- The top three industries in 2024 are Traveler Accommodation, Restaurants and Other Eating Places, and Education and Hospitals (Local Government).




Aug 2025 Labor Force Breakdown






Unemployment by Gender



Unemployment by Ethnicity







Job Trends



Labor Force Participation Rate Trends




Clark County, NV had an August 2025 unemployment rate of 5.64%, decreasing from 15.72% 5 years before.






Clark County, NV has 527,855 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 491,072.




Veterans

Clark County, NV has 139,623 veterans. The national average for an area this size is 115,819.




Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is about average in Clark County, NV. The national average for an area this size is 725,363 people 55 or older, while there are 684,475 here.




Violent Crime

Racial diversity is high in Clark County, NV. The national average for an area this size is 1,020,441 racially diverse people, while there are 1,498,907 here.




Property Crime








Top Growing Industries






Top Industry Employment Concentration






Top Industry GRP




