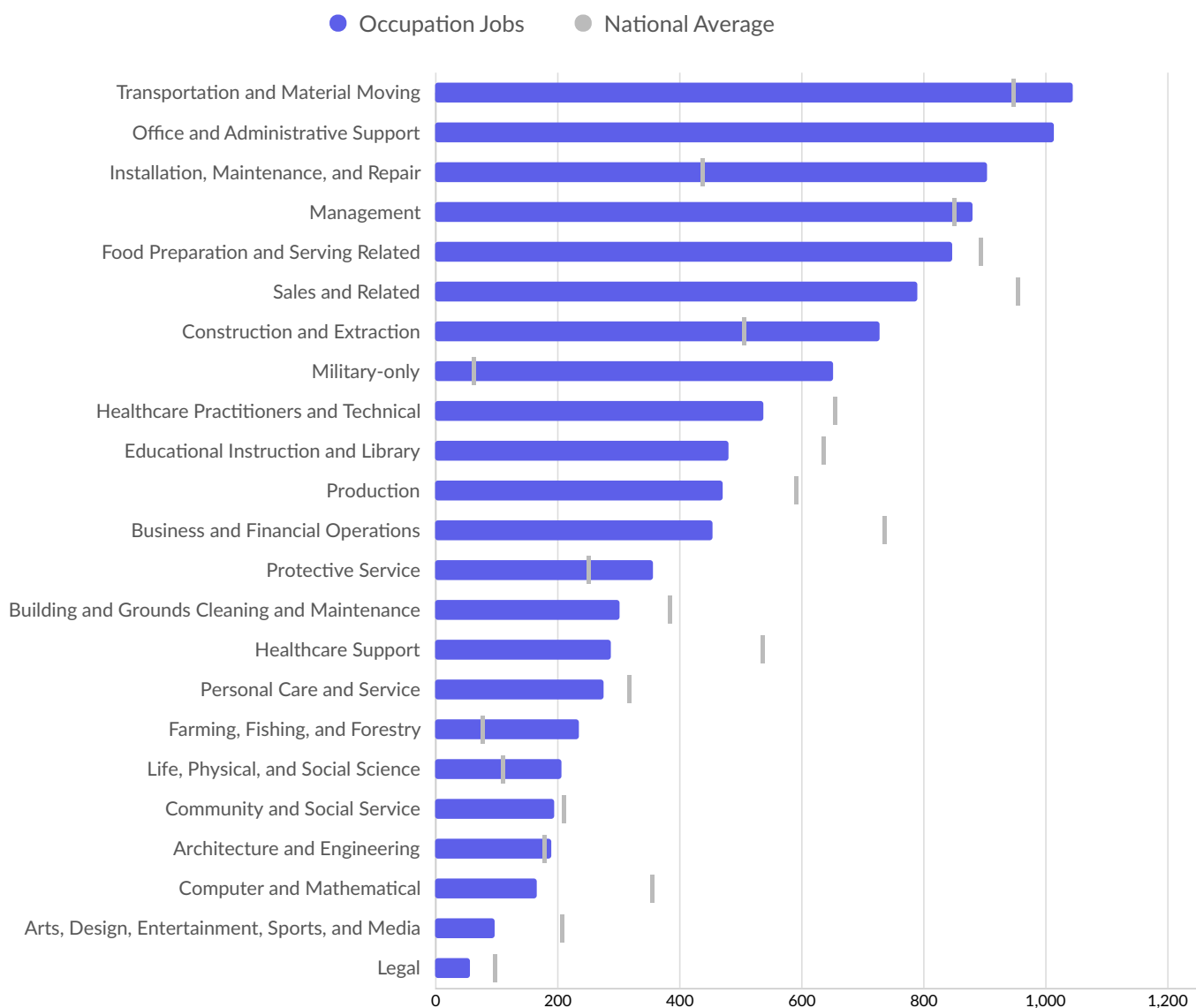

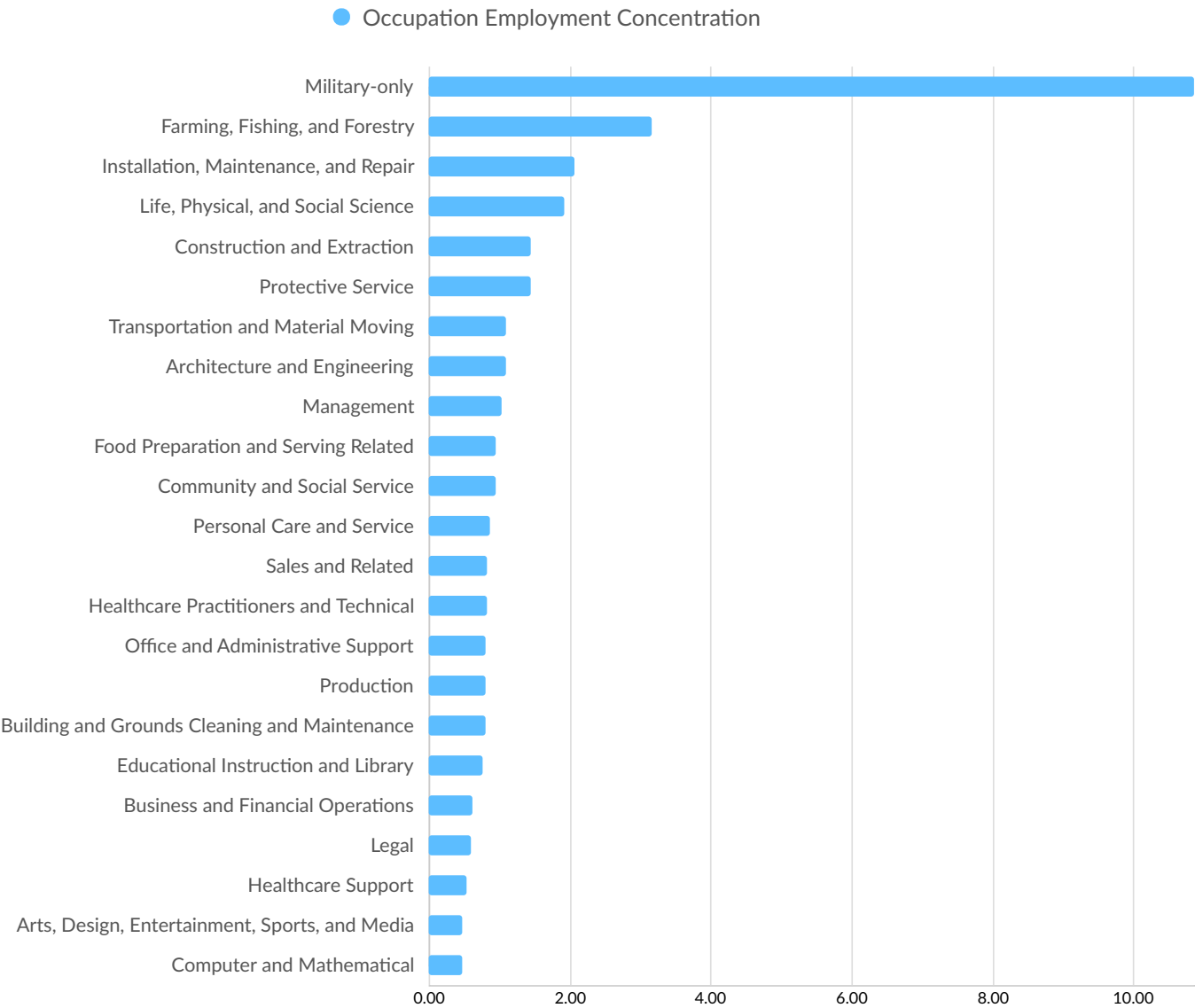

