- As of 2024 the region's population increased by 2.8% since 2019, growing by 1,483. Population is expected to increase by 2.1% between 2024 and 2029, adding 1,160.
- From 2019 to 2024, jobs declined by 0.4% in Elko County, NV from 24,237 to 24,138. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 4.4% by 4.8%. As the number of jobs declined, the labor force participation rate decreased from 71.7% to 65.1% between 2019 and 2024.
- Concerning educational attainment, **11.2% of Elko County, NV residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (10.3% below the national average), and **11.0% hold an Associate's Degree** (2.2% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2024 are Traveler Accommodation, Restaurants and Other Eating Places, and Education and Hospitals (Local Government).




Aug 2025 Labor Force Breakdown






Unemployment by Gender



Unemployment by Ethnicity







Job Trends








Millennials

Elko County, NV has 11,892 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 11,129.




Veterans

Elko County, NV has 2,726 veterans. The national average for an area this size is 2,675.




Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is low in Elko County, NV. The national average for an area this size is 16,438 people 55 or older, while there are 14,009 here.




Violent Crime

Elko County, NV has 3.37 violent crimes per 1,000 people. The national rate is 3.38 per 1,000 people.




Racial Diversity

Racial diversity is low in Elko County, NV. The national average for an area this size is 23,125 racially diverse people, while there are 19,482 here.




Property Crime








Top Growing Industries






Top Industry Employment Concentration






Top Industry GRP



Top Occupation Employment Concentration