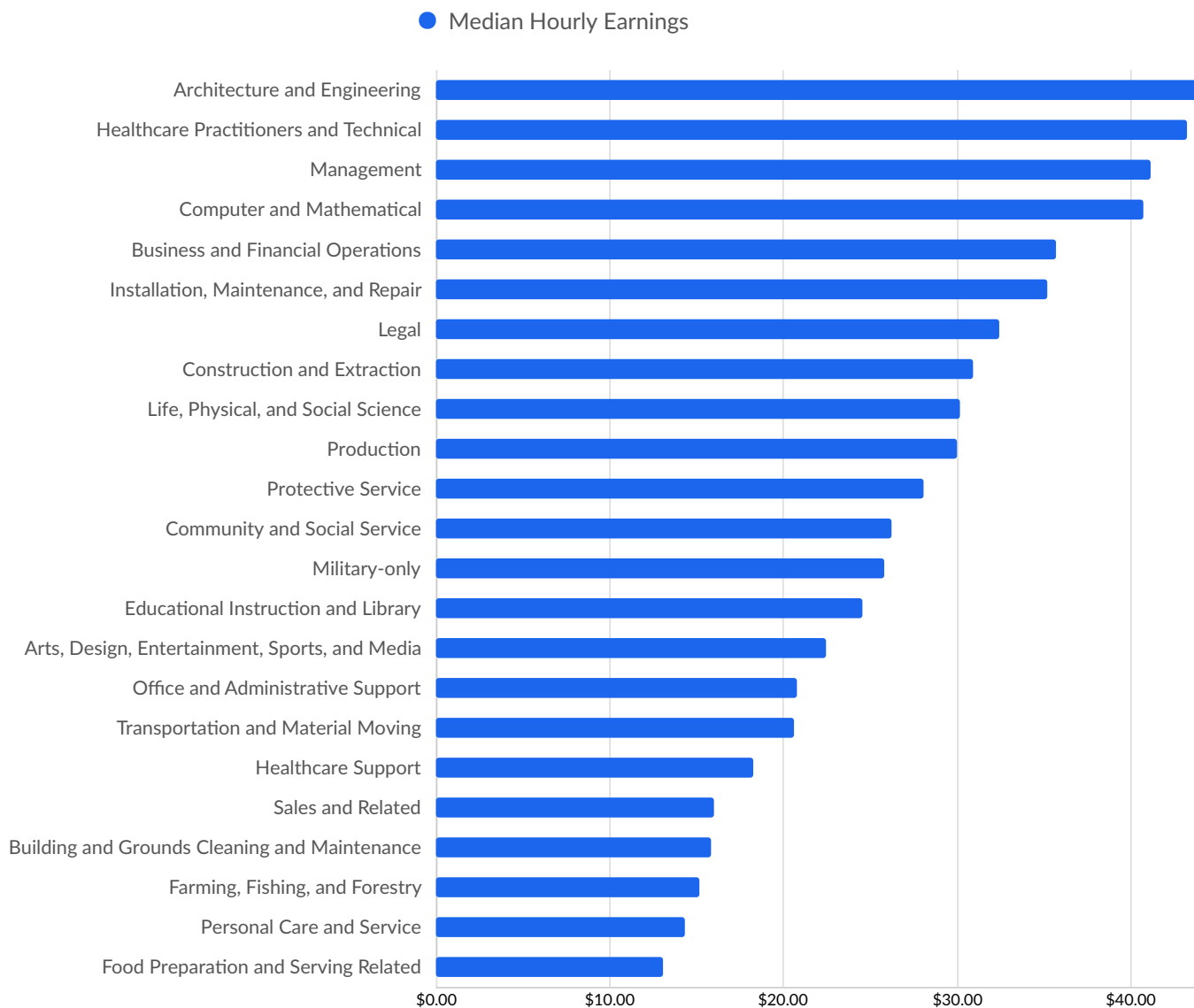
Top Growing Occupations



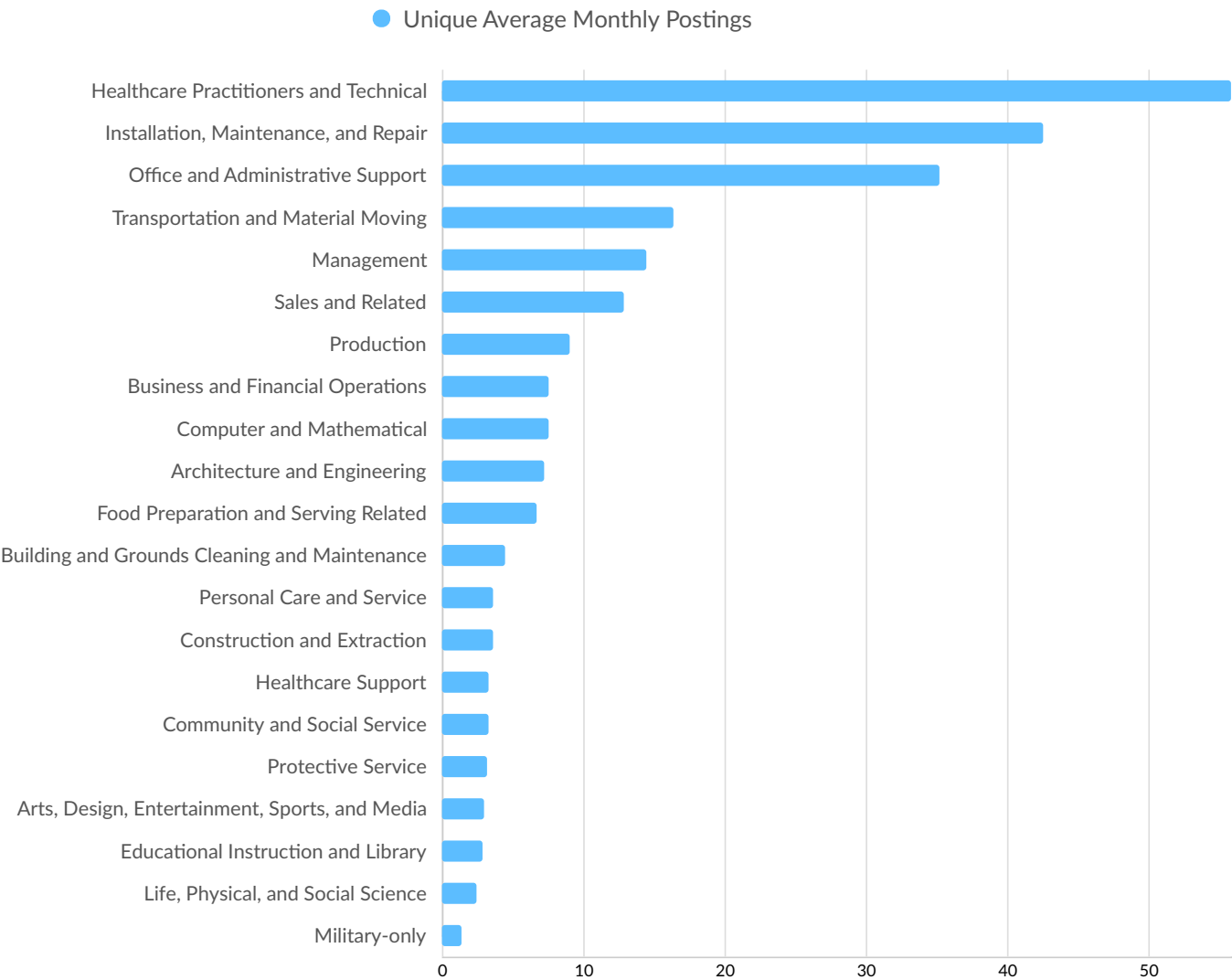
Top Occupation Employment Concentration



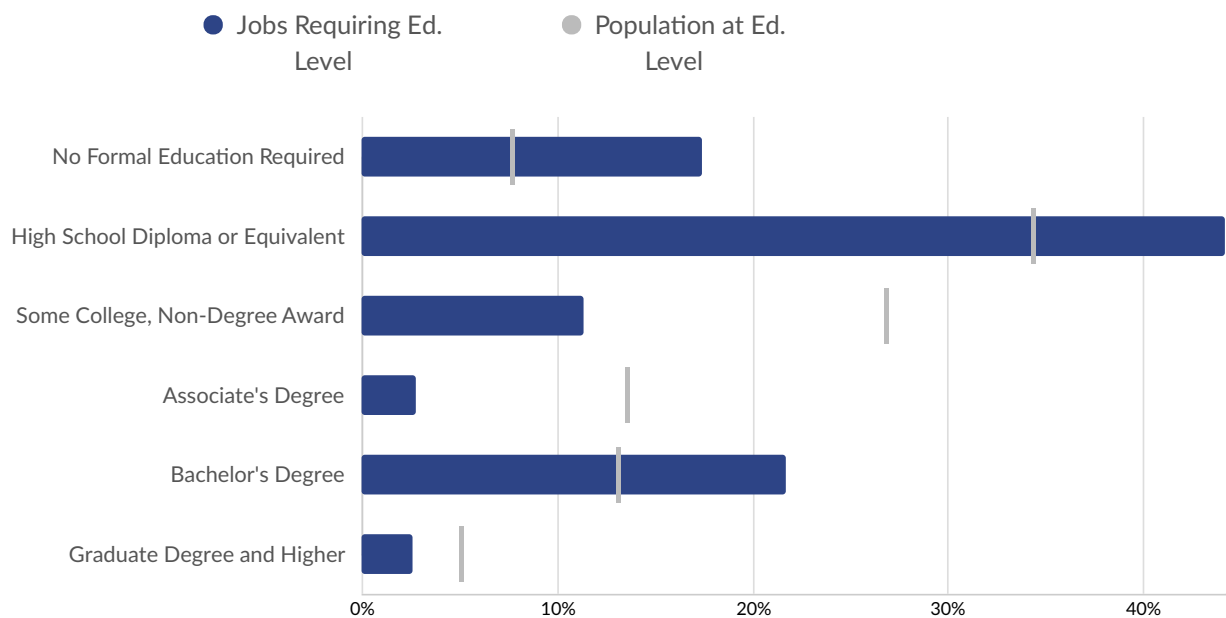
Top Occupation Earnings
